



Measurements

To Fit Bust

cm	81	86	91	97	102	107
in	32	34	36	38	40	42

Actual Size

cm	80	86	91	97	103	109
in	31½	34	36	38	40½	43

Full Length

cm	46	46	47	48	49	50
in	18	18	18½	19	19¼	19¾

Materials

300 [400:400:500:500:600]g of Noro Kama Shade 5.

1 Pair of 6mm (US10) knitting needles.
1 Pair of 5mm (US8) knitting needles.

TENSION

14sts and 20 rows to 10cm, 4in over stocking stitch **using 6mm (US10) knitting needles** or the size required to give the correct tension.

Special Abbreviations

2x2 Rib.

1st Row: *K2, P2, rep from * to last 2sts, K2.

2nd Row: P2, *K2, P2, rep from * to end.

Rep 1st and 2nd rows.

St-St. Stocking Stitch.

1st Row: Knit.

2nd Row: Purl.

Rep 1st and 2nd rows.

M1. Make one stitch. Pick up loop between last and next st and work into back of this loop.

Pockets (Work 2)

Using 6mm (US10) needles cast on 24sts and work 30 [32:36:38:42:44] rows in st-st.

Next Row: P3, m1, (P6, m1) 3 times, P3. 28sts.

Next Row: P1, K2, *P2, K2, rep from * to last st, P1.

Next Row: K1, *P2, K2, rep from * to last 3sts, P2, K1.

Rep last 2 rows 3 times more.

Cast off in rib.

Left Front

Using 5mm (US8) needles cast on 63 [67:71:75:79:83]sts.

1st Row: K2, *P2, K2, rep from * to last st, P1.

2nd Row: K1, *P2, K2, rep from * to last 2sts, P2.

1st and 2nd rows set rib.

Work 7 rows more in rib.

10th Row: Rib 7 [9:11:7:9:11], rib2tog, (rib 6 [6:6:8:8:8], rib2tog) 6 times, rib 6 [8:10:6:8:10]. 56 [60:64:68:72:76]sts.

Change to 6mm (US10) needles and working in st-st (throughout) cont until Left Front measures 20cm, 8in, ending with a ws row.

Next Row: Knit.

Shape Neck

Next Row: Cast off 28 [30:32:34:36:38]sts, purl to end. 28 [30:32:34:36:38]sts.

Next Row: Knit to end, K2tog (neck edge). 27 [29:31:33:35:37]sts.

Next Row: Purl.

Work 10 rows dec 1 st at neck edge in 3rd and every foll 4th row.

25 [27:29:31:33:35]sts.

Shape Armhole

Next Row: Cast off 3sts, knit to last 2sts, K2tog. 21 [23:25:27:29:31]sts.

Next Row: Purl.

Next Row: K2, K2tog, knit to end.

20 [22:24:26:28:30]sts.

Next Row: Purl to last 4sts, P2tog, P2. 19 [21:23:25:27:29]sts.

Next Row: K2, K2tog, knit to last 2sts, K2tog. 17 [19:21:23:25:27]sts.

Next Row: Purl.

Work 1 [1:1:3:5:9] rows dec 1 st at armhole edge **as before** in next and every foll 0 [0:0:2nd:2nd:2nd] row **AT SAME TIME** dec 1 st at neck edge in 0 [0:0:3rd:3rd:3rd] and foll 0 [0:0:0:4th] row. 16 [18:20:20:21:20]sts.

Work 22 [22:22:24:22:18] rows dec 1 st at neck edge only in 2nd [2nd:2nd:4th:2nd:2nd] and every foll 4th row.

10 [12:14:14:15:15]sts.

Cont without shaping until armhole measures 19 [19:20:21:22:23]cm, 7½ [7½:8:8½:8¾:9]in, ending with a ws row. Cast off.

Right Front

Using 5mm (US8) needles cast on 63 [67:71:75:79:83]sts.

1st Row: P1, *K2, P2, rep from * to last 2sts, K2.

2nd Row: P2, *K2, P2, rep from * to last st, K1.

1st and 2nd rows set rib.

Work 7 rows more in rib.

10th Row: Rib 6 [8:10:6:8:10], rib2tog, (rib 6 [6:6:8:8:8], rib2tog) 6 times, rib 7 [9:11:7:9:11]. 56 [60:64:68:72:76]sts.

Change to 6mm (US10) needles and working in st-st (throughout) cont until Right Front measures 20cm, 8in, ending with a ws row.

Shape Neck

Next Row: Cast off 28 [30:32:34:36:38]sts, knit to end. 28 [30:32:34:36:38]sts.

Next Row: Purl.

Next Row: K2tog (neck edge), knit to

end. 27 [29:31:33:35:37]sts.

Next Row: Purl.

Work 11 rows dec 1 st at neck edge in 3rd and every foll 4th row.

24 [26:28:30:32:34]sts.

Shape Armhole

Next Row: Cast off 3sts, purl to end.

21 [23:25:27:29:31]sts.

Next Row: Knit to last 4sts, K2togtbl, K2. 20 [22:24:26:28:30]sts.

Next Row: P2, P2togtbl, purl to end.

19 [21:23:25:27:29]sts.

Next Row: K2tog, knit to last 4sts, K2togtbl, K2. 17 [19:21:23:25:27]sts.

Next Row: Purl.

Work 1 [1:1:3:5:9] rows dec 1 st at neck edge in 0 [0:0:3rd:3rd:3rd] and foll 0 [0:0:0:4th] row **AT SAME TIME** dec 1 st at armhole edge **as before** in next and every foll 0 [0:0:2nd:2nd:2nd] row.

16 [18:20:20:21:20]sts.

Work 22 [22:22:24:22:18] rows dec 1 st at neck edge only in 2nd [2nd:2nd:4th:2nd:2nd] and every foll 4th row,

10 [12:14:14:15:15]sts.

Cont without shaping until armhole measures 19 [19:20:21:22:23]cm, 7½ [7½:8:8½:8¾:9]in, ending with a ws row.

Cast off.

Back

Using 5mm (US8) needles cast on 66 [70:74:78:82:86]sts and work 9 rows in 2x2 rib.

10th Row: Rib 5 [7:9:2:4:6], rib2tog, (rib 4 [4:4:6:6:6], rib2tog) 9 times, rib 5 [7:9:2:4:6]. 56 [60:64:68:72:76]sts.

Change to 6mm (US10) needles and working in st-st (throughout) cont until Back measures 20cm, 8in, ending with a ws row.

Work 14 rows more without shaping.

Shape Armhole

Cast off 3sts at beg of next 2 rows.

50 [54:58:62:66:70]sts.

Next Row: K2, K2tog, knit to last 4sts, K2togtbl, K2. 48 [52:56:60:64:68]sts.

Next Row: P2, P2togtbl, purl to last 4sts, P2tog, P2. 46 [50:54:58:62:66]sts.

Next Row: K2, K2tog, knit to last 4sts, K2togtbl, K2. 44 [48:52:56:60:64]sts.

Next Row: Purl.

Rep last 2 rows 1 [1:1:2:3:5] times more.

42 [46:50:52:54:54] sts.

Cont without shaping until armholes measure 19 [19:20:21:22:23]cm, 7½ [7½:8:8½:8¾:9]in, ending with a ws row.

Cast off.

Sew Pockets in position sideways with side edges immediately above rib and to cast off sts at neck and the cast on sts to front edge. Leave cast off sts of rib open to form opening.

Neck Border

Join shoulder seams. With rs facing, **using 5mm (US8) needles** working through double thickness of side edge of pocket and front neck pick up and knit 28 [30:32:34:36:38]sts from cast off sts at front of neck, 51 [51:53:56:58:60]sts evenly along shaped edge of neck, 22 [22:22:24:24:24]sts from back of neck, 51 [51:53:56:58:60]sts evenly along shaped edge of neck and working through double thickness of side edge of Pocket and front neck pick up and knit 28 [30:32:34:36:38]sts evenly from cast off sts at front of neck. 180 [184:192:204:212:220]sts.

Next Row: Knit.

Next Row: P1, *K2, P2, rep from * to last 3sts, K2, P1.

Next Row: K1, P2, *K2, P2, rep from * to last st, K1.

Rep last 2 rows 3 times more.

Cast off in rib.

Right Front Border

Using 5mm (US8) needles commencing at lower edge of Right Front, pick up and knit 10sts evenly along rib, 28sts evenly along front edge and 8sts evenly along Neck Border. 46sts.

Next Row: Knit.

Commencing with 1st row of 2x2 rib work 8 rows.

Cast off in rib.

Left Front Border

Using 5mm (US8) needles commencing at top of Neck Border, pick up and knit 8sts evenly along Neck Border, 28sts evenly along front edge and 10sts evenly along rib. 46sts.

Next Row: Knit.

Commencing with 1st row of 2x2 rib work 8 rows.

Cast off in rib.

Armhole Borders (Both alike)

Using 5mm (US8) needles pick up and knit 78 [78:82:86:90:94]sts evenly all round armhole edge.


Next Row: Knit.

Commencing with 1st row of 2x2 rib work 8 rows.

Cast off in rib.

To Complete

Join side and Armhole Border seams. See ball band for care instructions.

Materials

600 [600:700:700:800:800]g Noro Kogarashi Shade 7.
1 Pair of 6.5mm (US10.5) knitting needles.
1 Pair of 5.5mm (US9) knitting needles.
1 5.5mm (US9) 100cm Circular Needle.
Cable Needle.

Tension

12sts and 20 rows to 10cm, 4in over stocking stitch **using 6.5mm (US10.5) knitting needles** or the size required to give the correct tension.
Lower cable pattern of 71sts measures approximately 44cm, 17½in across.

Special Abbreviations

2x2 Rib.

1st Row: *K2, P2, rep from * to last 2sts, K2.
2nd Row: P2, *K2, P2, rep from * to end.
Rep 1st and 2nd rows.

St-St. Stocking Stitch.

1st Row: Knit.
2nd Row: Purl.
Rep 1st and 2nd rows.

EDGE TO EDGE WAISTCOAT

C4B. Slip next 2sts onto a CN and hold at back of work, K2, then K2 from CN.

C4F. Slip next 2sts onto a CN and hold at front of work, K2, then K2 from CN.

C2B. Slip next st onto a CN and hold at back of work, K1, then K1 from CN.

C2F. Slip next st onto a CN and hold at front of work, K1, then K1 from CN.

M1. Make one stitch. Pick up loop between last and next stitch and work into back of this loop.

Large Cable Panel

1st Row: K4, C4B, C4F, K4.

2nd Row: P16.

3rd Row: K2, C4B, K4, C4F, K2.

4th Row: P16.

5th Row: C4B, K8, C4F.

6th Row: P16.

From 1st to 6th row forms patt.

Right Front

Worked sideways from Left to Right.

Using 6.5mm (US10.5) needles cast on 93 [93:95:97:98:99]sts.

1st Row: P4, C2B, K1, C2F, *P4, patt 16sts as given for 3rd [1st:5th:1st:5th:3rd] row of Large Cable Panel, P4, C2B, K1, C2F*, work from * to * once more, P4, K22 [22:24:26:27:28].

2nd Row: P22 [22:24:26:27:28], K4, *P5, K4, P16, K4*, rep from * to * once more, P5, K4.

1st and 2nd rows set position of patt. ** Keeping continuity of patt as set (throughout) commencing with 5th [3rd: 1st:3rd:1st:5th] row of Large Cable Panel work 31 [33:35:39:41:43] rows more.

Shape Neck

1st Row: Cast off 5 [5:6:6:6:6]sts, patt to end. 88 [88:89:91:92:93]sts.

2nd Row: Patt.

3rd and 4th Rows: As 1st and 2nd rows. 83 [83:83:85:86:87]sts.

5th Row: Cast off 5 [5:5:6:6:6]sts, patt to end. 78 [78:78:79:80:81]sts.

6th Row: Patt.

7th and 8th Rows: As 5th and 6th rows. 73 [73:73:73:74:75]sts.

9th Row: Cast off 5 [5:5:5:6:6]sts in patt, patt to end. 68 [68:68:68:69]sts.

10th Row: Patt.

11th Row: Cast off 5 [5:5:5:6]sts in patt, patt to end. 63sts.

12th Row: Patt.

13th Row: Cast off 5sts in patt, patt to end. 58sts.

14th Row: Patt.

Cast off rem sts in patt.

Left Front

Worked sideways from Right to Left.

Using 6.5mm (US10.5) needles cast on

58sts.

1st Row: P4, C2B, K1, C2F, P4, patt 16sts as given for 1st row of Large Cable Panel, P4, C2B, K1, C2F, P4, patt 16sts as given for 1st row of Large Cable Panel, cast on 5sts. 63sts

2nd Row: P1, K4, P16, K4, P5, K4, P16, K4, P5, K4.

3rd Row: P4, C2B, K1, C2F, P4, patt 16sts as given for 3rd row of Large Cable panel, P4, C2B, K1, C2F, P4, patt 16sts as given for 3rd row of Large Cable Panel, P4, K1, cast on 5 [5:5:5:6]sts. 68 [68:68:68:69]sts.

4th Row: K1 [1:1:1:1:2], P5, K4, P16, K4, P5, K4, P16, K4, P5, K4.

5th Row: P4, C2B, K1, C2F, P4, patt 16 sts as given for 5th row of Large Cable panel, P4, C2B, K1, C2F, P4, patt 16sts as given for 5th row of Large Cable Panel, P4, C2B, K1, C2F, P1 [1:1:1:1:2], cast on 5 [5:5:5:6:6]sts. 73 [73:73:73:74:75]sts.

6th Row: P2 [2:2:2:3:4], K4, P5, K4, P16, K4, P5, K4, P16, K4, P5, K4.

1st to 6th row sets position of cable patt and st-st.

Keeping continuity of cable patt and st-st as set (throughout) proceed as follows:-

7th Row: Patt to end, cast on 5 [5:5:6:6:6]sts. 78 [78:78:79:80:81]sts

8th Row: Patt.

9th and 10th Rows: As 7th and 8th rows. 83 [83:83:85:86:87]sts.

11th Row: Patt to end, cast on 5 [5:6:6:6:6]sts. 88 [88:89:91:92:93]sts.

12th Row: Patt.

13th and 14th Rows: As 11th and 12th rows. 93 [93:95:97:98:99]sts.

Work 34 [36:38:42:44:46] rows more without shaping.

Cast off in patt.

Back

Work to ** as given for Right Front.

Keeping continuity of patt as set (throughout) commencing with 5th [3rd: 1st:3rd:1st:5th] of Large Cable Panel work 96 [100:104:112:116:120] rows.

Cast off in patt.

Armhole Borders (Both alike)

Join shoulder seams. With rs facing, **using 5.5mm (US9) needles** pick up and knit 46 [46:50:54:54:58]sts evenly along st-st edge of back and front.

Next Row: Knit.

Commencing with 1st row of 2x2 rib work 8 rows.

Cast off in rib.

Lower Border

Join side and Armhole Border seams.

With rs facing, **using 5.5mm (US9) needles** pick up and knit 47 [49:51:55:57:59]sts evenly along lower edge of Left Front, 98 [102:106:114:118:122]sts

evenly along lower edge of Back and 47 [49:51:55:57:59] sts evenly along lower edge of Right Front.

192 [200:208:224:232:240]sts.

1st Row: Knit.

2nd Row: P1, *K2, P2, rep from * to last 3sts, K2, P1.

3rd Row: K1, P2, *K2, P2, rep from * to last st, K1.

1st and 2nd rows set rib.

Cont in rib for 8cm, 3in, ending with a ws row.

Cast off in rib.

Front Border

With rs facing, **using 5.5mm (US9) circular needle**, commencing at lower edge of Right Front, pick up and knit 15sts evenly along rib, 70sts evenly along straight edge, 34 [34:36:38:38:40]sts evenly along shaped edge, 32sts evenly from back of neck, 34 [34:36:38:38:40]sts evenly along shaped edge, 70sts evenly along straight edge and 15sts evenly along rib. 270 [270:274:278:278:282]sts.


Next Row: Knit.

Commencing with 1st row of 2x2 rib work 8 rows.

Cast off in rib.

Stitch holders.

1 1/2 metre of ribbon.

Tension

18sts and 24 rows to 10cm, 4in, over stocking stitch **using 5mm (US8) knitting needles** or the size required to give the correct tension.

Special abbreviations

2x2 Rib.

1st Row: *K2, P2, rep from * to last 2sts, K2.

2nd Row: P2, *K2, P2, rep from * to end.

Rep 1st and 2nd rows.

St-St. Stocking Stitch.

1st Row: Knit.

2nd Row: Purl.

Rep 1st and 2nd rows.

M1. Make one stitch. Pick up loop between last and next stitch and work into back of this loop.

For general abbreviations see page 1.

LONG JACKET

Pocket Linings (Both alike)

Using 5mm (US8) needles cast on 27sts and work in st-st for 15cm, 6in, ending with a ws row.

Leave these 27sts on a stitch holder.

Left Front

Using 4mm (US6) needles cast on 53 [53:57:57:61:61]sts.

1st Row: *K2, P2, rep from * to last 5sts, K5.

2nd Row: K3, P2, *K2, P2, rep from * to end.

1st and 2nd rows set rib with border.

Cont in rib with border until Left Front measures 8cm, 3in, ending with a rs row.

Next Row: K3, leave these sts on a stitch holder, rib 10 [14:8:10:10:8], rib2tog, (rib 2 [2:4:6:4:8], rib2tog) 7 [5:6:4:6:4] times, rib 10 [14:8:10:10:8].

42 [44:47:49:51:53]sts.

Change to 5mm (US8) needles and working in st-st (throughout) cont until Left Front measures 27cm, 10 3/4in, ending with a ws row.

Place Pocket

Next Row: K8 [10:13:15:17:19], slip 27sts onto a stitch holder, knit across 27sts left on a stitch holder for first Pocket Lining, K7.

Next Row: Purl.

Cont until Left Front measures 47cm, 18 1/2in, ending with a ws row.

Shape Front Edge

Work 28 rows dec 1 st at end (front edge) in next and every foll 4th row.

35 [37:40:42:44:46]sts.

Work 8 rows dec 1 st at front edge in next and foll 6th row. 33 [35:38:40:42:44]sts.

Shape Armhole

Next Row: Cast off 4 [4:4:4:5:5]sts, knit to end. 29 [31:34:36:37:39]sts.

Next Row: Purl.

Work 6 [6:6:8:8:8] rows dec 1 st at armhole edge in every row **AT SAME TIME**

dec 1 st at front edge in 3rd row. 22 [24:27:27:28:30]sts.

Work 7 [7:9:7:7:9] rows dec 1 st at armhole edge in next and every foll alt row **AT SAME TIME** dec 1 st at front edge in 3rd [3rd:3rd:1st:1st:1st] and foll 6th row. 17 [19:20:21:22:23]sts.

Work 20 [20:18:24:24:22] rows dec 1 st at front edge only in 2nd [2nd:6th:6th:6th:4th] and every foll 6th row.

13 [15:17:17:18:19]sts.

Cont without shaping until armhole measures 19 [19:20:21:22:23]cm, 7 1/2 [7 1/2:8:8 1/4:8 3/4:9]in, ending with a ws row. Cast off.

Right Front

Using 4mm (US6) needles cast on 53 [53:57:57:61:61]sts.

1st Row: K5, *P2, K2, rep from * to end.

2nd Row: *P2, K2, rep from * to last 5sts, P2, K3.

1st and 2nd rows set rib with border.

Cont in rib with border until Right Front measures 8cm, 3in, ending with a rs row.

Next Row: Rib 10 [14:8:10:10:8], rib2tog, (rib 2 [2:4:6:4:8], rib2tog) 7 [5:6:4:6:4] times, rib 10 [14:8:10:10:8], turn and leave rem 3sts on a stitch holder.

42 [44:47:49:51:53]sts.

Change to 5mm (US8) needles and working in st-st (throughout) cont until Right Front measures 27cm, 10 3/4in, ending with a ws row.

Place Pocket

Next Row: K7, slip 27sts onto a stitch holder, knit across 27sts left on a stitch holder for second Pocket Lining, K8 [10:13:15:17:19].

Next Row: Purl.

Cont until Right Front measures 47cm,

18½in, ending with a ws row.

Shape Front Edge

Work 28 rows dec 1 st at beg (front edge) in next and every foll 4th row.

35 [37:40:42:44:46]sts.

Work 8 rows dec 1 st at front edge in next and foll 6th row. 33 [35:38:40:42:44]sts.

Shape Armhole

Next Row: Knit.

Next Row: Cast off 4 [4:4:4:5:5]sts, purl to end. 29 [31:34:36:37:39]sts.

Work 6 [6:6:8:8:8] rows dec 1 st at front edge in 3rd row **AT SAME TIME** dec 1 st at armhole edge in every row.

22 [24:27:27:28:30]sts.

Work 7 [7:9:7:7:9] rows dec 1 st at front edge in 3rd [3rd:3rd:1st:1st:1st] and foll 6th row **AT SAME TIME** dec 1 st at armhole edge in next and every foll alt row. 17 [19:20:21:22:23]sts.

Work 20 [20:18:24:24:22] rows dec 1 st at front edge only in 2nd [2nd:6th:6th:6th:4th] and every foll 6th row.

13 [15:17:17:18:19]sts.

Cont without shaping until armhole measures 19 [19:20:21:22:23]cm, 7½ [7½:8:8¼:8¾:9]in, ending with a ws row.

Cast off.

Back

Using 4mm (US6) needles cast on 98 [102:106:110:114:118]sts and work in 2x2 rib for 8cm, 3in, ending with a rs row.

Next Row: Rib 8 [10:4:6:8:10], rib2tog, (rib 6 [6:10:10:10:10], rib2tog) 10 [10:8:8:8:8] times, rib 8 [10:4:6:8:10]. 87 [91:97:101:105:109]sts.

Change to 5mm (US8) needles and working in st-st (throughout) cont until Back measures 47cm, 18½in, ending with a ws row.

Work 36 rows more.

Shape Armholes

Cast off 4 [4:4:4:5:5]sts at beg of next 2 rows. 79 [83:89:93:95:99]sts.

Work 6 [6:6:8:8:8] rows dec 1 st at each end of every row. 67 [71:77:77:79:83]sts. Work 7 [7:9:7:7:9] rows dec 1 st at each end of next and every foll alt row. 59 [63:67:69:71:73]sts.

Cont without shaping until armholes measure 19 [19:20:21:22:23]cm, 7½ [7½:8:8¼:8¾:9]in, ending with a ws row.

Cast off.

Sleeves (Both alike)

Important

Increases up Sleeves should be worked as follows:-

Work 1 st, m1, work to last st, m1, work 1.

Using 4mm (US6) needles cast on 39 [39:43:43:45:45]sts and work 6 rows in st-st.

Change to 5mm (US8) needles and working in st-st (throughout) work 91 [93:

93:93:91:99] rows inc 1 st at each end **as shown** in 3rd and every foll 11th [9th:9th:9th:8th:8th] row.

57 [61:65:65:69:71]sts.

Cont without shaping until Sleeve measures 45 [48:48:48:48:49]cm, 17¾ [19:19:19:19:19¼]in, ending with a ws row.

Shape Sleeve Top

Cast off 4 [4:4:4:5:5]sts at beg of next 2 rows. 49 [53:57:57:59:61]sts.

134 [134:134:138:138:138]sts.

2nd Row: K1, *P3tog, (K1, P1, K1) all into next st, rep from * to last st, K1.



Next Row: P1, K2, *P2, K2, rep from * to last st, P1.

Rep last 2 rows twice more.

Cast off in rib.

Second Pocket Border

With rs facing, **using 5mm (US8) needles** cast on 1 st, pick up and knit 34sts evenly from top of pocket, cast on 1 st. 36sts. (cast on sts are to be used to sew Pocket Borders to Scarf).

Next Row: Knit.

Next Row: K1, *P2, K2, rep from * to last

3sts, P2, K1.

Next Row: P1, K2, *P2, K2, rep from * to last st, P1.

Rep last 2 rows twice more.

Cast off in rib.

Hood

Using 6mm (US10) needles cast on 102 sts.

1st Row: K2, *P2, C2B, C2F, P2, K9, C6B, C6F, K9, P2, C2B, C2F, P2*, K2, P2, K2, rep from * to * once, K2.

2nd and Every Alt Row: K2, *K2, P4, K2, P30, K2, P4, K2, * P2, K2, P2, rep from * to * once, K2.

3rd Row: K2, *P2, C2F, C2B, P2, K6,

C6B, K6, C6F, K6, P2, C2F, C2B, P2, * K2, P2, K2, rep from * to * once, K2.

5th Row: K2, *P2, C2B, C2F, P2, K3, C6B, K12, C6F, K3, P2, C2B, C2F, P2, * K2, P2, K2, rep from * to * once, K2.

7th Row: K2, *P2, C2F, C2B, P2, C6B, K18, C6F, P2, C2F, C2B, P2, * K2, P2, K2, rep from * to * once, K2.

8th Row: K2, *K2, P4, K2, P30, K2, P4, K2, * P2, K2, P2, rep from * to * once, K2. 1st to 8th row sets patt.

Keeping continuity of patt as set (throughout) cont until Hood measures 18cm, 7in, ending with a ws row.

Shape Top

Next Row: Patt 48, K2tog, K2, K2togtbl,

patt 48. 100sts.

Work 32 rows dec 2sts **as before** in 3rd and every foll 4th row. 84sts.

Work 3 rows more without shaping.

Cast off in patt.

To Complete

Sew seam at top of Hood. Sew Pocket Linings and Pocket Borders in position using cast on sts. Fold Scarf in half and placing centre seam of Hood to fold sew evenly Hood evenly in position. Attach Hood to Scarf. See ball band for care instructions.

2nd Row: P1, *K1, P1, rep from * to end.

Rep 1st and 2nd rows.

St-St. Stocking stitch

1st Row: Knit.

2nd Row: Purl.

Rep 1st and 2nd rows.

M1. Make one stitch. Pick up loop between last and next stitch and work into back of this loop.

Front

Using 5mm (US8) needles cast on 105 [111:115:123:127:131]sts.

Working in st-st (throughout) work 75 [75:75:81:81:81] rows dec 1 st at each end of 9th and every foll 6th row. 81 [87:91:97:101:105]sts.

Cont without shaping until Front measures 37cm, 14½in, ending with a ws row.

Shape Armholes

Cast off 4 [4:4:4:5:5]sts at beg of next 2 rows. 73 [79:83:89:91:95]sts.

Work 4 [6:6:8:8:8] rows dec 1 st at each end of every row. 65 [67:71:73:75:79]sts.

Work 5 [3:3:3:3:5] rows dec 1 st at each end of next and every foll alt row. 59 [63:67:69:71:73]sts.

Work 1 [1:3:3:5:7] rows more without shaping.

Shape Neck

Next Row: K19 [21:23:23:24:25]sts, turn, leave rem 40 [42:44:46:47:48]sts on a stitch holder.

Working on these 19 [21:23:23:24:25]sts only proceed as follows:-

Next Row:

Purl. Work 2 rows dec 1 st at neck edge in every row. 17 [19:21:21:22:23]sts.

Work 6 rows dec 1 st at neck edge in next and every foll alt row.

14 [16:18:18:19:20]sts.

Work 9 rows dec 1 st at neck edge in next and every foll 4th row.

11 [13:15:15:16:17]sts.

Cont without shaping until armhole measures 19 [19:20:21:22:23]cm, 7½ [7½:8:8½:8¾:9]in, ending with a ws row.

Cast off.

With rs facing, working on rem 40 [42:44:46:47:48]sts, slip first 21 [21:21:23:23:23]sts onto a stitch holder, rejoin yarn to rem 19 [21:23:23:24:25]sts and knit

to end.

Next Row:

Purl. Work 2 rows dec 1 st at neck edge in every row. 17 [19:21:21:22:23]sts.

Work 6 rows dec 1 st at neck edge in next and every foll alt row.

14 [16:18:18:19:20]sts.

Work 9 rows dec 1 st at neck edge in next and every foll 4th row.

11 [13:15:15:16:17]sts.

Cont without shaping until armhole measures 19 [19:20:21:22:23]cm, 7½ [7½:8:8½:8¾:9]in, ending with a ws row.

Cast off.

Back

Using 5mm (US8) needles cast on 19 [21:23:27:31:35]sts.

Working in st-st (throughout) proceed as follows:-

Cast on 5sts at end of next 8 rows.

59 [61:63:67:71:75]sts.

Cast on 3sts at end of next 6 [6:8:10:10:10] rows. 77 [79:87:97:101:105]sts.

Cast on 2sts at end of next 6 [10:8:8:8:8] rows. 89 [99:103:113:117:121]sts.

Cast on 1 st at end of next 16 [12:12:10:10:10] rows.

105 [111:115:123:127:131]sts.

Next Row:

Knit.

Place a marker at each end of last row.

Next Row:

Purl.

Work 73 [73:73:79:79:79] rows dec 1 st at each end of 7th and every foll 6th row.

81 [87:91:97:101:105]sts.

Cont without shaping until Back

measures 37cm, 14½in from marker,

ending with a ws row.

Shape Armholes

Cast off 4 [4:4:4:5:5]sts at beg of next 2 rows.

73 [79:83:89:91:95]sts.

Work 4 [6:6:8:8:8] rows dec 1 st at each

end of every row. 65 [67:71:73:75:79]sts.

Work 5 [3:3:3:3:5] rows dec 1 st at each end of next and every foll alt row. 59 [63:67:69:71:73]sts. Cont without shaping until armhole measures 19 [19:20:21:22:23]cm, 7½ [7½:8:8½:8¾:9]in, ending with a ws row. **Next Row:** Cast off 11 [13:15:15:16:17]sts, K36 [36:36:38:38:38], cast off rem 11 [13:15:15:16:17]sts. Leave centre 37 [37:37:39:39:39]sts on a stitch holder.

Sleeves (Both alike)

Important

Increases up Sleeves should be worked as follows:-

Work 1 st, m1, work to last st, m1, work 1.

Using 4mm (US6) needles cast on 45 [45:49:49:53:53]sts and work in 1x1 rib for 5cm, 2in, ending with a rs row.

Next Row: Rib to end dec 4sts evenly across row. 41 [41:45:45:49:49]sts.

Change to 5mm (US8) needles and working in st-st (throughout) work 82 [86:86:86:85] rows inc 1 st at each end **as above** in 5th and every foll 11th [9th:9th:9th:9th:8th] row. 57 [61:65:65:69:71]sts. Cont without shaping until sleeve measures 43 [46:46:46:46:47]cm, 17 [18:18:18:18½]in, ending with a ws row.

Shape Sleeve Top

Cast off 4 [4:4:4:5:5]sts at beg of next 2 rows. 49 [53:57:57:59:61]sts. Work 4 [6:6:6:6:6] rows dec 1 st at each end of every row. 41 [41:45:45:47:49]sts. Work 12 [8:12:12:18:16] rows dec 1 st at each end of next and every foll alt row. 29 [33:33:33:29:33]sts.

Work 8 [10:10:10:8:10] rows dec 1 st at each end of every row. 13sts. Cast off 3sts at beg of next 2 rows. 7sts. Cast off rem 7sts.

Neckband

Join right shoulder seam. With rs facing, **using 4mm (US6) needles** pick up and knit 32sts evenly along left side of neck, 21 [21:21:23:23:23]sts left on a stitch holder at front of neck, 33sts evenly along right side of neck and 37 [37:37:39:39:39]sts left on a stitch holder at back of neck. 123 [123:123:127:127:127]sts.

Next Row: Knit.

Commencing with 1st row of 1x1 rib work 6 rows.

Cast off in rib.

Lower Front Border

With rs facing, **using 4mm (US6) needles** pick up and knit 105 [111:115:123:127:131]sts evenly along cast on edge of Front.

Next Row: K7 [5:7:7:8:10], inc in next st, (K9 [10:10:11:9:9], inc in next st) 9 [9:9:9:11:11] times, K7 [6:8:7:8:10]. 115 [121:125:133:139:143]sts. Commencing with 1st row of 1x1 rib work for 5cm, 2in, ending with a ws row. Cast off in rib.

Lower Back Border

With rs facing, **using 4mm (US6) needles** and commencing at marker at lower edge of back pick up and knit 79 [81:83:85:85:85]sts evenly along shaped edge, 19 [21:23:27:31:35]sts from cast on sts and 79 [81:83:85:85:85]sts evenly along shaped edge to marker.


177 [183:189:197:201:205]sts.

Next Row: K2 [5:3:3:5:3], inc in next st, (K3 [3:3:3:3:3] inc in next st) 25 [25:27:29:29:31] times, K2 [5:3:3:5:3]. 131 [137:143:153:157:163]sts.

Commencing with 1st row of 1x1 rib work for 5cm, 2in, ending with a ws row. Cast off in rib.

To Complete

Join left shoulder and Neckband seams. Fold Sleeves in half lengthways, then placing folds to shoulder seams sew Sleeves in position. Join Lower Borders, side seams and Sleeves. See ball band for care instructions.

2nd Row: P2, *K2, P2, rep from * to end.

Rep 1st and 2nd rows..

C30B. Cable 30 back. K15, turn, P15, turn, K15, turn, P15, turn, K15, turn, P15. Break off yarn and slip these 15sts onto a CN and hold at back of work, rejoin yarn and knit the next 15sts, turn, P15, turn, K15, turn, P15, turn, K15, turn, P15, turn and K15 then knit across 15sts left on a CN.

For general abbreviations see page 1.

SHRUG / WRAP

Cable Pattern

1st Row: Knit.

2nd Row: Purl.

3rd to 8th Row: Rep 1st and 2nd rows 3 times.

9th Row: K5, C30B, (K2, C30B) 7 times, K5.

10th Row: As 2nd row.

11th to 19th Row: Rep 1st and 2nd rows 4 times then 1st row once.

20th Row: Purl.

1st to 20th row sets patt.

Right Sleeve

This garment is worked sideways in one piece from Right Sleeve to Left Sleeve.

Using 4mm (US6) needles cast on 264sts.

Commencing with 3rd [11th:5th:19th: 15th:11th] row of Cable patt proceed as follows:-

Work 124 [134:134:136:136:138] rows.

Place marker threads at each end of last row.

Main Part

Work a further 126 [130:142:150:158: 162] rows.

Place marker threads at each end of last row.

Left Sleeve

Work a further 124 [134:134:136:136: 138] rows, ending with a ws row. Cast off in patt.

Back Lower Border

With rs facing, **using 3.25mm (US3) needles** pick up and knit 118 [126:134: 142:150:158]sts evenly between markers for Main Part.

Next Row:

Knit. Commencing with 1st row of 2x2 rib work 16cm, 6½in, ending with a ws row. Cast off in rib.

Front Lower Border

With rs facing, **using 3.25mm (US3) needles** pick up and knit 118 [126:134: 142:150:158]sts evenly between markers for Main Part.

Next Row:

Knit. Commencing with 1st row of 2x2 rib work 16cm, 6½in, ending with a ws row. Cast off in rib.

To Complete

Fold work in half lengthways and join Sleeve seams to markers. Join side edges of Lower Borders. Fold Lower Border in half onto ws and slip stitch in position. See ball band for care instructions.
