

Scarf Tango in Paris

**Abbreviations:**

BO = bind off  
CO = cast on  
k = knit  
k2tog= knit two (2) stitches together  
k3tog= knit three (2) stitches together  
p = purl  
RN= right needle  
LN= left needle  
RS = right side  
rep = repeat  
sl1k = slip a stitch knit-wise  
st(s) = stitch (es)  
tbl = through back loop  
w&t = wrap and turn  
WS = wrong side  
w/o = without  
wyib = with yarn in back.



**Yarn:**

**A** – Malabrigo SOCK - 400m/100g (col.416) - **200g**

**B** – Malabrigo SOCK - 400m/100g (col. 141) - **100g**

**Size:** wide – 41cm. / long - 200cm.

**Needles:** 3mm (double-edged needles with sharp ends).

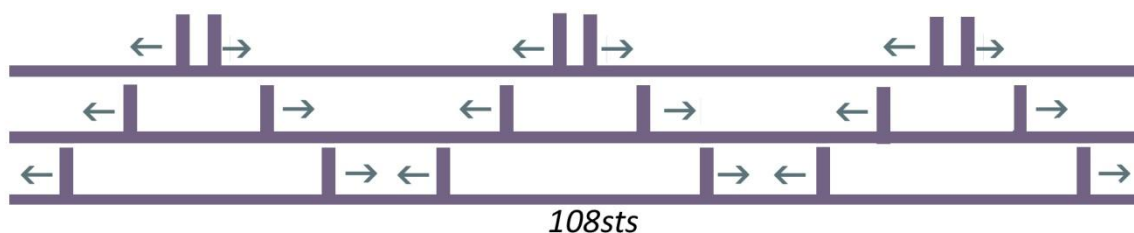
**Gauge:** 24sts and 30 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm

**Note:** I used “wrap and turn” (knit the indicated number of sts, wrap working yarn around next stitch, turn and knit back in the opposite direction), but any other short-row turn works just as well. Selvedge stitches are already included in this stitch count. Do not add any additional selvedge stitches.

This scarf is knitted seamlessly and without breaking off yarn.

If the execution of Rows 2, 8, 14 is difficult for you, then you can use the additional needle.

**Attention! - For photo-tutorial I've CO 36sts.**



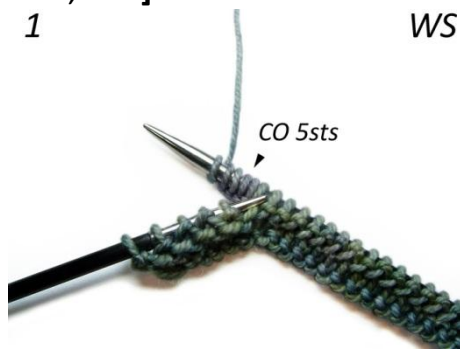
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**Row-by row description:**

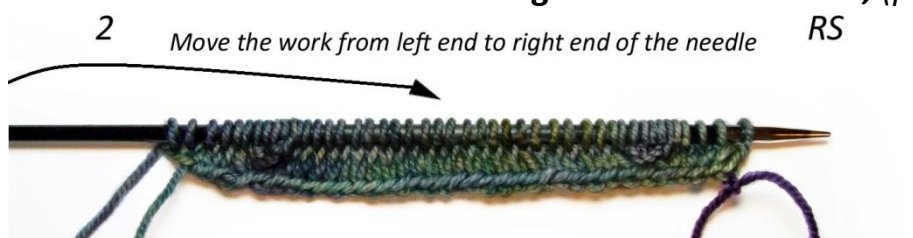
**Yarn "A"**

CO 108sts (multiple of 36) and purl one row.

**(Start RS) Row 1:** [k5, w&t; CO 5sts (using the loop cast-on method), (*photo 1*), turn work; sl1k, k29, w&t; CO 5sts (using the loop cast-on method), turn work; sl1k, k10] x 3 times.



**Move the work from left end to right end of the needle, (*photo 2*).**



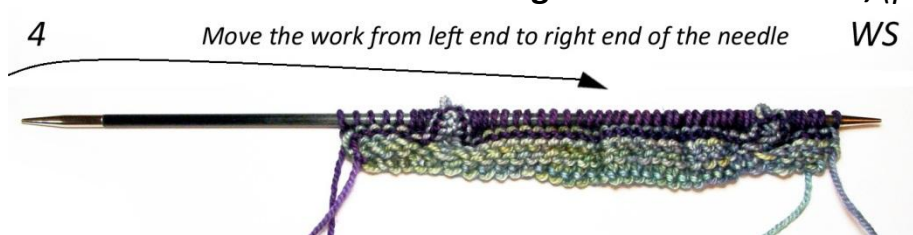
**Yarn "B"**

**(Start RS) Row 2:** [k5, pick up and knit 5sts (*red points in the photo 3, and photo 3a*); k30, pick up and knit 5sts; k11] x 3 times, turn work.

**(Start WS) Row 3:** k168.



**Move the work from left end to right end of the needle, (*photo 4*).**



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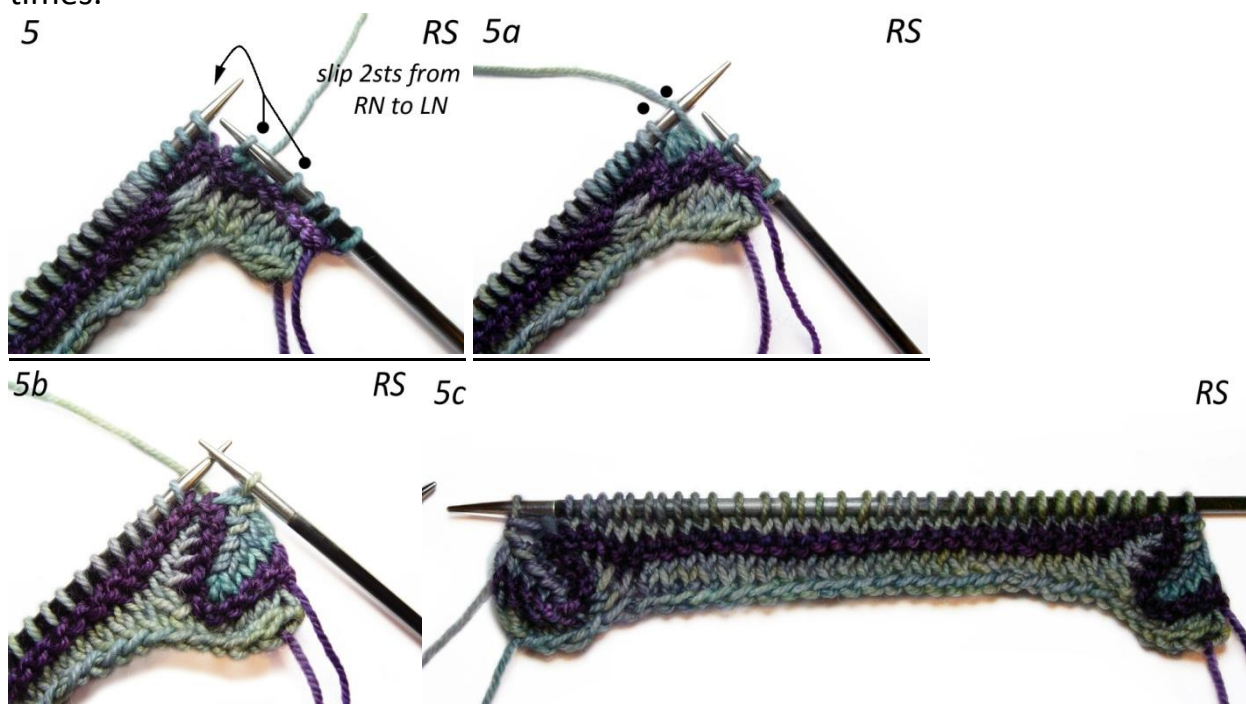
**Yarn "A"**

(Start WS) **Row 4:** p168, turn work.

(Start RS) **Row 5:** [k4, k3tog, (slip 2sts from RN to LN wyib, (photos 5, 5a), k3tog) x 4 times, (photo 5b); k38, k3tog tbl, (slip 2sts from RN to LN wyib, k3tog tbl) x 4 times, (photo 5c)] x 3 times, turn work.

(Start WS) **Row 6:** p108, turn work.

(Start RS) **Row 7:** [k11, w&t; CO 5sts (using the loop cast-on method), turn work; sl1k, k17, w&t; CO 5sts (using the loop cast-on method), turn work; sl1k, k16] x 3 times.



**Move the work from left end to right end of the needle.**

**Yarn "B"**

(Start RS) **Row 8:** [k11, pick up and knit 5sts; k18, pick up and knit 5sts; k17] x 3 times, turn work.

(Start WS) **Row 9:** k168.

**Move the work from left end to right end of the needle.**

**Yarn "A"**

(Start WS) **Row 10:** p168, turn work.

(Start RS) **Row 11:** [k10, k3tog, (slip 2sts from RN to LN wyib, k3tog) x 4 times; k26, k3tog tbl, (slip 2sts from RN to LN wyib, k3tog tbl) x 4 times, k6, (photo 6)] x 3 times, turn work.

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(Start WS) **Row 12:** p108, turn work.

(Start RS) **Row 13:** [k16, w&t; CO 5sts (using the loop cast-on method), turn work; sl1k, k7, w&t; CO 5sts (using the loop cast-on method), turn work; sl1k, k21] x 3 times.

**Move the work from left end to right end of the needle.**

**Yarn "B"**

(Start RS) **Row 14:** [k16, pick up and knit 5sts; k8, pick up and knit 5sts; k22] x 3 times, turn work.

(Start WS) **Row 15:** k168.

**Move the work from left end to right end of the needle.**

**Yarn "A"**

(Start WS) **Row 16:** p168, turn work.

(Start RS) **Row 17:** [k15, k3tog, (slip 2sts from RN to LN wyib, k3tog) x 4 times; k16, k3tog tbl, (slip 2sts from RN to LN wyib, k3tog tbl) x 4 times, k11] x 3 times, turn work.

(Start WS) **Row 18:** p108, turn work, (*photo 7*).



Continued: repeat **Rows 1 – 18 x 25 more times. BO all sts.**

Block.
