

KNITTING PATTERN: HOLME CARDIGAN

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**Sizes:**

XS (S) M (L) XL (XXL)

Yarn and quantity:

Lieve / Mondial, 5 (5) 6 (6) 6 (7) skeins

Needles:

5 mm (80 cm) and 5 mm (40 cm)

Gauge:

12 stitches = 8.5 cm on size 5 mm needles

Bust:

approximately 108 (115) 123 (130) 147 155 cm

Length:

approximately 50 (55) 55 (60) 65 (65) cm

Sleeve length:

approximately 45 (45) 48 (48) 51 (51) cm or desired length

EXPLANATIONS FOR THE RECIPE:

stockinette stitch = knit on the right side, purl on the wrong side

= knit stitch

purl = purl stitch

= needle

m = mask =

a stitch on the needle

sm = together

vr r = knit a knit stitch in the back loop

1 m loose off = take 1 stitch off the needle as if it were to be knitted knit*_* =

repeat the stitches between the asterisks

BUTTONHOLE

The first 6 m and the last 6 m on the needle are knitted throughout the body upwards as a ribbing of 1 knit and 1 purl for the edges. These stitches are kept outside the description of the pattern, so always remember to start and end with these on each pattern needle.

Buttonhole:

If you want to have buttonholes in your jacket, the first buttonhole should be made on the right edge after 3 cm.

How to knit buttonholes:

Knit 2 stitches together and make a yarn over. On the return row, knit the yarn over purlwise. The buttonhole is made in stitches 4 and 5 on the right edge.

THE BODY

Cast on 158 (170) 182 (194) 218 (230) stitches on 5 mm needles (80 cm) and knit a ribbing of 1 knit and 1 purl back and forth for 5 (5) 5 (5) 6 (6) cm.

Place a marker on each side of the body. 80 (86) 92 (98) 110 (116) for the back piece and 39 (42) 45 (48) 54 (57) m for each front piece.

Start knitting the pattern rows 1-20 (explained on the next page).

Remember to continue making buttonholes if you have chosen to include them on your jacket.

Knit until the body measures 30 (35) 35 (35) 40 (40) cm. From the wrong side, bind off 5 stitches on each side of each marker. A total of 10 stitches have now been bound off under each sleeve. From here, each piece is knitted separately.

BACK PIECE

The first two and the last two stitches on the back piece are knitted from here to full length as knit stitches. This is to create a 'firm' edge to pick up stitches for the sleeves later. The stitches in between are knitted in pattern.

When the back piece measures a total length of 50 (55) 55 (60) 65 (65) cm, you loosely bind off.

RIGHT FRONT PIECE

Continue knitting in the pattern. The last two stitches towards the armhole are knitted as knit stitches like on the back piece to pick up stitches for the sleeves later. When there are 4 cm left to the full length 46 (51) 51 (56) 61 (61) cm, you should decrease for a rounded neckline.

From the right side:

Place the 6 edge stitches on a thread and then bind off the next 10 (10) 10 (12) 12 (12) stitches. Knit to the end of the row. And knit the purl row back.

On the next stitch from the edge, decrease another 2 m and continue knitting until the front piece is as long as the back piece. Bind off.

LEFT FRONT PIECE

Knit as the right front piece, but mirrored.

SLEEVES

The sleeve is knitted on circular needles 5 mm (40 cm). Pick up around the armhole 63 (63) 63 (75) 87 (87) stitches on needle 5 mm (40 cm). Find the stitch that will sit directly under the sleeve and place a marker in this stitch. This stitch is kept outside the pattern and is knitted straight down.

When you knit the sleeve, you should evenly decrease the number of stitches to 40 (40) 40 (44) 44 (44) stitches.

Knit pattern needles 1-20 down until the sleeve measures 42 (42) 45 (45) 48 (48) cm or desired length. Pattern knitting ends here.

Knit ribbing 1 knit and 1 purl for 3 cm. Bind off loosely. Knit a second sleeve in the same way.

NECKLINE

Pick up about 60 (60) 60 (68) 68 (68) m including. stitch markers (12 pcs). Knit the neck edge in 1 knit and 1 purl for 4-5 cm. Bind off.

ASSEMBLY

Weave in all ends. All seams are done on the wrong side. Sew together the front pieces and the back piece at the shoulders.

Look at the buttons.

PATTERN

The pattern spans 20 stitches that are repeated upwards in the work. See also the diagram below the description.

6 stitches on each side are kept outside the pattern for the button band and are knitted as ribbing 1 knit and 1 purl upwards.

Needle 1: 2 knit, 1 purl, 2 purl
knit together, 3 knit* repeat* _ * until there are 7 stitches left on the needle 4 knit, 2 purl knit together, 1 purl, 1 knit

Needle 2: stockinette stitch

Needle 3: 3 knit, 1 purl, 2 purl knit together, 2 knit* 3
knit, 2 purl knit together, 1 purl, 3 knit, 1 purl, 2 purl knit together, 2 knit* repeat * _ * until there are 7 stitches left on the needle 3 knit, 2 purl knit together, 1 purl, 2 knit

Needle 4: stockinette stitch

Needle 5: 4 knit, 1 purl, 2 purl together knitwise, 1 knit* 2
knit, 2 purl together knitwise, 1 knit, 5 knit, 1 knit, 2 purl together knitwise, 1 knit* repeat * _ * until there are 7 stitches left on the needle 2 knit, 2 purl together knitwise, 1 knit, 3 knit

Needle 6: stockinette stitch

Needle 7: 5 knit, 1 purl, 2 purl together knitwise* 1
knit, 2 purl together knitwise, 1 knit, 7 knit, 1 knit, 2 purl together knitwise* repeat * _ * until there are 7 stitches left on the needle 1 knit, 2 purl together knitwise, 1 knit, 4 knit

Needle 8: stockinette stitch

Needle 9: 6 knit, 1 purl, 1 stitch off* 2
knit together, pull the loose stitch over, 1 purl 9 knit, 1 purl, 1 stitch off*
repeat * _ * until there are 7 stitches left on the needle 2 knit
together, pull the loose stitch over, 1 purl, 5 knit

Needle 10: stockinette stitch

Needle 11: 5 knit, 2 knit together, 1 purl

1 knit, 1 purl, 2 purl knit together, 7 knit, 2 knit together, 1 purl repeat * _ * until there are 7 stitches left on the needle 1 knit, 1 purl, 2 purl knit together,

4 knit Needle 12: stockinette stitch

Needle 13: 4 knit, 2 knit

together, 1 purl, 1 knit* repeat * _ * until there are 7 stitches left on the needle 2 knit, 1 purl, 2 purl together, 3 knit

Needle 14: stockinette stitch

Needle 15: 3 knit, 2 knit together, 1 purl, 2

knit* 3 knit, 1 purl, 2 purl together, 3 knit, 2 knit together, 1 purl, 2 knit* repeat * _ * until there are 7 stitches left on the needle 3 knit, 1 purl, 2 purl together, 2

knitNeedle 16: stockinette stitch

Needle 17: 2 knit, 2 knit together, 1 purl, 3


knit* 4 knit, 1 purl, 2 purl together, 1 knit, 2 knit together, 1 purl, 3 knit* repeat * _ * until there are 7 stitches left on the needle 4 knit, 1 purl, 2 purl together, 1 knit

Needle 18: stockinette stitch

Needle 19: 1 knit, 2 knit together, 1 purl, 4

knit* 5 knit, 1 purl, 1 stitch slipped, 2 knit together, pull the slipped stitch over, 1 purl, 4 knit* repeat from * to * until 7 stitches remain on the needle 5 knit, 1 purl, 2 purl together

Needle 20: stockinette stitch
