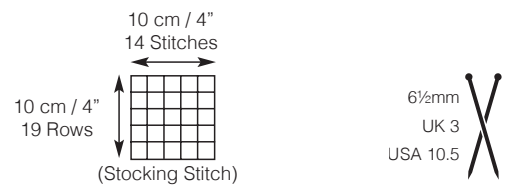

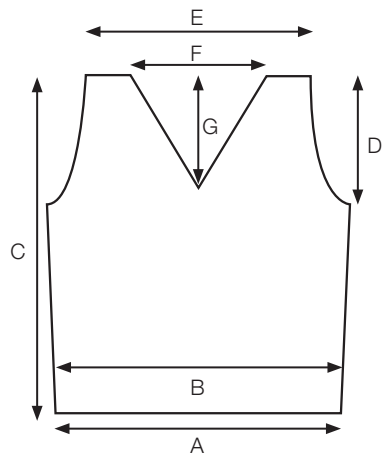

TIPS & TECHNIQUES

INTARSIA TECHNIQUE

When working with different balls of yarn the colour to be used should be twisted round the colour just used to link the colours together and avoid holes.

STITCHES & ABBREVIATIONS

A – shade A
alt – alternate
B – shade B
beg – beginning
cm – centimetres
cont – continue
dec – decrease(ing)
 foll – following
g – grammes
in – inch(es)
k – knit
mm – millimetres
O – no times or rows
p – purl
patt – pattern
psso – pass slipped stitch over
rem – remain(ing)
rep – repeat
rs – right side
s1 – slip 1 stitch knitways
s1p – slip 1 stitch purlways
st(s) – stitch(es)
tbl – through back of loop
tog – together
ws – wrong side
ybk – yarn back
yft – yarn front

BACK

Using 5½mm needles, thumb method and A, cast on 83 [93:101:109:117:125] sts.

1st Row. * K1, p1, rep from * to last st, k1.

2nd Row. P1, * k1, p1, rep from * to end.

1st and 2nd rows set **1x1 rib**.

Work in 1x1 rib for 9cm, (3½in), ending with a rs row.

Next Row. P4 [5:4:3:3:7], p2tog, (p10 [8:7:8:7:7], p2tog) 6 [8:10:10:12:12] times, p5 [6:5:4:4:8].

76 [84:90:98:104:112] sts. **

Change to 6½mm needles and using A, proceed as follows:-

1st Row. Knit.

2nd Row. Purl.

1st and 2nd rows set **st-st** (stocking stitch).

3rd Row. K38 [42:45:49:52:56]A, 38 [42:45:49:52:56]B.

4th Row. P38 [42:45:49:52:56]B, 38 [42:45:49:52:56]A.

From 1st to 4th row sets position of st-st

and stripe patt.

Working in st-st and stripe patt as set (throughout) cont until back measures 38 [38:38:39:40:41]cm, (15 [15:15:15½:15¾:16]in), ending with a ws row.

Shape Armholes

Cast off 4 [4:4:5:5:5] sts at beg of next 2 rows. 68 [76:82:88:94:102] sts.

1st Row. K1, yft, s1p, ybk, k1, s1, k1, psso, knit to last 5 sts, k2tog, k1, yft, s1p, ybk, k1. 66 [74:80:86:92:100] sts.

2nd Row. Yft, s1p, ybk, k1, yft, s1p, p2tog, purl to last 5 sts, p2togtbl, s1p, ybk, k1, yft, s1p. 64 [72:78:84:90:98] sts.
1st and 2nd rows set 3 st i-cord edges and armhole shapings.

Work 2 [4:4:4:6:8] rows dec 1 st at each end as before in every row.

60 [64:70:76:78:82] sts.

Next Row. K1, yft, s1p, ybk, k1, s1, k1, psso, knit to last 5 sts, k2tog, k1, yft, s1p, ybk, k1. 58 [62:68:74:76:80] sts.

Next Row. Yft, s1p, ybk, k1, yft, s1p, purl to last 3 sts, s1p, ybk, k1, yft, s1p.

Last 2 rows set 3 st i-cord edges and armhole shapings.

Work 4 [4:4:8:8:8] rows dec 1 st at each end as before in next and every foll alt row.

54 [58:64:66:68:72] sts.

Working the 3 st i-cord edges at each end cont without shaping until armholes measure 22 [24:26:27:28:29]cm, (8¾ [9½:10¼:10¾:11:11½]in), ending with a ws row.

Shape Shoulders

Cast off 5 [6:7:7:8:9] sts at beg of next 2 rows. 44 [46:50:52:52:54] sts.

Cast off 6 [6:8:8:8:9] sts at beg of next 2 rows. 32 [34:34:36:36:36] sts.

Cast off rem 32 [34:34:36:36:36] sts.

FRONT

Work as given for Back to **.

Change to 6½mm needles and using A, proceed as follows:-

1st Row. Knit.

2nd Row. Purl.

1st and 2nd rows set st-st.

3rd Row. K38 [42:45:49:52:56]B, 38 [42:45:49:52:56]A.

4th Row. P38 [42:45:49:52:56]A, 38 [42:45:49:52:56]B.

From 1st to 4th row sets position of stripe patt and st-st.

Working in stripe patt and st-st as set (throughout) cont until front measures

38 [38:38:39:40:41]cm, (15 [15:15:15½:15¾:16]in), ending with a ws row.

Shape Armholes

Cast off 4 [4:4:5:5:5] sts at beg of next 2 rows. 68 [76:82:88:94:102] sts. **

For 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th sizes only

1st Row. K1, yft, s1p, ybk, k1, s1, k1, psso, knit to last 5 sts, k2tog, k1, yft, s1p, ybk, k1.

[74:80:86:92:100] sts.

2nd Row. Yft, s1p, ybk, k1, yft, s1p, p2tog, purl to last 5 sts, p2togtbl, s1p, ybk, k1, yft, s1p.

[72:78:84:90:98] sts.

1st and 2nd rows set 3 st i-cord edges and armhole shapings.

Work [2:4:4:6:8] rows dec 1 st at each end as before in every row.

[68:70:76:78:82] sts.

For 4th, 5th and 6th sizes only

Next Row. K1, yft, s1p, ybk, k1, s1, k1, psso, knit to last 5 sts, k2tog, k1, yft, s1p, ybk, k1.

[74:76:80] sts.

Next Row. Yft, s1p, ybk, k1, yft, s1p, purl to last 3 sts, s1p, ybk, k1, yft, s1p.

For all 6 sizes

Shape Armholes and Divide for Neck

Next Row. K1, yft, s1p, ybk, k1, s1, k1, psso, k27 [27:28:30:31:33], turn, leave rem 36 [36:37:39:40:42] sts on a stitch holder. Working on these 31 [31:32:34:35:37] sts only proceed as follows:-

Next Row. Purl to last 5 [5:3:3:3:3] sts, (p2togtbl) 1 [1:0:0:0:0] times, s1p, ybk, k1, yft, s1p.

30 [30:32:34:35:37] sts.

For 1st size only

Next Row. K1, yft, s1p, ybk, k1, s1, k1, psso, knit to last 2 sts, k2tog. 28 sts.

Next Row. Purl to last 5 sts, p2togtbl, s1p, ybk, k1, yft, s1p. 27 sts.

For all 6 sizes

Next Row. K1, yft, s1p, ybk, k1, s1, k1, psso, knit to last 2 sts, k2tog. 25 [28:30:32:33:35] sts.

Next Row. Purl to last 3 sts, s1p, ybk, k1, yft, s1p.

Work 4 [4:2:4:4:4] rows dec 1 st at armhole edge as before in next and foll 2nd [2nd:0:2nd:2nd:2nd] row AT SAME TIME dec 1 st at neck edge in next and foll

2nd [2nd:0:2nd:2nd:2nd] row.

21 [24:28:28:29:31] sts.

Working the 3 st i-cord at armhole edge work 14 [20:20:22:22:22] rows dec 1 st at neck edge only in next and every foll alt row. 14 [14:18:17:18:20] sts.

Work 9 [5:9:5:5:5] rows dec 1 st at neck edge only in next and every foll 4th row. 11 [12:15:15:16:18] sts.

Working the 3 st i-cord at armhole edge cont without shaping until armhole measures 22 [24:26:27:28:29]cm, (8¾ [9½:10¼:10¾:11:11½]in), ending with a ws row.

Shape Shoulder

Next Row. Cast off 5 [6:7:7:8:9] sts, knit to end. 6 [6:8:8:8:9] sts.

Next Row. Purl.

Cast off rem 6 [6:8:8:8:9] sts.

With rs facing, rejoin yarn to rem 36 [36:37:39:40:42] sts and cast off 4 sts, knit to last 5 sts, k2tog, k1, yft, s1p, ybk, k1. 31 [31:32:34:35:37] sts.

Next Row. Yft, s1p, ybk, k1, yft, s1p, (p2tog) 1 [1:0:0:0:0] times, purl to end. 30 [30:32:34:35:37] sts.

For 1st size only

Next Row. K2tog, knit to last 5 sts, k2tog, k1, yft, s1p, ybk, k1. 28 sts.

Next Row. Yft, s1p, ybk, k1, yft, s1p, p2tog, purl to end. 27 sts.

For all 6 sizes

Next Row. K2tog, knit to last 5 sts, k2tog, k1, yft, s1p, ybk, k1. 25 [28:30:32:33:35] sts.

Next Row. Yft, s1p, ybk, k1, yft, s1p, purl to end.

Work 4 [4:2:4:4:4] rows dec 1 st at neck edge in next and foll 2nd [2nd:0:2nd:2nd:2nd] row AT SAME TIME dec 1 st at armhole edge as before in next and foll 2nd [2nd:0:2nd:2nd:2nd] row. 21 [24:28:28:29:31] sts.

Working the 3 st i-cord at armhole edge work 14 [20:20:22:22:22] rows dec 1 st at neck edge only in next and every foll alt row. 14 [14:18:17:18:20] sts.

Work 9 [5:9:5:5:5] rows dec 1 st at neck edge only in next and every foll 4th row. 11 [12:15:15:16:18] sts.

Working the 3 st i-cord at armhole edge cont without shaping until armhole measures 22 [24:26:27:28:29]cm, (8¾ [9½:10¼:10¾:11:11½]in), ending with a rs row.

Next Row. Cast off 5 [6:7:7:8:9] sts, purl to end. 6 [6:8:8:8:9] sts.

Next Row. Knit.

Cast off rem 6 [6:8:8:8:9] sts.

NECKBAND RIGHT SIDE

Join right shoulder seam. With rs facing, using 5½mm needles and A, pick up and knit 42 [42:44:44:44:44] sts evenly along right side of neck and 36 [38:38:42:42:42] sts evenly from 32 [34:34:36:36:36] cast off sts at back of neck. 78 [80:82:86:86:86] sts.

1st Row. * P1, k1, rep from * to end.

1st row sets rib.

Work 5 rows more in rib.

Cast off in rib.

LEFT SIDE

With rs facing, using 5½mm needles and A, pick up and knit 42 [42:44:44:44:44] sts evenly along left side of neck

1st Row. * K1, p1, rep from * to end.

1st row sets rib.

Work 5 rows more in rib.

Cast off in rib.

TO MAKE UP

Join left shoulder and neckband seams.

Placing right side over left side sew side edges of neckband in position to cast off edge at front of neck. Join side seams. Pin out garment to the measurement given. Cover with damp cloths and leave until dry. See ball band for washing and further care instructions.
