

Stole Twilight

Abbreviations:

BO = bind off
CO = cast on
k = knit
k2tog= knit two (2) stitches together
p = purl
sl1k = slip a stitch knit-wise
st(s) = stitch (es)
RN= right needle
LN= left needle
RS = right side
tbl = through back loop
tfl = through front loop
tw = turn work
WS = wrong side
w/o = without
wyib= with yarn in back
w&t = wrap and turn (knit the indicated number
of sts, wrap working yarn around next
stitch, turn and knit back in the opposite direction)
pm = place marker
rm = remove marker



Yarn:

A – Malabrigo Sock (col 870 Candombe) - 150g
B – Lang Yarns Mille Colori Baby (col 845) – 300g

Size: wide - 48cm. / long - 230 cm.


Needles: 3mm (double-edged needles), two pairs circular needles 3mm (long - 60cm or longer); 6 stitch markers.

Gauge: 28sts and 36 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm

Note:

Please, read the entire pattern before starting the work. The stole consists of four identical “Big triangles” and two identical “Small triangles”. Each triangle is composed of **Segments** (three parts: **a**, **b**, **c**) and/or **Half segment** (two parts: **a**, **b**). The direction of knitting is shown by arrows in the schematics. Besides indicated yarn that the sample was knit with, this motif can also be worked with any other yarn. Selvedge stitches are already included in the stitch count. Do not add any additional selvedge stitches.

Attention! - For Special abbreviation photo-tutorial I've used another kind of yarn.




Special abbreviation:

“w1-r1” = “wrap 1, return 1” (wrap next st = bring yarn to front between the st just worked and the next st on the left needle, sl1 (=next st on left needle)-wyif, bring yarn to back = behind this st), now, w/o turning, return both 1st to left needle and continue working).



“cdd 15” = 15 double decreases, (reducing stitches count by 30) = fifteen times k3tog with centered double decreases in worked as follows: cdd, *slip 2sts from RN to LN, w/o turning; cdd* - rep between ** 14 times. 1st remaining on RN.



“Segment” = repeat from * to * in this way:


(RS) **Yarn A:** K14, “w1-r1” (photo 1), w/o turning, slip 15sts from RN to LN (photo 1a).

(RS) 1: K15, w&t.	7: Sl1k, k4, w&t.	13: Sl1k, k8, w&t.
(WS) 2: K14, p1, tw.	8: K4, p1, tw.	14: K8, p1, tw.

4: K1, p1, tw.	10: K8, p1, tw.	16: K3, p1, tw.

(RS) 2: Sl1k, k14, "w1-r1", w/o turning; slip 15sts from RN to LN (photos 2, 2a), w/o turning.

Yarn B:

(RS) 1: K15, w&t.

(WS) 2: K14, p1, tw.

3: Sl1k, k2, w&t.

4: K2, p1, tw.

5: Sl1k, k6, w&t.

6: K6, p1, tw.

7: Sl1k, k10, w&t.

8: K10, p1, tw.

9: Sl1k, k13, w&t.

10: K13, p1, tw.

11: Sl1k, k10, w&t.

12: K10, p1, tw.

13: Sl1k, k6, w&t.


14: K6, p1, tw.

15: Sl1k, k2, w&t.

16: K2, p1, tw.

17: Sl1k, k12, w&t.

18: K12, p1, **w/o turning**, slip 15sts from RN to LN (photos 2b, 2c), w/o turning.

(WS) 1: P15, tw.

(RS) 2: Sl1k, k14, "w1-r1", w/o turning, slip 15sts from RN to LN (photos 3, 3a), w/o turning.

Yarn B:

(RS) 1: K15, w&t.

(WS) 2: K14, p1, tw.

3: Sl1k, k3, w&t.

4: K3, p1, tw.

5: Sl1k, k8, w&t.

6: K8, p1, tw.

7: Sl1k, k13, w&t.

8: K13, p1, tw.

9: Sl1k, k8, w&t.

10: K8, p1, tw.

11: Sl1k, k4, w&t.

12: K4, p1, tw.

13: Sl1k, k2, w&t.

14: K2, p1, tw.

15: Sl1k, k1, w&t.

16: K1, p1, tw.






(RS): Cdd 15, (photos 4, 4a, 4b. 1st on RN), w/o turning, rm*.




“Half segment” = repeat from * to * in this way:

* Part «a» -

(RS) Yarn A: K14, “w1-r1” (photo 5), w/o turning, slip 15sts from RN to LN (photo 5a).

(RS) 1: K15, w&t.	7: Sl1k, k4, w&t.	13: Sl1k, k8, w&t.
(WS) 2: K14, p1, tw.	8: K4, p1, tw.	14: K8, p1, tw.
3: Sl1k, k1, w&t.	9: Sl1k, k8, w&t.	15: Sl1k, k3, w&t.
4: K1, p1, tw.	10: K8, p1, tw.	16: K3, p1, tw.
5: Sl1k, k2, w&t.	11: Sl1k, k13, w&t.	17: Sl1k, k12, w&t.
6: K2, p1, tw.	12: K13, p1, tw.	18: K12, p1, w/o turning, slip 15sts from RN to LN, w/o turning (photos 5b, 5c).



Part «b» -

Yarn A:

(WS) **1:** P15, tw.

(RS) **2:** Sl1k, k14, “w1-r1” (photo 6), w/o turning, slip 15sts from RN to LN (photo 6a), w/o turning.

Yarn B:

(RS) **1:** K15, w&t.

7: Sl1k, k10, w&t.

(WS) **2:** K14, p1, tw.

8: K10, p1, tw.

3: Sl1k, k2, w&t.

9: Sl1k, k13, w&t.

4: K2, p1, tw.

10: K13, p1, w/o turning, move the work from left end to right end of the needle (photo 6b).

5: Sl1k, k6, w&t.


6: K6, p1, tw.

Yarn A:

(WS) **1:** Sl1k, p15, tw.

(RS) **2:** Sl1k, K15, tw.


(WS) **3:** BO 15sts, (1st remaining on RN) (photo 6c), break off the Yarn B, w/o turning*.



Direction:

Big triangle

The First strip:



Yarn A: CO 211sts (30sts for every segment, +1st) in this way: (30sts, pm) x 6 times, 31sts, tw.


(RS) Sl1k; “Segment” (from * to *) x 7 times; (1st remaining on RN), (photo 7), tw.




(WS) Break off the Yarn B, pick up and purl 210sts only through back loops (30sts for every segment), (pic 7a, photo 7b), tw.

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
Next (dividing I-cord): (RS) K1, k2tog tbl, (photo 8), w/o turning, [slip 2sts from RN to LN, (photo 8a), w/o turning, k1, k2tog tbl, w/o turning] x 208 times (2sts on RN), (photos 8b, 8c).



(WS) Turn work, BO 1st (1st remaining on RN), (photo 9); w/o turning.



The Second strip:




The next strip contains of six segments. We need to move the yarn 15sts. To do this: **(WS)** Pick up 15sts on the LN (photo 10) and immediately BO them (photo 10a).

(Or you can use a crochet hook for this – photo 10b). 1st remaining on RN, w/o turning.



(WS) Pick up and purl 180sts only through front loops in this way: 29sts, pm, (30sts, pm) x 4 times, 31sts (pic 11), tw.



(RS) Sl1k; “Segment”x 6 times (photo 12); (1st remaining on RN), tw.




(WS) Break off the Yarn B; pick up and purl 180sts only through back loops (30sts for every segment), tw.

Next (dividing I-cord): (RS) K1, k2tog tbl, w/o turning, [slip 2st from RN to LN, w/o turning, k1, k2tog tbl, w/o turning] x 178 times (2sts on RN).


(WS) Turn work, BO 1st (1st remaining on RN); w/o turning.

The Third strip:



The next strip contains of 5 segments. We need to move the yarn 15sts. To do this: **(WS)** Pick up 15sts on the LN and immediately BO them (or you can use a crochet hook for this). 1st remaining on RN, w/o turning.

(WS) Pick up and purl **150sts** only through front loops in this way: 29sts, pm, (30sts, pm) x 3 times, 31sts (pic 13), tw.



(RS) Sl1k; “Segment” x 5 times; (1st remaining on RN), tw.


(WS) Break off the Yarn B; pick up and purl 150sts only through back loops (30sts for every segment), tw.

Next (dividing I-cord): (RS) K1, k2tog tbl, w/o turning, [slip 2st from RN to LN, w/o turning, k1, k2tog tbl, w/o turning] x 148 times (2sts on RN) (photo 13a).




(WS) Turn work, BO 1st (1st remaining on RN); w/o turning.

The Fourth strip:



The next strip contains of 4 segments. We need to move the yarn 15sts. To do this: **(WS)** Pick up 15sts on the LN and immediately BO them (or you can use a crochet hook for this). 1st remaining on RN, w/o turning.

(WS) Pick up and purl **120sts** only through front loops in this way: 29sts, pm, (30sts, pm) x 2 times, 31sts (*pic 14*), tw.



(RS) Sl1k; **“Segment” x 4 times;** (1st remaining on RN), tw.


(WS) Break off the Yarn B; pick up and purl 120sts only through back loops (30sts for every segment), tw.

Next (dividing I-cord): (RS) K1, k2tog tbl, w/o turning, [slip 2st from RN to LN, w/o turning, k1, k2tog tbl, w/o turning] x 118 times (2sts on RN) (*photo 14a*).




(WS) Turn work, BO 1st (1st remaining on RN); w/o turning.

The Fifth strip:



The next strip contains of 3 segments. We need to move the yarn 15sts. To do this: **(WS)** Pick up 15sts on the LN and immediately BO them (or you can use a crochet hook for this). 1st remaining on RN, w/o turning.


(WS) Pick up and purl **90sts** only through front loops in this way: 29sts, pm, 30sts, pm, 31sts (*pic 15*), tw.



(RS) Sl1k; **“Segment” x 3 times;** (1st remaining on RN), tw.


(WS) Break off the Yarn B; pick up and purl 90sts only through back loops (30sts for every segment), tw.

Next (dividing I-cord): (RS) K1, k2tog tbl, w/o turning, [slip 2st from RN to LN, w/o turning, k1, k2tog tbl, w/o turning] x 88 times (2sts on RN) (photo 15a).




(WS) Turn work, BO 1st (1st remaining on RN); w/o turning.

The Sixth strip:



The next strip contains of 2 segments. We need to move the yarn 15sts. To do this: **(WS)** Pick up 15sts on the LN and immediately BO them (or you can use a crochet hook for this). 1st remaining on RN, w/o turning.

(WS) Pick up and purl **60sts** only through front loops in this way: 29sts, pm, 31sts (pic 16), tw.



(RS) Sl1k; “Segment” x 2 times; (1st remaining on RN), tw.


(WS) Break off the Yarn B; pick up and purl 60sts only through back loops (30sts for every segment), tw.

Next (dividing I-cord): (RS) K1, k2tog tbl, w/o turning, [slip 2st from RN to LN, w/o turning, k1, k2tog tbl, w/o turning] x 58 times (2sts on RN) (photo16a).




(WS) Turn work, BO 1st (1st remaining on RN); w/o turning.

The Seventh strip:



The next strip contains of 1 segments. We need to move the yarn 15sts. To do this: **(WS)** Pick up 15sts on the LN and immediately BO them (or you can use a crochet hook for this). 1st remaining on RN, w/o turning.

(WS) Pick up and purl 30sts only through front loops (pic 17).



(RS) Sl1k; **“Segment”**; (1st remaining on RN), tw.

(WS) Break off the Yarn B; pick up and purl **30sts** only through back loops, tw.

Next (dividing I-cord): (RS) K1, k2tog tbl, w/o turning, [slip 2st from RN to LN, w/o turning, k1, k2tog tbl, w/o turning] x 28 times (2sts on RN).


(WS) Turn work, BO 2sts. Break off the Yarn A.



Repeat the «Big Triangle» three more times.

Small triangle

The First strip:



Yarn A: CO 106sts (30sts x 3 - Segments 1-3; 15sts - **Half segment 4**, + 1st) in this way: 15sts, pm, (30sts, pm) x 2 times, 31sts, tw.

(RS) Sl1k; **“Segment” x 3 times**; **“Half segment” (from * to *)**, (1st remaining on RN).


(WS) Break off the Yarn B, pick up and purl **105sts** only through back loops, (photos 18, 18a), tw.



Next (dividing I-cord): (RS) K1, k2tog tbl, w/o turning, [slip 2st from RN to LN, w/o turning, k1, k2tog tbl, w/o turning] x 103 times (2sts on RN). Turn work, BO 1st (1st remaining on RN); w/o turning.


The Second strip:

Small triangle



The next strip contains of three Segments.

(WS) Pick up and purl **90sts** only through front loops in this way: 29sts, pm, 30sts, pm, 31sts (*pic 19, photo 19a*), tw.



(RS) Sl1k; **“Segment” x 3 times**, (1st remaining on RN); tw.


(WS) Break off the Yarn B, pick up and purl 90sts only through back loops (30sts for each segment), tw (*photo 19b*).

Next (dividing I-cord): (RS) K1, k2tog tbl, w/o turning, [slip 2st from RN to LN, w/o turning, k1, k2tog tbl, w/o turning] x 88 times (2sts on RN) (*photo 19c*). Turn work, BO 1st (1st remaining on RN); w/o turning.



The Third strip:

Small triangle




The next strip contains of 2 Segments and 1 Half segment.

(WS) Pick up and purl **76sts** only through front loops in this way: 15sts, pm, 30sts, pm, 31sts (*photo 20*), tw.

(RS) Sl1k; **“Segment” x 2 times; “Half segment”**; (1st remaining on RN), w/o turning.

(WS) Break off the Yarn B, pick up and purl 75sts only through back loops (*photo 20a*), tw.



Next (dividing I-cord): (RS) K1, k2tog tbl, w/o turning, [slip 2st from RN to LN, w/o turning, k1, k2tog tbl, w/o turning] x 73 times (2sts on RN). Turn work, BO 1st (1st remaining on RN); w/o turning.

The Fourth strip:

Small triangle



The next strip contains of two Segments.

(WS) Pick up and purl **60sts** only through front loops in this way: 29sts, pm, 31sts (*photo 21*), tw.

(RS) Sl1k; **“Segment”** x 2 times, (1st remaining on RN), tw.


(WS) Break off the Yarn B, pick up and purl 60sts only through back loops (30sts for each segment) (*photo 21a*), tw.



Next (dividing I-cord): (RS) K1, k2tog tbl, w/o turning, [slip 2st from RN to LN, w/o turning, k1, k2tog tbl, w/o turning] x 60 times (2sts on RN). Turn work, BO 1st (1st remaining on RN); w/o turning.

The Fifth strip:

Small triangle



The next strip contains of 1 Segment and 1 Half segment.

(WS) Pick up and purl **46sts** only through front loops in this way: 15sts, pm, 31sts (*photo 22*), tw.

(RS) Sl1k, **“Segment”**; **“Half segment”**, (1st remaining on RN).

(WS) Break off the Yarn B, pick up and purl 45sts only through back loops (*photo 22a*), tw.



Next (dividing I-cord): (RS) K1, k2tog tbl, w/o turning, [slip 2st from RN to LN, w/o turning, k1, k2tog tbl, w/o turning] x 43 times (2sts on RN). Turn work, BO 1st (1st remaining on RN); w/o turning.

The Sixth strip:

Small triangle




The next strip contains of 1 Segment.

(WS) Pick up and purl 30sts only through front loops (photo 23).

(RS) Sl1k, “Segment”, (1st remaining on RN), tw.

(WS) Break off the Yarn B, pick up and purl 30sts only through back loops (photo 23a), tw.



Next (dividing I-cord): (RS) K1, k2tog tbl, w/o turning, [slip 2st from RN to LN, w/o turning, k1, k2tog tbl, w/o turning] x 28 times (2sts on RN). Turn work, BO 1st (1st remaining on RN); w/o turning.

The Seventh strip:

Small triangle




The next strip contains of 1 Half segment.

(WS) Pick up and purl 15sts only through front loops (photo 24).

(RS) Sl1k; “Half segment”, (1st remaining on RN).

(WS) Break off the Yarn B, pick up and purl 15sts only through back loops (photo 24a), tw.



Stole Twilight

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Next (dividing I-cord): (RS) K1, k2tog tbl, w/o turning, [slip 2st from RN to LN, w/o turning, k1, k2tog tbl, w/o turning] x 13 times (2sts on RN). Turn work, BO 2sts.



Repeat the Small Triangle one more time.

Assembling:

First half of the Stole

Yarn A (use the first pair of circular knitting needles)

* From the selv sts **Small Triangle** (WS) pick up and purl 112sts only through back loops, w/o turning; from the selv sts **Big triangle** (WS) pick up and purl 224sts only through back loops, w/o turning; from the selv sts **Big triangle** (WS) pick up and purl 224sts only through back loops in this way (= 560sts):



Turn work.

(RS) 1: Sl1k, K559, tw.

(WS) 2: Sl1k, P559*: Break off the Yarn A.

Postpone work (w/o BO sts).

Second half of the Stole

Yarn A (use the second pair of circular knitting needles)

Repeat «First half of the Stole » from * to * one more time. Do not break Yarn A.


The connection of the two halves



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(RS) On the RN - First half of the stole, on the LN - Second half of the stole (photo 25).



Next:

Slip 2st from RN to LN (photo 26), k2tog, k2tog tbl (photo 26a), w/o turning; [slip 3sts from RN to LN (photo 26b), k2tog, k2tog tbl, (photo 26c), w/o turning] x 559 times (photo 26d). On RN 2sts. BO 2sts.



Border: *Pick up and purl from all selvedge stitches (only through back loops) on one side (RS) of the scarf. Purl one row + CO 2sts (using the loop cast-on method), turn work.

Next (I-cord): K1, k2tog tbl, [slip 2sts from RN to LN(wyib), k1, k2tog tbl] x until the end of the rows. BO 1st*.

Don't break off yarn, repeat from * to * along stole perimeter. BO 1st. Block.
