Instructions given for 66 cm (26 inch) Chest, larger sizes given in round brackets. Where only one figure is given this applies to all sizes.

K - Knit; **P** - Purl; **st(s)** - stitch(es); **st st** - stocking stitch (1 row K, 1 row P); **g st** - garter stitch (every row K); **inc** - increase(ing); **dec** - decrease(ing); **beg** - beginning; **alt** - alternate; **rept** - repeat; **cont** - continue; **patt** - pattern; **foll** - following; **rem** - remain(ing); **M1** - make 1, pick up loop before next st and work into back of it; **0** - no sts, rows or times to be worked in that particular size; **cm** - centimetres; **ins** - inches.

TENSION

It is important to check your tension before commencing the garment.

13th to 24th rows - Rept 1st to 12th rows once more.

25th to 48th rows - Rept 1st and 2nd rows 12 times.

These 48 rows form patt.

Cont in patt until back measures 52 (57, 62, 67, 68, 68, 69, 69, 70, 70, 71) cm, 20½ (22½, 24½, 26½, 26¾, 26¾, 27½, 27½, 27½, 27½, 28) ins from beg, ending with a wrong side row.

*** Shape Shoulders

Keeping patt correct, cast off 5 (5, 6, 6, 7, 7, 8, 8, 9, 9) sts at beg of next 6 rows, then 5 (6, 5, 8, 7, 9, 7, 9, 10, 9, 10) sts at beg of foll 2 rows. Leave rem 19 (21, 21, 23, 23, 23, 25, 25, 27, 27, 29) sts on a stitch holder.

POCKET LININGS (make 2)

Using 6½mm needles, cast on 13 (15, 15, 17, 17, 17, 17, 19, 19, 19, 19) sts and starting with a K row, work in st st for 9 (11, 11, 12, 12, 12, 12, 13, 13, 13, 13) cm, 3½ (4¼, 4¼, 4¾, 4¾, 4¾, 4¾, 5, 5, 5, 5) ins, ending with a P row. Leave these sts on a stitch holder.

LEFT FRONT

Using 5½mm needles, cast on 24 (26, 28, 30, 32, 34, 36, 38, 40, 42, 44) sts.

1st row (right side) - *K1, P1, rept from * to last 2 sts, K2.

2nd row - *K1, P1, rept from * to end.

**** Rept last 2 rows until work measures 5 (5, 5, 6, 6, 6, 6, 6, 6, 6) cm, 2 (2, 2, 2½, 2½, 2½, 2½, 2½, 2½, 2½) ins, ending with a right side row.

Next row (inc row) - Rib 4 (4, 5, 3, 4, 3, 4, 5, 4), *M1, rib 8 (9, 9, 6, 6, 7, 7, 8, 8, 8, 9), rept from * to last 4 (4, 5, 3, 4, 3, 4, 3, 4, 5, 4) sts, M1, rib 4 (4, 5, 3, 4, 3, 4, 3, 4, 5, 4), 27 (29, 31, 35, 37, 39, 41, 43, 45, 47, 49) sts.

Change to 6½mm needles and patt. ****

1st row (right side) - K3 (1, 3, 3, 1, 3, 1, 3, 1, 3, 1), *P1, K3, rept from * to last 0 (2, 0, 0, 2, 0, 2, 0, 2) sts, [P1, K1] 0 (1, 0, 0, 1, 0, 1, 0, 1, 0, 1) time.

2nd row - K1 (3, 1, 1, 3, 1, 3, 1, 3, 1, 3), *P1, K3, rept from * to last 2 (0, 2, 2, 0, 2, 0, 2, 0, 2, 0) sts, [P1, K1] 1 (0, 1, 1, 0, 1, 0, 1, 0, 1, 0) time.

3rd to 6th rows - Rept 1st and 2nd rows twice more.

7th row - K1 (3, 1, 1, 3, 1, 3, 1, 3, 1, 3), *P1, K3, rept from * to last 2 (0, 2, 2, 0, 2, 0, 2, 0, 2) sts, [P1, K1] 1 (0, 1, 1, 0, 1, 0, 1, 0, 1, 0) time.

8th row - K3 (1, 3, 3, 1, 3, 1, 3, 1, 3, 1), *P1, K3, rept from * to last 0 (2, 0, 0, 2, 0, 2, 0, 2, 0) sts, [P1, K1] 0 (1, 0, 0, 1, 0, 1, 0, 1, 0, 1) time.

9th to 12th rows - Rept 7th and 8th rows twice more.

These 12 rows set the 48 row patt as given for Back.

Cont in 48 row patt as set and work a further 8 (12, 12, 14, 14, 14, 16, 16, 16, 16) rows.

Place pocket

Next Row - Patt 7 (6, 8, 9, 11, 11, 13, 12, 14, 14, 16), slip next 13 (15, 15, 17, 17, 17, 17, 19, 19, 19, 19) sts onto a stitch holder and in place of these patt across 13 (15, 15, 17, 17, 17, 17, 19, 19, 19, 19) sts of first

Pocket Lining, patt to end.

Cont in patt until 14 (16, 16, 18, 18, 18, 18, 18, 20, 20, 20) rows less than on back have been worked before start of shoulder shaping, thus ending with a wrong side row.

Shape neck

Next row - Patt 25 (26, 28, 32, 34, 36, 37, 39, 41, 43, 44), turn and leave rem 2 (3, 3, 3, 3, 4, 4, 4, 5) sts on a stitch holder. Keeping patt correct, dec 1 st at neck edge on next 4 (2, 2, 4, 4, 4, 4, 4, 4, 4) rows, then on every foll alt row until 20 (21, 23, 26, 28, 30, 31, 33, 34, 36, 37) sts rem. Work 7 (7, 7, 9, 9, 9, 9, 9, 9, 9) rows straight, thus ending with a wrong side row.

Shape shoulder

Cast off 5 (5, 6, 6, 7, 7, 8, 8, 8, 9, 9) sts at beg of next and foll 2 alt rows. Work 1 row. Cast off rem 5 (6, 5, 8, 7, 9, 7, 9, 10, 9, 10) sts.

RIGHT FRONT

Using 5½mm needles, cast on 24 (26, 28, 30, 32, 34, 36, 38, 40, 42, 44) sts.

1st row (right side) - K2, *P1, K1, rept from * to end.

2nd row - *P1, K1, rept from * to end.

Work as given for Left Front from **** to ****.

1st row (right side) - *K3, P1, rept from * to last 3 (1, 3, 3, 1, 3, 1, 3, 1) sts, K3 (1, 3, 3, 1, 3, 1, 3, 1).

2nd row - K1 (3, 1, 1, 3, 1, 3, 1, 3, 1, 3), *P1, K3, rept from * to last 2 sts, P1, K1.

3rd to 6th rows - 1st and 2nd Rows twice more.

7th row - K1, *P1, K3, rept from * to last 2 (0, 2, 2, 0, 2, 0, 2, 0) sts, [P1, K1] 1 (0, 1, 1, 0, 1, 0, 1, 0) time.

8th row - K3 (1, 3, 3, 1, 3, 1, 3, 1, 3, 1), *P1, K3, rept from * to end.

9th to 12th rows - Rept 7th and 8th rows twice more.

These 12 rows set the 48 row patt as given for Back.

Cont in 48 row patt as set and work to match Left Front, reversing shapings, working an extra row before shaping shoulder, and noting that pocket will be placed as follows:-

Next row - Patt 7 (8, 8, 9, 9, 11, 11, 12, 12, 14, 14), slip next 13 (15, 15, 17, 17, 17, 19, 19, 19, 19) sts onto a stitch holder and in place of these patt across 13 (15, 15, 17, 17, 17, 19, 19, 19, 19) sts of second Pocket Lining, patt to end.

SLEEVES (both alike)

Using 5½mm needles, cast on 27 (29, 31, 33, 35, 35, 37, 37, 39, 39, 39) sts and work 5 (5, 5, 6, 6, 6, 6, 6, 6, 6) cm, 2 (2, 2, 2½, 2½, 2½, 2½, 2½, 2½, 2½) ins in rib as given for Back, ending with a right side row.

Next row (inc row) - Rib 3 (2, 3, 1, 4, 4, 9, 9, 4, 4, 4), M1, [rib 7 (5, 8, 6, 9, 9, 19, 19, 10, 10, 10), M1] 3 (5, 3, 5, 3, 3, 1, 1, 3, 3, 3) times, rib 3 (2, 4, 2, 4, 4, 9, 9, 5, 5, 5). 31 (35, 35, 39, 39, 39, 39, 43, 43, 43) sts.

Change to 6½mm needles and patt.

1st row (right side) - K3, *P1, K3, rept from * to end.

2nd row - K1, *P1, K3, rept from * to last 2 sts, P1, K1.

These 2 rows form patt.

Cont in patt, shaping sides by inc 1 st at each end of 5th (3rd, 5th, 5th, 5th, 5th, 5th, 5th, 5th, 5th) row from beg of patt and every foll 4th (6th, 4th, 4th, 4th, 4th, 4th, 4th, 4th, 4th) row until there are 43 (55, 47, 53, 59, 59, 69, 69, 65, 65, 79) sts, taking inc sts into patt.

66, 76, 81, 86, 91, 97, 102, 107 and 112 cm sizes only

Inc 1 st at each end of every foll 6th row from previous inc until there are 51 (61, 67, 69, 69, 73, 73, 75, 75) sts.

All sizes

Work straight until sleeve measures 32 (36, 40, 43, 43, 43, 44, 44, 45, 45, 45) cm, 12½ (14¼, 15¾, 17, 17, 17, 17¼, 17¼, 17¾, 17¾, 17¾) ins from beg, ending with a wrong side row.

Cast off loosely.

Neck border

Join shoulder seams by top sewing.

With right side facing and using 5½mm needles, K2 (3, 3, 3, 3, 3, 4, 4, 4, 4, 5) sts from right front, pick up and K14 (16, 16, 18, 18, 18, 18, 20, 20, 20) sts up right side of neck, K19 (21, 21, 23, 23, 23, 25, 25, 27, 27, 29) sts from back, pick up and K14 (16, 16, 18, 18, 18, 18, 18, 20, 20, 20) sts down left side of neck, then K2 (3, 3, 3, 3, 3, 4, 4, 4, 4, 5) sts from left front. 51 (59, 59, 65, 65, 65, 69, 69, 75, 75, 79) sts.

Starting with a 2nd row, work 10 (12, 12, 14, 14, 14, 14, 16, 16, 16, 16) cm, 4 (4¾, 4¾, 5½, 5½, 5½, 5½, 6½, 6½, 6½, 6½) ins in rib as given for back. Using a 6½mm needle, cast off loosely in rib.

Fold Neck Border in half to wrong side and sew in place.

Button border

Using 5½mm needles, cast on 7 (7, 7, 9, 9, 9, 9, 9, 9, 9) sts.

1st row (right side) - K2, *P1, K1, rept from * to last st, K1.

2nd row - K1, *P1, K1, rept from * to end.

Rept last 2 rows until border, when slightly stretched, fits up Left front for Girl's/Woman's Version, Right front for Boy's/Man's Version to top of Neck Border, sewing in place as you go along. Cast off in rib.

Mark position of 8 (8, 8, 9, 9, 9, 9, 9, 9, 9) buttons on Button Border with pins to ensure even spacing, first to come 1 cm (½ inch) from lower edge, last to come 1 cm (½ inch) below top of Neck Border and remainder spaced evenly between.

Buttonhole border

Work as given for Button Border with the addition of 8 (8, 8, 9, 9, 9, 9, 9, 9, 9) buttonholes to correspond with pins on

Button Border as follows:-

1st buttonhole row (right side) - Rib 2 (2, 2, 3, 3, 3, 3, 3, 3, 3, 3) for Girl's/ Woman's Version or rib 3 (3, 3, 4, 4, 4, 4, 4, 4, 4) for Boy's/Man's Version, cast off 2 sts, rib to end.

2nd buttonhole row - In rib, casting on 2 sts over those cast off.

POCKET TOPS (both alike)

With right side facing and using 5½mm needles, K across 13 (15, 15, 17, 17, 17, 17, 19, 19, 19) pocket sts.

Starting with a 2nd row, work in rib as given for Button Border for 5 (5, 5, 7, 7, 7, 7, 7, 7, 7) rows. Cast off evenly in rib.

YOKE SWEATER

BACK

Work as given for Back of Jacket from ** to **.

Change to 6½mm needles and patt.

1st row (right side) - K1, *P1, K3, rept from * to last 2 sts, P1, K1.

2nd row - K3, *P1, K3, rept from * to end.

These 2 rows form patt.

Cont in patt until back measures 34 (37, 40, 43, 43, 43, 43, 43, 43) cm, 13½ (14½, 15¾, 17, 17, 17, 17, 17, 17, 17) ins, ending with a wrong side row.

Change to 5½mm needles and work in g st for 6 rows.

Change to 6½mm needles and yoke patt.

1st row (right side) - K3, *P1, K3, rept from * to end.

2nd row - K1, *P1, K3, rept from * to last 2 sts, P1, K1.

3rd to 6th rows - Rept 1st and 2nd rows twice more.

7th row - K1, *P1, K3, rept from * to last 2 sts, P1, K1.

8th row - K3, *P1, K3, rept from * to end.

9th to 12th rows - Rept 7th and 8th rows twice more.

These 12 rows form yoke patt.

Cont in yoke patt until back measures 52 (57, 62, 67, 68, 68, 69, 69, 70, 70, 71) cm, 20½ (22½, 24½, 26½, 26½, 26½, 27½, 27½, 27½, 28) ins from beg, ending with a wrong side row.

Work as given for back of Jacket from *** to end.

FRONT

Work as given for back until 14 (16, 16, 18, 18, 18, 18, 20, 20, 20) rows less have been worked before start of shoulder shaping, thus ending with a wrong side row.

Shape neck

Next row - Patt 25 (26, 28, 32, 34, 36, 37, 39, 41, 43, 44), turn and work this side first.

Keeping patt correct, dec 1 st at neck edge on next 4 (2, 2, 4, 4, 4, 4, 4, 4) rows, then on every foll alt row until 20 (21, 23, 26, 28, 30, 31, 33, 34, 36, 37) sts rem. Work 7 (7, 7, 9, 9, 9, 9, 9, 9, 9) rows straight, thus ending with a wrong side row.

Shape shoulder

Cast off 5 (5, 6, 6, 7, 7, 8, 8, 8, 9, 9) sts at

beg of next and foll 2 alt rows. Work 1 row. Cast off rem 5 (6, 5, 8, 7, 9, 7, 9, 10, 9, 10) sts.

With right side facing, slip centre 9 (11, 11, 11, 11, 13, 13, 13, 13, 15) sts onto a stitch holder, rejoin yarn to rem sts, patt to end. Work to match first side, reversing shapings, working an extra row before shaping shoulder.

SLEEVES (both alike)

Work as given for Sleeves of Jacket.

Neck border

***** Join right shoulder seam by top sewing.

With right side facing and using 5½mm needles, pick up and K14 (16, 16, 18, 18, 18, 18, 20, 20, 20) sts down left side of neck, K9 (11, 11, 11, 11, 11, 13, 13, 13, 15) sts from front, pick up and K14 (16, 16, 18, 18, 18, 18, 20, 20, 20) sts up right side of neck, then K19 (21, 21, 23, 23, 23, 25, 25, 27, 27, 29) sts from back inc 1 st at centre. 57 (65, 65, 71, 71, 71, 75, 75, 81, 81, 85) sts.

Starting and ending with a 2nd row, work 5 (5, 5, 6, 6, 6, 6, 6, 6, 6) cm, 2 (2, 2, 2½, 2½, 2½, 2½, 2½, 2½, 2½) ins in rib as given for back of Jacket. *****

Next row (dec row) - K2 (1, 1, 2, 2, 2, 1, 1, 2, 2, 1), *K2tog, K3, rept from * to last 5 (4, 4, 4, 4, 4, 4, 4, 4), K2tog, K3 (2, 2, 2, 2, 2, 2, 2, 2, 2, 2). 46 (52, 52, 57, 57, 57, 60, 60, 65, 65, 68) sts.

Starting with a P row, work in st st for 5 rows. Using a 6½mm needle, cast off knitwise.

TEXTURED SWEATER

BACK

Work as given for back of Jacket from ** to **.

Change to 6½mm needles.

1st row (right side) - K3 (1, 3, 3, 1, 3, 1, 3, 1, 3, 1), [P1, K3] 6 (7, 7, 8, 9, 9, 10, 10, 11, 11, 12) times, P1, K3, *P1, K3, rept from * to last 0 (2, 0, 0, 2, 0, 2, 0, 2, 0, 2) sts, [P1, K1] 0 (1, 0, 0, 1, 0, 1, 0, 1, 0, 1) time.

2nd row - K1 (3, 1, 1, 3, 1, 3, 1, 3, 1, 3), [P1, K3] 7 (7, 8, 9, 9, 10, 11, 11, 12, 12) times.

times, P1, *K3, P1, rept from * to last 1 (3, 1, 1, 3, 1, 3, 1, 3, 1) sts, K1 (3, 1, 1, 3, 1, 3, 1, 3, 1).

3rd to 6th rows - Rept 1st and 2nd rows twice more.

7th row - K1 (3, 1, 1, 3, 1, 3, 1, 3, 1, 3), [P1, K3] 7 (7, 8, 9, 9, 10, 10, 11, 11, 12, 12) times, K2, *P1, K3, rept from * to last 0 (2, 0, 0, 2, 0, 2, 0, 2) sts, [P1, K1] 0 (1, 0, 0, 1, 0, 1, 0, 1) time.

8th row - K1 (3, 1, 1, 3, 1, 3, 1, 3, 1, 3), [P1, K3] 7 (7, 8, 9, 9, 10, 10, 11, 11, 12, 12) times, P1, K1, *P1, K3, rept from * to last 0 (2, 0, 0, 2, 0, 2, 0, 2) sts, [P1, K1] 0 (1, 0, 0, 1, 0, 1, 0, 1) time.

9th to 12th rows - Rept 7th and 8th rows twice more.

These 12 rows form first patt.

Cont in patt until Back measures approximately 32 (32, 32, 39, 39, 39, 39, 39, 39, 39, 39) cm, 12½ (12½, 12½, 15½, 15½, 15½, 15½, 15½, 15½, 15½, 15½) ins, ending with a 12th row of patt.

Work second patt.

1st row (right side) - K3 (1, 3, 3, 1, 3, 1, 3, 1, 3, 1), [P1, K3] 6 (7, 7, 8, 9, 9, 10, 10, 11, 11, 12) times, P1, K2, *K3, P1, rept from * to last 1 (3, 1, 1, 3, 1, 3, 1, 3, 1) sts, K1 (3, 1, 1, 3, 1, 3, 1, 3, 1).

2nd row - K3 (1, 3, 3, 1, 3, 1, 3, 1, 3, 1), [P1, K3] 6 (7, 7, 8, 9, 9, 10, 10, 11, 11, 12) times, P1, K1, P1, *K3, P1, rept from * to last 1 (3, 1, 1, 3, 1, 3, 1, 3, 1) sts, K1 (3, 1, 1, 3, 1, 3, 1, 3, 1).

3rd to 6th rows - Rept 1st and 2nd rows twice more.

7th row - K3 (1, 3, 3, 1, 3, 1, 3, 1, 3, 1), [P1, K3] 6 (7, 7, 8, 9, 9, 10, 10, 11, 11, 12) times, P1, K3, *P1, K3, rept from * to last 0 (2, 0, 0, 2, 0, 2, 0, 2) sts, [P1, K1] 0 (1, 0, 0, 1, 0, 1, 0, 1) time.

8th row - K1 (3, 1, 1, 3, 1, 3, 1, 3, 1, 3), [P1, K3] 7 (7, 8, 9, 9, 10, 10, 11, 11, 12, 12) times, *P1, K3, rept from * to last 2 (0, 2, 2, 0, 2, 0, 2, 0, 2) sts, [P1, K1] 1 (0, 1, 1, 0, 1, 0, 1, 0, 1, 0, 1) time.

9th to 12th rows - Rept 7th and 8th rows twice more.

These 12 rows form second patt.

Cont in patt until back measures 52 (57, 62,

67, 68, 68, 69, 69, 70, 70, 71) cm, 20½ (22½, 24½, 26½, 26½, 26½, 27½, 27½, 27½, 28) ins from beg, ending with a wrong side row.

Work as given for back of Jacket from *** to end.

FRONT

Work as given for Back until 14 (16, 16, 18, 18, 18, 18, 20, 20, 20) rows less have been worked before start of shoulder shaping, thus ending with a wrong side row.

Shape neck

Complete as given for Front of Yoke Sweater.

SLEEVES (both alike)

Work as given for Sleeves of Jacket.

Neck border

Work as given for neck border of Yoke Sweater from **** to ****.

Using a 6½mm needle, cast off loosely in rib.

MAKING UP

Jacket

Sew down pocket tops and linings. Sew on buttons.

Yoke Sweater

Join left shoulder seam and Neck Border, sew on by top sewing reversing seam for roll-back.

Textured Sweater

Join left shoulder seam and Neck Border, sew on by top sewing.

All Versions

Place markers 18 (20, 22, 24, 25, 25, 26, 26, 27, 27, 28) cm, 7 (8, 8¾, 9½, 9¾, 9¾, 10¼, 10¼, 10½, 10½, 11) ins down from shoulder seams on back and front(s) to mark armhole depth. Sew Sleeves in place between markers. Join side and sleeve seams, sew on by top sewing.

For Washing and Pressing instructions see ball band.
