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#202 truffles stole

This is the big sister to the Double Crème Brie scarf – a wider and slightly longer stole version in a chocolatey shade of merino wool/cashmere blend yarn that begs to be knit and worn!

Two panels of the lovely and truly unique threaded diamond cable are separated by chunky braided cables.

This is a relaxing knit for cable-lovers with spectacular results. Cable pattern stitches are both charted and written out.

Knit this beauty up as a sophisticated piece to throw over your shoulders or wear as a generous scarf. Two lengths included.

TECHNIQUES USED

- ❖ **k** = knit
- ❖ **p** = purl
- ❖ **pm** = place st marker
- ❖ **sm** = slip st marker
- ❖ **1/1 RC, 1/1 RPC, 1/1 LC, 1/1 LPC, 2/1 RC, 2/1 RPC, 2/1 LC, 2/1 LPC, 2/2 RC, 2/2 LC** = various cable crosses defined in PATTERN STITCHES section

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS: 17" [43 cm] wide x 60 ¼ (67 ½)" [153 (171.5) cm] long. Shorter version shown above.

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MATERIALS

- ❖ A worsted weight yarn in a merino wool/cashmere blend:
Approximate total yardage required: 790 (885) yds [722 (809) m]. **Yarn label suggested gauge:** 5 sts = 1" [2.5 cm] on size 5-7 [3.75 - 4.5 mm] needles. WHILE this yarn is named DK, it knits up more like a worsted weight with this pattern. Please visit this pattern at SweaterBabe.com for yarn suggestions, photos of finished projects, etc.
Shown in: Knit Picks Capra DK (85% Merino Wool/15% Cashmere; 1.75 oz/50g [123 yds/112.5 m] per ball): 7 (8) balls in Thicket #26557.
- ❖ Size 9 [5.5 mm] needles OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE
- ❖ Cable needle (cn)
- ❖ Stitch markers
- ❖ Row counter
- ❖ Yarn tapestry needle



GAUGE

- ❖ 28 sts = 6 ¼" [5.5 cm] and 22 rows = 4" [10 cm] in Threaded Diamond Cable
- ❖ 6 sts = 1" [2.5 cm] in Braided Cable





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Threaded Diamond Cable Written Instructions

Over 28 sts.

Row 1 [WS]: K6, [p2, k4, p2] twice, k6.

Row 2 [RS]: P5, 1/1 RC, 1/1 LC, p2, 2/1 RPC, 2/1 LPC, p2, 1/1 RC, 1/1 LC, p5.

Row 3 and all subsequent WS Rows: Knit the k sts and purl the p sts as they present themselves.

Row 4: P4, 1/1 RC, k2, 1/1 LC, 2/1 RPC, p2, 2/1 LPC, 1/1 RC, k2, 1/1 LC, p4.

Row 6: P4, k5, 2/1 RC, p4, 2/1 LC, k5, p4.

Row 8: P4, k4, 2/1 RC, k1, p4, k1, 2/1 LC, k4, p4.

Row 10: P4, k2, 2/2 LC, k2, p4, k2, 2/2 RC, k2, p4.

Row 12: P4, k1, 2/1 RC, k4, p4, k4, 2/1 LC, k1, p4.

Row 14: P4, 2/1 RC, k5, p4, k5, 2/1 LC, p4.

Row 16: P3, 2/1 RPC, 1/1 LPC, k2, 1/1 RPC, p4, 1/1 LPC, k2, 1/1 RPC, 2/1 LPC, p3.

Row 18: P2, 2/1 RPC, p2, 1/1 LPC, 1/1 RPC, p6, 1/1 LPC, 1/1 RPC, p2, 2/1 LPC, p2.

Row 20: P2, k2, p4, 1/1 LC, p8, 1/1 RC, p4, k2, p2.

Row 22: P2, 2/1 LPC, p2, 1/1 RC, 1/1 LC, p6, 1/1 RC, 1/1 LC, p2, 2/1 RPC, p2.

Row 24: P3, 2/1 LPC, 1/1 RC, k2, 1/1 LC, p4, 1/1 RC, k2, 1/1 LC, 2/1 RPC, p3.

Row 26: P4, 2/1 LC, k5, p4, k5, 2/1 RC, p4.

Row 28: P4, k1, 2/1 LC, k4, p4, k4, 2/1 RC, k1, p4.

Row 30: P4, k2, 2/2 RC, k2, p4, k2, 2/2 LC, k2, p4.

Row 32: P4, k4, 2/1 LC, k1, p4, k1, 2/1 RC, k4, p4.

Row 34: P4, k5, 2/1 LC, p4, 2/1 RC, k5, p4.

Row 36: P4, 1/1 LPC, k2, 1/1 RPC, 2/1 LPC, p2, 2/1 RPC, 1/1 LPC, k2, 1/1 RPC, p4.

Row 38: P5, 1/1 LPC, 1/1 RPC, p2, 2/1 LPC, 2/1 RPC, p2, 1/1 LPC, 1/1 RPC, p5.

Row 40: P6, 1/1 RC, p4, 2/2 RC, p4, 1/1 LC, p6.

Rep Rows 1 through 40 for patt.

RIGHT Braided Cable

Over 6 sts.

Row 1 and ALL WS Rows: P6.



Row 2 [RS]: K2, 2/2 LC.

Row 4: K6.

Row 6: 2/2 RC, k2.

Row 8: K6.

Rep Rows 1 through 8 for patt.



LEFT Braided Cable

Same as RIGHT Braided Cable, but Rows 2 and 6 are switched.

Over 6 sts.

Row 1 and ALL WS Rows: P6.


Row 2 [RS]: 2/2 RC, k2.

Row 4: K6.

Row 6: K2, 2/2 LC

Row 8: K6.

Rep Rows 1 through 8 for patt.



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KNITTING THE STOLE

CO 82 sts.

RIBBED EDGE

Row 1 [WS]: *P6, pm, k2, p2, k2, [p2, k1] twice, p4, [k1, p2] twice, k2, p2, k2, pm, p6*, pm, k2, pm; rep from * to * once.

Row 2 [RS]: *K6, sm, p2, k2, p2, [k2, p1] twice, 2/2 RC, [p1, k2] twice, p2, k2, p2, sm, k6*, sm, p2, sm; rep from * to * once.

Row 3: Knit the k sts, purl the p sts.

Row 4: 2/2 RC, k2, sm, p2, k2, p2, [k2, p1] twice, k4, [p1, k2] twice, p2, k2, p2, sm, 2/2 RC, k2, sm, p2, sm; k2, 2/2 LC, sm, p2, k2, p2, [k2, p1] twice, k4, [p1, k2] twice, p2, k2, p2, sm, k2, 2/2 LC.

Row 5: Rep Row 3.

Row 6: *K6, sm, p2, k2, p2, 1/1 RC, p1, k2, p1, 2/2 RC, p1, k2, p1, 1/1 LC, p2, k2, p2, sm, k6*, sm, p2, sm; rep from * to * once.

NOTE: With RS facing, the first two Braided Cables (first set) follow the RIGHT Braided Cable patt and the last two Braided Cables (second set) follow the LEFT Braided Cable patt so that the two sets mirror each other.

Reset Row counter to 0.

Row 1 [WS]: Work Row 1 of **LEFT** Braided Cable over first 6 sts, sm, work Row 1 of Threaded Diamond Cable over next 28 sts, sm, work Row 1 of **LEFT** Braided Cable over next 6 sts, sm, k2 for Rev St st, sm; work Row 1 of **RIGHT** Braided Cable over next 6 sts, sm, work Row 1 of Threaded Diamond Cable over next 28 sts, sm, work Row 1 of **RIGHT** Braided Cable over last 6 sts.

Row 2 [RS]: Work Row 2 of **RIGHT** Braided Cable over first 6 sts, sm, work Row 2 of Threaded Diamond Cable over next 28 sts, sm, work Row 2 of **RIGHT** Braided Cable over next 6 sts, sm, p2 for Rev St st, sm; work Row 2 of **LEFT** Braided Cable over next 6 sts, sm, work Row 2 of Threaded Diamond Cable over next 28 sts, sm, work Row 2 of **LEFT** Braided Cable over last 6 sts.

Cont in Cable patts (and 2 sts of Rev St st in the center) as established **through Row 319 (359)**, a **WS** row. This is 7 full 40-row reps **plus** ONLY Rows 1-39 (8 full 40-row reps **plus** ONLY Rows 1-39) of the Threaded Diamond Cable. It is also 39 full 8-row reps **plus** ONLY Rows 1-7 (44 full 8-row reps **plus** ONLY Rows 1-7) of the RIGHT and LEFT Braided Cables.

RIBBED EDGE

Reset Row counter to 0.

Row 1 [RS]: *K6, sm, p2, k2, p2, 1/1 RC, p1, k2, p1, 2/2 RC, p1, k2, p1, 1/1 LC, p2, k2, p2, sm, k6*, sm, p2, sm; rep from * to * once.

Row 2 [WS]: Knit the k sts, p the p sts.

Row 3 [RS]: K2, 2/2 LC, sm, p2, k2, p2, [k2, p1] twice, k4, [p1, k2] twice, p2, k2, p2, sm, k2, 2/2 LC, sm, p2, sm; 2/2 RC, k2, sm, p2, k2, p2, [k2, p1] twice, k4, [p1, k2] twice, p2, k2, p2, sm, 2/2 RC, k2.

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Row 4: Rep Row 2.

Row 5: *K6, sm, p2, k2, p2, [k2, p1] twice, 2/2 RC, [p1, k2] twice, p2, k2, p2, sm, k6*, sm, p2, sm; rep from * to * once.

Row 6 [WS]: BO all knit sts knit-wise and all purl sts purl-wise. Remove all markers along the way. Cut yarn and fasten off.

FINISHING

Block to measurements. Weave in all loose ends.

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
