hand knitting patterns instructions

Here below are the set of instructions to knit patterns. By the side of each explanation appear a small picture which reproduce the bigger one contained in the magazine main report. Large photos are at your disposal and free downloadable in Internet too, on the Adriafil's website **<http://www.adriafil.com>**

INSTRUCTIONS

Ensuring the best results from the yarn

In order to obtain the best results from the fantasy and multicoloured yarns, two balls of yarn should be used at the same time. If you work with one ball of yarn at a time, the combination of fibres and colours of these yarn may produce an irregular effect. By using two balls of yarn as suggested you will obtain the required effect ensuring the best results. Working with two balls of yarn is easy: use one ball to work one knitted row and one purled row (or forward and return needle and the other ball to work the next knitted row and purled row and so on.

SOME GOOD ADVICE

It is easy to take care of your knitwear if the yarn is **ADRIAFIL**.

Don't worry a garment worked in Adriafile yarn can be washed over and over again with no problem at all. Selected raw materials and proper workmanship guarantee excellent behaviour during washing. Simply follow the recommendations given by the symbols on the tag. Follow the instructions carefully to enjoy the beauty and softness of your work much longer

HANDWASHING

Wash in lukewarm water and a little specific detergent. Allow to soak for several minutes then dip the garment repeatedly holding by the shoulders. Rinse very thoroughly without wringing. Spread the garment out to dry. Do not hang.

MACHINE WASHING

Check that the garment can be machine washed. No pre-washing. Set on wool or pure virgin wool cycle at 40°. Use a specific detergent. Dry flat. Do not use bleach or enzymatic/ biological detergents for wool and mixed wool.

IRONING

Recommended temperature is 150° using vapour of steam iron. Skimming over the garment with the vapour of the steam iron, you will also "regenerate" the fibres.

Treat stains specifically, if in doubt decide for professional treatment.





Knitted back loop



Work knitted stitch, passing the yarn of the stitch behind the needle.

Increasing stitches




Increase 1 stitch at the centre, by picking up the yarn between two stitches with the left-hand needle and work it in

knitted back loop.


To increase 1 stitch after the last stitch, knit 1 stitch and without dropping it off the needle, purl it.

To increase 1 stitch at the beginning, pass the yarn over the needle and then knit or purl the stitch.

Decrease of 1 stitch




Knit 2 stitches together. Rightwise slant.



Slip off 1 stitch, knit next stitch, passing slipped stitch over knitted stitch. Leftwise slant.


Decrease of 2 stitches



Double pass. Slip a knitted stitch, knit 2 together, pass slipped stitch over stitch. The double pass stitch can also


be purled (purl the stitches together).

Decrease of 3 or more stitches




Work 3 stitches together like 1 stitch. (Rightwise slant.) For leftwise slant, work the 3 or more stitches together picking them up from the back.

Knitted stitch for embroidery



Knitted stitch for invisible joining to two parts



Knitted Yarn over

After a knitted stitch, bring yarn from back to front under the right-hand needle then work the next stitch normally.

Purled yarn over

Bring the yarn over the tip of the right-hand needle from back to front and then over, for a full turn.

Elastic rib

With a different coloured yarn cast on half the stitches plus 2 for ends. With the yarn of the work, work as follows:

Row 1 - * k 1., yo.* Repeat from * to *

Row 2 - k1 end st. *k1 into yo., slip purled st. *. Repeat from * to * k 1 end st.

Row 3 - k1 end st. * k1., slip purled st.

*. Repeat from * to * k1 end stitch. Repeat Row 3 for rib height required.

Jacquard stitch

Work in stock st following chart and legend; carry yarns across the back twisting the two yarns together at the colour change to avoid holes.

Intarsia stitch

Work in stock st. following chart and legend; use a different ball of yarn for each colour area and twist the two yarns across the back at each colour change to avoid holes. Work the large areas of the chart in stock st intarsia method and the small areas of the chart in stock stitch jacquard method.

Bobble

Work 5 stock stitches into 1 stitch, picking it up from the front and from the back, turn work., work 4 knitted rows with the above 5 sts, then with the left-hand needle pass the first stitches on the 5th starting from the closest.

Banded stitches

Cast 2 or more sts on a spare needle, bring yarn to front and pass yarn 3 or 4 times around these 2 or more sts. Bring sts to left-hand needle and work normally.

Cross 2 or more sts rightwise or leftwise

Rightwise: cast on the no. of stitches indicated on a spare needle across the back, work in stock st the same no. of stitches, then work in stock st the sts of the spare needle.


Leftwise: cast on the no. of sts. indicated on a spare n. across the front of the work, work in stock st the same no. of sts, the work in stock st, the sts on the spare needle.

Moving 2 or more sts rightwise or leftwise.

Rightwise: cast on the no. of sts indicated on spare needle in back of work, knit in the sts indicated, then purl sts of spare needle.

Leftwise: cast on the no. of sts indicated on a spare needle. in front of work, knit the succ. stitches, then knit the stitches on the spare needle.

PAG. 4 PLAITED RAGLAN PULLOVER



MATERIALS ADRIAFIL YARNS

MATERIALS REQUIRED

550 g. **Frizzy** yarn, colour no. 60 (A) and 50 g. **New Zealand** yarn, colour no. 44 (B). Knitting needles size 3½ and 4. Tapestry needle with rounded tip.

SIZE: 42

PATTERN STITCHES

Elastic rib
Rib stitch 2/2
Rib stitch and cable: work over 16 sts. (follow chart)

SAMPLE

10x10 cm. with knitting needles size 4 in rib st. 2/2 = 19 sts. and 28 rows.

WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

Back: Cast on 84 sts. with knitting needles size 3½ in B and work 6 rows. in elastic rib. Cont. with knitting needles size 4 in A and work in rib st. 2/2. When work measures 44 cm., equal to 124 rows. from beg. of rib st. 2/2, to shape raglans, bind off at each end every 2 rows. 5 sts. and 1 st. 27 times. At the same time when work measures 61 cm., equal to 172 rows. from beg. of rib st. 2/2 to shape the neckline, bind off the 14 centre sts. and Cont. working the 2 parts separately, bind off from inner end, every 2 rows., 2 sts. and 1 st.

Front: Work like back. When work measures 60 cm., equal to 168 rows. from beg. of rib st. 2/2, to shape the neckline, bind off the 12 centre sts. and Cont. working the two parts separately, bind off from inner end, every 2 rows., 2 sts. and 1 st. 2 times.



Sleeves: Cast on 44 sts. with knitting needles size 3½ in B and work 6 rows. in elastic rib. Cont. with knitting needles size 4 in A in rib st. 2/2, inc. at each end after the border 1 st. every 6 rows. 17 times. When work measures 48 cm., equal to 134 rows. from beg. of rib st. 2/2 to

shape raglans, bind off at each end, every 2 rows., 5 sts. and 1 st. 27 times. then bind off the remaining sts. in 1 time.

CABLES TO SHAPE RAGLANS: Work 4. With knitting needles size 3½ in B Cast on 16 sts. and work in rib st. and cable following the chart. When work measures 23 cm. bind off all sts.

MAKING UP AND FINISHING

Sew the sides of each cable to raglans leaving one end open on back. With knitting needles size 3½ in B knit up 138 sts. along the neckline and work 6 rows. in elastic rib. Graft the sts. with tapestry needle. Sew the end left open. Sew the sides and the sleeve seams.



PAG. 5 ROUND NECK PULLOVER



MATERIALS ADRIAFIL YARNS

MATERIALS REQUIRED

900 g. **Globe Uni** yarn, of which 400 g. dark green no. 24 (A), 200 g. brown no. 16 (B and /), 100 g. wine red no. 18 (x), 100 g. orange no. 36 (v), 50 g. black no. 01 (-) and 50 g. white no. 02 (O). Knitting needles sizes 4 and 5. Tapestry needle with rounded tip.

SIZE: 48

PATTERN STITCHES

Elastic rib
Rib stitch 1/1
Jacquard stitch (follow chart)

SAMPLE


10 x 10 cm. with knitting needles size 5 in jacquard st. = 17 sts. and 18 rows.

WORKING INSTRUCTIONS


Back: Cast on 95 sts. with knitting needles size 4 in A and work 4 rows in elastic rib. and 8 rows. in rib st. 1/1 (approx. 5 cm.). Cont. with knitting needles size 5 in jacquard st. following the chart. When work measures 60 cm., equal to 108 rows. from beg. of the jacquard st. bind off all sts. in 1 time.

Front: Work like back. When work measures 51 cm., equal to 92 rows.

from beg. of the jacquard st. to shape the neckline, bind off the 15 centre sts. and Cont. working the two parts separately, bind off from inner

end, every 2 rows, 4 sts., 3 sts., 2 sts. and 1 st. 2 times. When work measures 60 cm., equal to 108 rows. from beg. of the jacquard st. bind off the remaining sts. for the shoulders in 1 time.

Sleeves: Cast on 40 sts. with knitting needles size 4 in A and work 4 rows. in elastic rib. and 8 rows. in rib st. 1/1 (approx. 5 cm.). Cont. with knitting needles size 5 in jacquard st. inc. at each end after border 1 st. every 4 rows. 21 times. Work inc. sts. When work measures 48 cm.,

equal to 86 rows. from beg. of the jacquard st. bind off all sts. in 1 time.

MAKING UP AND FINISHING

Sew one of the shoulders. With knitting needles size 4 in A knit up 70 sts. along the neckline and work 8 rows. in rib st. 1/1 and 4 rows. in elastic rib. Graft the sts. with tapestry needle. Sew the other shoulder and the edge of the collar. Sew in sleeves. Sew the sides and the sleeve seams.

PAG. 6 FLARED JACKET



MATERIALS ADRIAFIL YARNS

MATERIALS REQUIRED

700 g. **Velluto** yarn, colour no. 54. Knitting needles size 6. Tapestry needle with rounded tip.

SIZE: 44

PATTERN STITCHES

Stock st.

SAMPLE

10 x 10 cm. with knitting needles size 6 in stock st. = 10 sts. and 15 rows.

WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

Back: Cast on 70 sts. with size no. 6 and work in stock st. dec. in the first 18 and 53 sts., 1 st. every 6 rows. 23 times. When work measures 48 cm., equal to 72 rows. inc. at each end 1 st. every 8 rows. 3 times. When work measures 66 cm., equal to 100 rows. to shape armholes, bind off at each end, every 2 rows., 2 sts. and 1 st. 2 times. When work measures 88 cm., equal to 132 rows. bind off the 12 side sts. for the shoulders and Cont. working another 6 rows. in stock st. on the remaining stitches bind off the stitches in 1 time.

Right Front: Cast on 41 st. with knitting needles size 6 and work in stock st., dec. in stitch 23, 1 st. every 6 rows. 23 times. When work measures 48 cm., equal to 72 rows. inc. leftwise 1 st. every 8 rows. 3 times. When work measures 66 cm., equal to 100 rows. to shape the armhole, bind off leftwise, every 2 rows., 2 sts. and 1 st. 2 times. When work


measures 88 cm., equal to 132 rows. bind off the last 12 sts. for the shoulder then Cont. working another 6 rows on the remaining stitches then bind off the stitches in 1 time. In the first 3 sts. work in 9 evenly spaced two-stitch loops, bind off 2 sts. and knit them up in the return row.)

Left Front: Work to match, without loops.

Sleeves: Cast on 50 sts. with knitting needles size 6 and work in stock st. dec. at each end 1 st. every 3 rows. 10 times. When work measures 23 cm., equal to 34 rows. Cont. inc. at each end 1 st. every 10 rows. 3 times. When work measures 46 cm., equal to 68 rows. for the sleeve hole, bind off at each end, every 2 rows., 2 sts. 2 times., 1 st. 23 times. then bind off the remaining sts. in 1 time.

MAKING UP AND FINISHING

Sew the shoulders and the collar. Sew in the sleeves. Sew the sides and the sleeve seams. Sew the buttons.



PAG. 7 V-NECK PULLOVER



MATERIALS ADRIAFIL YARNS

MATERIALS REQUIRED

600 g. **Crystal** yarn, colour no. 83 (A) and 50 g. **Merino** yarn, colour no. 41 sage green (B). Knitting needles size 4 and 5. Tapestry needle with rounded tip.

SIZE: 44

PATTERN STITCHES

Elastic rib
Purled stitch

SAMPLE

10 x 10 cm. with knitting needles size 5 in purled st. = 15 sts. and 23 rows.

WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

Back: Cast on 120 sts. with knitting needles size 4 in B and work 6 rows in elastic rib. Cont. with knitting needles size 5 in A in purled st. dec. in row 1 after the border 28 spaced sts. You will have 92 sts. Cont. dec. at each end 1 st. every 30 rows. 5 times. then Cont. knitwise without dec. When work measures 104 cm., equal to 240 rows. after the border, bind off at each end for the shoulders, every 2 rows., 8 sts. 3 times. and 6 sts. 1 time. then bind off the remaining sts. in 1 time.


Front: Work like back. When work measures 87 cm., equal to 200 rows. after the border, to shape the neckline, work the two front halves separately, dec. from internal end 1 st. every 4 rows 11 times. At the same time when work measures 104 cm., equal to 240 rows. after the border, bind off at each end for the shoulders, every 2 rows., 8 sts. 3 times and 6 sts. 1 time.

Sleeves: Cast on 40 sts. with knitting needles size 4 in B and work 6 rows. in elastic rib. Cont. with knitting needles size 5 in A in purled st. dec. in row 1 after the border 8 spaced sts. You will have 32 sts. Cont.

inc. at each end 1 st. every 7 rows. 15 times. When work measures 49 cm., equal to 112 rows. after the border bind off all sts. in 1 time.

MAKING UP AND FINISHING

Sew one of the shoulders. With knitting needles size 4 in B knit up 130 sts. along the neckline back and front and work 6 rows. in elastic rib. Graft the sts. with tapestry needle. Sew the other shoulder and the edge of the neckline. Sew in the sleeves. Sew the sides and the sleeve seams.

MATERIALS REQUIRED

800 g. **New Zealand** yarn, colour no. 54. Knitting needles sizes 4 and 4½. 4 buttons. Tapestry needle with rounded tip.

SIZE: 42

PATTERN STITCHES

Elastic rib
Rib stitch 1/1
Cable st., ribs, and fancy diamond pattern: work over 14 sts. (follow chart)

SAMPLE

10 x 10 cm. with knitting needles size 4½ in cable st., and fancy diamond pattern = 24 sts. and 28 rows.

WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

Back: Cast on 122 sts. with knitting needles size 4 and work 6 rows. in elastic rib. Cont. in cable st. and ribs following the chart from the 1st. to the 10th rows. (= border of approx. 4 cm.). Cont. with knitting needles size 4½ in cable st. and fancy diamond pattern following the chart and repeating from the 11th. to the 58th rows. When work measures 46 cm., equal to 128 rows. after the border, to shape armholes, bind off at each end 7 sts. When work measures 67 cm., equal to 188 rows. after the border, to shape the neckline, bind off the 20 centre sts. and Cont. working the two parts separately, bind off from inner end, every 2 rows., 4 sts., 3 sts., 2 sts. and 1 st. When work measures 70 cm, equal to 196 rows. after the border bind off the remaining sts. for the shoulders in 1 time.



Right Front: Cast on 62 sts. with knitting needles size 4 and work 6 rows. in elastic rib. Cont. in cable st. and ribs following the chart from 1st. to the 10th rows. (= border of approx. 4 cm.). Cont. with knitting needles size 4½ following the chart and repeating from the 11th. to 58th rows. When work measures 46 cm., equal to 128 rows. after the border, to shape the armhole, bind off leftwise 7 sts. At the same time to shape the neckline, dec. rightwise, alternating *1 time 1 st. every 2 rows., and 1 time 1 st. every 4 rows. * for a total of 21 times. When work measures 70 cm, equal to 196 rows. after the border bind off the remaining sts. for the shoulder in 1 time.

Left Front: Work to match.

Sleeves: Cast on 60 sts. with knitting needles size 4 and work 6 rows in elastic rib. Cont. in cable st. and ribs following the chart from 1st. to 10th rows. (= border of approx. 4 cm.). Cont. with knitting needles size 4½ following the chart and repeating from the 11th. to 58th rows., inc. at each end after border, 1 st. every 4 rows. 28 times. Work inc. sts. When work measures 47 cm., equal to 132 rows. after the border, bind off all sts. in 1 time.

MAKING UP AND FINISHING

Sew the shoulders. Sew in the sleeves. Sew the sides and the sleeve seams. With knitting needles size 4 knit up 62 sts. along the right front opening end to half way of the back collar and work 6 rows. in rib st. 1/1 and 4 rows. in elastic rib. Graft the sts. with tapestry needle. In the 4th row make 4 four-stitch loops, bind off 4 sts. and knit them up in the return rows), evenly spaced. Work a matching border, without loops, along the left front opening end. Sew the buttons.

HIGH NECK MINIPULLOVER



MATERIALS
ADRIAFIL YARNS

MATERIALS REQUIRED

500 g. **Folie** yarn, colour no. 82. Knitting needles sizes 4½ and 5. Tapestry needle with rounded tip.

SIZE: 42

PATTERN STITCHES

Elastic rib
Rib stitch 2/2
Fancy cable stitch: work over 8 sts. (follow chart)

SAMPLE

10 x 10 cm. with knitting needles size 5 fancy cable stitch = 19 sts. and 22 rows.

WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

Back: Cast on 82 sts. with knitting needles size 4½ and work 4 rows. in elastic rib. Cont. with knitting needles size 5 in fancy cable stitch following the chart, inc. at each end 1 st. every 10 rows. 6 times. When work measures 31 cm., equal to 68 rows. from beg. of the fancy cable stitch, to shape armholes, bind off at each end., 4 sts., 3 sts., 2 sts. and 1 st. When work measures 49 cm., equal to 108 rows. from beg. of the fancy cable stitch bind off the remaining sts. in 1 time.




Front: Work like back. When work measures 39 cm., equal to 86 rows. from beg. of the fancy cable stitch, to shape the neckline, bind off the 14 centre sts. and Cont. working the two parts separately, bind off from inner end, every 2 rows., 3 sts., 2 sts. 2 times., and 1 st. 3 times. When work measures 49 cm., equal to 108 rows. from beg. of the fancy cable stitch bind off the remaining sts. for the shoulders in 1 time.

Sleeves: Cast on 42 sts. with knitting needles size 4½ and work 4 rows. in elastic rib. Cont. with knitting needles size 5 in rib st. 2/2, inc. at each end after the border, 1 st. every 12 rows. 8 times. When work measures 47 cm., equal to 104 rows. from beg. of rib st. 2/2 for the sleeve hole, bind off at each end, every 2 rows., 4 sts., 3 sts. and 1 st. 16 times. then bind off the remaining sts. in 1 time.

MAKING UP AND FINISHING

Sew one of the shoulders. With knitting needles size 4½ knit up 86 sts. along the neckline and work in rib st. 2/2. When work measures 22 cm. work 4 rows. in elastic rib then graft the sts. with tapestry needle. Sew the other shoulder and the neck. Sew in sleeves. Sew the sides and the sleeve seams.

PAG. 10 **LONG JACKET**



MATERIALS
ADRIAFIL YARNS

MATERIALS REQUIRED

900 g **Kermesse** yarn colour no. 43 (A) and 50 g. **Merino** yarn, colour no. 40 (B). Knitting needles sizes 4½ and 5½. 6 buttons. Tapestry needle with rounded tip.

SIZE: 44

PATTERN STITCHES

Elastic rib
Purled stitch

SAMPLE

10 x 10 cm. with knitting needles size 5½ in purled stitch = 11 st. and 18 rows.


WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

Back: Cast on 82 sts. with knitting needles size 4½ in A and work 4 rows in elastic rib. Cont. with knitting needles size 5½ in purled st. dec. in row 1 20 spaced sts. You will have 62 sts. Cont. dec. at each end 1 st. every 12 rows. 9 times. then work knitwise without decreasing. When work measures 81 cm., equal to 146 rows. after the border, inc. at each end 1 st. every 4 rows. 6 times. When work measures 96 cm., equal to 172 rows. after the border, to shape armholes, bind off leftwise, every 2 rows., 3 sts., 2 sts. and 1 st. When work measures 117 cm., equal to 210 rows. after the border bind off the remaining sts. in 1 time.

Right Front: Cast on 45 sts. with knitting needles size 4½ in A and work 4 rows. in elastic rib. Cont. with knitting needles size 5½ in purled st. dec. in row 1 10 spaced sts. You will have 35 sts. Cont. dec. leftwise 1 st. every 12 rows. 9 times. the work knitwise without decreasing. When

work measures 81 cm, equal to 146 rows. after the border inc. leftwise 1 st. every 4 rows. 6 times. When work measures 93 cm., equal to 166 rows. after the border, for the part of the collar to turn up, inc. rightwise 1 st. every 4 rows 6 times. When work measures 96 cm., equal to 172 rows. after the border, to shape the armhole, bind off leftwise, every 2 rows., 3 sts. 2 sts. and 1 st. When work measures 117 cm., equal to 210 rows. after the border, bind off the last 12 sts. for the shoulder and Cont. on the remaining 18 sts. of the collar, dec. rightwise, every 2 rows. *1 time. 2 sts. and 1 time. 1 st. * for a total of 12 times. *

Left Front: Work to match.



Sleeves: Cast on 36 sts. with knitting needles size 4½ in A and work 4 rows. in elastic rib. Cont. with knitting needles size 5½ in purled st. dec. in row 1 8 spaced sts. You will have 28 sts. Cont. inc. at each end 1 st. every 10 rows. 7 times. When work measures 40 cm., equal to 72 rows. after the border, for the sleeve hole, bind off at each end, every 2 rows. 3 sts., 2 sts., 1 st. 8 times. and every 4 rows. 1 st. 3 times. then bind off the remaining sts. in 1 time.

Border: 2 follow the chart. With knitting needles size 4½ in B cast on 20 sts. and work in Stock st. for 130 cm. then bind off the stitches in 1 time.

MAKING UP AND FINISHING

Sew the shoulders. Sew in the sleeves. Sew the sides and the sleeve seams. With knitting needles size 4½ in A knit up purled stitches, 30 sts. along the back neckline and work in purled st. for 24 rows. then bind off the stitches in 1 time. Sew the ends of the back collar to the ends of the collar of the front. When the work measures 34 cm., equal to 74 rows. from beg. of the work in stock st. to shape the neckline, bind off the 8 centre sts. and Cont. working the two parts separately , bind off from inner end, every 2 rows., 3 sts., 2 sts. and 1 st. 3 times. When work measures 38 cm., equal to 84 rows. from beg. work in knitted stitch bind off the remaining sts. for the shoulders in 1 time.

Sleeves: Cast on 48 sts. with knitting needles size 4 and work 4 rows. in elastic rib. and 14 rows. in cable st. and ribs following the chart 1 (=border of approx. 5 cm.). Cont. with knitting needles size 4½ in cable st. and ribs following chart 2, inc. in row 1 after the border, at the ends of each cable 1 st. You will have 56 sts. Cont. inc. at each end 1 st. every 12 rows. 5 times. When work measures 30 cm., equal to 66 rows. from beg. of the cable stitch and ribs bind off all sts. in 1 time.

MAKING UP AND FINISHING

Embroider the front in knitted stitch following the chart. Sew one of the shoulders. With knitting needles size 4 knit up 73 sts. along the neckline and work 7 rows. in cable st. and ribs following chart 1 and 4 rows. in elastic rib. Graft the sts. with tapestry needle. Sew the other shoulder and the edge of the neckline. Sew in the sleeves. Sew the sides and the sleeve seams.



When work measures 48 cm., equal to 76 rows. from beg. of the diamond st. bind off all sts. in 1 time.

Front: Work like back. When work measures 40 cm., equal to 64 rows. from beg. of the diamond st. to shape the neckline, bind off the 10 centre sts. and Cont. working the two parts separately, bind off from inner end, every 2 rows., 2 sts. 2 times. and 1 st. 3 times. When work measures 48 cm., equal to 76 rows. from beg. of the diamond st. bind off the remaining sts. for the shoulders in 1 time.

Sleeves: Cast on 27 sts. with knitting needles size 5½ and work 2 rows. in elastic rib. and 5 rows. in rib st. 1/1 (approx. 3 cm.). Cont. with knitting needles size 6 in diamond st. inc. at each end after border, 1 st. every 12 rows. 6 times. When work measures 51 cm., equal to 82 rows. from beg. of the diamond st. bind off all sts. in 1 time.

MAKING UP AND FINISHING

Sew one of the shoulders. With knitting needles size 5½ knit up 75 sts. along the neckline and work 13 rows. in rib st. 1/1 and 4 rows. in elastic rib. Graft the sts. with tapestry needle. Sew the other shoulder and the neck. Sew in sleeves. Sew the sides and the sleeve seams.



PAG. 19 JACQUARD PULLOVER



MATERIALS ADRIAFIL YARNS

MATERIALS REQUIRED

700 g. **New Zealand** yarn, of which 300 g. light grey no. 83 (A and v), 200 g. grey no. 84 (C), 150 g. dark grey no. 86 (B) and 50 g. wine red no. 18 (x). Knitting needles sizes 4 and 4½. Tapestry needle with rounded tip.

SIZE: 48

PATTERN STITCHES

Elastic rib
Rib stitch 1/1
Cable stitch and fancy diamond pattern: work over 12 sts. (follow chart)
Jacquard stitch

SAMPLE

10 x 10 cm. with knitting needles size 4½ in cable st. and fancy diamond pattern and in jacquard st. = 23 sts. and 23 rows.

WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

Back: Cast on 138 sts. with knitting needles size 4 in A and work 4 rows. in elastic rib. and 12 rows. in rib st. 1/1 (approx. 7 cm.). Work 1 row knitted on purl then Cont. in cable st. and fancy diamond pattern and in jacquard st. following the chart. When work measures 42 cm., equal to 96 rows. after the border to shape armholes, bind off at each end 9 sts. When work measures 66 cm., equal to 152 rows. after the border bind off the remaining sts. in 1 time.



WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

Make a row of squares in alternating colours following the instructions for the bag. Close with a loop.

(Cap) Work in single crochet picking up all the stitches along the upper circumference. Work 2 rows in single crochet, and in Row 3 slip 1 st. every time you join the squares (8 dec.); repeat dec. 5 times every 3 rows and then cont. dec. each row until you finish the stitches.

Double crochet
Single crochet
Reverse single crochet

10 x 10 cm. with Crochet hook size 3 in Single crochet = 20 stitches for 30 rows

INSTRUCTIONS FOR SQUARES

Make a 4-stitch chain and close with a loop.

Row 1: Work 3 double crochets, 2 chains. Repeat 3 times (4 elem)

Row 2: Work in each 2-ch loop. *3 double crochets, 1 chain, 3 double crochets, 1 chain * Repeat from * to *

Row 3: Work in the loop along the side 3 double crochets, 1 chain (4 times) in the corners, 3 double crochets, 1 chain, 3 double crochets, 1 chain

Work a section of the same dimensions with the white wool.





Repeat from * to * and end with 4 chains, 1 double crochet, 4 chains in the 3rd last group of 3 single crochets, 1 double crochet, 1 chain, 1 double crochet on the last group of 3 single crochets.

Row 4 - 3 double crochets, 2 chains *3 double crochets in the arch of the 4 chains, 1 double crochet on the double crochet below; 3 double crochets in the next arch, 4 chains; 1 double crochet 1 bobble, 1 double crochet in the arch of the 3 chains; 3 ch sts., 1 double crochet, 1 bob-

ble. 1 double crochet in the next arch of 3 chains, 4 chains* Repeat from * to * and end with 4 double crochets in the second last arch of 4 chains, 1 double crochet on the double crochet below, 4 double crochets in the last arch of 4 chains, 2 chains, 3 double crochets.

Row 5 - 1 double crochet, 1 chain *3 double crochets in the 1st. arch, 7 double crochets on the 7 double crochets below, 3 double crochets in the next arch, 3 chains; 1 double crochet 1 bobble. 1 double crochet in the next arch, 3 chains* Repeat from * to * and end with 3 double crochets in the second last arch., 7 double crochets on the 7 double crochets below, 3 double crochets in the last arch, 1 chain, 1 double crochet.

Row 6 - 3 double crochets, *3 chains, 7 double crochets on the 13 double crochets below, 3 chains, 1 double crochet, 1 bobble, 1 double crochet in the next arch, 3 chains; 1 double crochet, 1 bobble. 1 double crochet in the next arch*. Repeat from * to * and end with 7 double crochets on the last 13 double crochets, 3 chains, 3 double crochets.

Row 7 - 1 double crochet, 1 chain, 1 double crochet, *4 chains, 1 double crochet at the centre of the 7 double crochets below, 4 chains, 1 double crochet, 1 bobble, 1 double crochet in the next arch; 3 chains, 1 double crochet, 1 bobble, 1 double crochet in the next arch; 3 chains, 1 double crochet, 1 bobble, 1 double crochet in the next arch* Repeat from * to * and end with 4 chains, 1 double crochet, 4 chains on the last 7 double crochets., 1 double crochet, 1 chain, 1 double crochet.

Row 8 - pick up from 4th row.

MAKING UP AND FINISHING

Work a trim around the 4 sides of the blanket as follows:

Row 1 - single crochet

Row 2 - starting from the corner: 2 double crochets in the same stitch of the chain, *5 ch st., slip 3 sts. of the chain* Repeat from * to * and end with 2 double crochets, 2 chains in the same stitch of the chain.

Row 3 - 5 chains, 1 single crochet at the centre of each arch. In the corner arch work in 4 double crochets.



Cast on 41 sts. with knitting needles size 2½ and work 4 rows in elastic rib and 24 rows in rib st. 1/1. Cont. with knitting needles size 3 and work 2 rows of band with eyelets (slip 2 knitted sts., 1 yo.) Now work the mask in eyelet stitch only on the 13 centre sts. for 30 rows. and leave the side stitches standing. Work in garter stitch for 8 rows. on the first 14 sts. and leave standing on the 15 sts. which you knit up along the right of the mask, on the 13 sts. of the mask, on the 15 sts. which you pick up on the left of the mask and on the last 14 standing sts. Diamond stitch: work over 6 sts. (follow chart 1)

Fancy cable stitch: work over 27 sts. (follow chart 2)

10 x 10 cm. with knitting needles size 4½ in diamond st. = 25 sts. and 32 rows.

WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

Back: Cast on 60 sts. with knitting needles size 3½ and work 4 rows. in elastic rib. and 7 rows. in rib st. 1/1 (approx. 3 cm.). Work 1 row in purled st. on the back of the work and inc. 10 spaced sts. You will have 70 sts. Cont. with knitting needles size 4½ in diamond st. following the chart 1. When work measures 26 cm., equal to 84 rows. from beg. of the diamond st. bind off the remaining sts. in 1 time.

Front: Cast on 60 sts. with knitting needles size 3½ and work 4 rows in elastic rib. and 7 rows. in rib st. 1/1 (approx. 3 cm.). Work 1 row in purled st. on the back of the work and inc. 12 spaced sts. You will have 72. m. Cont. with knitting needles size 4½ and work as follows: 27 sts. fancy cable stitch following chart 2, 18 sts. in diamond st. following chart 1 and 27 sts. in fancy cable stitch following chart 2. When work measures 15 cm., equal to 48 rows from beg. of the fancy cable stitch, to shape armholes, bind off at each end, every 2 rows, 2 sts. 3 times. When work measures 22 cm., equal to 70 rows from beg. of the fancy cable stitch, to shape the neckline, bind off the 8 centre sts. and cont. working the two parts separately, bind off from inner end, every 2 rows., 3 sts.,

2 sts. 3 times. and 1 st. 2 times. When work measures 26 cm., equal to 84 rows. from beg. of the fancy cable stitch bind off the stitches of the right shoulder leaving the stitches of the left shoulder standing.

Sleeves: Cast on 36 sts. with knitting needles size 3½ and work 4 rows






Elastic rib
Rib stitch 1/1
Stock st.
Purled stitch
Rib stitch 3/1 = 3 purled sts. k1.

SAMPLE

10 x 10 cm. with knitting needles size 3 in stock st. = 32 sts. and 4 rows.

WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

Right leg: Cast on 78 sts. with knitting needles size 2 1/2 and work 4 rows in elastic rib. Cont. in rib st. 1/1. When work measures 7 cm. cont. with knitting needles size 3 in stock st., inc. at each end after border 1 st. every 4 rows 23 times. When work measures 13 cm., equal to 56 rows. from beg. work in knitted stitch, cont. in knitted stitch. 

Right back top: Cast on 40 sts. with knitting needles size 3 and work in stock st. When work measures 7 cm., equal to 30 rows. to shape the armhole, bind off leftwise, every 2 rows, 3 sts. 2 times, 2 sts. and 1 st. When work measures 17 cm., equal to 74 rows. bind off the remaining sts. in 1 time.

Left back top: Work to match.

MAKING UP AND FINISHING

On the Front top with white wool pick up with several stitches the 2 adjacent ribs, alternating the every 5 rows, so as to form small diamonds. Embroider groups of flowers following the pattern. Sew the shoulders. With the blue wool make the two edgings as follows: Cast on 70 sts. and work 12 rows. in purled st. then bind off all sts. in 1 time. Trim the armhole with these edgings. Sew the sides. Sew the inside of the legs and join them at the front. On the back sew only the first 2 cm. after the crotch. With the blue wool cast on 150 sts. and work an edging as above. Fold this edging halfway and sew it together to the top and to the legs so that it extends on the right side of the work. With the blue wool make 2 edgings of 100 sts. as above. Trim the right and left back openings with these edgings. With the blue wool make an edging of 80 sts. and trim the neckline. Make 4 evenly spaced buttonholes on the left back opening inside the edge. Sew on the buttons.

MATERIALS ADRIAFIL YARNS

MATERIALS REQUIRED

100 g. **Avantgarde** yarn colour no. 09 pink. Knitting needles size 2½ and 3. 5 buttons. Tapestry needle with rounded tip.

AGE: 0-3 months

PATTERN STITCHES

Elastic rib
Rib stitch 1/1
Fancy stitch: work over 8 sts. (follow chart)
Knitted stitch

SAMPLE

10 x 10 cm. with knitting needles size 3 in fancy stitch = 30 sts. and 40 rows.

WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

Back: Cast on 80 sts. with knitting needles size 2½ and work 4 rows in elastic rib. and 11 rows in rib stitch 1/1 (approx. cm. 3). Cont. with knitting needles size 3 in fancy stitch following the chart. When work measures 12 cm., equal to 48 rows. from beg. of the fancy pattern, to shape armholes, bind off at each end, every 2 rows. 2 sts. 3 times. and 1 st. When work measures 24 cm., equal to 96 rows, bind off the remaining sts. in 1 time.

Right Front: Cast on 40 sts. with knitting needles size 2½ and work 4 rows in elastic rib. and 11 rows in rib st. 1/1 (approx. cm. 3). Cont. with knitting needles size 3 in fancy stitch. When work measures 12 cm., equal to 48 rows. from beg. of the fancy pattern, to shape the armhole, bind off leftwise every 2 rows 2 sts. 3 times and 1 st. At the same time to shape the neckline, bind off rightwise 1 st. every 2 rows 11 times. When work measures 24 cm., equal to

96 rows bind off the remaining sts. for the shoulder in 1 time.

Left Front: Work to match.



Sleeves: Cast on 44 sts. with rows. 2½ and work 4 rows. in elastic rib. and 11 rows in rib st. 1/1 (approx. cm. 3).

Cont. in fancy stitch inc. at each end, after the border 1 st. every 4 rows. x 14 times. When work measures 14 cm., equal to 56 rows for the sleeve hole, bind off at each end every 2 rows 2 sts. x 3 times then bind off the remaining sts. in 1 time.

MAKING UP AND FINISHING

Sew the shoulders. Sew in the sleeves. Sew the sides and the sleeve seams. With knitting needles size 2½ knit up n. 250 sts. along the right front opening end, the back neckline, and front opening and work 6 rows in rib st. 1/1 and 4 rows in elastic rib.

Graft the sts. with tapestry needle. In row 4 make 5 evenly spaced loops on the right front opening side. Sew on the buttons.

MATERIALS ADRIAFIL YARNS

MATERIALS REQUIRED

300 g. **New Zealand Stampato** yarn, colour no. 27. Knitting needles sizes 3½ and 4. 3 buttons and pink velvet collar. Tapestry needle with rounded tip.

AGE: 18 months

PATTERN STITCHES

Elastic rib
Stock st.
Cable stitch: work over 6 sts. (follow chart)

SAMPLE

10 x 10 cm. with knitting needles size 4 stock st. = 18 sts. and 27 rows.

WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

Back: Cast on 160 sts. with knitting needles size 3½ and work 14 rows. in elastic rib. (approx. 2 cm.). Cont. with knitting needles size 4 in stock st. Work in row 1 sts. two by two. You will have 80 sts. When work measures 29 cm., equal to 78 rows. from beg. work in stock st. Cont. in cable st. following the chart. When work measures 35 cm., equal to 94 rows. from beg. work in stock st. to shape armholes, bind off at each end, every 2 rows., 4 sts., 3 sts., 2 sts. and 1 st. 2 times. When work measures 46 cm., equal to 124 rows. from beg. work in stock st. bind off the remaining sts. in 1 time.

Right Front: Cast on 88 sts. with knitting needles size 3½ and work 14 rows. in elastic rib. (approx. 2 cm.). Cont. with knitting needles size 4 in stock st. Work in row 1 sts. two by two. You will have 44 sts. When work measures 29 cm., equal to 78 rows. from beg. work in stock st. Cont. in cable st. following the chart. When work measures 35 cm., equal to 94 rows. from beg. work in stock st. for the armhole, bind off leftwise, every 2 rows., 4 sts., 3 sts., 2 sts. and 1 st. 2 times. When work measures 41 cm., equal to 110 rows. from beg. work in stock st. to shape the neckline, bind off rightwise, every 2 rows., 8 sts., 4 sts., 2 sts. and 1 st. 3 times. When work measures 46 cm., equal to 124 rows. from beg. work in stock st. bind off the remaining sts. for the shoulder in 1 time.



Left Front: Work to match.

Sleeves: Cast on 56 sts. with knitting needles size 3½ and work 14

rows in elastic rib. (approx. 2 cm.). Cont. with knitting needles size 4 in stock st. Work in row 1 the stitches two by two. You will have 28 sts. Cont. inc. at each end 1 st. every 8 rows 5 times. When work measures 16 cm., equal to 44 rows. from beg. work in stock st. for the arm hole, bind off at each end, every 2 rows., 3 sts., 2 sts., 1 st. 8 times. and every 4 rows., 1 st. 3 times. then bind off the remaining sts. in 1 time.

MAKING UP AND FINISHING

Sew the shoulders. Sew in the sleeves. Sew the sides and the sleeve seams. With knitting needles size 3½ knit up 122 sts. along the right front opening end and work 6 rows. in elastic rib. Graft the sts. with tapestry needle. In row 1 make 3 evenly spaced loops in the body. Work a matching border along the left front open end, without loops. With knitting needles size 3½ knit up 132 sts. along the neckline and work 6 rows. in elastic rib. Graft the sts. with tapestry needle. Sew the buttons and fit the collar.



PAG. 26 BABY'S PANTS



MATERIALS ADRIAFIL YARNS

MATERIALS REQUIRED

100 g. **Avantgarde** yarn, colour no. 09 blue. Knitting needles size 2½ and 3.5 cm. 0 elastic band 1 cm high. Tapestry needle with rounded tip.

AGE: 6-9 months

PATTERN STITCHES

Elastic rib
Rib stitch in back loop 1/1
Stock st.

SAMPLE

10 x 10 cm. with knitting needles size 3 in stock st. = 29 sts. and 38 rows.


WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

Left leg: Cast on 66 sts. with knitting needles size 2½ and work 4 rows in elastic rib. and 36 rows in rib st. 1/1 (approx. 7 cm.). Cont. with knitting needles size 3 in stock st., inc. in row 1 after the border 10 evenly spaced sts., and at the ends 1 st. every 2 rows. 25 times. When work measures 13 cm., equal to 50 rows from beg. work in knitted stitch for the crotch, dec. at each end 1 st. every 2 rows 10 times then cont. in knitted stitch. When work measures 28 cm., equal to 106 rows from beg. work in knitted stitch to shape the waist band, work 12 rows in elastic rib. then graft the sts. with tapestry needle.

Left leg: Work to match right leg.

MAKING UP AND FINISHING

Sew the internal part of the legs and the front opening. Fit the elastic in the waist band then sew the back opening.



PAG. 26 BABY'S PULLOVER



MATERIALS ADRIAFIL YARNS

MATERIALS REQUIRED

100 g. **Avantgarde** yarn colour no. 09 blue. Knitting needles size 2½ and 3. 2 buttons. Tapestry needle with rounded tip.

AGE: 6-9 months

PATTERN STITCHES

Elastic rib
Rib stitch in back loop 1/1
Basket stitch: work over 6 sts. (follow chart)

SAMPLE

10 x 10 cm. with knitting needles size 3 in basket stitch = 30 sts. and 4 rows.

WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

Back: Cast on 84 sts. with knitting needles size 2½ and work 4 rows in elastic rib. and 16 rows in rib st. 1/1 (approx. 4 cm). Cont. with knitting needles size 3 in basket stitch following the chart. When work measures 24 cm. equal to 106 rows from beg. of the basket stitch bind off all sts. in 1 time.

Right Front: Cast on 53 sts. with knitting needles size 2½ and work 4 rows in elastic rib. and 16 rows in rib st. in back loop 1/1 (approx. 4 cm). In row 7 work a loop in the first 3 sts. Cont. with knitting needles size 3 in basket stitch, Work 3 rows then make a 2nd loop. Work another 3 rows then cont. dec. rightwise to shape the neckline 1 st. every 2 rows. 25 times. When work measures 24 cm., equal to 106 rows from beg. of the basket st. bind off the remaining sts. for the shoulder in 1 time.

Left Front: Work to match, without loops.

Sleeves: Cast on 50 sts. with knitting needles size 2½ and work 4 rows in elastic rib. and 22 rows in rib st. in back loop 1/1 (approx. 5 cm.). Cont. with knitting needles size 3 in basket stitch inc. in row 1 7 spaced sts. and at the ends 1 st. every 6 rows 23 times. When work measures 16 cm., equal to 72 rows bind off all sts. in 1 time.

MAKING UP AND FINISHING

Sew the shoulders. Sew in the sleeves. Sew the sides and the sleeve seams. With knitting needles size 2½ knit up 280 sts. along the right front opening end, back neckline and left front opening and work 8 rows in elastic rib. Graft the sts. with tapestry needle. Sew on the buttons.
