You need to have basic crochet skills to finish the pattern!

If you have any trouble following the pattern, feel free to contact me directly from the shop.

Final size of the toys with the recommended materials and tools ~ 13 cm/5.12", ~ 7cm/2.76".

Use any materials and tools you like, but the final size of your toy may differ.

## Recommended materials and tools:

### For Big Whale:

Scheepjes Catona 100% mercerized cotton yarn (Silver Blue) #528 50g/125m

Scheepjes Catona 100% mercerized cotton yarn (Old Lace) #130 25g/62,5m

Safety eyes 9 mm/0,35"

### For Baby Whale:

Scheepjes Catona 100% mercerized cotton yarn (Crystalline) #385 10g/25m

Scheepjes Catona 100% mercerized cotton yarn (Bridal White) #105 10g/25m

Safety eyes 6 mm/0,24"

2,25 mm crochet hook (US B)

Fiberfill for stuffing

Tapestry needle and scissors

White embroidery thread

## Abbreviations:

st / sts = stitch / stitches

ch = chain stitch

sc = single crochet

slst = slip stitch

inc = increase (2 single crochets in one stitch)

dec = invisible decrease (2 stitches together working on front loops only)

BLO = back loop only

(...) = repeat between ( ) number of times indicated

[...] = total number of stitches in the round or row

### Fine weight yarn.

Number 2 in Standard Yarn Weight System (SPORT, BABY).

I used **Sport (5 ply)** cotton yarn.

**Skill level:** beginner - intermediate

### Suggested substitute yarn:

"Alize Bahar"

"Alpina Anabel"

"Ice Yarns Camilla Cotton"

"Schachenmayr Catania"

"Phildar Phil Cotton 3"

"Patons Grace"

- ❖ **Toy is crocheted in continuous spirals without joining the rounds, do not turn or slip stitch unless otherwise stated in the pattern!**
- ❖ **You can use a scrap of contrasting yarn instead of the stitch marker!**

# Big Whale!

## Body:

Working in rounds. Start with Scheepjes Catona (Old Lace) #130.

Start with foundation chain.

**Rnd 1.** 9 ch [9]

Start in the 2<sup>nd</sup> chain from the hook: 7 sc, 3 sc into the last chain, (turn the crocheting and on the other side of foundation chain work) 6 sc, 2 sc into the last chain [18]

### ***Crochet in continuous spirals!***

**Rnd 2.** inc, 6 sc, (inc) \* 3 times, 6 sc, (inc) \* 2 times [24]

**Rnd 3.** 1 sc, inc, 6 sc, (1 sc, inc) \* 3 times, 6 sc, (1 sc, inc) \* 2 times [30]

**Rnd 4.** 30 sc [30] – 1 round

**Rnd 5.** (2 sc, inc) \* 10 times [40]

**Rnd 6.** 40 sc [40] – 1 round

**Rnd 7.** (4 sc, inc) \* 8 times [48]

**Rnd 8.** (5 sc, inc) \* 8 times [56]

**Rnd 9.** 56 sc [56] – 1 round

Change yarn into Scheepjes Catona (Silver Blue) #528. [Images 2, 3](#)

**Rnd 10. BLO (back loop only):** 3 sc, inc, (6 sc, inc) \* 7 times, 3 sc [64] [Images 4, 5](#)

**Rnd 11.** 64 sc [64] – 1 round

**Rnd 12.** (7 sc, inc) \* 8 times [72]

**Rnds 13-18.** 72 sc [72] – 6 rounds

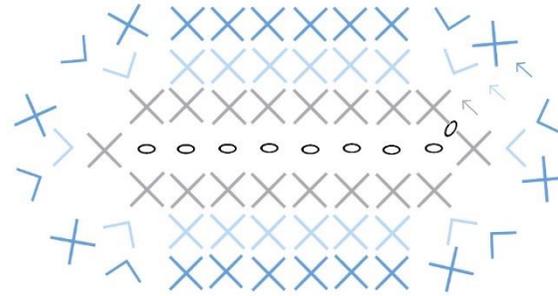

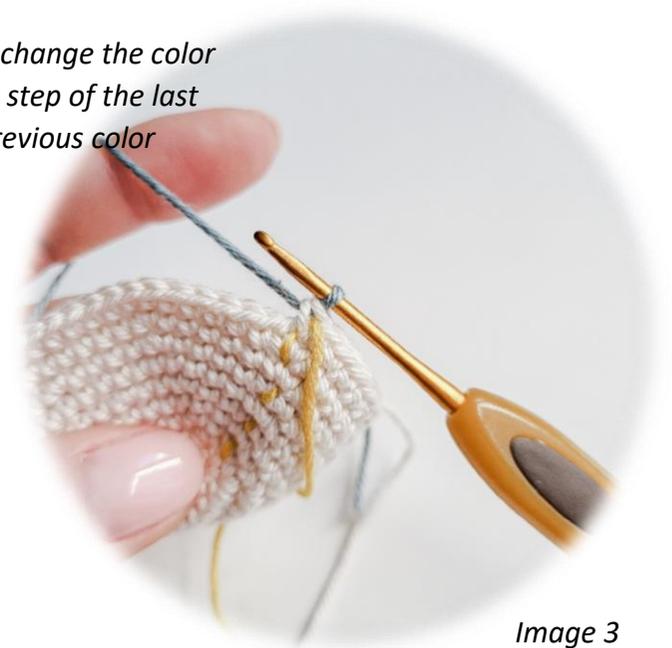

**Useful Tip.** Always change the color of yarn at the last step of the last stitch of the previous color

**Rnd 19.** 4 sc, inc, (8 sc, inc) \* 7 times, 4 sc  
[80]

**Rnds 20-24.** 80 sc [80] – 5 rounds

Insert the safety eyes between rounds 13 and 14. To place them symmetrical skip different number of stitches to the left and to the right from the marker thread [Images 7-11](#).

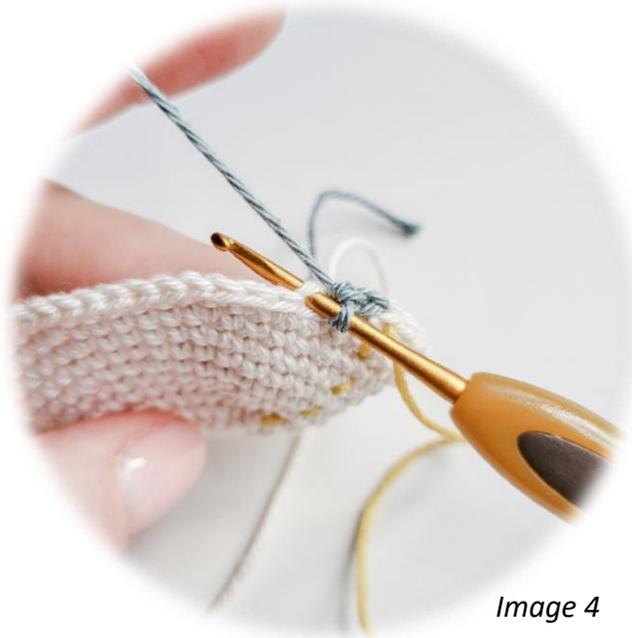

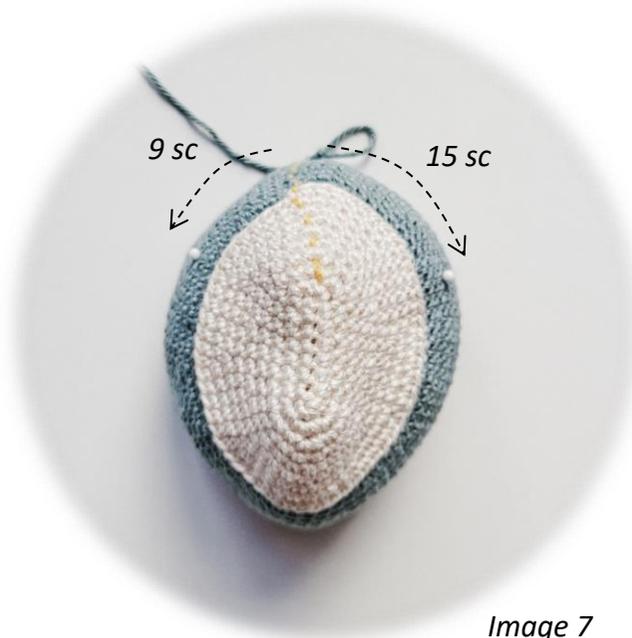

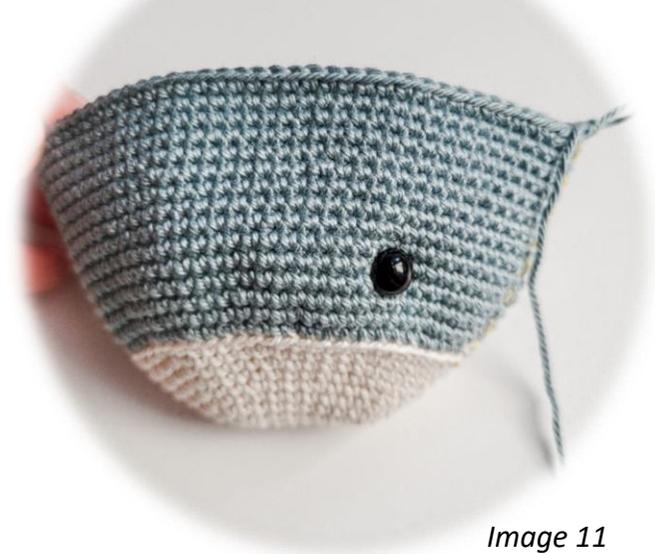

## Tail:

**Rnd 1.** Work 8 sc to *marker 1* [Image 12](#), skip 62 sts of body for the head and closing, insert the hook into the next stitch with *marker 2* [Image 13](#) and crochet 10 sc [18]

**Rnds 2-3.** 18 sc [18] – 2 rounds

**Rnd 4.** (4 sc, dec) \* 3 times [15]

**Rnd 5.** 15 sc [15] – 1 round

**Rnd 6.** (3 sc, dec) \* 3 times [12]

**Rnd 7.** 12 sc [12] – 1 round

Stuff the body and tail with fiberfill.

**Rnd 8.** (2 sc, dec) \* 3 times [9]

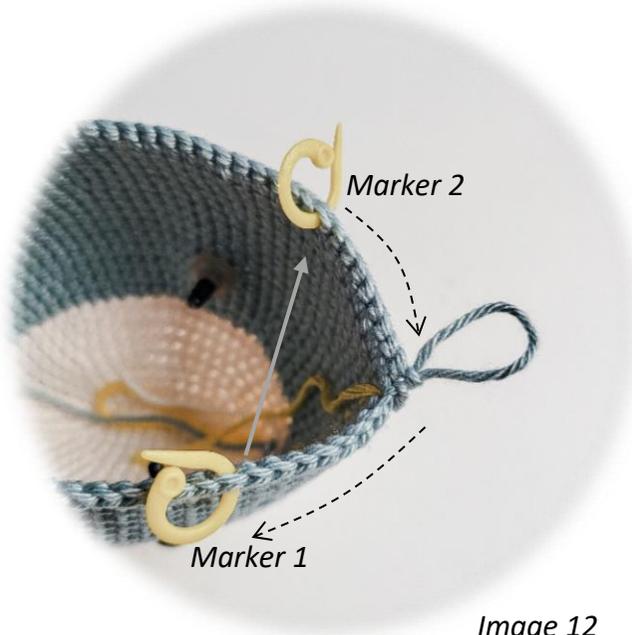

**Rnd 9.** (1 sc, dec) \* 3 times [6]

Using a needle or crochet hook thread the yarn tail through the front loops and pull to tighten! [Images 15,16](#)

Weave in the yarn end.

*Head:*

Skip 3 sts from both sides of the tail. And in the 4<sup>th</sup> sts insert the markers [Image 18](#).

Insert the hook across two stitches with the markers and pick up the yarn [Image 19](#) and

pull it through [Image 20](#). Make a sc to connect both sides. Leave a long tail of yarn, we are going to use it later to close the hole [Image 20](#).

**The 1<sup>st</sup> sc of Rnd 1 work in the same stitch [Images 21, 22](#). This will be the 1<sup>st</sup> stitch of the next round [Images 23, 24](#).**

**Rnd 1.** 56 sc [56] – 1 round

**Rnd 2.** (5 sc, dec) \* 8 times [48]

**Rnd 3.** 48 sc [48] – 1 round

**Rnd 4.** 2 sc, dec, (4 sc, dec) \* 7 times, 2 sc [40]

**Rnd 5.** 40 sc [40] – 1 round

**Rnd 6.** (3 sc, dec) \* 8 times [32]

**Rnd 7.** 1 sc, dec, (2 sc, dec) \* 7 times, 1 sc [24]

Stuff the head firmly with filler! Insert small amounts at a time until you get the right shape (more stuffing material insert in the front side of the head) [Image 26](#). Take your time with this step.

**Rnd 8.** (1 sc, dec) \* 8 times [16]

**Rnd 9.** (dec) \* 8 times [8]

Using a needle or crochet hook thread the yarn tail through the front loops and pull to tighten [Image 27](#)!

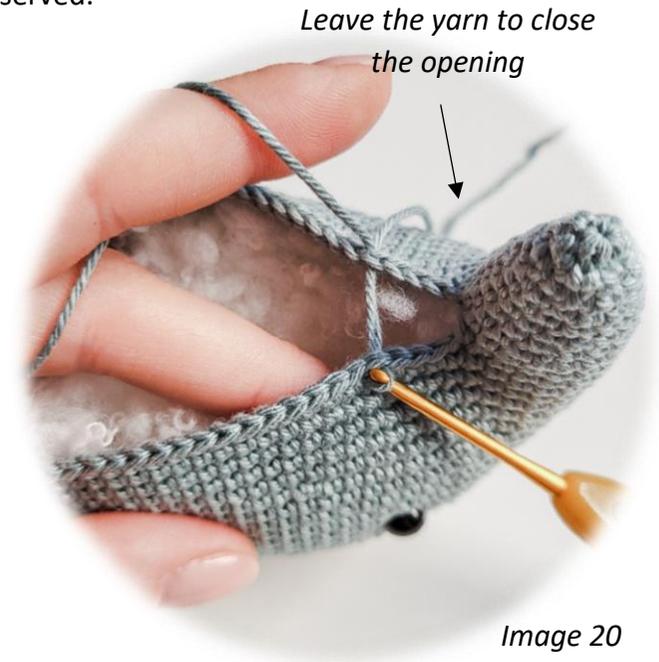

Weave in the yarn end.

Close the opening of the body by going across each stitch *Images 28-31*. Weave in the yarn end.

Turn the body upside down and reattach yarn (Old Lace) #130 to round 10 where we completed the stitches in Back Loop Only (BLO) [Image 32](#). Insert your hook into the Front Loop of the first stitch of round 10 and work slst. Continue to slst around [Images 33-35](#), weave in the yarn end.

## Fins (make 2):

Working in rounds. Using Scheepjes Catona (Silver Blue) #528.

- Rnd 1.** 4 sc in magic ring [4]
- Rnd 2.** (inc, 1 sc) \* 2 times [6]
- Rnd 3.** 6 sc [6] - 1 round
- Rnd 4.** (inc, 1 sc) \* 3 times [9]
- Rnd 5.** 9 sc [9] – 1 round
- Rnd 6.** (inc, 2 sc) \* 3 times [12]
- Rnd 7.** 12 sc [12] – 1 round
- Rnd 8.** (inc, 3 sc) \* 3 times [15]
- Rnd 9.** (dec, 3 sc) \* 3 times [12]

**Rnd 10.** (dec, 2 sc) \* 3 times [9]

Fold the fin in half and crochet through two layers 4 sc *Image 36*.

Fasten off and leave long thread for sewing.

### *Tail fin:*

Working in rows. Using Scheepjes Catona (Silver Blue) #528.

13 chains

**Row 1.** in the 2<sup>nd</sup> chain from the hook: 12 sc, 3 ch and turn

**Row 2.** in the 2<sup>nd</sup> chain from the hook: **BLO** 14 sc, 3 ch and turn

**Row 3.** in the 2<sup>nd</sup> chain from the hook: **BLO** 16 sc, 3 ch and turn

**Row 4.** in the 2<sup>nd</sup> chain from the hook: **BLO** 18 sc, 3 ch and turn

**Row 5.** in the 2<sup>nd</sup> chain from the hook: **BLO** 20 sc, 4 ch and turn

**Row 6.** in the 2<sup>nd</sup> chain from the hook: **BLO** 23 sc, 4 ch and turn

**Row 7.** in the 2<sup>nd</sup> chain from the hook: **BLO** 13 sc

Fasten off and leave long thread for sewing.

*Weave in the smaller tail using the needle*

*Thread the yarn tail through the visible loops in the middle and pull to tighten*

*Wrap the yarn tail around the middle several times, secure the yarn tail at the bottom of the Tail fin!*

## Assembling:

### Sculpting!

Take the yarn (Silver Blue) #528 and long needle!

Insert the needle with a long piece of yarn in **point 1**. Leave there a long piece of yarn (8-10 cm). Pull out the needle from **point 2**, insert the needle in the **point 3**, pull out from **point 1**. Pull well both of threads and tie them tightly [Images 45, 46](#). (You can repeat this action one more time!)

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Repeat sculpting with another eye! Weave in the ends. Cut them.

Using 6 strands of white embroidery thread embroider the highlights as shown on *Images 47, 48!* Weave in the ends.

Using same yarn, we crocheted the body embroider the eyelids as shown on the *Images 49, 50!* Work as many stitches as you like, to be satisfied with the thickness of the eyelid. Weave in the ends.

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Using Scheepjes Catona (Old Lace) #130  
embroider the spots (make 4-5 stitches for  
each spot) on the head`s top randomly  
*Images 51, 52.*

Sew the tail fin to the whale`s tail *Images*  
*53, 54.* Weave in the yarn end.

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Sew the fins onto either side of the body to round 12. Skip 2 sts from the eye. Sew the fin in the diagonal to Rnd 12 [Images 55, 56](#).

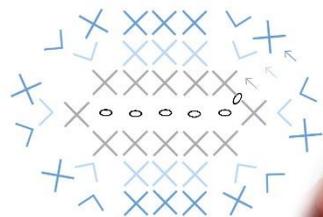

## Baby Whale!

### Body:



Working in rounds. Start with Scheepjes Catona (Bridal White) #105. Start with foundation chain.

**Rnd 1.** 6 ch [6]

Start in the 2<sup>nd</sup> chain from the hook: 4 sc, 3 sc into the last chain, (turn the crocheting and on the other side of foundation chain work) 3 sc, 2 sc into the last chain [12]

#### ***Crochet in continuous spirals!***

**Rnd 2.** inc, 3 sc, (inc) \* 3 times, 3 sc, (inc) \* 2 times [18]

**Rnd 3.** 1 sc, inc, 3 sc, (1 sc, inc) \* 3 times, 3 sc, (1 sc, inc) \* 2 times [24]

**Rnd 4.** 24 sc [24] – 1 round

**Rnd 5.** (2 sc, inc) \* 8 times [32]

Change yarn into Scheepjes Catona (Crystalline) #385.

**Rnd 6. BLO (back loop only):** 32 sc [32] – 1 round

**Rnd 7.** (3 sc, inc) \* 8 times [40]

**Rnds 8-10.** 40 sc [40] – 3 rounds

**Rnd 11.** 2 sc, inc, (4 sc, inc) \* 7 times, 2 sc [48]

**Rnds 12-13.** 48 sc [48] – 2 rounds

Insert the safety eyes between rounds 8 and 9. To place them symmetrical skip different number of stitches to the left and to the right from the marker thread. Refer to the [Image 61](#).

### Tail:

**Rnd 1.** Work 5 sc to **marker 1**, skip 37 sts of body for the head and closing, insert the hook into the next stitch with **marker 2** and crochet 6 sc [Image 64](#) [11]

**Rnd 2.** 11 sc [11] – 1 round

**Rnd 3.** 3 sc, (dec) \* 2 times, 4 sc [9]

**Rnd 4.** 9 sc [9] – 1 round

Stuff the body and tail with fiberfill.

**Rnd 5.** (1 sc, dec) \* 3 times [6]

Using a needle or crochet hook thread the yarn tail through the front loops and pull to tighten!

Weave in the yarn end.

### Head:

Skip 1 sts from both sides of the tail. And in the 2<sup>nd</sup> sts insert the markers [Image 67](#).

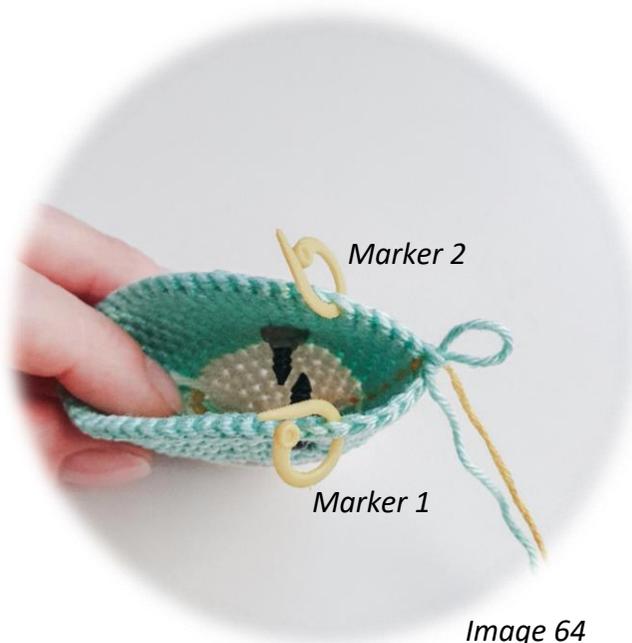

Insert the hook across two stitches with the markers and pick up the yarn and pull it through. Make a sc to connect both sides. Leave a long tail of yarn, we are going to use it later to close the hole [Image 68](#).

**The 1<sup>st</sup> sc of Rnd 1 work in the same stitch. This will be the 1<sup>st</sup> stitch of the next round.**

**Rnd 1.** 35 sc [35] – 1 round

**Rnd 2.** (3 sc, dec) \* 7 times [28]

**Rnd 3.** 28 sc [28] – 1 round

**Rnd 4.** 1 sc, dec, (2 sc, dec) \* 6 times, 1 sc [21]

Stuff the head firmly with filler! Insert small amounts at a time until you get the right shape. Take your time with this step.

**Rnd 5.** (1 sc, dec) \* 7 times [14]

**Rnd 6.** (dec) \* 7 times [7]

Using a needle or crochet hook thread the yarn tail through the front loops and pull to tighten [Image 70](#)!

Weave in the yarn end.

Close the opening of the body by going across each stitch. Weave in the yarn end.

Turn the body upside down and reattach (Bridal White) #105 yarn to round 6 where



we completed the stitches in Back Loop Only (BLO). Insert your hook into the Front Loop of the first stitch of round 6 and work slst. Continue to slst around and weave in the yarn end *Image 71*.

## Fins (make 2):

Working in rounds. Using Scheepjes Catona (Crystalline) #385.

**Rnd 1.** 4 sc in magic ring [4]

**Rnd 2.** (inc, 1 sc) \* 2 times [6]

**Rnd 3.** 6 sc [6] - 1 round

**Rnd 4.** (inc, 1 sc) \* 3 times [9]

**Rnd 5.** 9 sc [9] – 1 round

**Rnd 6.** (dec, 1 sc) \* 3 times [6]

Fold the fin in half and crochet through two layers 2 sc.

Fasten off and leave long thread for sewing.

## Tail fin:

Working in rows. Using Scheepjes Catona (Crystalline) #385.

7 chains

**Row 1.** in the 2<sup>nd</sup> chain from the hook: 6 sc, 3 ch and turn

**Row 2.** in the 2<sup>nd</sup> chain from the hook: **BLO** 8 sc, 3 ch and turn

**Row 3.** in the 2<sup>nd</sup> chain from the hook: **BLO** 10 sc, 4 ch and turn

**Row 4.** in the 2<sup>nd</sup> chain from the hook: **BLO**  
13 sc, 4 ch and turn

**Row 5.** in the 2<sup>nd</sup> chain from the hook: **BLO**  
7 sc

Fasten off and leave long thread for sewing.

## Assembling:

Using 6 strands of white embroidery thread  
embroider the highlights [Image 75](#). Weave in the ends!

Using same yarn, we crocheted the body embroider the eyelids as shown on the [Image 75](#)! Weave in the ends!

Using Scheepjes Catona (Bridal Whire) #105 embroider the spots on the head`s top  
randomly [Image 76](#).

Sew the tail fin to the whale`s tail [Image 77](#). Weave in the yarn end.

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Sew the fins onto either side of the body to round 9. Skip 2 sts from the eye. Sew the fin in the diagonal to Rnd 9 *Images 78, 79.*
