MEASUREMENT (CM)

Bust, approx	140
Length, approx	55
Sleeve seam, approx	40

YARN (GRAMS)

Myk Norwegian Lambswool

Main Color 600

NEEDLES

US 10/6 mm: 40 and 80 cm circular; set of 5 dpn,

US 7 / 4.5 mm longer circular for zipper bands

Crochet Hook: US G-6 / 4 mm

GAUGE

12 st moss stitch = 10 cm. 15 m stockinette stitch = 10 cm. One granny square measures approx 17 x 17 cm.

The pattern is written by Sister Act AS and is protected, it is not allowed to copy or sell the pattern.

Make sure to read the pattern carefully, for the best result.

PATTERN NOTES

16 squares are worked, then crocheted together for the front and back pieces.

The hem contains rows of tr clusters and is finished with a ribbed border. For the yoke pick up stitches and knit moss stitch as explained in the pattern. For the sleeves pick up stitches around the yoke and knit from the top.

SQUARE:

Work 8 dc in magic ring.

Round 1: Work 3 ch (= 1 tr), 2 tr in each dc from the previous round. Finish with 1 sl st in 3. ch from the beginning of the round.

Round 2: Work 3 ch (= 1 tr), 1 ch, * 1 tr in tr from the previous round, 1 ch* rep * -* and finish with 1 sl st in 3. ch from the beginning of the round (= 16 tr and 16 ch-sp).

Round 3: Work 3 ch (= 1 tr), * 2 tr in ch-sp, 1 tr in tr from the previous round * rep * -* and finish with 1 sl st in 3. ch from the beginning of the round = 48 tr.

Round 4: This round contains ch-sp which are fastened with sl st in every 3. tr from the previous round. As followed: *5 ch, sl st in 3. tr. 2 ch, sl st in 3. tr. 3 ch, sl st in 3. tr. 2 ch, sl st in 3. tr*. rep * -* and finish with a sl st in the last tr from the previous round.

Round 5: *3 ch (= 1 tr), 4 tr in the big ch-sp, 3 ch, 5 tr in the same ch-sp, 1 sl st in the next ch-sp (ch-sp with 2 ch). 5 tr in the next ch-sp (ch-sp with 3 ch), 1 sl st in next ch-sp (ch sp with 2 chr) *, * rep * -* and finish with 1 sl st in 3. ch from the beginning of the round. Cut the thread.

Round 6: This round starts at the top of the first corner. *1 sl st, 3 ch, 1 sl st i same ch-sp. 5 ch, 1 tr in sl st from previous round, 3 ch, 1 sl st in the 3. tr from the previous round. 3 ch, 1 tr in sl st from previous round, 5 ch.* rep * -* 3 times. Finish with a sl st in the first ch-sp.

Round 7: *3 ch (= 1 tr), 1 tr in the same ch-sp, 2 ch, 2 tr in the same ch-sp. 5 tr in the next ch-sp (with 5 ch), 3 tr in the next ch-sp (with 3 ch), 3 tr in the next ch-sp (with 3 ch), 5 tr in the next ch-sp (with 5 ch)*. rep * -* 3 times. Finish with 1 sl st in 3. ch from the



beginning of the round

RIGHT FRONT

Now we crochet 4 squares together like this:

Enter the hook in the tr on the corner of the square, make sure to only go through the back of the loop. Next go through back of loop on the next square. Pull the yarn through all the loops. This will produce a chain on top of the squares. Start on the right hand side and work to the left, then repeat from top to bottom.

HEM

Work tr clusters (3 tr in same stitch) along the bottom edge. This part of the hem will measure approx. 4 cm.

Round 1: 1 sl st in the corner, 3

ch, 1 tr cluster between the 1. and 2. tr. Skip 3 tr, 1 tr cluster between the next tr, repeat (between the squares 1 tr cluster in the edge, skip to the edge of the next square, 1 tr cluster) = 16 tr clusters

Round 2: 3 ch (turning chain), 1 tr cluster between the tr cluster from the previous round. Repeat until you have worked 4 rounds.

Now work 1 dc in each tr from the previous round.

Cut thread and pick up stitches (1 stitch in back loop of each dc) = 47 stitches.

KNIT RIB

Round 1 (wrong side):): Knit one = edge stitch, * purl one, knit one *. Rep. * - * until 2 stitches remain, purl one, knit one = edge stitch.

Round 2 (right side): Knit one = edge stitch, *knit one, purl one*. Rep. * - * until 2 stitches remain, knit one, knit one = edge stitch.

Repeat round 1 and 2 til the rib is approx. 6 cm. Tip: from round 2 you slip the first stitch purlwise to obtain a nice edge.

YOKE

Pick up stitches (1 stitch in back loop of each tr) = 47 stitches.

Knit moss stitch:

Round 1 (wrong side): 1 edge stitch, purl one, knit one, rep. and finish with 1 edge stitch.

Round 2 (right side):): Knit over knit and purl over purl.

Round 3 (wrong side): 1 edge stitch, knit one, purl one, rep. and finish with 1 edge stitch.

Round 4 (right side): Knit over knit and purl over purl.

Repeat round 1 through 4 but from round 5 (= wrong side) we start decreasing for shoulder and neckline:

Bind off the first 3 stitches for the shoulder, continue with moss stitch until the end of the row. Turn the work, bind off 6 stitches for the neckline and continue with moss stitch until the end of the row. On the following rounds, only bind off 1 stitch towards the neckline, while binding off 3 stitches for the shoulder at each shoulder decrease. Repeat the decreases for the shoulder and neckline a total of 14 times, 7 times on each side = 33 stitches decreased.

Bind off the remaining stitches.

The shoulder decreases create a sloping shoulder.

LEFT FRONT

Like the right front but you mirror the bind off at the yoke. This means that you decrease for the neckline at the beginning of the wrong side, and for the shoulder at the beginning of the right side

BACK

Now we crochet 8 squares together.

Work the tr clusters as in the front = 32 tr clusters

For the rib pick up 94 stitches and knit as explained.

For the yoke pick up 94 stitches and work moss stitches as explained. On the 4th row, decrease as follows: Bind off the first 3 stitches from the wrong side, knit to the end of the row. Repeat the decrease until you have decreased the same number of stitches as on the front piece (7 times in total).

Cast off and crochet the shoulder seam.

NECKLINE

Pick up approx. 56 stitches around the neckline. Work rib for 14 cm, cast off and fold the neck double to the inside and sew down

SLEEVE

Pick up 56 stitches along the yoke (start approx. 24 cm from the shoulder in the front). Work moss stitch back and forth and start decreasing after 4 cm. K2tog, knit until 2 stitches left, k2tog. Repeat every 4. cm 6 times. Cast off after 30 cm.

Now we are crocheting a hem:

Round 1: 1 chain stitch in the outermost stitch, 3 ch, 1 tr clusters in the back loop of the 2nd stitch, skip 3 stitches, 1 tr cluster in the back loop of the next stitch. Continue like this until you have 13 groups of double crochets. Crochet 1 group of double crochets in the corners, turn the work = 13 groups of double crochets.
Round 2: 3 chain stitches, now place the groups of double crochets between the groups of double crochets

from the previous round.

Work tr clusters as explained until you have 6 rows with tr clusters. Finish with a round of dc and cut tread.
Pick up approx. 38 stitches and knit rib approx. 5 cm.

BUTTON BAND

Pick up 80 stitches with circular needle US 7/4,5mm (80cm) in the back loop of the edge stitches/tr.

Work 5 rows with stockinette stitch, cast off. Pick up the same amount of stitches on the inside of the button band and knit 5 rows with stockinette stitch (with the wrong side facing the wrong side of the button band).

Repeat on the other side.

Put in the zipper.

Crochet together the side seams.



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
