Almue Shawl

A BEAUTIFUL TRIANGULAR SHAWL WITH STRIPES IN MATCHING
COLOURS AND A SIMPLE YET ELEGANT LACE PATTERN.
A MUST HAVE IN YOUR WARDROPE

SIZE
Onesize

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Wingspan:

200 cm

Center Depth:

85 cm

YARN

CAMILLA VAD LAMBSWOOL 9/3 (New
Zealand Lambswool, 100% wool, 300m / 328 yds
per 100 g)

A: 100 g col. 14 Stålgrå

B: 100 g col. 30 Mørk Messing

C: 100 g col. 20 Duck Egg

D: 100 g col. 16 Mellem Grå

E: 100 g col. 15 Antracit

NEEDLES

Circular needles, **4,0 mm / US 6 (80 cm**
circular needles)

GAUGE

20 sts & 40 rows = 10 x 10 cm in garter stitch on
4mm needles

PLEASE NOTE

The shawl is worked sideways in garter
stitch. Increases are made only on the right
side of the shawl.

INCREASES

Pick up the strand between the sts and knit it tbl.

FORKORTELSER

k = knit

p = purl

st(s) = stitch(es)

tog = together

inc = increase

yo = yarn over

tbl = through the back loop

col. = colour

Directions

Cast on 3 sts on 4.0 mm / US 6 needles with one strand of col. **A**

Row 1: Knit

Row 2: (right side) K2, make inc, k1 = 4 sts.

Row 3: Knit

Row 4: K3, make inc, k1 = 5 sts.

Row 5: Knit

Row 6: K3, make inc, k2 = 6 sts.

Row 7: Knit

Row 8: K3, make inc, k3 = 7 sts.

Continue to make inc on the right side after the first 3 sts till you have **20** sts on the needle. Maybe place a marker to remind you where to make the inc.

NARROW STRIPE

Change to col. **B** and continue to make inc after the first 3 sts on the right side and knit all sts on the back side. Knit 4 rows as described = 2 ridge with col. **B** = **22** sts.

WIDE STRIPE

Change to col. **C** and continue to make inc after the first 3 sts on the right side and knit all sts on the back side. Knit 8 rows as described = 2 ridge with col. **C** = **26** sts.

Lace ridge: K3, make inc, k1, *yo, k2tog* repeat to last 2 sts, k2.

Next row: Knit = **27** sts.

Continue to make inc after the first 3 sts on the right side and knit all sts on the back side. Knit 6 rows as described = ridge with col. **C** = **30** sts.

Make a narrow stripe with col. **B**, make a wide stripe with col. **D**, make a narrow stripe with col. **B**, make a wide stripe with col. **E**.

Continue this way to knit narrow and wide stripes as described. The narrow stripes are knitted with col. **B** and the wide stripes are knitted in this order; **A**, **C**, **D**, **E** and repeated till you have **23** narrow stripes.

Knit another wide stripe with col. **E**.
Change to col. **B** and knit the first 3 rows of the narrow stripe = **252** sts.

Next row: Bind off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends. Wash the shawl and lay it flat to dry.

Use the left over yarn for tassels or pompom.
