



Fair Isle Scarf

Measurements

Approximately 160 x 24cm/63 x 9½in.

Materials

1 x 50g (175m) ball of Rowan Felted Tweed DK in each of Ginger (154), Phantom (153), Clay (177), Watery (152), Avocado (161), Rage (150), Gilt (160), Bilberry (151), Seasalter (178), Paisley (171) and Maritime (167).*
3½mm (No. 10) and 3¾mm (No. 9) circular knitting needles, 40cm long.

Tension

25 stitches and 29 rows, to 10 x 10cm, over coloured pattern, using 3¾mm needles.

Abbreviations

K, knit; **p**, purl; **st**, stitch; **inc**, increase (by working twice into same st); **dec**, decrease (by working 2 sts together); **ss**, stocking stitch (every round k); **mst**, moss st.

Note

Yarn amounts are based on average requirements and are therefore approximate. Instructions in square brackets are worked as stated after 2nd bracket.

To make

With 3½mm circular needle and Gilt, cast on 119 sts.

Taking care not to twist the cast-on edge, work in rounds thus:

1st round: K1, [p1, k1] to end.

2nd round: P1, [k1, p1] to end.

These 2 rounds form mst.

Mst another 4 rounds, inc 1 st at end of last round – 120 sts.

Change to 3¾mm circular needle.

Reading chart from right to left on every round and stranding yarn not in use loosely across wrong side, work in ss (every round k) and pattern from chart, until scarf measures approximately 158cm from beginning, ending with a complete stripe pattern, dec 1 st at end of last round – 119 sts.

Change to 3½mm circular needle.

Continue in Gilt only.

1st round: P1, [k1, p1] to end.

2nd round: K1, [p1, k1] to end.

These 2 rounds form mst.

Mst another 4 rounds. Cast off in mst.

Press as given on ball band. Flatten scarf and join cast-on edge together, then join cast-off edge together.
