

WEIGHT: DK

■ **COLOUR A (BLUE)**

224 YD / 204 M, OR 1 SKEIN OF BRITISH DK FROM LES GARÇONS

■ **COLOUR B (BEIGE)**

360 YD / 329 M, OR 2 SKEINS OF BRITISH DK FROM LES GARÇONS

■ **COLOUR C (RED)**

224 YD / 204 M, OR 1 SKEIN OF BRITISH DK FROM LES GARÇONS

Sample shown in British DK from Les Garçons (70% Bluefaced Leicester Wool, 30% Masham Wool, non-superwash; 263 yd / 240 m per 100 g skein), in the "Édith's Butler" (Colour A), "Twyla's Sand" (Colour B) and "Aleks's Red Squirrel Friend" (Colour C) colourways.

NEEDLES

CIRCULAR, 24" / 60 CM IN LENGTH, US 5 / 3.75 MM, OR SIZE NEEDED TO MATCH GAUGE

GAUGE | 22 STITCHES AND 32 ROWS = 4" / 10 CM IN GARTER STITCH, WORKED FLAT, BLOCKED

NOTIONS

STITCH MARKERS (2), TAPESTRY NEEDLE

THE ROCKETEER SCARF INSTRUCTIONS

THE ROCKETEER SCARF BEGINS WITH TWO LONG STRIPED TRIANGLES THAT ARE JOINED TOGETHER TO FORM THE FIRST AND SECOND BLOCKS. FROM THERE, YOU WILL PICK UP STITCHES ALONG THE EDGE TO WORK THE THIRD AND FOURTH BLOCKS, AND THEN REPEAT THE PROCESS TO ATTACH THE FIFTH BLOCK. THE SCARF IS FINISHED WITH A NEAT I-CORD BORDER WORKED ALONG THE ENTIRE OUTSIDE EDGES.

FIRST BLOCK



Using Colour A and the long-tail cast-on method, CO 6 sts.

INCREASE SECTION

ROW 1 (RS, INC): Using Colour A, k1, m1r, k to last st, sl1 wyif. *1 st inc'd*

ROW 2 (WS): K to last st, sl1 wyif.

Join Colour B.

ROWS 3-4: Using Colour B, work **ROW 2** twice.

ROWS 5-6: Using Colour A, work **ROW 2** twice.

ROWS 7-8: Using Colour B, work **ROW 2** twice.

Work **ROWS 1** to **8** a further 33 times. *33 sts inc'd*

YOU SHOULD HAVE 40 STS ON YOUR NEEDLES.



DECREASE SECTION

Place a marker on the fabric at the beginning of the next row to indicate where to start picking up stitches for the **THIRD BLOCK**.



ROW 1 (RS, DEC): Using Colour A, k1, ssk, k to last st, sl1 wyif. *1 st dec'd*

ROW 2 (WS): K to last st, sl1 wyif.

ROWS 3-4: Using Colour B, work **ROW 2** twice.

ROWS 5-6: Using Colour A, work **ROW 2** twice.

ROWS 7-8: Using Colour B, work **ROW 2** twice.

Work **ROWS 1** to **8** a further of 36 times. *36 sts dec'd*

YOU SHOULD HAVE 3 STS ON YOUR NEEDLES.

Break Colour A.

THE ROCKETEER SCARF INSTRUCTIONS

SECOND BLOCK

INCREASE SECTION

ROW 1 (RS, INC): Using Colour C, k1, m1r, k to last st, sl1 wyif. *1 st inc'd*

ROW 2 (WS): K to last st, sl1 wyif.

ROWS 3-4: Using Colour B, work **ROW 2** twice.

ROWS 5-6: Using Colour C, work **ROW 2** twice.

ROWS 7-8: Using Colour B, work **ROW 2** twice.

Work **ROWS 1** to **8** a further 36 times. *36 sts inc'd*

YOU SHOULD HAVE 40 STS ON YOUR NEEDLES.

DECREASE SECTION

Place a marker on the fabric at the beginning of the next row to indicate where to stop picking up stitches for the **FOURTH BLOCK**.

ROW 1 (RS, DEC): Using Colour C, k1, ssk, k to last st, sl1 wyif. *1 st dec'd*

ROW 2 (WS): K to last st, sl1 wyif.

ROWS 3-4: Using Colour B, work **ROW 2** twice.

ROWS 5-6: Using Colour C, work **ROW 2** twice.

ROWS 7-8: Using Colour B, work **ROW 2** twice.

Work **ROWS 1** to **8** a further of 32 times. *32 sts dec'd*

YOU SHOULD HAVE 7 STS ON YOUR NEEDLES.



Break Colour B.

Using Colour C, work **ROWS 1** and **2** of **DECREASE SECTION**. *1 st dec'd*

YOU SHOULD HAVE 6 STS ON YOUR NEEDLES.

BO all sts. Break Colour C.

THE ROCKETEER SCARF INSTRUCTIONS

THIRD BLOCK

With RS facing, using Colour C, beginning at the apex of the **FIRST BLOCK**, where a marker was placed, pick up and knit 148 sts along the selvedge edge (1 st in each selvedge st) until you reach the point where the **FIRST** and **SECOND BLOCKS** meet, at the center of the scarf.

YOU SHOULD HAVE 148 STS ON YOUR NEEDLES.

Break Colour C. Slide the sts from one end of the needles to the other end. Remove marker from the **FIRST BLOCK**.

Rejoin Colour C at the beginning of the pick-up row. With RS facing, using Colour C and the cable cast-on method, CO 2 sts.

YOU SHOULD HAVE 150 STS ON YOUR NEEDLES, DIVIDED AS FOLLOWS: 2 STS FOR THE THIRD BLOCK AND 148 STS FROM THE PICK-UP ROW.

At the end of every RS row, a "ssk" is worked using the last stitch of the **THIRD BLOCK** stitches and one stitch from the pick-up row to attach the **THIRD BLOCK** to the **FIRST BLOCK**.

INCREASE SECTION

SETUP ROW (RS): K1, ssk, turn. Read note and skip to **ROW 2**.

The **SETUP ROW** replaces **ROW 1** for the first repeat of the **INCREASE SECTION**.

ROW 1 (RS, INC): K to 1 st before previous turn, m1r, ssk, turn. *1 st inc'd*

ROW 2 (WS): K to last st, sl1 wyif.

ROW 3: K to 1 st before previous turn, ssk, turn.

ROW 4: K to last st, sl1 wyif.

ROWS 5-8: Work **ROWS 3** and **4** twice.

Work **ROWS 1** to **8** a further 26 times. *26 sts inc'd*

YOU SHOULD HAVE 68 STS ON YOUR NEEDLES, DIVIDED AS FOLLOWS: 28 STS FOR THE THIRD BLOCK AND 40 STS FROM THE PICK-UP ROW.

Place a marker on the fabric at the beginning of the next row to indicate where to begin picking up stitches for the **FIFTH BLOCK**.

EVEN SECTION

ROW 1 (RS): K1, ssk, k to 1 st before previous turn, m1r, ssk, turn.

ROW 2 (WS): K to last st, sl1 wyif.

ROW 3: K to 1 st before previous turn, ssk, turn.

ROW 4: K to last st, sl1 wyif.

ROWS 5-8: Work **ROWS 3** and **4** twice.

Work **ROWS 1** to **8** a further 9 times.

Break Colour C. Turn. Slide the sts from one end of the needles to the other end.

YOU SHOULD HAVE 28 STS ON YOUR NEEDLES.

THE ROCKETEER SCARF INSTRUCTIONS

FOURTH BLOCK

With RS facing, using Colour A and the needle that is now closer to the center of the scarf, pick up and knit 148 sts from the start of the **SECOND BLOCK** along the selvedge edge (1 st in each selvedge st) until the end of the increase section, where a marker was placed. Remove marker from the **SECOND BLOCK**.

YOU SHOULD HAVE 176 STS ON YOUR NEEDLES, DIVIDED AS FOLLOWS: 28 STS IN COLOUR C FROM THE THIRD BLOCK AND 148 STS IN COLOUR A FROM THE PICK-UP ROW.

Break Colour A; do not turn. Slide the sts from one end of the needles to the other end, ready to knit the Colour C sts from the **THIRD BLOCK**.

EVEN SECTION

At the end of every RS row of the **EVEN SECTION**, a "ssk" or a "sss" is worked using the last stitch or the last two stitches of the **FOURTH BLOCK** stitches and one stitch from the pick-up row to attach the **FOURTH BLOCK** to the **SECOND BLOCK**.

SETUP ROW (RS): Using Colour A, k1, m1r, k25, sssk, turn. Read note and skip to **ROW 2**.

The **SETUP ROW** replaces **ROW 1** for the first repeat of the **EVEN SECTION**.



ROW 1 (RS): K1, m1r, k to 2 sts before previous turn, sssk, turn.

ROW 2 (WS): K to last st, sl1 wyif.

ROW 3: K to 1 st before previous turn, ssk, turn.

ROW 4: K to last st, sl1 wyif.

ROWS 5-8: Work **ROWS 3** and **4** twice.

Work **ROWS 1** to **8** a further 9 times.

Place a marker on the fabric at the beginning of the next row to indicate where to stop picking up stitches for the **FIFTH BLOCK**.

Work **ROWS 1** to **8** once more.

YOU SHOULD HAVE 132 STS ON YOUR NEEDLES, DIVIDED AS FOLLOWS: 28 STS FOR THE FOURTH BLOCK AND 104 STS FROM THE PICK-UP ROW.

THE ROCKETEER SCARF INSTRUCTIONS

DECREASE SECTION

At the end of every RS row of the **DECREASE SECTION**, a "ssk" is worked using the last stitch of the **FOURTH BLOCK** stitches and one stitch from the pick-up row to attach the **FOURTH BLOCK** to the **SECOND BLOCK**.

ROW 1 (RS, DEC): K1, ssk, k to 1 st before previous turn, ssk, turn. *1 st dec'd*

ROW 2 (WS): K to last st, sl1 wyif.

ROW 3: K to 1 st before previous turn, ssk, turn.

ROW 4: K to last st, sl1 wyif.

ROWS 5-8: Work **ROWS 3** and **4** twice.

Work **ROWS 1** to **8** a further 24 times. *24 sts dec'd*

YOU SHOULD HAVE 7 STS ON YOUR NEEDLES, DIVIDED AS FOLLOWS: 3 STS FOR THE FOURTH BLOCK AND 4 STS FROM THE PICK-UP ROW.

NEXT ROW (RS, DEC): K1, sssk, turn. *1 st dec'd*

NEXT ROW (WS): K1, sl1 wyif.

NEXT ROW: K1, ssk, turn.

NEXT 4 ROWS: Work previous 2 rows twice.

YOU SHOULD HAVE 2 STS ON YOUR NEEDLES.

Break Colour A. Using a tapestry needle, weave the tail through the remaining sts and pull closed.

FIFTH BLOCK

With RS facing, using Colour B, beginning at the marker placed in the **THIRD BLOCK**, pick up and knit 82 sts along the selvedge edge (1 st at each point and 1 st in each selvedge st) until you reach the marker placed in the **FOURTH BLOCK**.

Break Colour B. Slide the sts from one end of the needles to the other end.

Rejoin Colour B at the beginning of the pick-up row.

With RS facing, using Colour B and the cable cast-on method, CO 2 sts.

YOU SHOULD HAVE 84 STS ON YOUR NEEDLES, DIVIDED AS FOLLOWS: 2 STS FOR THE FIFTH BLOCK AND 82 STS FROM THE PICK-UP ROW.

THE ROCKETEER SCARF INSTRUCTIONS



FIRST HALF

At the end of every RS row of the **FIRST HALF**, a "ssk" is worked using the last stitch of the **FIFTH BLOCK** and one stitch from the pick-up row to attach the **FIFTH BLOCK** to the **THIRD BLOCK**.

SETUP ROW (RS): K1, ssk, turn. Read note and skip to **ROW 2**.

The **SETUP ROW** replaces **ROW 1** for the first repeat of the **FIRST HALF**.

ROW 1 (RS, INC): K to 1 st before previous turn, m1r, ssk, turn. *1 st inc'd*

ROW 2 (WS): K to last st, sl1 wyif.

ROW 3: K to 1 st before previous turn, ssk, turn.

ROW 4: K to last st, sl1 wyif.

ROWS 5-8: Work **ROWS 3** and **4** twice.

Work **ROWS 1** to **8** a further 9 times. *9 sts inc'd*

Work **ROWS 1** and **2** once more. *1 st inc'd*

YOU SHOULD HAVE 53 STS ON YOUR NEEDLES, DIVIDED AS FOLLOWS: 12 STS FOR THE FIFTH BLOCK AND 41 STS FROM THE PICK-UP ROW.



SECOND HALF

At the end of every RS row of the **SECOND HALF**, a "ssk" or a "sssk" is worked using the last stitch or the last two stitches of the **FIFTH BLOCK** stitches and one stitch from the pick-up row to attach the **FIFTH BLOCK** to the **FOURTH BLOCK**.

ROW 1 (RS): K to 1 st before previous turn, ssk, turn.

ROW 2 (WS): K to last st, sl1 wyif.

ROWS 3-6: Work **ROWS 1** and **2** twice.

ROW 7 (RS, DEC): K to 2 sts before previous turn, sssk, turn. *1 st dec'd*

ROW 8 (WS): K to last st, sl1 wyif.

Work **ROWS 1** to **8** a further 9 times. *9 sts dec'd*

YOU SHOULD HAVE 3 STS ON YOUR NEEDLES, DIVIDED AS FOLLOWS: 2 STS FOR THE FIFTH BLOCK AND 1 ST FROM THE PICK-UP ROW.

NEXT ROW (RS): K1, ssk.

NEXT ROW (WS): K1, sl1 wyif.

YOU SHOULD HAVE 2 STS ON YOUR NEEDLES.

BO all sts.

THE ROCKETEER SCARF INSTRUCTIONS

APPLIED I-CORD BORDER

You can start your applied i-cord border anywhere on the project.



With WS facing, using Colour B and the long-tail method, CO 3 sts, then pick up and knit 1 st from the selvedge edge. SI 4 sts from the right needle to the left needle.

K2, k2tog tbl, pick up and knit 1 st from the selvedge edge. SI 4 sts from the right needle to the left needle; work *-* until the border is complete, k2, k2tog tbl.

If the i-cord border feels less elastic than the garter stitch fabric, every two selvedge stitches, cast on an extra stitch using the backwards loop method before continuing to pick up from the next selvedge stitch.

Graft the remaining 3 sts to the three sts cast on at the start of the i-cord border.



FINISHING

Weave in ends. Block to measurements.

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BO bind off

CO cast on

DEC('D) decrease(d)

INC('D) increase(d)

K knit

K2TOG knit two stitches together

M1R make one right-leaning stitch

RS right side

SL slip purlwise

SS(S)K slip, slip, (slip,) knit: Slip the next two (three) stitches, knitwise, individually. Return them to the left needle without twisting and knit them together through the back loop.

ST(S) stitch(es)

TBL through back loop

WS wrong side

WYIF with yarn in front
