YARN USAGE

Teddy basserne H 27 cm:

Go handmade Vintage: 50 g

Go handmade Teddy: 100 g

MATERIAL

Crochet hook: 3,0 - 3,5 mm

Eyes: 10 mm

Filling



Crocheted in Go handmades Teddy:
100% Polyester, 50 g/65 m and Go handmades
Vintage: 70% Wool/30% Bamboo, 25 g/60 m

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YARN USAGE:

50 g Go handmade Vintage
100 g Go handmade Teddy

MATERIAL:

Eyes 10 mm
Filling
Crochet hook 3,0 - 3,5 mm

All stated yarn lengths are for guidance only.

It is recommended to add the filling as you go along.

st(s)	Stitch(es)
cr	Centre ring (2 ch, work the specified number of stitches into the second stitch from the hook)
ch	Chain stitch
dc	Double crochet
1 dc inc	Increase (2 dc in one st)
dc 2 tog	Decrease (2 dc worked together)
{...}	The instructions shown in these brackets should be repeated for the whole round/row.
(..)	At the end of the round/row - indicates the total number of stitches.

Work with *Teddy Yarn*.

1.)	cr with 6 dc	(6)
2.)	{1 dc inc}	(12)
3.)	{1 dc, 1 dc inc}	(18)
4.)	{2 dc, 1 dc inc}	(24)
5.)	{3 dc, 1 dc inc}	(30)
6.)	{4 dc, 1 dc inc}	(36)
7.)	{5 dc, 1 dc inc}	(42)
8.)	{6 dc, 1 dc inc}	(48)
9.)	{7 dc, 1 dc inc}	(54)
10.)	{8 dc, 1 dc inc}	(60)
11. - 15.)	60 dc	(60)
16.)	{8 dc, 1 dc dec}	(54)
17.)	{7 dc, 1 dc dec}	(48)

Add filling to the body.

HEAD

Start with *Vintage Yarn*.

1.)	cr with 6 dc	(6)
2.)	{1 dc inc}	(12)
3.)	{1 dc, 1 dc inc}	(18)
4.)	18 dc	(18)
5.)	{2 dc, 1 dc inc}	(24)
6.)	24 dc	(24)
7.)	{3 dc, 1 dc inc}	(30)
8.)	{4 dc, 1 dc inc}	(36)
9.)	{11 dc, 1 dc inc}	(39)

10.)	39 dc	(39)
11.)	15 dc, 9 dc inc, 15 dc	(48)
12.)	{7 dc, 1 dc inc}	(54)

Turn the head so that the 9 increased sts from round 11 are facing up (as the forehead).

Add the eyes in round 8 with a distance of 9 st.

The stoppers for the eyes are added from the inside, push them on with the aid of a coin if necessary.

Change to *Teddy Yarn*.

17.)	{7 dc, 1 dc dec}	(48)
18.)	{6 dc, 1 dc dec}	(42)
19.)	{5 dc, 1 dc dec}	(36)
20.)	36 dc	(36)

Add filling to the head.

Cut the yarn and pull through the stitches, tighten and sew the head together.

Shape the head and the eye hollows:

With vintage yarn, thread a needle with approx. 25 cm yarn

Put the needle in from under the chin and out at the side of the eye.

Guide the thread around some stitches by the eye and then back out under the chin. Tighten the yarn to form the hollow around the eye, tighten the yarn through a few stitches under the chin.

Repeat for the other side of the same eye.

The hollow for the eye is now completed. Should you want the hollow deeper the process can be repeated and a stitch added towards the top of the eye.


Remember to always keep the yarn tight when the needle is pulled out under the chin, during the

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sewing to keep the tension and for the hollow to become permanent.

Repeat the process for the other eye
See illustration.

Embroider nose/mouth as an upside down "Y".
Sew the head onto the body.



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EAR (2 X)

Work with *Vintage Yarn*.

1.)	cr with 6 dc	(6)
2.)	{1 dc, 1 dc inc}	(9)
3.)	{2 dc, 1 dc inc}	(12)
4.)	{3 dc, 1 dc inc}	(15)
5.)	{4 dc, 1 dc inc}	(18)
6.)	{5 dc, 1 dc inc}	(21)
7. - 13.)	21 dc	(21)

Press the ear together a bit at the opening and attach to the head – at the same height as the eyes.

ARM (2 X)

Start with *Vintage Yarn*.

1.)	Crochet 9 ch st, then start at the 2. chain from the hook. 1 dc inc in 1. ch, 6 dc, 3 dc in the next ch. Now crochet 7 dc on the opposite side.	(18)
2. - 9.)	18 dc	(18)
10.)	2 dc, 1 dc dec, 7 dc, 1 dc dec, 5 dc	(16)
	Change to the <i>Teddy</i> yarn.	
11. - 26.)	16 dc	(16)
27.)	{1 dc dec}	(8)
28.)	{1 dc dec}	(4)

Stuff the arms with filling.

Sew the arms onto the body.

LEG (2 X)

Start with the *Vintage yarn*.

1.)	Crochet 11 ch st, then start at the 2. chain from the hook. 1 dc inc in 1. ch, 8 dc, 3 dc in the next ch. Now crochet 9 dc on the opposite side	(22)
2. - 9.)	22 dc	(22)
10.)	1 dc, 1 dc dec, 9 dc, 1 dc dec, 8 dc	(20)
	Change to the <i>Teddy</i> yarn.	
11. - 24.)	20 dc	(20)
25.)	{1 dc dec}	(10)
26.)	{1 dc dec}	(5)

Stuff the legs with filling.

Attach the legs onto the bottom of the body.

Sew through the paws 2 - 3 times with approx. 25 cm *Vintage yarn*. Add tension to give the desired shape and fasten the ends.

Good to know

Gohandmade's collection is developed and handcrafted by the expert - passionated crocheters that loves their crafts. All are crocheted to meet what we find is a medium tightness and what suits best.

Hook Size & Tension

Crocheters crochet very differently: some crochet with a hook size 2,0 mm and obtain the same size of design and quality as a person who crochets with a hook size 4,0 mm. We owe this knowledge to the team of crocheters who join us. The key to crochet a specific size is a lot about the crochet style/hands/skills, rather than the size of hook. Therefore, we will recommend a range of hook sizes.



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
