



STRIPED SWEATER

FINISHED SIZE To fit my Snowshoe Hare Pattern (**Hare finished size**
Approx. 31cm/ 12in tall from feet to top of head)

YARN A 1/2 x 50g ball 4-ply/ fingering weight alpaca or merino yarn in red
I used Drops Nord shade 14 Red

YARN B 1/2 x 50g ball 4-ply/ fingering weight wool or cotton yarn in bright red
I used Milliamia Naturally Soft Cotton shade 331 Bright Red

YARN C 1/2 x 50g ball 4-ply/ fingering weight alpaca or merino yarn in off-white
I used Drops Alpaca shade 0100 Off-White

YARN D 1/2 x 50g ball 4-ply/ fingering weight wool or cotton yarn in white
I used Milliamia Naturally Soft Cotton shade 310 Pure White
- Or use a single DK/ light-worsted 8-ply in Red and white

KNITTING NEEDLES Pair of 3.75mm/ US 5 straight knitting needles

TENSION 14 stitches and 12 rows over 5cm with 3.75mm needles and yarn AB

PATTERN NOTES:

- . Use Cable Cast-on throughout
- . General knitting abbreviations can be found on Page 3

COLOURED MARKER GUIDE:

This guide is here to pull out and use together with the pattern should to wish to use similar coloured guides to mine for ease of following:

PALE TURQUOISE RIGHT BACK SLEEVE

BLUE RIGHT FRONT SLEEVE

BABY PINK LEFT FRONT SLEEVE

PINK LEFT BACK SLEEVE

BLUE RIGHT BACK TO SLEEVE

BLUE RIGHT FRONT TO SLEEVE

PALE TURQUOISE LEFT FRONT TO SLEEVE

PALE TURQUOISE LEFT BACK TO SLEEVE

GENERAL ABBREVIATIONS:

K = knit

P = purl

inc = increase

dec = decrease

K2tog/ K3tog = knit two together/ knit three together

P2tog/ P3tog = purl two together/ purl three together

RH/LH = right hand/ left hand **RS/WS** = right side/ wrong side

st/ sts =stitch/ stitches

Skpo = slip one stitch, knit next stitch, pass slipped stitch over knit stitch to decrease by one stitch

Kfb = knit into front then into back of stitch to increase by one stitch

Pfb = Purl into front then knit into back of stitch to increase by one stitch

Beginning at the Neck

Cast on 36 sts for Neck Edge

Row 1 RS) [K2, p2] across

Rows 2-4 Repeat last row three times

Row 5 inc) K4, [kfb, k8] three times, kfb, k4 - 40sts

Rows 6-8 Beginning with a purl row work three rows stocking stitch

Row 9 inc) K4, [kfb, k9] three times, kfb, k5 - 44sts

Row 10 Purl

Start adding **Stripe Pattern** as follows:

Row 11 K2 in **White**, [K4 in **Red**, k4 in **White**] five times, k2 in **Red**

Row 12 inc) Pfb, p1 in **Red**, [P4 in **White**, p4 in **red**] five times, p2, pfb in **White** - 46sts

Row 13 K3 in **White**, [K4 in **Red**, k4 in **White**] five times, k3 in **Red**

Row 14 inc) Pfb, p2 in **Red**, [P4 in **White**, p4 in **red**] five times, p2, pfb in **White** - 48sts

***NOTE:** From now on the colours in the stripes will be written as **R** for Red; **W** for White, moving the markers on each knitting row as follows:*

Sleeves set-up

Row 15 inc) W - K4, R - k4, W - k3, kfb, R - k1 (*PM on last stitch for Right Back Sleeve*), kfb, k2, W - kfb, k1 (*PM on last stitch for Left Front Sleeve*), kfb, k1, R - k4, W - K4, R - k1, kfb, k1 (*PM on last stitch for Left Back Sleeve*), kfb, W - k2, kfb, k1 (*PM on last stitch for Left Back Sleeve*), R - kfb, k3, W - K4, R - k4 - 56sts

Row 16 R - P4, W - p4, R - p5, W - p5, R - p6, W - p4, R - p4, W - p6, R - p5, W - p5, R - P4, W - p4

Row 17 inc) W - K4, R - k4, W - k4, kfb, R - k1 (*PM on last stitch for Right Back Sleeve*), kfb, k3, W - k1, kfb, k1 (*PM on last stitch for Left Front Sleeve*), kfb, k2, R - k4, W - K4, R - k2, kfb, k1 (*PM on last stitch for Left Back Sleeve*), kfb, k1, W - k3, kfb, k1 (*PM on last stitch for Left Back Sleeve*), R - kfb, k4, W - K4, R - k4 - 64sts

Row 18 R - P4, W - p4, R - p6, W - p6, R - p8, W - p4, R - p4, W - p8, R - p6, W - p6, R - P4, W - p4

Row 19 inc) W - kfb, k3, R - k4, W - k5, kfb, R - k1 (*PM on last stitch for Right Back Sleeve*), kfb, k4, W - k2, kfb, k1 (*PM on last stitch for Left Front Sleeve*), kfb, k3, R - k4, W - K4, R - k3, kfb, k1 (*PM on last stitch for Left Back Sleeve*), kfb, k2, W - k4, kfb, k1 (*PM on last stitch for Left Back Sleeve*), R - kfb, k5, W - K4, R - k3, kfb - 74sts

Row 20 R - P5, W - p4, R - p7, W - p7, R - p10, W - p4, R - p4, W - p10, R - p7, W - p7, R - P4, W - p5

Row 21 inc) W - kfb, k4, R - k4, W - k6, kfb, R - k1 (*PM on last stitch for Right Back Sleeve*), kfb, k5, W - k3, kfb, k1 (*PM on last stitch for Left Front Sleeve*), kfb, k4, R - k4, W - K4, R - k4, kfb, k1 (*PM on last stitch for Left Back Sleeve*), kfb, k3, W - k5, kfb, k1 (*PM on last stitch for Left Back Sleeve*), R - kfb, k6, W - K4, R - k4, kfb - 84sts

Row 22 R - P6, W - p4, R - p8, W - p8, R - p12, W - p4, R - p4, W - p12, R - p8, W - p8, R - P4, W - p6

DIVIDE SLEEVES

Row 23 inc) W - kfb, k5, **R** - k4, **W** - k7, kfb, **R** - k1 (*Remove Marker*), kfb, k6, **W** - k4, kfb, k1 (*Remove Marker*), kfb, Turn so purl side faces:

Working back across all 20 Right Sleeve sts:

Row 24 W - p9, **R** - p9, **W** - p2, Turn so purl side faces:

Cut White yarn, work solely only in **Red** yarn for Right Sleeve as follows:

Right Sleeve

Row 25 [K2, p1] six times, k2, Turn so purl side faces

Row 26 [P2, k1] six times, p2, Turn so knit side faces

Rows 27-28 Repeat last two rows once

PM at each end of last row for **Sleeve Markers**

Row 29 [K2, p1] six times, k2, Turn so purl side faces

Row 30 [P2, k1] six times, p2, Turn so knit side faces

Rows 31-32 Repeat last two rows once

Cast off in rib all 20 Right Cuff sts.

Left Sleeve

RS facing, rejoin yarn to the sts on your left needle, continue as follows:

Row 23 inc) W - kfb, k4, **R** - k4, **W** - K4, **R** - k4, kfb twice, k1 (*Remove Marker*), kfb, k4, **W** - k6, kfb, k1 (*Remove Marker*), **R** - kfb, Turn so purl side faces:

Row 24 R - p2, **W** - p9, **R** - p9, Turn so purl side faces:

Cut White yarn, work solely only in **Red** yarn for Left Sleeve as follows:

Left Sleeve

Row 25 [K2, p1] six times, k2, Turn so purl side faces

Row 26 [P2, k1] six times, p2, Turn so knit side faces

Rows 27-28 Repeat last two rows once

PM at each end of last row for **Sleeve Markers**

Row 29 [K2, p1] six times, k2, Turn so purl side faces

Row 30 [P2, k1] six times, p2, Turn so knit side faces

Rows 31-32 Repeat last two rows once

Cast off in rib all 20 Left Cuff sts.

Left Back

RS facing, rejoin yarn to 17 Left Back sts on your left needle, continue as follows:

Row 23 inc) R - k7, **W** - K4, **R** - k5, kfb - 18 Left Back sts

You'll now work to join Left Back; add Left Underarm; work across Front; add Right Underarm; work across Right Back as follows:

NOTE: *Cut White yarn, work solely only in Red yarn from now on*

Row 24 WS) inc) P18 (Left Back), cast on 6 sts (Left Underarm), p20 (Front), Turn so knit side faces cast on 6 sts (Right Underarm), p18 (Right Back) - 68sts

Row 25 [K2, p1] across to last 2 sts, k2

Row 26 [P2, k1] across to last 2 sts, p2

Row 27 [K2, p1] six times, k1, **PM** on last st for **Right Back to Sleeve**
Marker, k1, p1, k2, p1, **PM** on last st for **Right Front to Sleeve Marker**, [k2,
 p1] six times, k2, p1 **PM** on last st for **Left Front to Sleeve Marker**, k2, p1,
 k2, **PM** on last st for **Right Back to Sleeve Marker**, p1, [k2, p1] five times, k2

Row 28 [P2, k1] across to last 2 sts, p2

Row 29 [K2, p1] across to last 2 sts, k2

Row 30 [P2, k1] across to last 2 sts, p2

Cast off in rib all 68 Waist Edge sts.

To Join Seams

Weave in all the ends to neaten.

WS together, working on one side of the Left Sleeve at a time as follows:

Match the Left Back Sleeve with the Left Front to Sleeve Marker, work mattress stitch to join the sleeve to the front from where you divided to the left back/ left front to sleeve markers (*see Fig. 1, join dotted lines A to B for joining Sleeve to Front*).

Match the Left Back Sleeve with the Left Back to Sleeve Marker, work mattress stitch to join the sleeve to the left back from where you divided to the left back/ left back to sleeve markers.

Then join the sleeve cuff from the markers to the Cuff Cast-Off Edge (*see Fig. 2, join dotted lines C to D for joining Sleeve Seam*).

To Join Back Seam

WS together mattress stitch the seam to join the Left Back to Right Back from the cast-on edge at the neck to the cast-off edge at the waist (*see Fig. 1, join dotted lines E to F for joining Back Seam*).


