Abbreviations:

BO = bind off.

CO = cast on.

sl1k = slip a stitch knit-wise.

st(s) = stitch (es).

k = knit

 **k2tog** = knit two (2) stitches together.

 **ssk** = slip, slip, knit: [Slip a stitch knitwise] twice.

Insert left needle from left to right into fronts of both stitches, and knit together through back loops.

 **k3tog** = knit three (3) stitches together.

 **sl1-k2tog-ssso** = slip a stitch knitwise, k2tog, pass slipped stitch over k2tog.

p = purl

 **p2tog** = purl two (2) stitches together.

 **p3tog** = purl three (3) stitches together.

yo = yarn over

RN = right needle

LN = left needle

w&t = wrap and turn

rs = right side

ws = wrong side

(1st on RN) = 1 st remaining on the right needle.

/ = next

Yarn:

A – Schachenmayr Tahiti 07607 - **200g**

(Start working with blue color area. Keep working until the middle of the yellow section and then start using the blue again. Alternatively, you can come up with your own color scheme).

B – Malabrigo Mechita 150 (Azul Profundo) - **100g**

Size: wide – 34 cm. / long – 180 cm (without fringe) or optional.

Needles: 2.5 mm (double-edged needles with sharp ends); 2mm (for Leaves).

Gauge: 28sts and 36 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm

Note: Please, read the entire pattern before starting the work.

I used “wrap and turn” (knit the indicated number of sts, wrap working yarn around next stitch, turn and knit back in the opposite direction), but any other short-row turn works just as well. Selvedge stitches are already included in this stitch count. Do not add any additional selvedge stitches.

In the wrong side YO of the previous row knit crossed stitch  to avoid holes in the knitted cloth.

If the execution of **Strip 2** (Rows 6 and “Dividing strip”) is difficult for you, then you can use the additional needles.

Special abbreviation:

“Dividing strip” = a narrow strip in a contrasting color to separate the multicolor strips.

I suggest you choose one of the options for the execution of this strip.

Option 1 (This option is easier):

Row 1 rs: Knit to the end row.

Row 2 ws: Sl1k, knit to last stitch, p1.

Option 2 (This option is more effective, but after the end of the row you will need to break off the Yarn B):

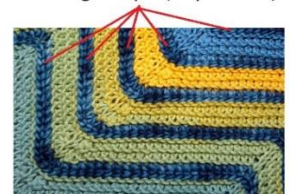
Start rs: **Horizontal braid** to the end of the row. Yarn “B” break off. Without turning. Move the work from left end to right end of the needle. Knit the next row on the right side again.

See the last page of this pattern for details on the **Horizontal braid**.

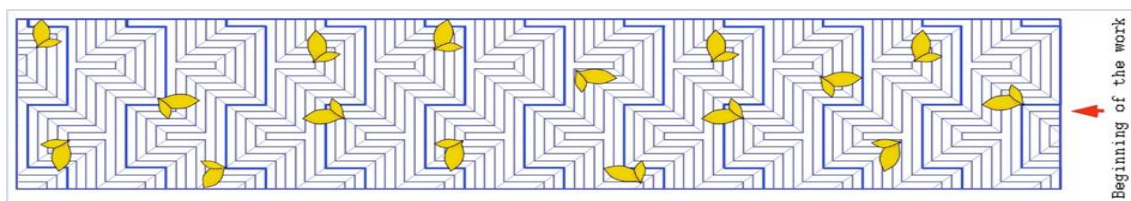

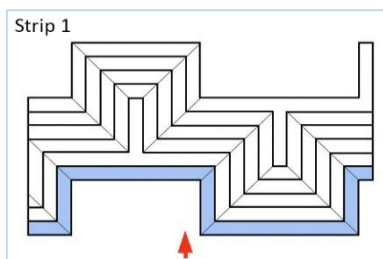

Yarn A CO 150sts.

Row 1 rs: K4, yo, k1, yo; k14, ssk, k1, k2tog; k40, ssk, k1, k2tog; k14, yo, k1, yo; k36, yo, k1, yo; k14, ssk, k1, k2tog; k9, p1.

Row 2 ws: Sl1k, k10, p1, k16, p1, k38, p1, k16, p1, k42, p1, k16, p1, k4, p1.

Row 3 rs: Sl1k, k4, yo, k1, yo; k14, ssk, k1, k2tog; k38, ssk, k1, k2tog; k14, yo, k1, yo; k38, yo, k1, yo; k14, ssk, k1, k2tog; k8, p1.

Row 4 ws: Sl1k, k7, k2tog, p1, ssk; k14, yo, p1, yo; k40, yo, p1, yo;

k14, k2tog, p1, ssk; k36, k2tog, p1, ssk; k14, yo, p1, yo; k5, p1.

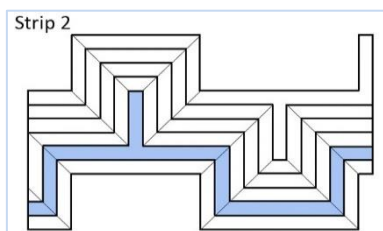
Row 5 rs: Sl1k, k6, yo, k1, yo; k14, ssk, k1, k2tog; k34, ssk, k1, k2tog; k14, yo, k1, yo; k42, yo, k1, yo; k14, ssk, k1, k2tog; k6, p1.

Row 6 ws: Sl1k, k7, p1, k16, p1, k44, p1, k16, p1, k36, p1, k16, p1, k7, p1.

Yarn B:

Start rs: "Dividing strip" (option of your choice).

Row 1 rs: K8, yo, k1, yo; k14, ssk, k1, k2tog; k32, ssk, k1, k2tog; k14, yo, k1, yo; k44, yo, k1, yo; k14, ssk, k1, k2tog; k6.

Row 2 ws: Sl1k, k6, p1, k16, p1, k46, p1, k16, p1, k34, p1, k16, p1, k8, p1.

Row 3 rs: Sl1k, k8, yo, k1, yo; k14, ssk, k1, k2tog; k30, ssk, k1, k2tog; k14, yo, k1, yo; k46, yo, k1, yo; k14, ssk, k1, k2tog; k4, p1.

Row 4 ws: Sl1k, k3, k2tog, p1, ssk; k14, yo, p1, yo; k48, yo, p1, yo; k14, k2tog, p1, ssk; k28, k2tog, p1, ssk; k14, yo, p1, yo; k9, p1.

Row 5 rs: Sl1k, k10, yo, k1, yo; k14, ssk, k1, k2tog; k26, ssk, k1, k2tog; k14, yo, k1, yo; k27, tw;

* Sl1k, k2, p1, turn work* - repeat between ** 17 more times (*photo 1*); ws: Sl1k, k2, p1, turn work / rs: Sl1k, k3, without turning; pick up and knit 18sts (*pick up stitches through back and front every of selv.sts; photos 2, 2a*); without turning; k23, yo, k1, yo; k14, ssk, k1, k2tog; k2, p1, (*photo 3*).



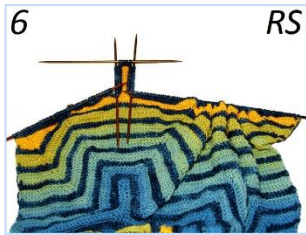
Row 6 ws: Sl1k, k3, p1, k16, p1, k24, p18, k4. Next, use additional needles: pick up and purl 18sts (*pick up stitches through back and front every of selv.sts; photos 4, 4a*); without turning; k24, p1, k16, p1, k28, p1, k16, p1, k11, p1; turn work (*photo 5*).



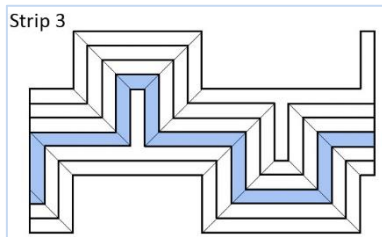

Start rs: "Dividing strip" (option of your choice), (*photo 6*).

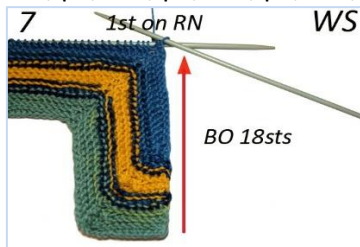

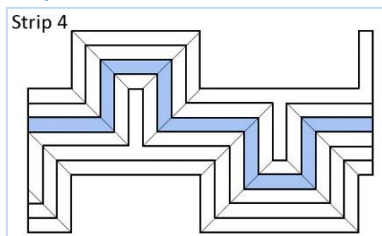
Row 6 ws: BO 18sts (1st on RN, *photo 7*), without turning; k23, p1, k16, p1, k12, p1, k16, p1, k24, p1, k16, p1, k20, p1, k16, p1, k15, p1; turn work.

Start rs: "Dividing strip" (option of your choice).

Strip 4



Yarn A

Row 1 rs: K16, yo, k1, yo; k14, ssk, k1, k2tog; k16, ssk, k1, k2tog; k14, yo, k1, yo; k22, ssk, k1, k2tog; k14, yo, k1, yo; k12, yo, k1, yo; k14, ssk, k1, k2tog; k22.

Row 2 ws: Sl1k, k22, p1, k16, p1, k14, p1, k16, p1, k24, p1, k16, p1, k18, p1, (k16, p1) - twice.

Row 3 rs: Sl1k, K16, yo, k1, yo; (k14, ssk, k1, k2tog) - twice; k14, yo, k1, yo; k22, ssk, k1, k2tog; (k14, yo, k1, yo) - twice; k14, ssk, k1, k2tog; k20, p1.

Row 4 ws: Sl1k, k19, k2tog, p1, ssk; k14, yo, p1, yo; k16, yo, p1, yo; k14, k2tog, p1, ssk; k22, yo, p1, yo; k14, k2tog, p1, ssk; k12, k2tog, p1, ssk; k14, yo, p1, yo; k17, p1.

Row 5 rs: Sl1k, K18, yo, k1, yo; k14, ssk, k1, k2tog; k10, ssk, k1, k2tog; k14, yo, k1, yo; k22, ssk, k1, k2tog; k14, yo, k1, yo; k18, yo, k1, yo; k14, ssk, k1, k2tog; k18, p1.

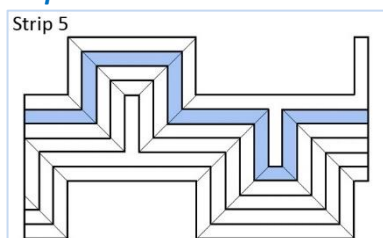

Row 3 rs: Sl1k, K20, yo, k1, yo; k14, ssk, k1, k2tog; k6, ssk, k1, k2tog; k14, yo, k1, yo; k22, ssk, k1, k2tog; k14, yo, k1, yo; k14, ssk, k1, k2tog; k16, p1.

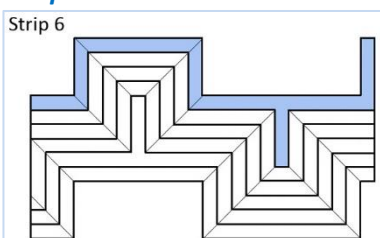

Row 2 ws: Sl1k, k14, p1; k16, p1; k30, p1; k16, p1; k24, p1; k14; k3tog, k2, sl1-k2tog-ssso; turn work; *rs: Sl1k, k2, p3tog, turn work/ ws: Sl1k, k2, sl1-k2tog-ssso, turn work* - rep between ** 6 more times;

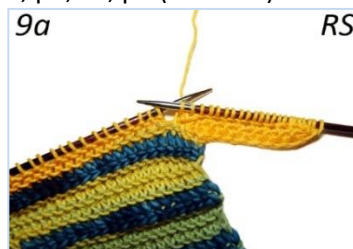
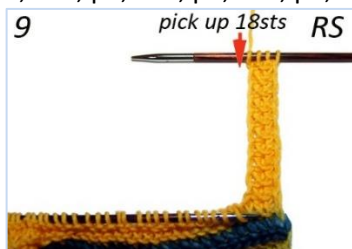
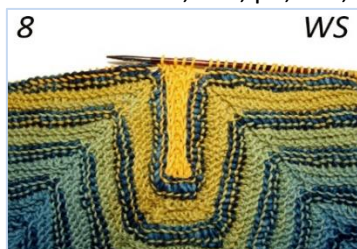
rs: Sl1k, k2, p3tog, turn work/ ws: Sl1k, k2, k3tog (*photo 8*), without turning; k23, p1.

Row 3 rs: Sl1k, k48, ssk, k1, k2tog; k14, yo, k1, yo; k30, yo, k1, yo; k14, ssk, k1, k2tog; k12, p1.

Row 4 ws: Sl1k, k11, k2tog, p1, ssk; k14, yo, p1, yo; k32, yo, p1, yo; k14, k2tog, p1, ssk; k47, p1.

Row 5 rs: (Sl1k, k2, p1, turn work) x 18 times, turn work; Sl1k, k3, without turning; pick up and knit 18sts (*pick up stitches through back and front every of selv.sts; photos 9, 9a*); without turning; k43, ssk, k1, k2tog; k14, yo, k1, yo; k34, yo, k1, yo; k14, ssk, k1, k2tog; k10, p1.

Row 6 ws: Sl1k, k11, p1; k16, p1; k36, p1; k16, p1; k44, p1; k16, p1; k3, p1 (= 150sts).

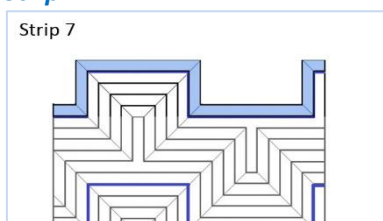

Start rs: "Dividing strip" (option of your choice).

Repeat **Stripes 1- 6** 9 more times or up to your desired scarf length.

Row 1 rs: K4, yo, k1, yo; k14, ssk, k1, k2tog; k40, ssk, k1, k2tog; k14, yo, k1, yo; k36, yo, k1, yo; k14, ssk, k1, k2tog; k10.

Row 2 ws: Sl1k, k10, p1, k16, p1, k38, p1, k16, p1, k42, p1, k16, p1, k4, p1.

Row 3 rs: Sl1k, k4, yo, k1, yo; k14, ssk, k1, k2tog; k38, ssk, k1, k2tog; k14, yo, k1, yo; k38, yo, k1, yo; k14, ssk, k1, k2tog; k8, p1.

Scarf Labyrinth of reflections.

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Row 4 ws: Sl1k, k7, k2tog, p1, ssk; k14, yo, p1, yo; k40, yo, p1, yo; k14, k2tog, p1, ssk; k36, k2tog, p1, ssk; k14, yo, p1, yo; k5, p1.

Row 5 rs: Sl1k, k6, yo, k1, yo; k14, ssk, k1, k2tog; k34, ssk, k1, k2tog; k14, yo, k1, yo; k42, yo, k1, yo; k14, ssk, k1, k2tog; k6, p1.

Row 6 ws: Sl1k, k7, p1, k16, p1, k44, p1, k16, p1, k36, p1, k16, p1, k7, p1;

“Dividing strip” for Option 1

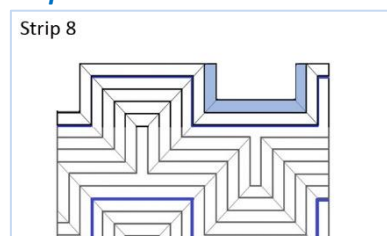
Start RS: Knit one row.

Start WS: Sl1k, k24 (postpone this 25sts without BO sts), BO 46sts, k70, BO 9sts.

Or “Dividing strip” for Option 2

Start rs: BO 9sts; “Horizontal braid” 70sts; BO 46sts; “Horizontal braid” 25sts (postpone this 25sts without BO sts, *photo 10*). Knit the next row on the right side again.

Strip 8:



Yarn A

Row 1 rs: K14, ssk, k1, k2tog; k32, ssk, k1, k2tog; k14; turn work.

Row 2 ws: Sl1k, k14, p1, k34, p1, k14, p1.

Row 3 rs: Sl1k, k12, ssk, k1, k2tog; k30, ssk, k1, k2tog; k12, p1.

Row 4 ws: Sl1k, k11, k2tog, p1, ssk; k28, k2tog, p1, ssk; k11, p1.

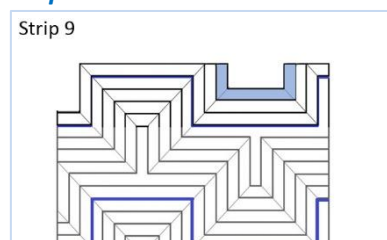

Row 4 ws: Sl1k, k3, k2tog, p1, ssk; k11, p1.

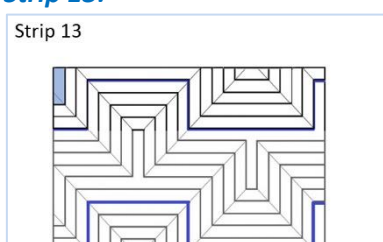
Row 5 rs: Sl1k, k10, ssk, k1, k2tog; k2, p1.

Row 6 ws: Sl1k, k3, p1, k11, p1.

Start rs: "Dividing strip" (option of your choice).

Strip 13:



Yarn A

Row 1 rs: K10, ssk, k1, k2tog; k2.

Row 2 ws: Sl1k, k2, p1, k10, p1.

Row 3 rs: Sl1k, k8, ssk, k1, k2tog; p1.

Row 4 ws: K2tog, p1, ssk; k7, p1; turn work.

Row 5 rs: Sl1k, k7, k3tog; turn work.

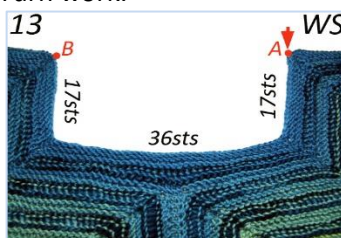
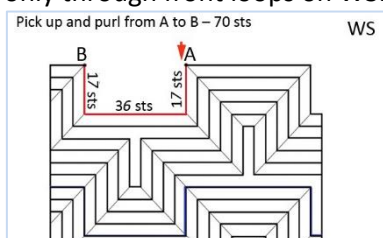
BO 9sts (*photo 12*).



Now back to the down side of the scarf.

Yarn A

WS: From the selv sts pick up and purl from **A** to **B** 70 sts (*see schematic and photo 13*). Pick up stitches only through front loops on WS. Turn work.



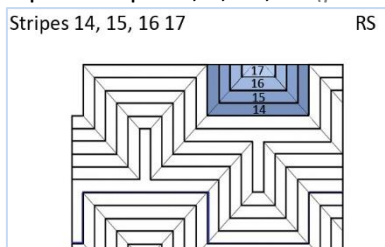

Start rs: "Dividing strip" (option of your choice). Knit the next row on the right side again.

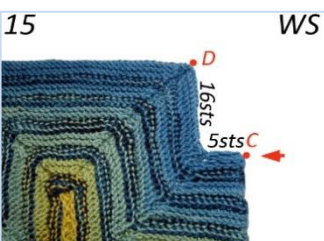
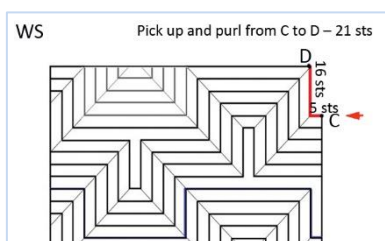

Strip 18:

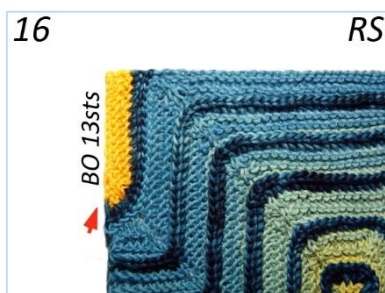
Yarn A

WS: From the selv sts pick up and purl from **C** to **D** 21sts (*see schematic and photo 15*). Pick up stitches only through front loops on WS. Turn work.



Yarn B

Start rs: “Dividing strip” (option of your choice). Knit the next row on the right side again.



Yarn A

Row 1 rs: K14, ssk, k1, k2tog; k2.

Row 2 ws: Sl1k, k2, p1, k14, p1.

Row 3 rs: Sl1k, k12, ssk, k1, k2tog; p1.

Row 4 ws: K2tog, p1, ssk; k11, p1.

Row 5 rs: Sl1k, k11, k3tog.

BO 13sts (*photo 16*).



BORDER:

Yarn B: From the selv sts any side (WS) pick up and purl all sts, turn work. (RS) Purl one row. BO all sts. Repeat for the next sides.

LEAVES FOR APPLICATION:

Yarn A

CO 25sts with 2mm needles.

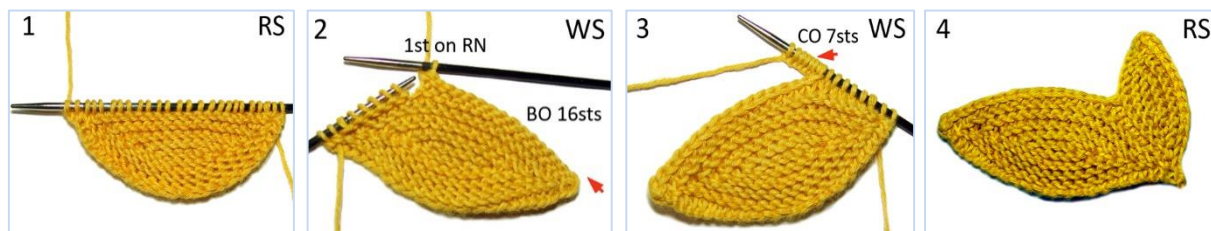
Sl1k, k22, w&t/ k20, w&t/ k18, w&t/ k16, w&t/ k14, w&t/ k12, w&t/ k10, w&t/ k8, w&t/ k6, w&t/ k5, w&t/ k6, w&t/ k8, w&t/ k10, w&t/ k12, w&t/ k14, w&t/ k16, w&t/ k18, w&t/ k20, w&t/ k23, (*photo 1*); turn work.

Scarf Labyrinth of reflections.

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(WS) BO 16sts (*1st on RN, photo 2*); without turning; p5, w&t/ k6; without turning; CO 7sts (*using the loop cast-on method, photo 3*), turn work.

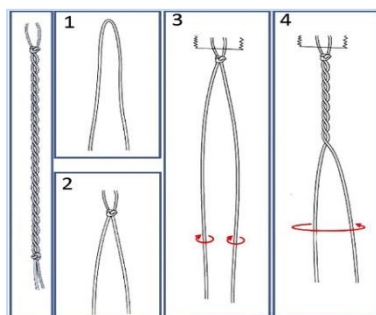
Sl1k, k13, w&t/ k12, w&t/ k10, w&t/ k8, w&t/ k6, w&t/ k5, w&t/ k6, w&t/ k8, w&t/ k10, w&t/ k13; turn work. BO 16sts (*photo 4*).



Make 15 more of these leaves.

Place leaves on scarf as shown (see schematic on page 2 of this pattern), pin in place to prevent shifting, and sew on using tapestry needle and color A yarn.

FINISHING



Yarn A

To finish, for fringe, cut lengths of yarn 25 cm long. Number of piece of yarn = number of selv. sts on the short sides of the scarf. Evenly space them along the end, making sure to tie snug knots. Apply fringe in this way: see pic.

Block lightly.

Horizontal braid (Lateral braid, Estonian Vikkel braid).



Start by casting on a new stitch before the first stitch.

Knit into the back of the 2nd stitch. Then knit into the 1st stitch. Drop both stitches off the left needle. Slip the first stitch on right needle back onto the left needle. Repeat *-* until last st on row. K last st, and pass next to last st over.
