FREE CROCHET PATTERN

Lacy Flowers Scarf



TYPE: Crochet

DESIGNER: Amy Gunderson for Premier® Yarns

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS:

Width: 14"

Length: 78"

GAUGE:

25 sts x 21 rows = 4" in patt

Save time, check your gauge.

HOOKS & NOTIONS:

- US Size D-3 (3.25 mm) or size needed to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle

MATERIALS:

Premier® Yarns Cotton Sprout® Stripes
(100% Cotton; 7oz/200g, 874yds/800m)

- 2172-05 Cornflower Stripe – 1 ball

SKILLS/TECHNIQUES USED IN THIS PATTERN:

- Chain, single and double crochet stitches.

STITCH GUIDE

Shell: [Dc, ch 3, dc, ch 3, dc] in st or sp indicated.

V-Stitch (V-St): [Dc, ch 3, dc] in st or sp indicated.

Spike Stitch (Spike St): Insert hook into dc 2 rows below, work sc around ch-5 of previous row.

Lacy Flowers Pattern (*begins with multiple of 8 chs + 7*)

Row 1: Dc in 7th ch from hook (skipped 6 chs count as dc + ch 3), *sk 3 chs, sc in next ch, sk 3 chs**, **Shell** in next ch; rep from * across, ending last rep at **, [dc, ch 3, dc] in last ch, turn.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in first dc, ch 2, ***V-St** in next sc**, ch 5, sk next **Shell**; rep from * across, ending last rep at **, ch 2, sc in last dc, turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in first st, **Shell** in **V-st** **, **Spike St** in dc 2 rows below; rep from * across, ending last rep at **, sc in last sc, turn.

Row 4: Ch 4 (counts as dc + ch 1), dc in same sc, *ch 5, sk next **Shell****, **V-St** in next sc; rep from * across, ending last rep at **, [dc, ch 1, dc] in last sc, turn.

Row 5: Ch 6 (counts as dc + ch 3), dc in first ch-1 sp, ***Spike St** in next dc 2 rows below**, **Shell** in **V-St**; rep from * across, ending last rep at **, dc in ch-1 sp, ch 3, dc in last dc, turn.

Rep Rows 2-5 for patt.

PATTERN NOTES

This rectangular Scarf is worked flat from end to end.

SCARF

Ch 95. Work in **Lacy Flowers** patt until yarn is gone, ending with a Row 3 or 5 of patt. Fasten off.

FINISHING


Weave in ends. Block piece to finished measurements.


