## INSTRUCTIONS

### *Ensuring the best results from the yarn*

In order to obtain the best results from the fantasy and multicoloured yarns, two balls of yarn should be used at the same time. If you work with one ball of yarn at a time, the combination of fibres and colours of these yarn may produce an irregular effect. By using two balls of yarn as suggested you will obtain the required effect ensuring the best results. Working with two balls of yarn is easy: use one ball to work one knitted row and one purled row (or forward and return needle and the other ball to work the next knitted row and purled row and so on.

## SOME GOOD ADVICE

**It is easy to take care of your knitwear if the yarn is ADRIAFIL.**

Don't worry a garment worked in Adriafile yarn can be washed over and over again with no problem at all. Selected raw materials and proper workmanship guarantee excellent behaviour during washing. Simply follow the recommendations given by the symbols on the tag. Follow the instructions carefully to enjoy the beauty and softness of your work much longer

### HANDWASHING

Wash in lukewarm water and a little specific detergent. Allow to soak for several minutes then dip the garment repeatedly holding by the shoulders. Rinse very thoroughly without wringing. Spread the garment out to dry. Do not hang.

### MACHINE WASHING

Check that the garment can be machine washed. No pre-washing. Set on wool or pure virgin wool cycle at 40°. Use a specific detergent. Dry flat. Do not use bleach or enzymatic/biological detergents for wool and mixed wool.

### IRONING

Recommended temperature is 150° using vapour of steam iron. Skimming over the garment with the vapour of the steam iron, you will also "regenerate" the fibres.

**Treat stains specifically, if in doubt decide for professional treatment.**




# TECHNICAL INSTRUCTIONS

## Knitted back loop



Work knitted stitch, passing the yarn of the stitch behind the needle.

## Increasing stitches




Increase 1 stitch at the centre, by picking up the yarn between two stitches with the left-hand needle and work it in

knitted back loop.


To increase 1 stitch after the last stitch, knit 1 stitch and without dropping it off the needle, purl it.

To increase 1 stitch at the beginning, pass the yarn over the needle and then knit or purl the stitch.

## Decrease of 1 stitch




Knit 2 stitches together. Rightwise slant.



Slip off 1 stitch, knit next stitch, passing slipped stitch over knitted stitch. Leftwise slant.


## Decrease of 2 stitches



Double pass. Slip a knitted stitch, knit 2 together, pass slipped stitch over stitch. The double pass stitch can also


be purled (purl the stitches together).

## Decrease of 3 or more stitches




Work 3 stitches together like 1 stitch. (Rightwise slant.) For leftwise slant, work the 3 or more stitches together picking them up from the back.

## Knitted Yarn over

After a knitted stitch, bring yarn from back to front under the right-hand needle then work the next stitch normally.

## Purled yarn over

Bring the yarn over the tip of the right-hand needle from back to front and then over, for a full turn.

## Elastic rib

With a different coloured yarn cast on half the stitches plus 2 for ends. With the yarn of the work, work as follows:

**Row 1** - \* k 1., yo.\* Repeat from \* to \*

**Row 2** - k1 end st. \*k1 into yo., slip purled st. \*. Repeat from \* to \* k 1 end st.

**Row 3** - k1 end st. \* k 1., slip purled st.

\*. Repeat from \* to \* k1 end stitch. Repeat Row 3 for rib height required.

## Jacquard stitch

Work in stock st following chart and legend; carry yarns across the back twisting the two yarns together at the colour change to avoid holes.

## Intarsia stitch

Work in stock st. following chart and legend; use a different ball of yarn for each colour area and twist the two yarns across the back at each colour change to avoid holes. Work the large areas of the chart in stock st intarsia method and the small areas of the chart in stock stitch jacquard method.

## Bobble

Work 5 stock stitches into 1 stitch, picking it up from the front and from the back, turn work., work 4 knitted rows with the above 5 sts, then with the left-hand needle pass the first stitches on the 5th starting from the closest.

## Banded stitches

Cast 2 or more sts on a spare needle, bring yarn to front and pass yarn 3 or 4 times around these 2 or more sts. Bring sts to left-hand needle and work normally.

## Cross 2 or more sts rightwise or leftwise

Rightwise: cast on the no. of stitches indicated on a spare needle across the back, work in stock st the same no. of stitches, then work in stock st the sts of the spare needle.

Leftwise: cast on the no. of sts. indicated on a spare n. across the front of the work, work in stock st the same no. of sts, the work in stock st, the sts on the spare needle.

Moving 2 or more sts rightwise or leftwise.

Rightwise: cast on the no. of sts indicated on spare needle in back of work, knit in the sts indicated, then purl sts of spare needle.

Leftwise: cast on the no. of sts indicated on a spare needle. in front of work, knit the succ. stitches, then knit the stitches on the spare needle.

## PAG. 4 MINIDRESS



### MATERIALS ADRIAFIL YARNS

#### MATERIAL REQUIRED

600 g. **Blue Caribe**, colour n.59. Size 3 and 3 1/2 knitting needles. Size 2,5 crochet hook. Wool needle with rounded tip.

**SIZE:** 42

#### PATTERN STITCHES

Elastic rib  
2/2 rib stitch  
Chain stitch  
Double crochet  
Single crochet

#### SAMPLE

10 x 10 cm. with size 3 1/2 knitting needles, 2/2 rib stitch = 32 sts e 32 rows.

#### WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

**Back and front:** cast on 150 sts with size 3 knitting needles and work 4 row in elastic rib. Change to size no. 3 1/2 and work in 2/2 rib stitch. When work measures 63 total ht. for the neck, cross the 28 centre sts, and end the two parts separately, dec. from neck side, every 2 rows, 11 sts, 7 sts, 3 sts, 2 sts 3 times. 1 st 2 times. At the same time when work measures 65 cm. for the sleeve holes, cross on sides, every 2 rows 16 sts., 6 sts., 4 sts., 3 sts., 2 sts. e 1 st.

**Neck edge:** Make two, one for the back neck and one for the front neck. Using the crochet hook cast on a chain of 80 sts. then work as follows:

**Row 1.** - single crochet

**Row 2.** - \*5 chs., slip 4 chs, 1 single crochet\*.

Repeat from \* to \*

**Row 3.** - 5 single crochets in each look and 1 crochet on the single crochet of the previous row.

**Row 4.** - To turn, make 6 chs and place the crochet hook at the centre of the 1st loop, 4 chs. and Cont. with 1 single crochet and 4 chs.

**Row 5.** - 4 single crochets in each loop and 1 crochet in the single crochet of the previous row. End with 4 single crochets.

**Row 6.** - \*4 chs., 1 crochet\* Repeat from \* to \*

**Row 7.** - like row 5

**Row 8.** - like row 4


**Row 9.** - like row 5

**Sleeve hole edges.** Make two.

Cast on a chain of 160 sts. and work as for the neck edge.

#### MAKING UP AND FINISH

Sew sides. Sew with invisible stitches an edge on the neck of the front and on the neck of the back. Sew with invisible stitches an edge around each sleeve hole of the front, leaving the middle section free to use for the shoulder strap; then sew the last section to the sleeve hole of the back.



## PAG. 5 MINI CARDIGAN



### MATERIALS ADRIAFIL YARNS

#### MATERIAL REQUIRED

350 g. **India** yarn, colour no.50. Size 3 and 4 knitting needles. 6 buttons. Wool needle with rounded tip.

*Important:* This garment may also be realised with **Panama** yarn.

**SIZE:** 42

#### PATTERN STITCHES

Elastic rib  
Rib stitch 1/1  
Fancy pattern: work over 20 sts. (see chart)

#### SAMPLE

10 x 10 cm. with size 4 knitting needles in fancy pattern = 24 sts and 28 rows

#### WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

**Back:** Cast on 122 sts with size 3 knitting needles and work 4 rows in elastic rib. Cont. in rib stitch 1/1. When work measures

2 cm tot. ht. change to size no.4 knitting needles in fancy pattern following chart and increasing on sides 1 st. every 8 rows 9 times. When work measure 32 cm tot. ht., for the sleeve holes, cross on sides, every 2 rows, 4 sts, 3 sts, 2 sts e 1 st. When work measures 50 cm tot. ht. cross all the sts.

**Right front:** Cast on 62 sts. with size 3 knitting needles and work 4 row in elastic rib. Cont. in rib stitch 1/1. When work measures 2 cm tot. ht. change to size 4 knitting needles in fancy pattern, increase leftwise 1 st. every 8 rows 9 times. When work measures 32 cm tot. ht., for the sleeve hole, cross leftwise, every 2 rows, 4 sts, 3 sts, 2 sts. and 1 st. When work measures 38 tot. ht. for the neck, cross rightwise, every 2 rows, 8 sts., 4 sts., 3 sts, 2 sts 3 times. and 1 st. 2 times. When work measures 50 cm tot. ht. cross the 38 sts. remaining for the shoulder.

**Left front:** Work symmetrically.


**Sleeves:** Cast on 82 sts with size.3 needles and work 4 rows in elastic rib. Cont. in rib stitch 1/1. When work measures 2 cm tot. ht. change to size 4 knitting needles in fancy pattern. Work 2 rows the for sleeve hole, cross on sides, every 2 rows, 1 st. 6 times., 2 sts., 3 sts. 2 times. and 4 sts 3 times., then cross the remaining sts.

#### MAKING UP AND FINISH

Sew the shoulders. Fit the sleeves. Sew the sides and the


undersleeve. With size 3 knitting needles pick up 120 sts. along the front right-hand opening and work 6 rows in rib stitch 1/1, making in the 3rd row 5 buttonholes of 3 sts (cross 3 sts. and bring them on the return row), at regular distance. Work 4 rows in elastic rib then close the sts with the needle in knit stitch. Work

the left-hand edge in the same way. With size 3 knitting needles pick up 140 sts around the neck and work 6 rows in rib stitch 1/1, making in the 3rd row a buttonhole, in the first 4 sts. Work 4 rows in elastic rib then close the sts. with the needle in knit stitch. Sew the buttons.

## PAG. 6 PULLOVER



### MATERIALS ADRIAFIL YARNS

#### MATERIAL REQUIRED

700 g Lime yarn, colour no. 82. Size 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> and 4 knitting needles. Wool needle with rounded tip.  
*Important:* Lime yarn must be used double.

**SIZE:** 42

#### PATTERN STITCHES

Elastic rib  
Rib stitch 1/1  
Purled stitch  
Open-work stitch: Row 1, Row 3 and Row 5. \*1 back look, 1 yo, 1 double passed, 1 yo\* Repeat from \* to \*. Row 2 and even rows, purled.

#### SAMPLE

10 x 10 cm size 4 knitting needles in open-work stitch = 22 sts and 28 rows.

#### WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

**Back:** Cast on 117 sts size 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> knitting needles and work 6 rows in elastic rib. Change to size 4 knitting needles and work alternating 6 purled rows to 6 open-work stitch rows. When work measures 35 cm tot. ht. for the raglans, cross on sides 1 st. every 2 rows 23 times. At the same time, when work measures 46 cm


tot. ht. for the neck, cross the 29 centre sts and end the two parts separately, dec. from neck side, every 2 rows, 5 sts. 2 times., 3 sts. 3 times. and 2 sts 1 time. When work measures 50 cm tot. ht. cross the 29 remaining sts for the shoulders.

**Front:** Work as for back.

**Sleeves:** Cast on 76 sts with size 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> knitting needles and work 6 rows in elastic rib. Change to size 4 knitting needles and work alternating 6 purled rows to 6 open-work stitch rows. Work 4 rows then for the raglans cross on sides 1 st. every 2 rows 23 times.; to end cross the remaining sts.

#### MAKING UP AND FINISH

Sew 3 raglans. With size 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> knitting needles pick up 150 sts. around the neck and work 5 rows in rib stitch 1/1 and 4 rows in elastic rib. Close the sts with needle in knit stitch. Sew the 4th raglan. Sew the sides and the undersleeves.



## PAG. 6 HAT



### MATERIALS ADRIAFIL YARNS

#### MATERIAL REQUIRED

100 g Cheope yarn, colour no. 48 olive green. Size 3,5 crochet hook.

#### PATTERN STITCHES

Chain stitch  
Single crochet  
Double crochet  
Knotted Double crochet  
Treble crochet  
Double treble crochet  
Reverse stitch

## WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

Cast on chain 6 sts and close with a loop. Cont. work as follows:

**Row 1** - 15 treble c. and close with 1 sc

**Row 2** - on treble c. increase. 1 st every 3 sts below (tot. 20 treble c.) and close with 1 sc.

**Row 3** - \*1 treble c on every st below, 2 chns.\* Repeat from \* to \* 20 times. End with 1 sc.

**Row 4** - \* 2 double treble c. in the space of 2 chns. between one treble crochet below and another, 2 chns.\* Repeat from \* to \* tot. 40 treble c. End with 1 sc

**Row 5** - \*3 double treble crochets in the space of 2 chns. below, 2 chns.\* Repeat from \* to \*. End with 1 single crochet.

**Rows 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11** - \*3 double treble crochets in the space of 2 chns.

below, 3 chns.\* Repeat from \* to \*. End with 1 single crochet.

**Row 12** - \*5 double treble crochets in the space of 3 chns. below\* Repeat from \* to \* for the whole row

**Row 13** - 1 double crochet on every st below increase, 1 st every 5 sts. (tot. 20 inc.)

**Row 14** - work in knotted double crochet (Work 1 double crochet not closed on the first st, 1 double crochet not closed on the 2nd st, end together. Cont. working the 2nd with the 3rd, the 3rd with the 4th and so on. The double crochet not closed starts always where the previous st. is fixed).

**Row 15** - work in knotted double crochet, increase 1 st. every 6 sts.

**Row 16 - 25** - work in knotted double crochet, without increasing.

**Row 26** - reverse stitch.

## PAG. 7 TOP



### MATERIALS ADRIAFIL YARNS

#### MATERIAL REQUIRED

150 g. **Gem** yarn, colour no.73. Size 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> and 4 knitting needles. Wool needle with rounded tip.

**SIZE:** 42

#### PATTERN STITCHES

Elastic rib

Plait and rib stitch: work on 7 sts.

(follow chart)

#### SAMPLE

10 x 10 cm with size 4 knitting needles in plait and rib stitch = 25 sts. and 36 rows.

## WORKING INSTRUCTIONS


**Back:** Cast on 105 sts with size 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> knitting needles and work 6 rows in elastic rib. Change to size 4 knitting needles and work in plait and rib stitch following the chart. When work measures 18 cm tot. ht. for the neck, cross rightwise 7 sts. 8 times., 4 sts. 3 times., 2 sts. 4 times. and 1 st. 5 times. At the same time, when work measures 22 cm tot. ht. for the raglan, cross leftwise, every 2 rows., 2 sts. 12 times.

**Front:** Work symmetrically.

**Neck edge:** Cast on 13 sts. with size 4 knitting needles and work p1, 11 plait and rib stitches and 1p. When work measures 84 cm tot. ht., cross all the stitches.

## MAKING UP AND FINISH

Sew the sides. With size 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> knitting needles pick up 70 sts. around the sleeve hole front and back and work 6 rows in elastic rib. End the stitches with needle in knit stitch. With size 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> knitting needles pick up 180 sts. along each side of the edge and work 6 rows in elastic rib. End the sts with needle in knit stitch. Join the two ends of the edge and sew it around the neckline with invisible stitches, below the ribbed edge.



## PAG. 7 MINI CARDIGAN



### MATERIALS ADRIAFIL YARNS

#### MATERIAL REQUIRED

350 g. **Gem** yarn, colour no. 73. Size 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> and 4 knitting needles. 3 buttons. Wool needle with rounded tip.

**SIZE:** 42

#### PATTERN STITCHES

Elastic rib

Plait and rib stitch: work on 7 sts. (follow chart of the tank top).

#### SAMPLE

10 x 10 cm with size 4 knitting needles work in plait and rib stitch = 25 sts. and 36 rows.

## WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

**Back:** Cast on 97 m. with size 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> knitting needles and work 6 rows in elastic rib. Change to size 4 knitting needles and work in plait and rib stitch following the chart. When work measures 26 cm tot. ht. for the sleeve holes, cross on sides, every 2 rows, 3 sts, 2 sts. and 1 st. 2 times. When work measures 44 cm tot. ht. cross all the stitches.

**Right-hand Front:** Cast on 57 sts. with size 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> knitting needles and work 6 rows in elastic rib. Change to size 4 knitting needles and work in plait and rib stitch. While you work, in the first 2 sts, make 3 buttonholes of 3 sts., (cross 3 sts. and bring them on the return needles), evenly spaced. When work measures 26 cm tot. ht. for the sleeve hole, cross leftwise, every 2 rows., 3 sts., 2 sts. and 1 st. 2 times. At the same time, for the neck, cross rightwise, in the first 5 sts. (1 p., 4 plait stitches), 1 st. every 2 rows. 23 times. When work measures 44 cm. tot. ht. cross the remaining 27 sts. for the shoulder.


**Left-hand Front:** Work symmetrically, without buttonholes.

**Sleeves:** Cast on 45 sts with size 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> knitting needles and work 6 rows in elastic rib. Change to size 4 knitting needles and work in plait and rib stitch, increase on the sides 1 st every 6 rows 21

times. When work measures 48 cm tot. ht. for the sleeve hole, cross on sides, every 2 rows., 3 sts., 2 sts. 3 times., 1 st. 18 times., 3 sts. 3 times. and 2 sts. then cross the remaining stitches.

**MAKING UP AND FINISH**

Sew the shoulders. Fit the sleeves. Sew the sides and the undersleeves. With size 3 1/2 knitting needles pick up 160 sts. along the right-hand front opening, to half-way along the back neck and work 6 rows in rib stitch 1/1 and 4 rows in elastic rib. End the stitch with needle in knit stitch. Work the left-hand edge in the same way. Sew buttons.



**PAG. 8 MINI CARDIGAN**



**MATERIALS ADRIAFIL YARNS**

**MATERIAL REQUIRED**

Total of 400 g. **Panama** yarn, of which 200 g. green no. 57 (A), 100 g. yellow no. 55 (x), 50 g. blue no. 56 (v) and 50 g. orange no. 53 (.). Knitting needles size 3 1/2 and 4. 4 buttons. Wool needle with rounded tip. Important: This garment may also be made in India yarn.

**SIZE:** 42

**PATTERN STITCHES**

Elastic rib  
Knitted stitch  
Jacquard stitch

**SAMPLE**

10 x 10 cm with size 4 knitting needles in jacquard stitch = 28 sts. and 28 rows.

**WORKING INSTRUCTIONS**

**Back:** Cast on 94 m. with size 3 1/2 knitting needles in A and work 4 rows in elastic rib. Change to size 4 knitting and work in jacquard stitch following the charge, increasing on the sides 1 st. every 6 rows 12 times. When work measures 26 cm tot. ht. for the sleeve holes, cross on sides, every 2 rows., 4 sts., 3 sts., 2 sts. e 1 st 2 times. When work measures 43 cm tot. ht. cross all the stitches.

**Right-hand front:** Cast on 48 sts. with size 3 1/2 knitting needles in A and work 4 rows in elastic rib. Cont. with size 4 knitting needles in jacquard stitch increasing leftwise 1 st. every 6 rows 12 times. While you work in the first 3 sts. make, 4 button holes of 3 sts. (cross. 3 sts and pick them up on the return needle), ensuring they are evenly spaced. When work measures 26 cm tot. ht. for the sleeve hole, cross leftwise, every 2 rows., 4 sts, 3 sts., 2 sts and 1 st. 2 times. At the same time, for the neck, cross rightwise 1 st. every 2 rows 26 times. When work measures 45 cm. tot. ht. cross the 10 remaining sts for the shoulder.



**Left-hand front:** Work symmetrically without buttonholes.

**Sleeves:** Cast on 86 sts. with size 3 1/2 knitting needles in A

and work 4 rows in elastic rib. Cont. with size 4 knitting needles in jacquard stitch. When work measures 4 cm tot. ht. for the sleeve hole, cross on sides, every 2 rows, 4 sts, 3 m., 2 sts. 2 times., 1 st. 16 times., 3 sts. 2 times. and 2 sts. 2 times., then cross the remaining stitches.

**MAKING UP AND FINISH**

Sew the shoulders. Fit the sleeves. Sew the sides and the undersleeves. With size 3 1/2 knitting needles pick up 200 sts. along the front right-hand opening, neckline and front left-hand opening, in the 4 ribbed rows, and knit 2 rows with the yellow, 2 rows with the blue, 2 rows with the red and 4 rows in elastic rib with the green. End the sts with needle in knit stitch. To make a border at the bottom with the green pick up 10 sts. along the two short sides of the edge and work 4 rows in elastic rib. End the sts with the needle in knit stitch. Sew buttons.

**MATERIALS ADRIAFIL YARN**

**MATERIAL REQUIRED**

600 g. **Flower** yarn, colour no. 52. Size 3 1/2 knitting needles. Size no. 2,5 crochet hook. Wool needle with rounded tip.

**SIZE:** 42

**PATTERN STITCHES**

Knitted stitch  
Chain  
Double crochet  
Bobble

**SAMPLE**

10 x 10 cm with size 3 1/2 knitting needles in knitted stitch.= 26 sts. and 34 rows.

## WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

**Back:** Cast on 128 sts. with size 3 1/2 knitting needles and work in stock stitch. On the enlarged yarn purl on the plain side of the work and work in stock stitch on the purl side of the work. Decrease on the sides 1 st. every 8 rows 9 times. Work in stock st. for 12 rows then increase on the sides 1 st. every 6 rows 9 times. When work measures 45 cm. tot. ht. for the sleeve holes, cross on sides, every 2 rows, 4 sts., 3 sts., 2 sts. 2 times. and 1 st. When work measures 67 cm. tot. ht. cross all the stitches.

**Front:** Work as for back. When work measures 47 cm. tot. ht. for the neck, work the two parts separately, decreasing from the neck side, 1 st. every 3 rows 24 times. As you work the neck, make 3 buttonholes in the first and last 3 sts. Row 1 to row 4. and the other two spaced by 10 rows. When work measures 67 cm. tot. ht. cross the remaining 28 sts. for the shoulders.


**Sleeves:** Cast on 56 m. with size 3 1/2 knitting needles and work in stock st. increasing 1 st on the sides every 6 rows 15 times. When work measures 44 cm tot. ht. for the sleeve hole, cross on sides, every 2 rows., 5 sts., 3 sts., 2 sts. 3 times., 1 st 12 times., 3 st 2 times. and 2 sts. 2 times. then cross the remaining sts.

## MAKING UP AND FINISH

Sew the shoulders. Fit the sleeves. Sew the sides and the undersleeves. With the crochet hook work an edging around the neck, the bottom of the front, the back and sleeves, as follows:

Row 1 - \*1 double crochet, 3 chns., skip 3 sts\*. Repeat from \* to \*.

Row 2 - in each loop of 3 chns., work 1 double crochet 1 bobble



(3 chns., 1 single crochet in the 1st of these). Make a cord of about 150 cm and pass it through the buttonholes of the neck and then knot it at the centre.





## MAKING UP AND FINISH

Sew the shoulders. Fit the sleeves. Sew the sides and the undersleeves. With size 3 1/2 knitting needles pick up 156 sts. along the front right-hand opening and work 4 rows in elastic rib. End the sts with needle in knit stitch. Work the left-hand edge in the same way. With size 3 1/2 knitting needles pick up 140 sts. around the neck and work 4 rows in elastic rib. End the sts with needle in knit stitch. Sew buttons.

## PAG. 10 BAG

### MATERIALS ADRIAFIL YARNS

#### MATERIAL REQUIRED

500 g **Ibiza** yarn, colour no. 36. Size 4 and 4,5 crochet hook. Two braidings.

#### PATTERN STITCHES

Chain  
Ribbed Double crochet  
Treble crochet

#### WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

**Bag:** Cast on a chain of 28 sts with crochet hook size 4.

**Row 1.** - work ribbed double crochet on the two sides of the chain, increasing 3 sts for each side on the two corners. Cont.

working in a circle for another 9 rows continuing to increase 3 sts per side at the corners.

**From Row 11** change to size 4.5 crochet hook to work trebles in circular direction without increasing. (in row 1 take the stitch to the back of the work to form the cord). Cont. with treble c. for another 13 rows. Work 1 row in double crochet decreasing 1 st every 2 rows.

**Closing flap:** work on only 28 sts. (back half of bag) in treble c for 10 rows. Work the edge of the flap with 2 rows of treble c.

**Strap:** Cast on a chain of 12 sts. Cont. working in treble c. (10 sts.) for 72 rows.

#### MAKING UP AND FINISH

Fix the strap to the bag with invisible stitches starting from the base on the right and then on the left. Sew the two sections of the braiding on the bag and on the flap, evenly spaced.

#### MATERIAL REQUIRED

600 g. **Wind** yarn, colour no. 74 (A); total of 200 g. Panama yarn, of which 50 g. green no. 56 (B), 50 g. yellow no. 55 (C), 50 g. green no. 57 (D) and 50 g. orange no. 53 (E). Size 3 and 3 1/2 knitting needles. Wool needle with rounded tip.

**SIZE:** 42

#### PATTERN STITCHES

Elastic rib  
Purled stitch  
Fancy stitch: work on 4 sts. (follow chart)



When work measures 70 cm. tot. ht. cross the remaining 40 sts for the shoulder.



**Sleeves:** Cast on 66 sts. with size 3 knitting needles and work 6 rows in elastic rib. 

With size 3<sup>1/2</sup> knitting needles pick up 180 sts. along the front right-hand opening, up to half of the back neck and work 2 rows in rib stitch 1/1 and 4 rows in elastic rib. End with needle in knit stitch. Work the left hand edge in the same way.



### MAKING UP AND FINISH

With size 4<sup>1/2</sup> knitting needles pick up the 36 centre sts of the back and work in purled stitch, 2 rows with Ibiza yarn and 2 rows with Cuba yarn. When work measures 7 cm tot. ht. cross all the stitches. Sew the shoulders. Fit the sleeves. Sew the sides and undersleeves. Sew the neck behind the neckline of the fronts. Using the crochet hook and the Cuba yarn, work at the bottom of the back, front and sleeves, 2 double crochet and 1 reverse stitch. Work the same edging around the right-hand and left-hand right opening starting from the neck join.

## PAG. 14 BAG

### MATERIALS ADRIAFIL YARNS

#### MATERIAL REQUIRED

300 **Ibiza** yarn, colour no.81. Size 3,5. e 4 crochet hook.

#### PATTERN STITCHES

Chain  
Ribbed Double crochet

#### WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

Cast on chain of 5 sts. with the 3.5 crochet hook and end with a



**Left-hand back:** Work symmetrically. Sleeves: Cast on 50 sts with size 2 1/2 knitting needles and work 4 rows in elastic rib cont. in back loop rib stitch 1/1. When work measures 3 cm. tot. ht. change to size 3 knitting needles and work as follows: k 20 sts, 10 st. in plaited st. and k 20 sts. Increase on the sides 1 st. every 4 rows 11 times. When work measures 20 cm. tot. ht. for the sleeve hole, cross on sides, every 2 rows., 5 sts. 6 times. then cross the remaining stitches.

**MAKING UP AND FINISH**

Sew the shoulders. Fit the sleeves. Sew the sides and the undersleeves. With size 2 1/2 knitting needles pick up 86 sts. around the neckline and work 3 rows in rib stitch 1/1 and 4 rows in elastic rib End with needle in knitted stitch. With size 2 1/2 knitting needles pick up 100 sts. along back left-hand opening and work 6 rows in back loop rib stitch 1/1. In Row 3 make 6 buttonholes of 2 sts. (cross 2 sts. and bring on return needle), ensuring they are evenly spaced. Work. 4 rows in elastic rib and end with needle in knit stitch. Work the left-hand edge in the same way, without buttonholes. Sew buttons. Embroider the teddy bear on the front following the chart.

### MATERIALS ADRIAFIL YARNS

#### MATERIAL REQUIRED

100 g. **Peplo** yarn, colour no. 02. Knitting needles size 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> and 3. 40 cm of 2 cm high elastic band. Wool needle with rounded tip.

#### PATTERN STITCHES

Elastic rib

Back loop rib stitch 1/1

Knitted stitch



When work measures 37 cm. tot. ht. for the waist edge work 20 rows in stock st., in row 1 work the stitches in twos then cross. Now work the left leg symmetrically.

Sew the two legs. Fold waist edge in half on back of work and sew with invisible sts leaving a small opening. Fit the elastic and sew opening.

Elastic rib

Plaited stitch: work on 5 sts. (follow chart 1) Shift plaited stitch:

### WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

**Back:** Cast on 109 m. size 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> e work 4 rows in elastic rib cont. in plaited st. following the chart 1. When work measures 5 cm. tot. ht. change to size 3 knitting needles in shift plaited st., following the chart 2. When work measures 32 tot. ht. cross all the stitches.

**Right-hand front:** Cast on 56 sts. with size 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> knitting needle and work 4 rows in elastic rib cont. in plaited st. When work measures 5 cm. tot. ht. change to size 3 knitting needles and work in shift plaited st. When work measures 20 cm. tot. ht., for the neck, cross rightwise 1 st. every 3 rows 24 times. When work measures 32 cm. tot. ht. cross the remaining 32 sts. for the shoulder.

**Left-hand front:** Work symmetrically. Sleeves: cast on 57 sts. with size 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> knitting needles and work 4 rows in elastic rib cont. in plaited st. When work measures 5 cm tot. ht. change to size 3 knitting needles and work in shift plaited st. inc. on sides 1 st. every 4 rows 19 times. When work measures 24 cm. tot. ht. cross all the stitches.

### MAKING UP AND FINISH

Sew the shoulders. Fit the sleeves. Sew the sides and the undersleeves. With size 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> knitting needles pick up 312 sts. along the front right-hand opening, back neck and front left-hand opening and work 5 rows in plaited st and 4 rows in elastic rib. End with needle in knit st. When working row 3 make 4 buttonholes of 3 sts. (cross. 3 sts. and bring on return needle), ensuring they are evenly spaced. Sew on buttons.

Cast on 149 sts. with size 3 1/2 knitting needles using the yellow and work as follows: Row 1° and row 2° - knitted





When work measures 16 cm. tot. ht. for the sleeve holes, cross on sides, in the first and the last 2 sts., 2 sts. every 2 rows 4 times. When work measures 18 cm. tot. ht. pick up the work in diamond st. Work 10 rows (= 1 diamond) then cont. in stock st. When work measures 22 cm. tot. ht. for the neck, cross the 8 centre sts. and end the two parts separately, cross from the neck side, every 2 rows., 3 sts., 2 sts. 2 times. and 1 st. 2 times. When work measures 26 cm. tot. ht. cross the remaining 19 sts for the rows. Sleeves: cast on 46 sts. with size 3 knitting



needles and work 4 rows in elastic rib cont. in rib stitch 1/1. 

**Back:** Cast on 122 sts. with size 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> A knitting needles and work 12 sts. in elastic rib. Cont. in rib stitch 1/1. When work measures 4 cm. tot. ht. Change to size 3 and work in jacquard

st. following the chart. When work measures 20 cm. tot. ht. For the sleeve holes, cross on sides, in the first and the last 2 sts, 2 sts. every 2 rows. 5 times. When work measures 34 cm. tot. ht. cross all the stitches.




**Sleeves:** Cast on 64 sts. with size 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> knitting needles in A and work 4 rows in elastic rib. Cont. in rib stitch 1/1. When work measures 6 cm. tot. ht. change to size 3 knitting needles in jacquard st, increase, 1 st every 4 rows 16 times. When work measures 24 cm. tot. ht., for the sleeve hole, cross on sides, in the first and last st, 2 sts. every 2 rows. 5 times then cross the remaining sts.

#### MAKING UP AND FINISH

Sew the shoulders, Fit the sleeves and sew the sides and the undersleeves. With the crochet hook work a row around the neck in double crochet and a row in reverse st. Sew on buttons.

## PAG. 22 BABY BLANKET WITH TRAIN



### MATERIALS ADRIAFIL YARNS

350 g. **Dolcezza Baby** yarn, colour no. 60. Knitting needles size 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>. Crochet hook size 1,75. For the train use dark pink, light pink, green, light yellow and beige wool.

Important: This garment may also be realised in Avantgarde yarn.

**DIMENSIONS:** 73 x 63 cm

#### PATTERN STITCHES

Basket st: Row 1 - knitted st. Rows 2, 3 and 4 - k1.\* k3., p5\* Repeat from \* to \* and end with k1. Row 5 - knitted st. Rows 6, 7 and 8 - \* k5, p3.\* Repeat from \* to \* Row 9. - pick up from row 1 Double crochet Chain Treble crochet Bobble

#### SAMPLE

10 x 10 cm. with size 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> in basket st = 27 sts. and 48 rows.

#### WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

Cast on 152 m. with size 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> knitting needles and work in basket st. When work measures 60 cm tot. ht. cross all the stitches.

#### MAKING UP AND FINISH

With crochet hook, make an edging all around as follows:

**Row 1** - in double crochet.

**Row 2** - 1 treble c, 2 chns., 1 treble, 2 chns., 1 treble on 4 corners, while on sides work as follows: 1 treble, 2 chns., slip 2 sts:

**Row 3** - in double crochet (3 sts in each loop).

**Row 4** - on the centre st. of the first corner work in 1 treble c., 3 chns., 1 treble c., 4 chns., slip 2 square, 1 double crochet on the next treble c., 4 chns. Repeat for all the row.

**Row 5** - 7 treble cs. in the space between the 2 treble cs., 5 chns., 7 treble cs. in the space between the next 2 treble cs. Repeat. **Row 6** - with single crochets reach the centre of the 7 treble cs. and work 1 double crochet, 5 chns.; at the centre of the 5 chns. below work in 1 treble c., 3 chns., 1 treble c.. Repeat.

**Row 7** - in the 3 chn loop between the 2 treble cs. work in 2 treble cs. close together, 1 bobble, 2 treble cs. close together 4 times., 3 chns. Skip to set of next 2 treble cs. and work in same way. At the 4 corners also work on the double crochet below (3 consecutive fans). Now make the train. Engine (dark pink) Cast on a chain of 28 sts and work in treble c. for 7 rows. For the chimney work in 4 treble cs. for 4 rows. For the window work in 3 treble cs. for 6 rows, slip 6 sts, 3 treble cs. for 6 rows, 6 chns. to join the two parts; now work 2 rows in treble c. (12 sts) Pick up 14 sts for the engine end, work in treble c. for 5 rows. dec.

2 sts. for each side row. Trim with single crochet. Wagon (green) Cast on 30 chns. and work in treble c. for 7 rows then work 4 treble cs. for 6 row edge, slip 8 sts, work another 4 treble cs. for 6 rows., slip another 8 sts. Work another last 4 treble cs. for 6 rows. Join the parts with 8 chns. and work 2 rows in treble c.. Trim with double crochet. Wheels (beige) - make 8 Cast on 4 chns. end with loop. Work in 1 treble c., 2 chns. 8 times. End. Work 3 sc in each space of 2 chns. End. Attach the different parts of the train to the blanket following the photograph and embroider the smoke clouds in grass st. with the beige.

## PAG. 23 STRIPED BABY JUMPER



### MATERIALS ADRIAFIL YARNS

#### MATERIAL REQUIRED

250 g. **Avantgarde** yarn, of which 150 g. white no. 02 (A), 50 g. colour turquoise no. 75 (B) and 50 g. orange no. 77 (C). Knitting needles size 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> and 3. Wool needle with rounded tip. *Important:* This garment may also be realised with **Peplo** yarn.

**SIZE:** 12 months

### PATTERN STITCHES

Elastic rib

Rib stitch 1/1

Fancy pattern garter stitch: From row 1° to row 6° garter stitch in A. Row 7- 8 garter st. in B, \*work.5 sts., pass 1 st. without working, work, 3 sts, pass 1 sts. without working.\* Repeat from \* to \* Row 9, row 10 - garter st. in C passing row 6 and row 10 without working. Row 11, row 12 - like row 7 and 8 from row 13 to 18 - garter st. in A, also work the sts. passed, crossing them. Row 19, row 20 - garter st. in B: \*pass 1 st. without working, work. 3 sts., pass 1 st. without working, work 5 m.\* Repeat from \* to \*. Row 21, row 22 - garter st. in C passing the sts. without working Row 23, row 24 - garter st. in B, passing the sts. without working Row 25 - pick up from row 1 working the passed sts. and crossing them.

### SAMPLE

10 x 10 cm. with size 3 knitting needles in fancy pattern garter st. = 28 sts. and 50 rows.

### WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

**Back:** Cast on 89 sts. with size 3 in A knitting needles and work


in fancy pattern garter st. When work measures 20 cm tot. ht. . for the sleeve holes., cross on sides 6 m. When work measures 30 cm. tot. ht. cross all the stitches.

**Front:** Work like back. When work measures 24 cm. tot. ht. for the neck, cross the 9 centre sts. and end the two parts separately, cross from neck side, every 2 rows., 4 sts., 3 sts., 2 sts. and 1 st. When work measures 30 cm. tot. ht. cross the 24 remaining sts for the shoulders.

**Sleeves:** Cast on 40 sts. with size 3 knitting needles in A and work in fancy pattern garter st. increase on sides 1 st. every 4 rows 18 times. When work measures 25 cm. tot. ht. cross all the stitches.

### MAKING UP AND FINISH

Sew a shoulder. With size 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> knitting needle pick up 120 sts. around the neckline and work 5 rows in rib stitch 1/1 and 4 rows in elastic rib; end with needle in knit stitch. Sew the other shoulder. Fit the sleeves, Sew the sides and the undersleeves.



## PAG. 24 TEA TABLECLOTH



### MATERIALS ADRIAFIL YARNS

#### MATERIAL REQUIRED

100 g. **Uno Makò 5** yarn col. 91 (brown), 50 g. for each of the following colours: no. 85 (green), no. 86 (yellow), no. 87 (light green), no. 84 (orange), no. 17 (red). Crochet hook size 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>.

### PATTERN STITCHES

Chain, Treble crochet, Double crochet.

### WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

Work the tablecloth in double crochet for the ribbing in yellow for 2 rows and in treble crochet for the brown ribbing - 2 rows. Make the following fruits and sew them on with small invisible sts.

7 cherries: Cast on 3 chns., End with loop. Work 3 rows in single crochet increasing a stitch every 2.1 orange: Cast on 4

chns., work on two sides of the chns 1 double crochet for 6 rows, increasing the sts regularly at every row.  
 2 apricots: Cast on 1 chn. of 10 sts, work on the two sides by two dividing a third of the points in double crochet, a third in half treble, a third in treble c.  
 3 strawberries: Cast on 3 chns., work in half treble c. for 6

rows increasing 2 sts. at every row on sides. Work the leaves in the same way dividing in double crochet, in half treble c., treble c., work for 2 rows or 1 row. The chains change according to the length required to fill the spaces (6 chns. - 16 chns. - 22 chns.).

## PAG. 24 ROUND POT HOLDER



### MATERIALS ADRIAFIL YARNS

#### MATERIAL REQUIRED

30 g **Uno Makò 5** yarn in colours 84 (orange) and 5 (green). Crochet hook size 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>.

#### PATTERN STITCHES

Chain, double crochet, Treble c.

#### WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

With the cotton doubled use the orange to cast on a chain of 8 sts closed with loop.

**Row 1** - Work. \* 2 treble cs., 1 chns. \*. Repeat from \* to \* 10 times.

**Row 2** - Work \* 1 double crochet in the loop 1 chn below, 3 chns. \*. Repeat from \* to \*.

**Row 3** - Work \* 2 treble cs. closed together in the first loop of 3 chns. 2 treble cs. in the second loop, 4 chns. \*. Repeat from \* to \* starting from the loop of the 2nd pair of 2 treble cs.

**Row 4** - Work \* 6 single crochets in each loop of 4 chns.

From **row 5** to **row 10** - With the green cotton work a double crochet increasing regularly to keep it flat.

**Row 11** - \* 1 double crochet 3 chns. 1 double crochet in the same single crochet\*, skip a stitch. Repeat from \* to \*. Make a loop (last 4 sts) at the end.

## PAG. 24 POT HOLDER WITH CHERRY



### MATERIALS ADRIAFIL YARNS

#### MATERIAL REQUIRED

30 g. **Uno Makò 5** yarn in colours no. 91 (brown) and a few grams of the following colours: no. 85 (green), n. 86 (yellow), no. 17 (red). Crochet hook size 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>.

#### PATTERN STITCHES

Chain, fancy pattern - row 1 double crochet; row 2 and

successive rows work 2 chns. at a time, fit in the 1st stitch and pull the yarn, fit in the 2nd stitch and remove, End 3 holes together.

#### WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

Form a chain of 28 sts.

Row 1 - double crochet. Row 2 and succ. in fancy pattern. At the end trim with 1 row in brown double crochet forming 1 loop at a corner and 1 yellow row.

#### MAKING UP AND FINISHE

Make 3 cherries and 2 leaves as for the tablecloth. Sew on to the pot holder with invisible stitches.

## PAG. 25 CURTAIN



### MATERIALS ADRIAFIL YARNS

#### MATERIAL REQUIRED

200 g. **Cablè** cotton 8 colour no. 02 white size 1,25 crochet hook.

#### PATTERN STITCHES

Chain  
 Double crochet  
 Treble crochet  
 Double treble crochet  
 Triple treble cr.  
 Bobble

**From row 1 to 8** - \* 1 treble c. , 2 chns pass 2 chns\*. Repeat (8 "filet" squares) from \* to \*.

**Row 9** - In the first square at the corner work \* 10 double treble crochets, 3 chns , pass 2 squares work 6 treble cs. in the next 2 squares, 3 chns, pass another 2 squares\* Repeat from \* to \*.

**Row 10** - \* 1 triple treble c., 1 chns 11 times on each corner, 3 chns 1 triple treble c. at the centre of the 6 treble cs. below, 3 chns \*. Repeat from \* to \*.

**Row 11** - \* 1 double crochet on the first triple treble c. of the 1st corner, 3 chns 1 double crochet. Repeat 10 times; 5 double crochets on the 3 chns below, 5 double crochets on the next 3 chns. \*. Repeat from \* to \*. Make other elements joining them in row 11 with the 3 chn loops. (3 end loops and 3 beg. loops at the edges of the 5 double crochets).

**On the bottom make an edge as follows:**

**Row 1** - (Pass the first 5 loops of 3 chns.). Work \* 1 double

#### WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

Cast on a chain of 25 ch. sts.

crochet, 3 chns., 1 double crochet 3 times. (3 loops), 8 chns. \* pass to next corner, 1 double crochet in the 1st loop, 3 chns. 3 times. 8 chns. Pass to the first corner of the next piece, pass 2 loops. Repeat from \* to \*.

**Row 2** - \* 1 double crochet, 3 chns. on every loop below; on the 8 chns. below work 4 double crochets, 3 bobbles, 4 double crochets. \*. Repeat from \* to \*. End with 1 double crochet, 3 chns. 3 times.

**Row 3** - 1 double crochet, 3 chns., 1 double crochet; \* 10 chns., 1 double crochet, 3 chns., 1 double crochet, 3 chns., 1 double

crochet \*. Repeat from \* to \*.

**Row 4** - 2 double crochets, 1 bobble, 2 double crochets in the loop of 3 chns.; on the 10 chns. work 5 double crochets, 3 bobbles, 5 double crochets. Repeat.

### MAKING UP AND FINISH

Form 5 rings to fit the curtain in the curtain holder working a chn in the size required and working for 3 rows in loops of 1 double crochet, 3 chns., 1 double crochet. Fix the loops to the curtain at regular distance.

### MATERIALS ADRIAFIL YARNS

#### MATERIAL REQUIRED

1 ball of 250 g. for a 1 metre trim in Faraone yarn colour 02 white. Crochet hook size 1,50

#### PATTERN STITCHES

Chain  
Double crochet  
Treble crochet  
Bobble

### WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

Make a chain of the required size.

**Row 1** - 1 treble c. in every chain st.

**Row 2** - \* 1 treble c., pass 3 double crochets, 3 chns, 1 treble c.\* Repeat from \* to \*.

**Row 3 to row 7** - 3 chns. to turn work \* 1 treble c. at centre of the 3 chns below 1 treble c. - Repeat from \* to \*.

**Row 8** - 3 chns. to turn; 3 chns 1 treble c. repeated 7 times. On the 7 squares below, \* 6 chns, pass two squares, 1 treble c. cont. with 3 chns 1 treble c. 11 times (11 squares) \*. Repeat the row from \* to \* end with 1 treble c. spaced by 3 chns (tot. 7 squares).

**Row 9** - 3 double crochets in the space of 3 chns. below, 8 double crochets on the 6 chns below. Repeat the row.

**Row 10** - 1 treble c., 3 chns. 1 treble c. 6 times (6 squares), 6 chns. pass one square pass to centre of the 8 double crochets \* 4 treble cs. in the same stitch 6 chns., pass a square, work 1 treble c. 3 chns. 9 times, 6 chns. \*. Repeat from \* to \* end with 1 treble c., 3 chns. 6 times.

**Row 11** - 1 treble c., 3 chns., 1 treble c. 5 times Pass a square, 5 double crochets on the 6 below \* 4 chns., 2 treble cs., 1 chns. 2 treble cs. at the centre of the 4 sts., 4 chns. , 5 double crochets on the next 6 chns. \* Repeat from \* to \*. End with 1 treble c. 3 chns. 5 times.

**Row 12** - 1 treble c. 3 chns. 5 times, 5 chns., in the loop of 3 chns. Work \* 2 treble cs. 3 chns., 2 treble cs., 2 chns., 2 treble cs. at the centre of the 4 treble cs. below, 2 chns., 2 treble cs. on the next 3 chns., 6 chns., 1 treble c., 3 chns. \*. 7 times Repeat from \* to \*.

**Row 13** - 1 treble c., 3 chns. 1 treble c. 5 times, Pass a square, 5 double crochets on the 6 chns. below, \* 3 chns. 2 treble cs. on the 2 chns. after the first 2 treble cs. below 2 treble cs., 2 chns., 2 treble cs. at the centre of 4 treble cs., 2 chns., 2 treble

cs. on the next 2 chns., 3 chns. 5 double crochets, 3 chns., 1 treble c., 3 chns. 5 times \*. Repeat from \* to \*.

**Row 14** - 1 treble c., 3 chns., 1 treble c. 4 times \*5 chns., 2 treble c. in the loop of 3 chns., 2 chns., 2 treble cs. in the next loop, 2 chns., 4 treble cs. at the centre of the 4 sts below, 2 chns., 2 treble cs., 2 chns., 2 treble cs., 6 chns., 1 treble c. in the loop of 3 chns., 2 chns. 4 times \*. Repeat from \* to \*.

**Row 15** - 1 treble c., 3 chns., 1 treble c. 3 times, \* 4 double crochets on the 6 chns. below, 3 chns., 2 treble cs., 2 chns., 2 treble cs., 2 chns., 4 treble cs. at the centre of the 4 below, 2 chns., 2 treble cs., 2 chns., 2 treble cs., 3 chns., 4 double crochets on the 6 chns., 1 double crochet in the next 1st loop, 3 chns. 1 treble c. 3 times \*. Repeat from \* to \*.

**Row 16** - 1 treble c., 3 chns., 1 treble c. 3 times. \* 6 chns., 2 treble cs., 2 chns., 2 treble cs., 2 chns., 2 treble cs., 2 chns., 4 treble cs. at the centre of the 4 below, 2 chns., 2 treble cs., 2 chns., 2 treble cs., 2 chns., 2 treble cs., 6 chns., 1 treble c., 3 chns., 3 times. \*. Repeat from \* to \*.

**Row 17** - 1 treble c., 3 chns., 1 treble c. 2 times \*4 double crochets on the 6 chns. below, 3 chns. pass to the loop 1 st after the 2 treble cs., work 2 treble cs., 2 chns., 2 treble cs., 2 chns., 2 treble cs., 2 chns., 4 treble cs. at the centre of the 4 m. below, 2 chns., 2 treble cs., 2 chns., 2 treble cs., 2 chns., 2treble cs., 3 chns., 4 double crochets, 3 chns., 1 treble c., 3 chns., 1 treble c. (there will be only one centre loop) \*. Repeat from \* to \*.

**Row 18** - 1 treble c., 3 chns., 1 treble c., 3 chns., 1 treble c. \* 6 chns., 2 treble cs., 2 chns., 4 treble cs. at the centre of the 4 below, 2 chns., 2 treble cs., 6 chns., 1 treble c., 3 chns., 1 treble c. \*. Repeat from \* to \*.

**Row 19** - 1 treble c., 3 chns., 1 treble c., 2 chns., 1 treble c. \* 4 double crochets, 3 chns., 2 treble cs., 2 chns., 4 treble cs. at the centre of the 4 m. below, 2 treble cs., 2 chns., 4 double crochets on the loop of 6 chns., 2 double crochets on the 3 chns. in the loop between 2 treble cs. \*. Repeat from \* to \*.

**Row 20** - 1 treble c., 3 chns., 1 treble c. \* 5 chns., 2 treble cs., 2 chns. 5 times, 4 treble cs. at the centre of the 4 m. below, 2 chns., 2 treble cs. 5 times, 5 chns., 1 double crochet at the centre of the 3 chns., below \*. Repeat from \* to \*.

**Row 21** - 4 double crochets on the 3 chns. between the first 2 treble cs. \* 4 double crochets in the next 5 chn loop, 1 bobble, 2 treble cs. 13 times, 4 double crochets \*. Repeat from \* to \*.

## MATERIALS ADRIAFIL YARNS

### MATERIAL REQUIRED

800 g. Doppio Ritorto yarn 12/3=8 colour n. 12. Crochet hook size. 1,25. Size 80 pieces

### PATTERN STITCHES

Chain, Double crochet, Single crochet, Treble crochet, Bobble

### WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

Cast on 1 chn of 12 sts End with loop.

**Row 1** - Work 7 treble cs., 5 chns. 4 times. End with a single crochet.

**Row 2** - With single crochet sts. reach 1st loop of 4 chns., work \* 3 treble cs., 4 chns., 3 treble cs., 5 chns. \*: Fit crochet hook in the next loop. Repeat from \* to \* another 3 times (4 corners). End with 1 single crochet.

**Row 3** - Work \* 1 treble c. on each of the 3 treble cs. below and another 3 treble cs. in the loop of chns., 4 chns., 3 treble cs. in the same loop, another 3 treble cs. on the 3 m. below, 3 chns., 1 double crochet at the centre of the 5 chns., 3 chns. \*. Repeat from \* to \*. End with 1 single crochet.

**Row 4** - Work \* 1 treble c. on each of the 6 sts. below, 3 treble cs. in the 4 chn loop., 3 treble cs. in the same loop , 6 treble cs., 5 chns., \*. Repeat from \* to \*. End with 1 single crochet.

**Row 5** - Work \* 9 treble cs., on the 9 below, 3 treble cs. in the loop, 4 chns., 3 treble cs. in the same loop , 9 treble cs., 3 chns., 1 double crochet at the centre of the 5 chns. below, 3 chns. \*. Repeat from \* to \*. End with 1 single crochet.

**Row 6** - Work \* 12 treble cs. on the 12 below, 3 treble cs. in the loop, 4 chns., 3 treble cs. in the same loop , 12 treble cs., 5 chns. \*. Repeat from \* to \*. End with single crochet.

**Row 7** - Work \* 15 treble cs., 3 treble cs. in the loop, 4 chns., 3 treble cs. in the same loop , 15 treble cs., 3 chns., 1 double crochet at the centre of the 5 chn. loop ., 3 chns. \*. Repeat from \* to \*. End with single crochet.

**Row 8** - Starting from the 1st treble c. of 18 below. Work 8 chns. \* pass 6 treble cs., work 12 treble cs. on each of the next 3 treble cs. in the loop, 4 chns., 3 treble cs. in the same loop , 12 treble cs., 6 chns., 1 treble c. on the last of the 18 below, 4 chns., 1 treble c. on the first of the next 18, 4 chns. \*. Repeat from \* to \*. End with a single crochet.

**Row 9** - 8 chns., pass 6 treble cs. \* 9 treble cs., 9 treble cs. in the loop, 4 chns., 3 treble cs. in the same loop , 9 treble cs., 5 chns., a treble c. on the last of the 5 below, 3 chns., 1 double

crochet at the centre of the next loop , 3 chns., 1 treble c. on below, 3 chns., 1 double crochet, 3 chns., 1 treble c., 3 chns., 1 double crochet at centre of the loop, 3 chns., 1 treble c., 5 chns. \*. Repeat from \* to \*. End with single crochet.

**Row 10** - 8 chns., pass 6 treble cs., \* 6 treble cs., 3 treble cs., in the loop, 4 chns., 3 treble cs. in the same loop , 6 treble cs. on the base st., 5 chns., 1 treble c. on the last of the 12 below, 3 chns., 1 double crochet at the centre of the loop, 3 chns., 1 treble c. on st. below , 5 chns., 1 treble c. on next st., 5 chns., 1 treble c., 5 chns., 1 treble c., 3 chns., 1 double crochet, 3 chns., 1 treble c., 5 chns. \*. Repeat from \* to \*. End with single crochet.

**Row 11** - 8 chns., pass 6 treble cs. \* 3 treble cs., 3 treble cs. in the loop, 4 chns., 3 treble cs. in the same loop , 3 treble cs., 5 chns., 1 treble c. on the last of the 9 below, 3 chns., 1 double crochet at the centre of the loop, 3 chns., 1 treble c., 5 chns., 1 treble c., 3 chns., 1 double crochet, 3 chns., 1 treble c. in each of the next 3 loops, 5 chns., 1 treble c., 3 chns., 1 double crochet, 3 chns., 1 treble c., 5 chns. \*. Repeat from \* to \*. End with a single crochet.

**Row 12** - 8 chns., pass 6 treble cs.. In the space of 4 chns. work \* 3 treble cs., 4 chns., 3 treble cs., 5 chns., 1 treble c. on the last of the 6 below, 3 chns., 1 double crochet, 3 chns., 1 treble c., 5 chns., 1 treble c. on the next, 3 chns., 1 double crochet, 3 chns., 1 treble c., 5 chns., 1 treble c. 3 times on the 3 loops below, 3 chns., 1 double crochet, 3 chns., 1 treble c., 5 chns., 1 treble c., 3 chns., 1 double crochet, 3 chns., 1 treble c., 5 chns. \*. Repeat from \* to \*. End with single crochet.

**Row 13** - With single crochets fit the crochet hook in the space of 4 chns. Work \* 3 treble cs., 4 chns., 3 treble cs. like the previous row, 3 chns., in the loop of 5 chns. work 2 treble cs., 2 chns., 2 treble cs., 3 chns., 1 double crochet on the double crochet below, 3 chns.; on the next 5 chns., 2 treble cs., 2 chns., 2 treble cs., 3 chns., 1 double crochet, 3 chns., 2 treble cs., 2 chns., 2 treble cs., 3 chns., 1 double crochet on the next double crochet, 3 chns., 2 treble cs., 2 chns., 2 treble cs., 3 chns., 1 double crochet on the base double crochet, 3 chns., 2 treble cs., 2 chns., 2 treble cs., 4 chns. \*. Repeat from \* to \*. End.

**Row 14** - In the space of 2 chns. between the 2 groups of treble cs. work the full row as follows: 1 treble c., 1 bobble, 1 treble c. 4 times, in order to shape fans, 3 chns. Pass to the next group.

### MAKING UP AND FINISH

Make the various pieces and join them together with two centre bobbles of each fan. The centre of the joint of 4 parts is worked like row 1 of the piece: 12 chns. close with loop, work 7 treble cs., 5 chns. which will be used to hook the bobbles. Repeat another 3 times.
