Gauge

21 stitches x 32 rows = 10cm / 4 inches knit flat and in pattern, using 4.5mm needles, blocked.

Overview

The cardigan has an all over faux cable design. It is worked top down with raglan increases. The neck is shaped with short rows, then the body is knit flat and the sleeves are knit in the round. The buttonband is worked as you knit the body leaving only the neck band to be picked up at the end. The design overall is fairly easy but it requires you to be able to follow the chart and work the increase stitches in pattern.

Techniques for the pattern**Raglan detail**

Odd-numbered rows are worked on the right side, the even-numbered rows are worked on the wrong side. A chart is also available at the bottom of the pattern.

Row 1: p1, k3, p1

Row 2: k1, p3, k1

Row 3-6: repeat rows 1 and 2

Row 7: p1, wyib sl 3 to RH needle, pass the 3rd stitch over the first 2 stitches. slip those 2 stitches back onto LH needle. K1, YO, k1

Row 8, k1, p1, p tbl, p1, k1

Raglan increases

On the wrong side: Make 1 yarn over, work raglan detail, 1 yarn over. Increase like this at each stitch marker (= 8 stitches increased each round).

On the right side

Knit in the back loop of the yarn over (yarn over twists to the left).

WORK RAGLAN DETAIL AS PER THE INSTRUCTIONS.

Slip the yarn over onto the right needle as if to knit, place it back onto the left needle (it is now twisted), and knit in the front loop (yarn over twists to the right).

On the following wrong side row after resolving the yarn overs, work the new stitch according to the pattern.

Buttonholes

Work buttonholes on the right-hand side buttonband (when the garment is worn). Work from the wrong side side. Work 4 stitches, p2tg, make 1 yarn over, continue in pattern. On the next row (right side), purl the yarn over to leave a hole. The first buttonhole should be roughly 6-6-6-6-7-7-7-7cm from the cast on edge. The remaining 5 buttonholes are worked with approx. 7-7-7-7-8-8-8cm between each one. There should be 2cm from the last buttonhole to the cast off edge. The 7th buttonhole is worked on the neckband.

As you work the buttonholes you can place a stitch marker on the left-hand side buttonband to note exactly where the corresponding button should go.

Buttonband

The buttonband is worked over the first and last 10 stitches on each side of the cardigan. It's worked with a twisted slipped stitch design. The slipped stitches are then twisted to give a slightly different take on a 1x1 rib.

When slipping the first stitch on the wrong side of the right buttonband slip it with yarn in front, for all remaining stitches hold your yarn in back when slipping.

To get the twisted stitches slip the stitches knitwise.

If you're a looser knitter you can also twist when working the stitch on the very edge of each buttonband to give a clean finish.

Left buttonband

Right side: [sl,p] repeat 5 times

Wrong side: [k,p] repeat 5 times

Right buttonband

Right side: [p,sl] repeat 4 times, p, k

Wrong side: sl, [k,p] repeat 4 times, k

I recommend placing a unique stitch marker to denote which buttonband is the right-hand side one and the one in which you'll be working the buttonholes.

Making adjustments to the pattern

Adjusting the length

If you'd like to add or take away length you'll have to keep in mind even button spacing. You can do this by working one more or one less buttonhole. Alternatively you can make the spacing between the buttonholes slightly smaller or larger. To work out exactly how you'd need to add or

take away from each spacing; take the amount of length you'd like to add or take off and divide it by 6. Then add or subtract that number from all the button spacings including the spacing of the first buttonhole from the cast on edge

Adjusting the sleeves

If you'd like to make the sleeves wider and you're working a size that involves working the sleeve increases every 4th row you can replace some of those increases with increasing every row until your sleeve reaches your desired measurements.

To make the sleeves more fitted you can work the increases for the sleeves every 4th row at the end of the raglan increases. This can be done for any size.

The pattern on the sleeves will still have to match up so you'll have to add or take away stitches in multiples of 8.

Pattern starts here!

Before starting the pattern please read through the techniques section.

1. Neck shaping

Using 4.5mm needles and long tail cast on, cast on 111-111-111-111-127-127-127-127-127 stitches.

Sizes XS-L:

Row 1 of short rows (RS):

[k1, p1] 5 times in total (10 stitches for the buttonband). You can place a marker here to help you keep track of when to work the buttonband.

[K3, p1] repeat 2 times in total, k3 (21 stitches in total for the front)

Place of marker.

Work the raglan detail over the next 5 stitches.

Place a marker.

[K3, p1] repeat 2 times in total, k3 (11 stitches for the left sleeve).

Place marker.

Work the raglan detail over the next 5 stitches.

Place a marker.

[K3, p1] repeat 6 times in total, k3 (27 stitches for the back).

Place marker.

Work the raglan detail over the next 5 stitches.

Place a marker.

[K3, p1] repeat 2 times in total, k3 (11 stitches for the right sleeve).

Place marker. Work the raglan detail over the next 5 stitches.

Place a marker.

Knit 2. Turn and mds. (-- stitches worked total)

P1, YO, sm.

Work the raglan detail over the next 5 stitches. Sm.

YO. [p3, k1] repeat 2 times in total, p3 (11 stitches for the right sleeve). YO. Sm.

Work the raglan detail over the next 5 stitches. Sm.

YO. [p3, k1] repeat 6 times in total, p3 (27 stitches for the back). YO. Sm.

Work the raglan detail over the next 5 stitches. Sm.

YO. [p3, k1] repeat 2 times in total, p3 (11 stitches for the left sleeve). YO. Sm.

Work the raglan detail over the next 5 stitches. Sm.

YO. Purl 2. Turn and mds.

Row 3 (RS):

K1, resolve YO. Sm.

Raglan detail. Sm.

Resolve YO. [K3, p1] repeat 2 times in total, k3. Resolve YO. Sm.

Row 10 of this section corresponds to row 4 of the chart.

2. Yoke

Now you'll be working back and forth across the whole row.
You'll continue working the buttonband (and buttonholes) and making increases.
Keep working the body and sleeve stitches as established according to the chart. You'll be starting this section on row 13 of the chart.
Keep an eye on the chart as you work further increases so the new stitches still match the pattern. You should be working the faux cable detail on the raglan at the same time as working it on the body.

Continue working the raglan increases until you have worked a total of 28-24-20-36-36-32-44-40-36 rows of raglan increases.

The increases worked during the short row section will count towards this total.

Total stitches= 335-303-271-399-415-383-479-447-415

For sizes XS, L, XL and 3X:

Continue onto section 3 after working the right side and resolving all your yarn overs.

At the end of this section you should have:

49-57-61-69 stitches for each front
67-83-83-99 stitches for each sleeve
83-99-107-123 stitches for the back

Total stitches= 335-399-415-479

For sizes S, M, 2X, 4X and 5X:

You'll now be working the increases on the sleeves every 4th row instead of every 2nd. You'll continue working body increases every 2nd row.

When starting these increases you should have:

45-41-57-65-61 stitches for each front
59-51-75-91-83 stitches for each sleeve
75-67-99-115-107 stitches for the back

Continue working increases until you've worked a total of 32-36-40-48-52 increase rounds for the body and 28-28-36-44-44 increase rounds for the sleeves.

You should have:

53-57-65-73-77 stitches for each front,
67-67-83-99-99 stitches for each sleeve
91-99-115-131-139 stitches for the back

Total stitches = 351-367-431-495-511

You can now continue onto section 3 after working the right side and resolving all your yarn overs.

3. Splitting for sleeves

You'll start this section on the wrong side.

Work until you get to the first stitch marker.

Remove the stitch marker and work the raglan detail stitches. Those stitches will now be worked as part of the body.

Remove stitch marker and place 67-67-67-83-83-83-99-99-99 stitches on hold (right sleeve).

Remove stitch marker.

Cast on 3-3-3-11-11-11-19-19-19 stitches under the arm. Work the raglan detail stitches.

Work across the back until you reach a stitch marker. Remove stitch marker. Work raglan detail stitches.

Remove stitch marker and place 67-67-67-83-83-83-99-99-99 stitch on hold (left sleeve).

Remove stitch marker.

Cast on 3-3-3-11-11-11-19-19-19 stitches under the arm. Work the raglan detail stitches.

Remove stitch marker and work all the stitches until the end of the row.

Total stitches on the needles: 207-223-239-255-271-287-319-335-351

4. Body

Continue knitting the body and buttonbands as established. Start working the underarm and the stitches that were the raglan detail to fit the pattern (instead of working the motif on the raglan detail every 8 rows work it so it fits with the already established pattern on the body)

Remember to continue working the buttonholes.

Once the body reaches roughly 38-38-38-38-38-44-44-44-44cm along the front edge start on the ribbing.(you should be roughly 3.5cm past the 5th button hole)

Finish after working row 4 or 12 of the chart. Continue with 4.5mm needles.

Row 1 (RS): work buttonband, [tbl, p1] to 10 stitches from the end, work buttonband.

Row 2 (WS): work buttonband, [tbl, k1] to 10 stitches from end, work buttonband.

Repeat row 1 and 2 until you are 2cm past your last buttonhole.

Your ribbing should be roughly 5cm.

Work a tubular bind off to finish off the body.

5. Neckband

Using 3.75mm needles, pick up 111-111-111-111-127-127-127-127-127 stitches for the neckline.

Row 1(WS): Sl, [k1, ptbl] to the end of row

Row 2(RS): Sl, [p1, ktbl] to the end of row

For sizes XS-L work row 1 one more time (3 rows in total)

For sizes XL-5X work rows 1 and 2 one more time and then work row 1 once more (5 rows in total)

Now work 4 stitches from the edge, k2tg, yo, work to the end of the row.

For sizes XS-L work row 1 and 2.

For sizes XL-5X work row 1 and 2 2 times (4 rows in total)

Cast off using tubular bind off.

6. Sleeves

Place beginning of round marker. Pick up 5-5-5-13-13-13-21-21-21 stitches under the arm.

total stitches= 72-72-72-96-96-96-120-120-120

The picked stitches will be incorporated into the faux cable pattern. Start working the sleeves in the round. Make sure you're following the chart.

Knit until the sleeve is roughly 3cm from your wrist. Finish after working round 4 or 12 of the chart.

Now switch to 4mm needles. Decrease evenly across the round to 42-42-42-48-48-48-54-54-54 stitches. Knit across the whole round.

Now start the ribbing. [ktbl, p1] across the whole round. Work 8 rounds in total of ribbing.

Finish off the sleeve with a tubular cast off.

7 .Finishing

Weave in all the ends and block.

Sew on your buttons. If your buttons are heavy you can sew a piece of ribbon to the inside of the buttonband to stop it from stretching.

Depending on the yarn used and the size, your cardigan can end up quite heavy. To prevent the neck from stretching too much you can add some elastic thread to the neck band. You can also add a crochet chain along where you picked up for the neck. This should give extra stability.

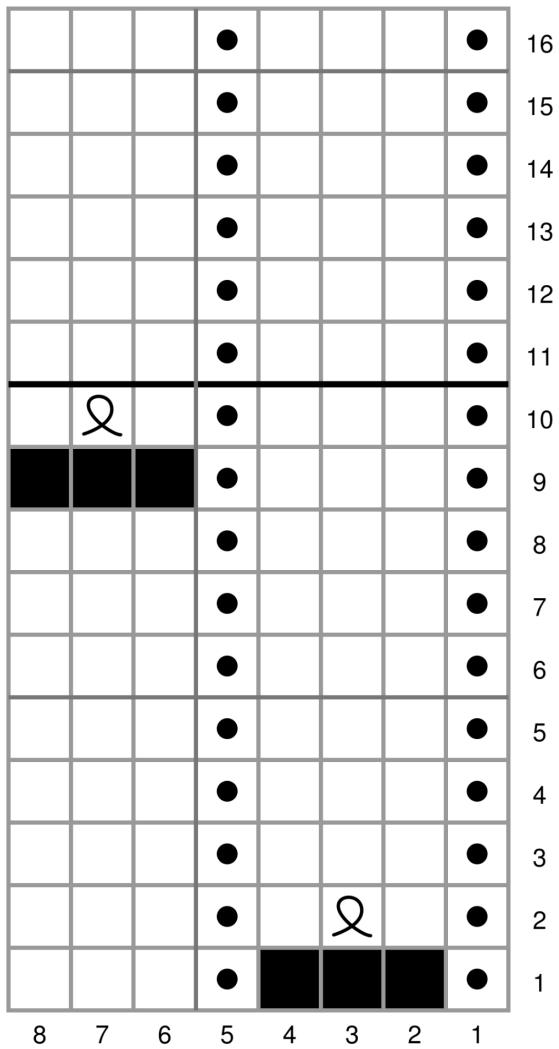

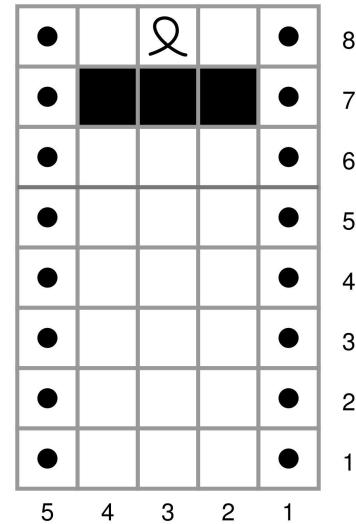

Written instructions for knitting flat

Row 1(RS): p1, wyib sl 3 to RH needle, pass the 3rd stitch over the first 2 stitches. slip those 2 stitches back onto LH needle. K1, YO, k1, p1, k3.

Row 2(WS) p3, k1, p1, p tbl, p1, k1

Row 3: p1, k3, p1, k3

Row 4: p3, k1, p3, k1

Row 5-8: repeat row 3 and 4

Row 9: p1, k3, p1. wyib sl 3 to RH needle, pass the 3rd stitch over the first 2 stitches. slip those 2 stitches back onto LH needle. K1, YO, k1

Row 10: p1, p tbl, p1, k1, p3, k1

Row 11-16: repeat row 3 and 4

Written instructions for knitting in the round

Round 1: p1, wyib sl 3 to RH needle, pass the 3rd stitch over the first 2 stitches. slip those 2 stitches back onto LH needle. K1, YO, k1, p1, k3.

Round 2: p1, k1, k tbl, k1, p1, k3

Round 3: p1, k3, p1, k3

Rounds 4-8: repeat round 3

Round 9: p1, k3, p1, wyib sl 3 to RH needle, pass the 3rd stitch over the first 2 stitches. slip those 2 stitches back onto LH needle. k1, YO, k1.

Round 10: p1, k3, p1, k1, k tbl, k1,

Rounds 11-16: repeat round 3
