$\alpha$  : stockinette turtle neck and crochet hem and cuffs / The model is 1m 55 cm / 5'1" tall and wearing a size S.



$\beta$  : crochet turtle neck and ribbed hem and cuffs



Size M

$\gamma$  : crochet crew neck and hem, and stockinette sleeves



Size S

This sweater combines crochet and knitting. The four-leaf clover motifs are worked with crochet hooks, and the other parts are worked with knitting needles. The construction is rather unique and it starts from the bottom of the yoke up, then the other parts are worked top-down, which allows you to try the sweater on and choose the length and type of the neck as well as the hem and sleeves. I hope you enjoy this freedom of choice, deciding as you go on the options to work. This pattern contains two files: Sweater's general instructions itself and Crochet Techniques. Please download both files.







4.5 mm / US7 circular needle and dpns for body and sleeves

4 mm / US 6 circular needle and dpns for hem and cuff ribbing

JP7/0 (4 mm / G-6) crochet hook

JP6/0 (3.5 mm / E-4) crochet hook

## GAUGES (after blocking)

18.5 sts and 28 rows/rnds = 10 cm / 4" in stockinette stitch

with 4.5 mm / US7 needle

18 chain sts = 10 cm / 4" with JP7/0 (4 mm / G-6) crochet hook

(Work the foundation chain with loose tension. The gauge given above for chain stitch is a knitting gauge because stitches are picked up along the chain with knitting needle. Please refer to Four-Leaf Clover Finished Sizes for clover leaves' gauge.)

## Four-leaf Clover Finished Sizes

**Clover starting with ch5 using JP7/0 (4 mm/G6) hook**

3.5 cm tall x 4 cm wide / 1 $\frac{1}{8}$ " tall x 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " wide



**Clover starting with ch4 using JP7/0 (4 mm/G6) hook**

2.7 cm tall x 3 cm wide / 1 $\frac{1}{8}$ " tall x 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " wide



**Clover starting with ch3 using JP7/0 (4 mm/G6) hook**

2.5 cm tall x 2.2 cm wide / 1" tall x  $\frac{3}{8}$ " wide



**Clover starting with ch3 using JP6/0 (3.5 mm/E4) hook**

2.2 cm tall x 2 cm wide /  $\frac{7}{8}$ " tall x  $\frac{3}{4}$ " wide



**Clover starting with ch2 using JP6/0 (3.5 mm/E4) hook**

1.5 cm tall x 2 cm wide /  $\frac{5}{8}$ " tall x  $\frac{3}{4}$ " wide

[German Short Row](#): turn work and with yarn in front, slip 1 st purlwise and pull yarn to back of work until the stitch looks doubled. We call this doubled st GS in this pattern.


## INSTRUCTIONS

Start from the bottom of the yoke up using crochet hook.

NOTE : Please refer to “Crochet Techniques” file for all the following instructions marked with ♦.



Using JP7/0 (4 mm / G6) crochet hook, placing removable markers every 8 sts, ch 248 (256, 264, 272)( 280, 296, 312, 328).



You will have 1 clover motif every 8 sts.

NOTE: If you are an experienced crocheter, you may not want to place removable markers. I however invite you to do so because you need to count stitches working clover motifs. The pattern assumes that you have them placed.

【You will have 31 (32, 33, 34)(35, 37, 39, 41) clover motifs.】

**Rnd 1:** Following Step 1-1 of ♦ 3, work to end of chain.

With last st of first row on hook, being careful not to twist leaves, insert hook in st marked with first M (see photo below) and sl st to join in the round.



**Rnd 2:** Following Step 1-2 of ♦ 3, work to end. Sl st in first st (st shown with arrow in photo).



**Rnd 3:** Following Step 2-1 of ♦ 3, work to end.

**Rnd 4:** Following Step 2-2 of ♦ 3, work to end. Sl st in first st.

**Rnd 5:** Following Step 3-1 of ♦ 3, work to end.

**Rnd 6:** Following Step 3-2 of ♦ 3, work to end. Sl st in first st.

Choose the neck from 3 options and proceed with your version.

From this point forward, when knitting four leaves, the crochet hook size may differ from the instructions in ♦ 3. Please follow the instructions of this file.

## NECK 1

### Stockinette Turtleneck version



Still using JP7/0 (4 mm/G6) hook and following ♦ 2, connect the leaves, placing a removable marker to every slipped st:

Work {ch4, sl st} 31 (32, 33, 34)(35, 37, 39, 41) times.



【You will have a 4-st chain and 1 slipped st per clover motif and 155 (160, 165, 170)(175, 185, 195, 205) total sts.】

Using 4.5 mm / US7 circular needle and following ♦ 1, pick up and knit every st. Be sure to pick up marked sts, removing markers. PM for BOR.

【155 (160, 165, 170)(175, 185, 195, 205) sts on needle】

### Decreases

**Rnds 1-2 (2, 2, 3)(3, 3, 4, 5):** K to M (BOR), SM

**Rnd 3 (3, 3, 4)(4, 4, 5, 6):** [K5, k2tog] 8 (5, 5, 2)(0, 0, 0, 0) times, [k4, k2tog] 3 (7, 8, 13)(12, 5, 0, 0) times, [k3, k2tog] 0 (0, 0, 0)(2, 12, 39, 16) times, [k2, k2tog] 0 (0, 0, 0)(0, 0, 0, 5)

times, [k5, k2tog] 9 (5, 4, 0)(0, 0, 0, 0) times,

[k4, k2tog] 3 (8, 9, 13)(13, 5, 0, 0) times, [k3, k2tog] 0 (0, 0, 0)(3, 13, 0, 17) times, [k2, k2tog] 0 (0, 0, 0)(0, 0, 0, 5) times  
【23(25, 26, 28)(30, 35, 39, 43) sts dec'd, 132 (135, 139, 142)(145, 150, 156, 162) total sts】

**Rnds 4 (4, 4, 5)(5, 5, 6, 7)-7 (7, 7, 8)(8, 9, 11, 13):** K to M (BOR), SM

**Rnd 8 (8, 8, 9)(9, 10, 12, 14):** [K4, k2tog] 8 (5, 5, 2)(0, 0, 0, 0) times, [k3, k2tog] 3 (7, 8, 13)(12, 5, 0, 0) times, [k2, k2tog] 0 (0, 0, 0)(2, 12, 39, 16) times, [k1, k2tog] 0 (0, 0, 0)(0, 0, 0, 5) times, [k4, k2tog] 9 (5, 4, 0)(0, 0, 0, 0) times, [k3, k2tog] 3 (8, 9, 13)(13, 5, 0, 0) times, [k2, k2tog] 0 (0, 0, 0)(3, 13, 0, 17) times, [k1, k2tog] 0 (0, 0, 0)(0, 0, 0, 5) times.

【23(25, 26, 28)(30, 35, 39, 43) sts dec'd, 109 (110, 113, 114)(115, 115, 117, 119) total sts】

### RAGLAN DECREASES

Decrease on even-numbered rnds only on front and back inside markers.

**Rnd 1:** K17, PM, k37 (38, 39, 40)(40, 40, 41, 42), PM, k17, PM, k38 (38, 40, 40)(41, 41, 42 43), SM (BOR)

**Rnd 2:** {K17, SM, k2tog, k to 2 sts before M, ssk, SM} twice.

【4 sts dec'd, 105 (106, 109, 110)(111, 111, 113, 115) total sts】

**Rnds 3-6:** Rep Rnds 1-2 twice (read SM instead of PM).

【8sts dec'd, 97 (98, 101, 102)(103, 103, 105, 107) total sts】

### SHAPE BACK NECK WITH GERMAN SHORT ROWS

**Row 1:** K2, turn.

**Row 2:** GS, p1, SM, p to next M, SM, p2, turn.

**Row 3:** GS, k1. SM, k to 5 sts before M, turn.

**Row 4:** GS, p to 5 sts before next M, turn.

**Row 5:** GS. then working KDS, k to next M, SM(BOR)

**Rnd 6:** {K17, SM, k2tog, k to 2 sts before next M, ssk, SM} twice, working KGS.

【4 sts dec'd, 93 (94, 97, 98)(99, 99, 101, 103) total sts】

## STOCKINETTE TURTLE NECK

**Rnd 1:** removing markers you encounter, k to M(BOR), SM.

Rep Rnd 1 for 11 cm / 4.25" or to your desired length.

## RIB EDGE

Sizes S & L only

**Rnds 1-2:** [K1, p1] to M (BOR), SM.

Bind off all sts as they appear.

【 - (94, - , 98)( - , - , - , - ) total sts】

Proceed to Yoke to Sleeve separation.

Sizes XS, M, XL, 2XL, 3XL, 4XL

**Rnd 1:** K2tog, p1,[k1, p1] to M(BOR), SM.

【1 st dec'd, 92 ( - , 96, - )(98, 98, 100, 102) total sts】

**Rnd 2:** [K1, p1] to M(BOR), SM.

Bind off all sts as they appear.

Proceed to Yoke to Sleeve separation.

## NECK 2

### CROCHET FOUR-LEAF CLOVER TURTLE NECK



Change to JP6/0 (3.5 mm/E4) hook.

Sizes XS, S, M only

**Rnd 7:** Following Step 4-1 of ◆ 3, work to end.

**Rnd 8:** Following Step 4-2 of ◆ 3, work to end. Sl st in first st.

**Rnd 9:** Following Step 5-1 of ◆ 3, work to end.

**Rnd 10:** Following Step 5-2 of ◆ 3, work to end. Sl st in first st.

Proceed to Neck Set-up Rnds.

Sizes L, XL only

**Rnd 7** Following Step 3-1 of ◆ 3, work to end.

**Rnd 8:** Following Step 4-2 of ◆ 3, work to end. Sl st in first st.

**Rnd 9:** Following Step 4-1 of ◆ 3, work to end.

**Rnd 10:** Following Step 4-2 of ◆ 3, work to end. Sl st in first st.

**Rnd 11:** Following Step 5-1 of ◆ 3, work to end.

**Rnd 12:** Following Step 5-2 of ◆ 3, work to end. Sl st in first st.

Proceed to Neck Set-up Rnds.

Sizes 2XL, 3XL, 4XL only

**Rnd 7:** Following Step 3-1 of ◆ 3, work to end.

**Rnd 8:** Following Step 3-2 of ◆ 3, work to end. Sl st in first st.

**Rnd 9:** Following Step 3-1 of ◆ 3, work to end.

**Rnd 10:** Following Step 4-2 of ◆ 3, work to end. Sl st in first st.

**Rnd 11:** Following Step 4-1 of ◆ 3, work to end.

**Rnd 12:** Following Step 4-2 of ◆ 3, work to end. Sl st in first st.

**Rnd 13:** Following Step 5-1 of ◆ 3, work to end.

**Rnd 14:** Following Step 5-2 of ◆ 3, work to end. Sl st in first st.

Proceed to Neck Set-up Rnds.

## Neck Set-up Rnds

NOTE: Work Rnd 1 and Rnd 2, referring to ◆ 4.

Sizes XS, S, M, L, XL, 2XL only

**Rnd 1:** Work <A> 4 ( 2, 3, 4)(2, 1, - , - ) times, then work <B> 5 (8, 7, 6)(9, 11, 8, 2) times.

**Rnd 2:** Ch5, dc in 3<sup>rd</sup> ch from hook, sl sc in ★ of lower leaflet, {Ch2, dc in same ★, Ch2, dc in ★, sl sc in ★ of lower leaflet} twice, Ch2, dc in same ★, work <D> 3 ( 1, 2, 3)(1, 0, - , - ) times, work <E> 5 (8, 7, 6)(9, 11, - , - ) times, sl st in first st.

【You have 22 (22, 23, 24)(24, 25, 25, 25) clovers.】

Sizes 3XL, 4XL only

**Rnd 1:** Work <B> - ( - , - , - )( - , - , 8, 2) times, then work <C> - ( - , - , - )( - , - , 3, 7) times.

**Rnd 2:** Ch5, dc in 3<sup>rd</sup> ch from hook, sl sc in ★ of lower leaflet, Ch2, dc in same ★, Ch2, dc in ★, sl sc in ★ of lower leaflet, Ch2, dc in same ★, work <E> - ( - , - , - )( - , - , 7, 1) time(s), work <F> - ( - , - , - )( - , - , 3, 7) times, sl st in first st.

【You have 22 (22, 23, 24)(24, 25, 25, 25) clovers】

All Sizes

**Rnd 3:** Following Step 5-1 of ♦ 3, work to end.

**Rnd 4:** Following Step 5-2 of ♦ 3, work to end. Sl st in first st.

**Rnds 5-10:** Rep Rnds 3-4 three more times.

**Rnd 11:** Rep Rnd 3.

**Rnd 12:** Ch3, dc in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook, sl sc in ★ of lower leaflet, {Ch1, dc in same ★, Ch1, dc in ★, sl sc in ★ of lower leaflet}, rep { } to end, sl st in first st.

You can adjust the collar's length to your liking by increasing or decreasing the number of repeats of Rnds 5-12. End with an uneven number of rnd in this case.

Proceed to Yoke to Sleeve Separation.

## NECK 3

### Four-leaf Clover Crew Neck



Sizes XS, S, M only

Continue with JP7/0 (4 mm/G6) hook.

**Rnd 7:** Following Step 3-1 of ♦ 3, work to end.

Change to JP6/0 (3.5 mm/E4) hook.

**Rnd 8:** Following Step 4-2 of ♦ 3, work to end. Sl st in first st.

**Rnd 9:** Following Step 4-1 of ♦ 3, work to end.

**Rnd 10:** Following Step 4-2 of ♦ 3, work to end. Sl st in first st.

Referring to ♦2, connect leaves, placing a removable marker to every slipped st, as follows:

{Ch3, sl st, Ch2, sl st, Ch2, sl st} 1 (4, 7, -) (-, -, -, -) times,

{Ch3, sl st, Ch2, sl st} 14 (10, 6, -) (-, -, -, -) times.

【You have a 2 or 3-st chain and 1 slipped st per clover motif and have 108 (110, 112, -) (-, -, -, -) total sts】

Sizes L, XL, 2XL only

Continue with JP7/0 (4 mm/G6) hook.

**Rnd 7:** Following Step 3-1 of ♦ 3, work to end.

**Rnd 8:** Following Step 3-2 of ♦ 3, work to end. Sl st in first st.

**Rnd 9:** Following Step 4-1 of ♦ 3, work to end.

Change to JP6/0 (3.5 mm/E4) hook.

**Rnd 10:** Following Step 4-2 of ♦ 3, work to end. Sl st in first st.

**Rnd 11:** Following Step 4-1 of ♦ 3, work to end.

**Rnd 12:** Following Step 4-2 of ♦ 3, work to end. Sl st in first st.

Referring to ♦2, connect leaves, placing a removable marker to every slipped st, as follows:

{Ch3, sl st, Ch2, sl st, Ch2, sl st} - (-, -, 10) (7, 5, -, -) times,  
{Ch2, sl st} - (-, -, 4) (14, 22, -, -) times.

【You have a 2 or 3-st chain and 1 slipped st per clover and have - (-, -, 112) (112, 116, -, -) total sts】

Sizes 3XL, 4XL only

Continue with JP7/0 (4 mm/G6) hook.

**Rnd 7:** Following Step 3-1 of ♦ 3, work to end.

**Rnd 8:** Following Step 3-2 of ♦ 3, work to end. Sl st in first st.

**Rnd 9:** Following Step 4-1 of ♦ 3, work to end.

Change to JP6/0 (3.5 mm/E4) hook.

**Rnd 10:** Following Step 4-2 of ♦ 3, work to end. Sl st in first st.

**Rnd 11:** Following Step 4-1 of ♦ 3, work to end.

**Rnd 12:** Following Step 4-2 of ♦ 3, work to end. Sl st in first st.

**Rnd 13:** Following Step 5-1 of ♦ 3, work to end.

**Rnd 14:** Following Step 5-2 of ♦ 3, work to end. Sl st in first st.

Referring to ♦2, connect leaves, placing a removable marker to every slipped st, as follows:

{Ch2, sl st} - (-, -, -) (-, -, 38, 36) times, {Ch1, sl st} - (-, -, -) (-, -, 1, 5) time(s).

【You have a 1 or 2-st chain and 1 slipped st per clover motif and have - (-, -, -) (-, -, 116, 118) total sts】

All sizes

**Pick-up Rnd:** Using 4 mm / US6 circular needle and referring to ♦1, pick up and knit every st, including marked sts. PM for BOR. 【108 (110, 112, 112) (112, 116, 118) total sts】

**Rnd 1:** K to M (BOR), SM

**Rnd 2:** [Ktbl 1, p1] to M(BOR), SM.

Rep Rnd 2 for 3cm / 1.25". RM.

BO all sts as they appear.

## YOKE TO SLEEVE SEPARATION

Using 4.5 mm / US7 circular needle and referring to ◆ 1, pick up and knit every chain st, being sure to pick up at marked sts. PM for BOR.

In order to place a new BOR M at the left back shoulder, start picking up sts at 14 (14, 14, 14)(15, 15, 16, 17)th st left to the current BOR marker (white M in the photo).

NOTE: While picking up sts, check that you have 8 sts between marked st and the st before M.

【248 (256, 264, 272)(280, 296, 312, 328) total sts】



**Rnd 1:** {K80 (84, 87, 90)(93, 100, 107, 113), PM, k44 (44, 45, 46)(47, 48, 49, 51)}, PM, rep {} once, SM(BOR).

**Rnds 2-8:** K to M (BOR), SM

## RAGLAN INCREASES

**Rnd 1:** {K1, M1R, k to 1 st before M, M1L, k1, SM} 4 times.

【8 sts inc'd, 256 (264, 272, 280)(288, 304, 320, 336) total sts】

**Rnd 2:** K to M (BOR), SM

Rep Rnds 1-2, 0 (0, 1, 2)(3, 3, 5, 7) more time(s).

【0 (0, 8, 16)(24, 24, 40, 56) sts inc'd, 256 (264, 280, 296)(312, 328, 360, 392) total sts】

## WORK BACK ONLY (SHAPE BACK HIGHER)

**Row 1 (RS):** K82 (86, 91, 96)(101, 108, 119, 129), turn.

**Row 2 (WS):** P82 (86, 91, 96)(101, 108, 119, 129), turn.

Rep last 2 rows 5 (6, 6, 6)(6, 6, 6, 6) more times.

【12 (14, 14, 14)(14, 14, 14, 14) total rows】

## SLEEVE SEPARATION

{K82 (86, 91, 96)(101, 108, 119, 129), RM, put next 46 (46, 49, 52)(55, 56, 61, 67) sts on hold onto waste yarn, RM, turn work and Cable Cast On 6 (6, 6, 6)(8, 10, 10, 10) sts, turn work} 2 times, PM(BOR)

【176 (184, 194, 204)(218, 236, 258, 278) total body sts】

## LOWER BODY

Choose the hem from 2 options and proceed with your version.

### HEM 1

#### RIBBED HEM

**Rnd 1:** K to M (BOR), SM

Rep Rnd 1 until lower body measures 31cm / 12.25" or 6cm / 2.25" shorter than your desired length.

#### RIBBING

**Rnd 1:** Change to 4 mm/US6 circular needle and [k1, p1] to M(BOR), SM.

Rep Rnd 1 until ribbing measures 6cm / 2.25".

BO all sts as they appear.

### HEM 2

#### CLOVER HEM

**Rnd 1:** K to M (BOR), SM

Rep Rnd 1 until lower body measures 29cm / 11.5" or 8cm / 3.25" shorter than desired length.

#### MAKE CLOVER LEAVES

Using JP7/0 (4 mm/G6) hook, Crochet BO all sts on circular needle.



Be careful not to bind off sts too tightly.

Place removable markers every 5 sts 8 (7, 8, 9)(11, 11, 12, 11) times, every 6 sts 8 (10, 10, 10)(9, 10, 12, 14) times, then every 5 sts 8 (7, 8, 9)(11, 11, 12, 11) times, every 6 sts 8 (9, 9, 9)(9, 11, 11, 14) times. We will make a clover leaf between each set of markers.

【You will have 32 (33, 35, 37)(40, 43, 47, 50) leaves.】



**Rnd 1:** Following Step 2-1 of ◆ 3, work to end.

**Rnd 2:** Following Step 2-2 of ◆ 3, work to end. Sl st in first st.

**Rnds 3-6:** Rep Rnds 1-2 twice.



## Sleeves

### RIGHT SLEEVE

Place 46(46, 49, 52)(55, 56, 61, 67) sts previously set on hold onto 4.5 mm / US7 needle(s).

Starting at the center of 6 (6, 6, 6)(8, 10, 10, 10) underarm CO sts, pick up and knit 3 (3, 3, 3)(4, 5, 5, 5), pick up and knit 8 (9, 9, 9)(9, 9, 9, 9) sts along the 12 (14, 14, 14)(14, 14, 14, 14) back rows, k46(46, 49, 52)(55, 56, 61, 67), pick up and knit 3 (3, 3, 3)(4, 5, 5, 5) from underarm, PM(BOR).

【60 (61, 64, 67)(72, 75, 80, 86) total sts】

**Rnds 1-8 (8, 7, 7)(6, 6, 5, 5):** K to M (BOR), SM

**Rnd 9 (9, 8, 8)(7, 7, 6, 6):** K1, k2tog, k to 3 sts before M, ssk, k1, SM(BOR).

Rep Rnds 1-9 (9, 8, 8)(7, 7, 6, 6) 7 (7, 8, 8)(9, 10, 11, 14) more times.

【44 (45, 46, 49)(52, 53, 56, 56) total sts】

### LEFT SLEEVE

Place 46(46, 49, 52)(55, 56, 61, 67) sts previously set on hold onto 4.5 mm / US7 needle(s).

Starting at the center of 6 (6, 6, 6)(8, 10, 10, 10) underarm CO sts, pick up and knit 3 (3, 3, 3)(4, 5, 5, 5), k46(46, 49, 52)(55, 56, 61, 67), pick up and knit 8 (9, 9, 9)(9, 9, 9, 9) sts along the 12 (14, 14, 14)(14, 14, 14, 14) back rows, pick up and knit 3 (3, 3, 3)(4, 5, 5, 5) from underarm, PM(BOR).

【60 (61, 64, 67)(72, 75, 80, 86) total sts】

**Rnds 1-8 (8, 7, 7)(6, 6, 5, 5):** K to M (BOR), SM

**Rnd 9 (9, 8, 8)(7, 7, 6, 6):** K1, k2tog, k to 3 sts before M, ssk, k1, SM(BOR).

Rep Rnds 1-9 (9, 8, 8)(7, 7, 6, 6) 7 (7, 8, 8)(9, 10, 11, 14) more times.

【44 (45, 46, 49)(52, 53, 56, 56) total sts】

Choose from 3 types of sleeves and proceed with your version. Both sleeves are worked the same from now on.

### CUFF 1

#### RIBBED CUFFS

Work even in stockinette stitch until sleeve measures 36cm / 14.25" (or 6cm/2.25" shorter than desired length).

Sizes XS, M, XL, 3XL, 4XL only

**Rnd 1:** Change to 4mm / US6 needle, k to M (BOR), SM.

【44 (-, 46, -)(52, -, 56, 56) total sts】

Sizes S, L, 2XL only

**Rnd 1:** Change to 4mm / US6 needle, k2tog, K to M (BOR), SM.

【- (44, -, 48)(-, 52, -, -) total sts】

#### RIBBING

**Rnd 2:** [K1, p1] to M(BOR).

Rep Rnd 2 until ribbing measures 6cm/ 2.25".

BO all sts as they appear.

## CUFF 2

### STOCKINETTE SLEEVES

Work even in stockinette stitch until sleeve measures 40cm/15.75" (or 2 cm/0.75" shorter than desired length).

Sizes XS, M, XL, 3XL, 4XL only

**Rnd 1:** Still with 4mm / US7 needle, k to M (BOR), SM

【44 ( - , 46 , - )( 52, - , 56, 56) total sts】

Sizes S, L, 2XL only

**Rnd 1:** Still with 4mm / US7 needle, k2tog, K to M (BOR), SM

【- ( 44, - , 48)( - , 52, - , - ) total sts】

## RIBBING

**Rnds 2-3:** [K1, p1] to M(BOR).

BO all sts as they appear.

## CUFF3

### CLOVER CUFF

Work even in stockinette stitch until sleeve measures 37cm/14.5" (or 5cm/2" shorter than desired length).

Using JP7/0 (4 mm/G6) hook, Crochet BO all sts, being careful not to work too tightly.

Then, place removable markers every 5 sts 4 (4, 2, 5)(2, 1, 4, 4) time(s), every 6 sts 4 (4, 6, 4)(7, 8, 6, 6) times.

【You will have 8 (8, 8, 9)(9, 9, 10, 10) sets of leaves.】

**Rnd 1:** Following Step 2-1 of ◆ 3, work to end.

**Rnd 2:** Following Step 2-2 of ◆ 3, work to end. Sl st in first st.

**Rnd 3:** Rep Rnd 1.

Change to JP6/0 (3.5 mm/E4) hook.

**Rnd 4:** Following Step 3-2 of ◆ 3, work to end. Sl st in first st.

**Rnd 5:** Following Step 5-1 of ◆ 3, work to end.



## Finishing

Weave in ends and block to shape the sweater.
