



# Harvest Moon Mittens

## Materials

### Yarn

200 yds (183 m) of sport/DK weight Merino yarn, Estabrook Goldenrod

175 yds (160 m) of Estabrook Slate

10 yds (9 m) Estabrook Natural

### Needles

US size 3 DPN's

### Notions

Tapestry needle, waste yarn, scissors

## Gauge

6.5 stitches x 6 rows = 1 inch

## Sizing

circumference = 9 inches

length = 12.25 inches


cuffed = 10 inches

Key
Yellow Main Color
Grey Contrast Color
White Accent Color
Open circle m1
Blue Thumb
White ssk
Diagonal line k2tog
Diagonal line k3tog
White sssk

## Skill Level

Intermediate

## Right Mitten




Cast on 44 stitches in main color. Work in the round in 1 x 1 ribbing for 25 rows. K1 row increasing 3 stitches evenly across row. Begin right mitten chart. On row 22 move 13 thumb stitches to waste yarn or yarn holder and CO 13 sts in pattern. Work to end of chart, Kitchener remaining stitches together.


### Thumb

Remove the waste yarn from the thumb and pick up 13 sts from CO edge. You should have 26 stitches total. Work thumb chart. Pull yarn through remaining sts, weave in ends, and block.

Repeat for the left mitten.
