MATERIALS

Friends Cotton 8/4

1 skein of color 05
1 skein of color 72
1 skein of color 31

or

1 skein of color 45
1 skein of color 108

Crochet hook 2.5 mm / US C-2

Filling

Safety eyes, black, 4 mm

Yarn needle

Scissor

YARN QUALITY

 **Friends Cotton 8/4**, Hobbii

100% Cotton

50 g / 1.75 oz = 160 m / 175 yds

ABBREVIATIONS

mr = magic ring

sc = single crochet

inc = increase

dec = decrease

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 2.5 cm / 0.9"

Length: 12.5 cm / 4.9"

PATTERN INFORMATION

This pattern utilizes crochet stitches such as single crochet (sc), increases (inc) and decreases (dec).

If you're new to amigurumi, don't worry! The instructions are clear and perfect for beginners! The pattern includes guidance on how to change colors in order to achieve the markings of a sardine. It's an opportunity for you to experiment with color combinations that add a personalized touch to your amigurumi creation. If you're someone who likes having instructions, the pattern actually comes with photos that show you important steps like putting in the eyes and closing up the last hole. This visual guide makes following the pattern easier. Enjoy!




INFO AND TIPS

For Increase (inc):

In the designated stitch, make two single crochets.

For Decrease (dec):

- Insert the hook into the next stitch.
- Yarn over and pull up a loop.
- Insert the hook into the following stitch.
- Yarn over and pull up a loop.
- Yarn over and pull through all three loops on the hook.



Changing Colors:

- When you're ready to switch colors, complete the last single crochet of the round until the last yarn-over of the stitch.
- Instead of finishing the last yarn-over with the current color, use the new color to complete the stitch.
- Continue with the new color in the next round.



HEAD

Make 1. Use yarn color 05.

Round 1: Magic ring, 5 sc. (5)

Round 2: 5 sc in the same stitches. (5)


Round 3: 5 inc. (10)

Round 4-5: Sc in each stitch around. (10)

Round 6: (1 sc, inc) x 5. (15)

Round 7-8: Sc in each stitch around. (15)

Insert safety eyes between rounds 5 and 6, with an interspace of about 6 stitches. Cut the yarn and continue with the body.



1ST SARDINE: BODY

Change yarn color.

Round 9-27: Sc in each stitch around. (15)

Round 28: (Decrease, 3 sc) x 3. (12)

Round 29-31: Sc in each stitch around. (12)

Stuff the sardine.

Round 32: 6 decreases. (6)

Cut the yarn and leave a long tail to close the remaining hole.



2ND SARDINE: BODY

Repeat the pattern for the body of the first sardine, but alternate the colors every two rows.

FINS

Make 2.

Round 1: Magic ring, 5 sc. (5)

Round 2: 5 sc in the same stitches. (5)

Round 3: 5 increases (inc). (10)

Round 4-7: Sc in each stitch around. (10)

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Flatten and pinch the ears. Sew the bottom stitches together. Sew the fins to the bottom of the body over the last round.
