

Cowl Braided (Imitate Entrelac).
 Design and pattern instructions © 2017 Tashashu Gordon

Abbreviations:

- BO = bind off
- CO = cast on
- k = knit
- k2tog= knit two (2) stitches together
- p = purl
- RN= right needle
- LN= left needle
- RS = right side
- sl1k = slip a stitch knit-wise
- st(s) = stitch (es)
- tbl = through back loop
- WS = wrong side
- wyib = with yarn in back.
- w/o = without
- yo = yarn over



Yarn: Seam Toscana 01 (Hand Painted Yarn) – 120g (400m/100g)

Size: wide – 31 cm. / long - 82 cm. (or optional)

Needles: 3mm.

Gauge: 24sts and 30 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm

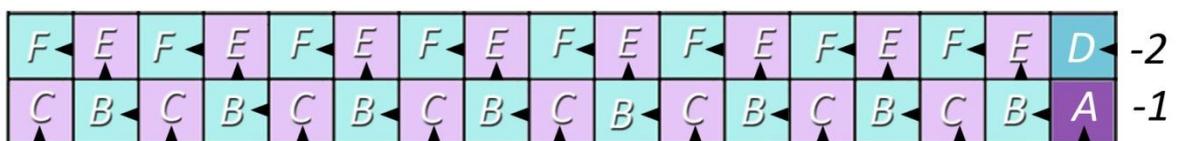
Note:

Selvedge stitches are already included in this stitch count. Do not add any additional selvedge stitches.

For this photo tutorial, I used the yarns Pehorka Merino (Hand Painted Yarn).

This cowl looks like entrelac but knitted without exhausting turns.

Attention! - For photo-tutorial I've CO 25sts (10x2+5).



black arrow = direction of work

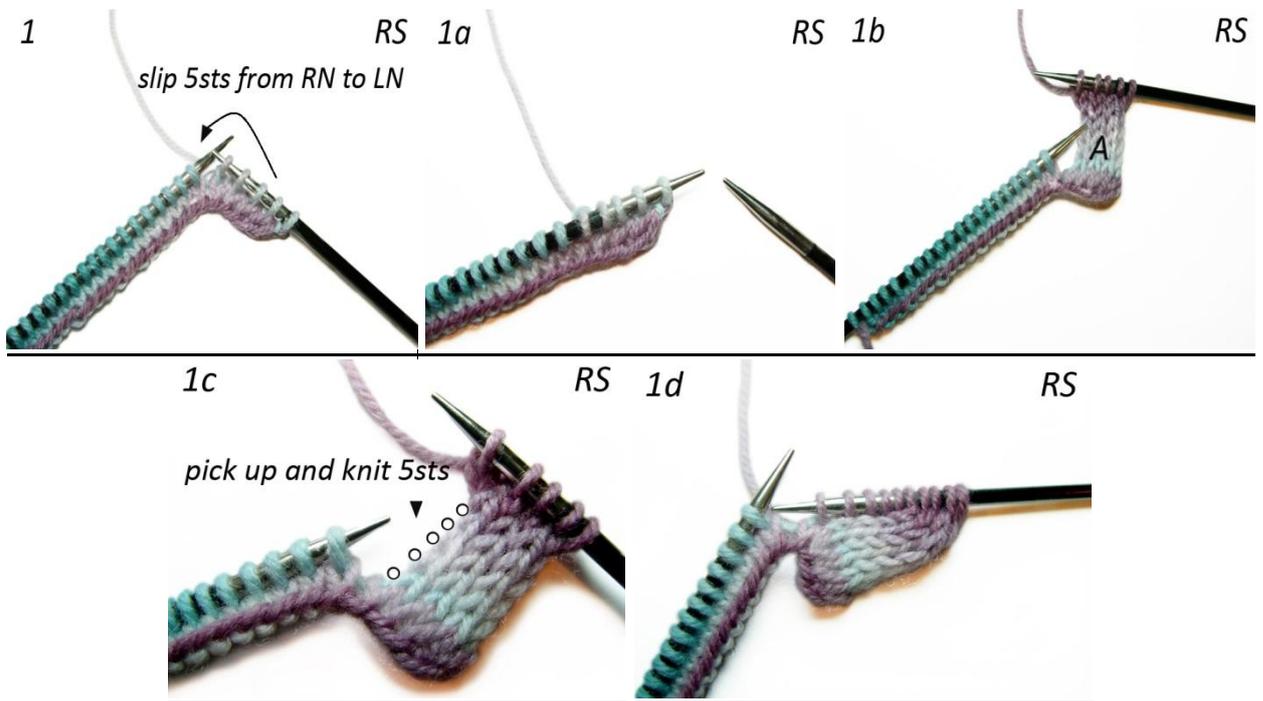
Instructions:

CO 95 sts (5 + multiple of 10) and work 1 purl row.

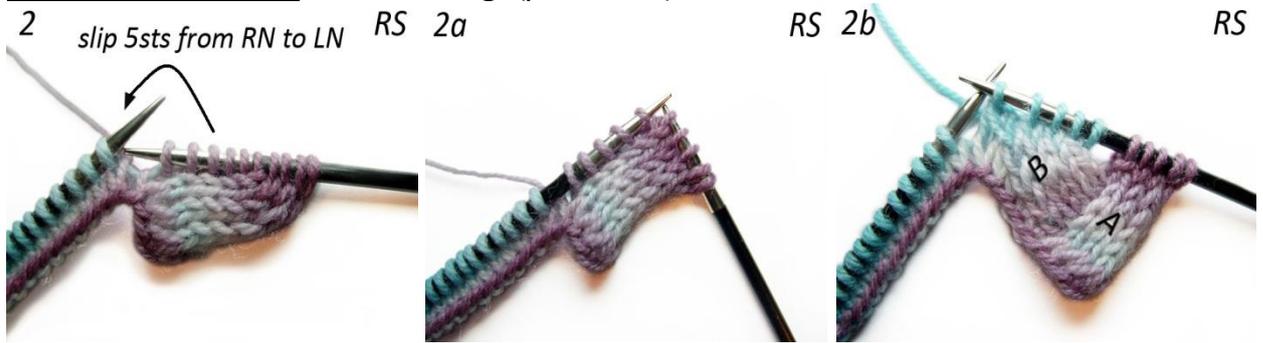
1 strip: (see Schematic)

(RS) Vertical I-Cord «A»: K5, w/o turning, [slip 5sts from RN to LN(wyib), (photos 1, 1a), k5] x 5 times (photo 1b), w/o turning, pick up and knit 5sts (white points in the photo 1c), w/o turning, (photo 1d)

*** (RS) Horizontal I-Cord «B»:** [slip 5sts from RN to LN(wyib), (photos 2, 2a), k4, k2tog tbl] x 5 times, w/o turning, (photo 2b)



(RS) Vertical I-Cord «C»: K5, w/o turning, [slip 6sts from RN to LN(wyib), (photos 3, 3a), k2tog, k4] x 5 times (photo 3b), w/o turning, pick up and knit 5sts (white points in the photo 3c), w/o turning, (photo 3d) *

Continued: repeat from * to * - 8 more times. /For this photo tutorial - 1 more times/, (photo 3e). Turn work.

2 strip: (see Schematic)

(WS): Sl1k, p4, [pick up and purl 5sts (white points in the photo 4), w/o turning, p5] x 9 times, /for this photo tutorial - 1 more times (photo 4a)/, w/o turning, CO 5sts (using the loop cast-on method, photo 4b), turn work.



(RS) Horizontal I-Cord «D»: K4, k2tog tbl, w/o turning, [slip 5sts from RN to LN(wyib), k4, k2tog tbl] x 4 times, w/o turning, (photo 5)



*** (RS) Vertical I-Cord «E»:** K5, w/o turning, [slip 6sts from RN to LN(wyib), k2tog, k4] x 5 times, (photo 6), w/o turning, pick up and knit 5sts (white points in the photo 6a), w/o turning

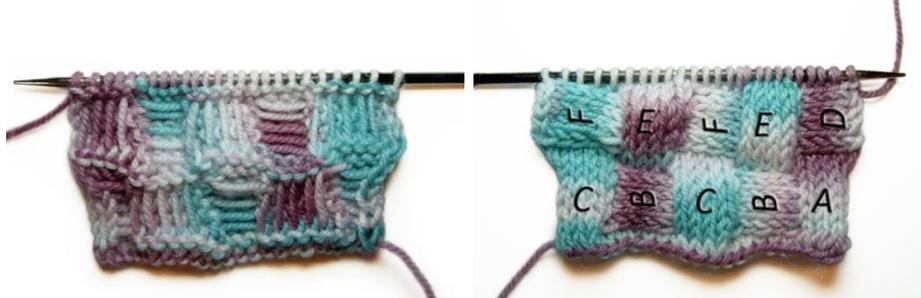
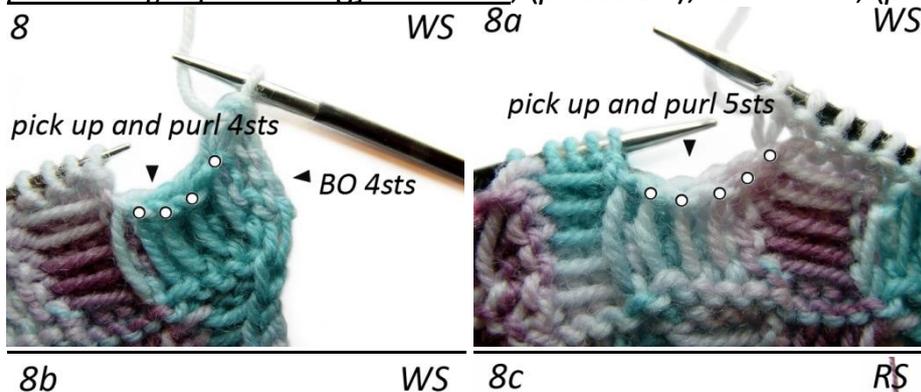


(RS) Horizontal I-Cord «F»: [slip 5sts from RN to LN(wyib), k4, k2tog tbl] x 5 times, w/o turning, (photo 7) *



Continued: repeat from * to * - 8 more times, turn work.

(WS) BO 4sts (1st remaining on RN), w/o turning, pick up and purl 4sts (white points in the photo 8), w/o turning, [p5, pick up and purl 5sts (white points in the photo 8a), w/o turning] x 9 times, (photo 8b), turn work, (photo 8c).



Continued: repeat strips 1-2 x 15 more times or to desired length. BO all sts.

Border: Pick up and purl from selvedge stitches on the long side (WS) of the cowl + CO 5 sts (using the loop cast-on method), turn work.

Next: K4, k2tog tbl, [slip 5sts from RN to LN (wyib), k4, k2tog tbl] x until the end of the rows. Repeat on other long side.

To finish - stitch the short side.
