

Fall Haze Cardigan

Small size



AE1203-877-01

This cardigan consists of the **left front piece, right front piece, back piece, sleeves, and front band**. First, complete the knitting of the front and back pieces, then connect them at the corresponding positions, next pick up stitches and knit in the round for the sleeves, then pick up stitches to knit the front band, and make buttonholes on the right front band. The video tutorial is demonstrated using a large size as an example.





Size	Bust width	Garment length	Sleeve length
Small	56 cm	56.5 cm	42 cm

The handcrafted measurements may have an error of 1 to 2 cm. Due to variations in individual tension, the size of the sample is for reference only.

Materials: Susan's Family Impression Misty Feather & Dawn Impression & Dimond Thread Wool

Needles: 4.50 mm and 4.00 mm circular needles & short straight needles

Chart Key

-  **P on RS, K on WS** : purl on right side, knit on wrong side
-  **K on RS, P on WS** : knit on right side, purl on wrong side
-  **k2tog** : knit 2 stitches together
-  **ssk** : slip, slip, knit (slip 2 stitches knitwise one at a time, knit the 2 slipped stitches through the back loop)
-  **1/1 LC** : slip 1 st onto cn, hold in front, k1, k1 from cn
OR with right needle behind left needle, knit 2nd st tbl, knit first st, drop both sts from left needle
-  **1/1 RC** : slip 1 st onto cn, hold in back, k1, k1 from cn
OR k2tog but do not drop sts from left needle, k1, drop both sts from left needle
-  **2/1 LC** : slip 1 st onto cn, hold in front, k2, k1 from cn
-  **1/2 RC** : slip 2 st onto cn, hold in back, k1, k2 from cn
-  **yarn over short row** : knit to the turning point in the first row, stop and turn, yarn over before working, and closing the gap when reach the yarn over.
-  **yo** : yarn over

Note: 1. This pattern is using **American terminology**. All measurements in charts are in cm.


2. The chart represent the **right side** of fabric, so check the key to see how to work a certain symbol on the right side and on the wrong side.

Schematic Diagram





Part 1 Right front piece A

The right front piece is knitted from bottom-up, dividing into three parts: the bottom edge, the body, and the shoulder. Please refer to the video demonstration for more details.



- Note:1. The chart represent the right side of fabric, so check the key to see how to work a certain symbol on the right side and on the wrong side.
- 2. The left and right on the charts refer to the actual wearing position.
- 3. After completing the front piece, do not bind off. Instead, place the stitch loops on a short straight needle, break yarn, and pause knitting.



Part 2 Left front piece B

The left front piece and right front piece are knitted in the same order but in symmetrical direction. Both are divided into the bottom edge, body, and shoulder, but with different patterns. Please refer to the video demonstration for more details.






Part 3 Back piece and Sewing the Shoulders

The back piece is knitted in the same sequence as the front piece. After completing one side of the shoulder, sew it to the corresponding shoulder of the front piece using the knit-as-you-sew method to join the shoulders. Please refer to the video demonstration for more details.



Part 4 Sew the body together **D**




After completing the front and back pieces, sew together the bottom edge to the underarm section. Please refer to the video demonstration for more details.

Part 5 Sleeves **E**

Video 77' 51"


Pick up stitches along the armhole and knit the sleeve. The sleeve is worked in the round. Please refer to the video demonstration for more details.



Part 6 Front band **F**

Video 88' 05" 

Pick up stitches and knit the front band, and make buttonholes on the right front piece. After completing the front band, sew on the buttons at the corresponding positions. Please refer to the video demonstration for more details.



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
