

**This mesh jumper is worked top down in a graphic mesh pattern.  
The jumper is seamless.**

#### Size

XS (S) M (L) XL (XXL) XXXL

#### Measurements

##### Bust circumference:

110 (115) 120 (125) 130 (135) 140 cm

##### Bust measurement:

80-87 (88-93) 94-99 (100-107)

108-116 (117-124) 125-136 cm

#### Recommended needles

Circular needle 4.5 mm (60 cm)

Circular needle 6 mm (60 cm)

Alternatively, use double pointed needles in the same sizes if you do not wish to use the magic loop method.

#### Gauge

12 sts and 18 rows with needle 6 mm in pattern = 10 x 10 cm

The number of sts is divisible by 3 inclusive 2 selvages. You can see how to work the pattern on the first page. If you do not get the right gauge, change to a smaller or larger needle size.

#### Yarn

Hittegarn from Mama

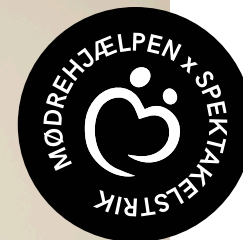
100 % unprocessed surplus wool from Danish meat sheep - 130 m/100 g

600 (600) 700 (700) 700 (800) 800 g

#### Yarn alternatives

1 strand of Vams from Rauma held together with 1 strand Tilia from filcolana.

1 strand of Fritidsgarn from Sandnes held together with 1 strand Tynn silk mohair from Sandnes



## MEGA ERIKA JUMPER

XS (S) M (L) XL (XXL) XXXL

## Abbreviations

**st(s):** Stitch(es)

**k:** Knit.

**p:** Purl.

**rnd(s):** Round(s)

**BOR:** Beginning of round

**RS:** Right side

**WS:** Wrong side

**yo(s):** Yarnover(s)

**k2tog:** Knit 2 stitches together

**p2tog:** Purl 2 stitches together

**Sl1p:** Slip 1 stitch purlwise

**K1 tbl:** Knit 1 stitch through the back loop

**M1R:** Use the left needle to pick up the bar between the stitches from the back and knit it

**M1L:** Use the left needle to pick up the bar between the stitches from the front and knit it through the back loop

**SSK:** Slip 1 knitwise, slip 1 knitwise, move the stitches back onto the left needle, knit them together through the back loop

**Cent-doub-dec:** Slip 2 stitches knitwise as if you were to knit them together, knit 1 stitch, pass the 2 loose stitches together over the knit stitch

## About the pattern

The jumper is worked top down.

Begin by working with the back piece.

The front piece is then worked by picking up stitches from the back piece. Stitches are picked up for the sleeves and the neckline.

## Back piece

Using needle 6 mm,

cast on 63 (66) 69 (72) 75 (78) 81 sts.

**Next row (WS):** K1, p until 1 st remains, k1.

Begin working the hole pattern.

**Row 1 (RS):** K1, SSK, yo, yo,

\*cent-doub-dec, yo, yo; repeat from \* until 3 sts remain, k2tog, k1.

**Row 2:** K1, p1, \*k1, p2; repeat from \* until 1 st remains, k1.

**Row 3:** K1, p until 1 st remains, k1.

**Row 4:** K1, p until 1 st remains, k1.

Repeat rows 1-4 a total of  
8 (8) 9 (9) 10 (10) 11 times.

Work rows 1-2 again.

Cut off the yarn and place the sts on a stitch holder.

## Left front piece

Count 21 (21) 24 (24) 27 (27) 30 sts along the left side of the cast on edge from the outer edge towards the middle of the back piece. You should face the RS of the back piece when counting. Pick up 21 (21) 24 (24) 27 (27) 30 sts from the counted sts and towards the outer edge.

K 6 rows.

**Next row (WS):** K1, p until 1 st remains, k1.

Begin working the hole pattern.

**Row 1 (RS):** K1, SSK, yo, yo,  
\*cent-doub-dec, yo, yo; repeat from \* until 3 sts remain, k2tog, k1.

**Row 2:** K1, p1, \*k1, p2; repeat from \* until 1 st remains, k1.

**Row 3:** K1, p until 1 st remains, k1.

**Row 4:** K1, p until 1 st remains, k1.

Repeat rows 1-4 a total of  
4 (4) 4 (4) 4 (4) 4 times.

Work increases at the beginning of the RS rows to shape the neckline like this:

**Row 1 (RS):** K1, SSK, yo, yo,

\*cent-doub-dec, yo, yo; repeat from \* until 3 sts remain, k2tog, k1.

**Row 2:** K1, p1, \*k1, p2; repeat from \* until 1 st remains, k1.

**Row 3:** K1, M1L, p1, M1L,  
p until 1 st remains, k1.

**Row 4:** K1, p until 1 st remains, k1.

**Row 5:** K1, M1L, k1, yo, yo,  
\*cent-doub-dec, yo, yo; repeat from \* until 3 sts remain, k2tog, k1.

**Row 6:** K1, p1, \*k1, p2; repeat from \* until 2 sts remain, p1, k1.

**Row 7:** K1, M1L, p1, M1L, p until 1 st remains, k1.

**Row 8:** K1, p to end until 1 st remains, k1.

**Row 9:** K1, M1L, SSK, yo, yo,  
\*cent-doub-dec, yo, yo; repeat from \* until 3 sts remain, k2tog, k1.

Sizes XS, M, XL and XXXL only

**Row 10:** K1, p1, \*k1, p2; repeat from \* until 2 sts remain, p1, k1.

Sizes S, L and XXL only

**Row 10:** K1, p1, \*k1, p2; repeat from \* until 2 sts remain, p1, M1R, k1.

= 28 (29) 31 (32) 34 (35) 37 sts.

Cut off the yarn and place the sts on a stitch holder.

## Right front piece

From the RS, pick up  
21 (21) 24 (24) 27 (27) 30 sts on the right-hand side of the back piece. Begin at the edge and work your way towards the middle. You should face the RS of the back piece.

K 6 rows.

**Next row (WS):** K1, p until 1 st remains, k1.

Begin working the hole pattern.

**Row 1 (RS):** K1, SSK, yo, yo,  
\*cent-doub-dec, yo, yo; repeat from \* until 3 sts remain, k2tog, k1.

**Row 2:** K1, p1, \*k1, p2; repeat from \* until 1 st remains, k1.

**Row 3:** K1, p until 1 st remains, k1.

**Row 4:** K1, p until 1 st remains, k1.

Repeat rows 1-4 a total of  
4 (4) 4 (4) 4 (4) 4 times.

Work increases at the end of the RS rows to shape the neckline towards the left:

**Row 1 (RS):** K1, SSK, yo, yo,  
\*cent-doub-dec, yo, yo; repeat from \* until 3 sts remain, k2tog, k1.

**Row 2:** K1, p1 \*k1, p2; repeat from \* until 1 st remains, k1.

**Row 3:** K1, p until 2 sts remain, M1R, p1, M1R, k1.

**Row 4:** K1, p until 1 st remains, k1.

**Row 5:** K1, SSK, yo, yo, \*cent-doub-dec, yo, yo; repeat from \* until 2 sts remain, k1, M1R, k1.

**Row 6:** K1, p2, \*k1, p2; repeat from \* until 1 st remains, k1.

**Row 7:** K1, p until 2 sts remain, M1R, p1, M1R, k1.

**Row 8:** K1, p until 1 st remains, k1.

**Row 9:** K1, SSK, yo, yo, \*cent-doub-dec, yo, yo; repeat from \* until 3 sts remain, k2tog, M1R, k1.

Sizes XS, M, XL and XXXL only

**Row 10:** K1, p2, \*k1, p2; repeat from \* until 1 st remains, k1.

Sizes S, L and XXL only

**Row 10:** K1, M1L, p2, \*k1, p2; repeat from \* until 1 st remains, k1.

= 28 (29) 31 (32) 34 (35) 37 sts



## All sizes

### Row 11 (joining the front pieces):

K1, p until 2 sts remain, p2tog tbl, cast on 9 (10) 9 (10) 9 (10) 9 new sts at the end of the row, place the sts of the left front piece back on the needle, p the first 2 sts tog, p until 1 st remains, k1 = 63 (66) 69 (72) 75 (78) 81 sts.

**Row 12:** K1, p until 1 st remains, k1.

Work even in hole pattern like this:

**Row 1 (RS):** K1, SSK, yo, yo, \*cent-doub-dec, yo, yo; repeat from \* until 3 sts remain, k2tog, k1.

**Row 2:** K1, p1, \*k1, p2; repeat from \* until 1 st remains, k1.

**Row 3:** K1, p until 1 st remains, k1.

**Row 4:** K1, p until 1 st remains, k1.

Repeat rows 1-4 a total of 3 (3) 4 (4) 5 (5) 6 times.

Work rows 1-2 again.

Joining back piece and front piece

Next row: P2tog, p until 2 sts remain, p2tog tbl, cast on 3 (3) 3 (3) 3 (3) 3 sts, place marker (side marker), place the sts of the back piece back on the needle, p the first 2 sts tog, p until 2 sts remain of the back piece, p2tog tbl, cast on 3 (3) 3 (3) 3 (3) 3 sts, place marker (BOR) and join in the round = 128 (134) 140 (146) 152 (158) 164 sts.

K 1 rnd.

## Body

Work hole pattern in the round like this:

**Rnd 1:** SSK, yo, yo,

\*cent-doub-dec, yo, yo; repeat from \* until 5 sts before side marker, k2tog, p3, SSK, yo, yo, \*cent-doub-dec, yo, yo; repeat from \* until 5 sts before BOR marker, k2tog, p3.

**Rnd 2:** \*K2, p1; repeat from \* until 4 sts remain before side marker, k4, \*k2, p1; repeat from \* until 4 sts remain before BOR marker, k4.

**Rnd 3:** P to end.

**Rnd 4:** K to end.

Repeat rnds 1-4 a total of 13 (13) 14 (14) 15 (15) 16 times until the back piece (measured midway on the back) measures approx. 44 (44) 46 (46) 48 (48) 50 cm.

Work rnd 1-2 again.

K 2 rnds.

## Bottom ribbing

Change to needle 4.5 mm and work 1 rnd in twisted rib stitch while increasing as follows:

\*K1 tbl, p1, k1 tbl, M1R; repeat from \* as many times as possible and work rib stitch to end. Remove the rnd marker when you come to it. If the last st is a k st, work another increase.

Work 8 (8) 8 (8) 8 (8) 8 cm in twisted rib stitch (k1 tbl, p1).



Before binding off, work the 2 following rnds:

**Rnd 1:** \*K1 tbl, sl1p with yarn in front; repeat from \* to end.

**Rnd 2:** \*Sl1p with yarn in back, p1; repeat from \* to end.

Bind off using the Italian bind off method.

### Sleeves

Begin in the middle of the 3 sts which were cast on for the body.

From the RS using needle 6 mm, pick up 54 (54) 57 (57) 63 (63) 66 sts along the armhole (pick up approx. 3 and 2 sts per hole in the pattern). It is important that the number of sts is divisible by 3. Join in the round and place marker.

K 1 rnd.

The body is now worked in hole pattern in the round with decreases like this:

**Rnd 1:** \*Cent-doub-dec, yo, yo; repeat from \* to end.

**Rnd 2:** \*K2, p1; repeat from \* to end.

**Rnd 3:** P to end.

**Rnd 4:** K until 1 st remains, move the last st to the right needle without knitting it, remove the marker, move the st back onto the left needle and place the marker again. The BOR is now moved 1 st to the right.

Repeat rnds 1-4 a total of 2 (2) 3 (3) 3 (4) 4 times.

**\*\*Next rnd (first decrease rnd):**

\*Cent-doub-dec, yo, yo; repeat from \* until 6 sts remain, cent-doub-dec, cent-doub-dec, pass the second st on the right needle over the first st, yo, yo.

Work rnds 2-4 as before.

Work rnds 1-4 as before a total of 2 times without decreasing on the first rnd.

### Next rnd (second decrease rnd):

\*Cent-doub-dec, cent-doub-dec, move the 2 sts on the right needle to the left needle, pass the innermost st over the outermost st, move the st back onto the right needle, yo, yo, \*cent-doub-dec, yo, yo; repeat from \* to end.

Work rnds 2-4 as before.

Work rnds 1-4 as before a total of 2 times without decreasing on the first rnd;

repeat from \*\* 1 more time  
= 42 (42) 45 (45) 51 (51) 54 sts.

Work rnds 1-2 again.

K 2 rnds. Sizes M, L, XL and XXL only:  
K2tog at the end of the rnd.

### Sleeve ribbing

Change to needle 4.5 mm and work 8 cm in twisted rib stitch (k1 tbl, p1).

Before binding off, work the 2 following rnds:

**Rnd 1:** \*K1 tbl, sl1p with yarn in front; repeat from \* to end.

**Rnd 2:** \*Sl1p with yarn in back, p1; repeat from \* to end.

Bind off using the Italian bind off method.

Same procedure for the second sleeve.

### Neckline

Using needle 4.5 mm, pick up 88 (90) 90 (92) 92 (94) 94 sts along the neckline like this:

Begin at the right-hand side of the neck. Pick up 20 (20) 22 (22) 24 (24) 26 sts along the neck, pick up 30 (30) 30 (30) 30 (30) 30 sts along the left-hand side of the neckline, pick up 8 (10) 8 (10) 8 (10) 8 sts along the middle part of the neckline, pick up 30 (30) 30 (30) 30 (30) 30 sts along the right-hand side of the neckline, join in the round and place marker.

Work 20 rnds in twisted rib stitch (k1 tbl, p1).

Fold the neckline and knit it onto the WS of the work while binding off using needle 6 mm like this:

Pick up 1 st from the picked up sts on the left needle from the WS and k the st together with the first st the left needle, \*pick up another st on the left needle and k it tog with the first st on the left needle. Now pass the second st over the first st on right needle to bind off the st; repeat from \* until all sts are bound off.

### Finishing

Weave in all ends.
