Stitch Patterns:**K1P1 Rib**

Row 1 (RS): *K1, p1; repeat from * to end.

All Following Rows: Knit the knit sts and purl the purl sts.

Narrow Left Cable (8 sts)

Row 1 (RS): P2, 2/2 LC, p2.

Rows 2, 4 and 6 (WS): K2, p4, k2.

Rows 3 and 5: P2, k4, p2.

Repeat Rows 1 – 6 for the pattern.

Narrow Right Cable (8 sts)

Row 1 (RS): P2, 2/2 RC, p2.

Rows 2, 4 and 6 (WS): K2, p4, k2.

Rows 3 and 5: P2, k4, p2.

Repeat Rows 1 – 6 for the pattern.

Wide Left Cable (12 sts)

Row 1 (RS): P2, k8, p2.

Rows 2, 4, 6, 8, 10 and 12: K2, p8, k2.

Row 3: P2, 4/4 LC, p2.

Rows 5, 7, 9 and 11: Repeat Row 1.

Repeat Rows 1 – 12 for the pattern.

Row 1 (RS): P2, k8, p2.

Rows 2, 4, 6, 8, 10 and 12: K2, p8, k2.

Row 3: P2, 4/4 RC, p2.

Rows 5, 7, 9 and 11: Repeat Row 1.

Repeat Rows 1 – 12 for the pattern.

Special Stitches:

2/2 LC: Slip 2 stitches to a cable needle and hold in the front of work, k2, then k2 from the cable needle.

2/2 RC: Slip 2 stitches to a cable needle and hold in the back of work, k2, then k2 from the cable needle.

4/4 LC: Slip 4 stitches to a cable needle and hold in the front of work, k4, then k4 from the cable needle.

4/4 RC: Slip 4 stitches to a cable needle and hold in the back of work, k4, then k4 from the cable needle.

K1-tbl: Knit 1 through the back of the loop.

M1p: Make 1 purlwise: lift strand between sts with the left needle, from front to back, purl through the back of loop.

P1f&b: Purl into the front and back of the same stitch.

P1-tbl: Purl 1 through the back of the loop.

Wrap & Turn: On knit rows, with the yarn in back, slip the next stitch purlwise, bring the yarn to the front between stitches, return the slipped stitch to the left needle, turn the work and bring the yarn to the purl side between the stitches. When hiding the wrap on subsequent rows, use the right needle to lift the front strand of the wrap up to the left needle and knit the wrap and stitch together. On purl rows, with the yarn in front, slip the next stitch purlwise, bring the yarn to the back between stitches, return the slipped stitch to the left needle, turn the work and bring the yarn to the knit side between the stitches. When hiding the wrap on subsequent rows, use the right needle to lift the back strand of the wrap up to the left needle and purl the wrap and stitch together.

Note:

The stitches for the button band and buttonhole band are placed on holders before changing needle sizes. These bands will be worked on the smaller needles as an applied edging so that the bands are firmer than if worked with the larger needles.

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Begin Pattern:

Back

With the smaller needles, cast on 103 (115, 129, 141, 155, 167, 181) sts.

Sizes XS (S, XL, 2XL) only

Row 1 (WS): K2, *p1, k1; repeat from * to last the st, k1.

Row 2 (RS): *K1, p1; repeat from * to the last st, k1.

Sizes M (L, 3XL) only

Row 1 (WS): *K1, p1; repeat from * to the last st, k1.

Row 2 (RS): K2, *p1, k1; repeat from * to the last st, k1.

All Sizes

Repeat the last 2 rows until the ribbing measures 1½", end with a WS row.

Set-up Row 1 (RS): Work 14 (20, 27, 33, 40, 46, 53) sts in established ribbing, M1p, k1, k2tog, p1, k1, M1p, (p1, k1) 32 times, p1, M1p, k1, p1, k1, k2tog, M1p, work in established ribbing to the end – 105 (117, 131, 143, 157, 169, 183) sts.

Size XS only

Set-up Row 2 (WS): K1, p4, (k1, p1) 4 times, pm, k2, p4, k2, pm, [(p1, k1) 4 times, p5, k1] 4 times, (p1, k1) 3 times, p1, pm, k2, p4, k2, pm, (p1, k1) 4 times, p4, k1.

Sizes S (L, 2XL) only

Set-up Row 2 (WS): K1, p0 (1, 0), (k1, p1) 2 (1, 1) time(s), [k1, p5, (k1, p1) 4 times] 1 (2, 3) time(s), pm, k2, p4, k2, pm, [(p1, k1) 4 times, p5, k1] 4 times, (p1, k1) 3 times, p1, pm, k2, p4, k2, pm, [(p1, k1) 4 times, p5, k1] 1 (2, 3) time(s), (p1, k1) 2 (1, 1) time(s), p0 (1, 0), k1.

Sizes M (XL, 3XL) only

Set-up Row 2 (WS): K1, p3 (2, 1), (k1, p1) 4 times, [k1, p5, (k1, p1) 4 times] 1 (2, 3) time(s), pm, k2, p4, k2, pm, [(p1, k1) 4 times, p5, k1] 4 times, (p1, k1) 3 times, p1, pm, k2, p4, k2, pm, [(p1, k1) 4 times, p5, k1] 1 (2, 3) time(s), (p1, k1) 4 times, p3 (2, 1), k1.

All Sizes

Change to the larger needles.

Next Row (RS): K1, working Row 1 of the Back Chart, work the first 12 (4, 11, 3, 10, 2, 9) sts before the repeat for your size, work the 14-st repeat 0 (1, 1, 2, 2, 3, 3) time(s), sm, work the next 8 sts, sm, work the 14-st repeat 4 times, work the next 7 sts, sm, work the next 8 sts, sm, work the 14-st repeat 0 (1, 1, 2, 2, 3, 3) time(s), work the remaining 12 (4, 11, 3, 10, 2, 9) sts of the chart for your size, then k1.

Continue in the established pattern until the piece measures 14" from the beginning, end with a WS row.

Shape Armholes

Bind off 4 (6, 8, 10, 12, 14, 16) sts at the beginning of the next 2 rows, 0 (0, 0, 0, 4, 4, 5) sts at the beginning of the next 0 (0, 0, 0, 2, 2, 2) rows, 3 sts at the beginning of the next 0 (2, 2, 2, 2, 2, 2) rows, then 2 sts at the beginning of the next 2 (2, 2, 4, 2, 4, 4) rows – 93 (95, 105, 109, 115, 119, 127) sts remain.

Decrease Row (RS): Ssk, work in pattern to the last 2 sts, k2tog – 2 sts decreased.

Repeat the Decrease Row every RS row 2 (1, 3, 2, 2, 3, 5) more time(s) – 87 (91, 97, 103, 109, 111, 115) sts remain.

Continue even until the armholes measure 7¼ (7¾, 8¼, 8¾, 9¼, 9¾, 10¼)" , end with a WS row.

Shape Neck and Shoulders

Place markers on each side of the center 31 (33, 33, 35, 37, 39, 41) sts for the neck.

Short Row 1 (RS): Work to the marker, join a second ball of yarn and work the marked sts, place the center 31 (33, 33, 35, 37, 39, 41) sts just worked onto a stitch holder, then work to the last 5 (6, 6, 7, 7, 7, 8) sts, w&t.

Work both sides at the same time with separate balls of yarn.

Short Row 2 (WS): Work to the neck; on other side, bind off 3 sts, then work to the last 5 (6, 6, 7, 7, 8) sts, w&t.

Short Row 3: Work to the neck; on other side, bind off 3 sts, then work to 6 (6, 7, 7, 8, 8, 8) sts before the last turn, w&t.

Short Row 4: Work to the neck; on other side, bind off 2 sts, then work to 6 (6, 7, 7, 8, 8, 8) sts before the last turn, w&t.

Short Row 5: Work to the neck; on other side, bind off 2 sts, then work to 6 (6, 7, 7, 8, 8, 8) sts before the last turn, w&t.

Short Row 6: Work to the neck; on other side, work to 6 (6, 7, 7, 8, 8, 8) sts before the last turn, w&t.

Short Row 7: Work to the neck; on other side, work to end of the row and hide wraps, then place these 23 (24, 27, 29, 31, 31, 32) sts on a holder.

Next row: Work to end of the row and hide wraps, then place these 23 (24, 27, 29, 31, 31, 32) sts on a holder.

Left Front

With the smaller needles, cast on 60 (66, 73, 79, 86, 93, 99) sts.

Row 1 (WS): P2, *k1, p1; repeat from * to the last 2 (2, 1, 1, 2, 1, 1) st(s), k2 (2, 1, 1, 2, 1, 1).

Row 2 (RS): K1 (1, 2, 2, 1, 2, 2), *p1, k1; repeat from * to the last st, k1.

Row 3: Sl 1, *p1, k1; repeat from * to the last 1 (1, 2, 2, 1, 2, 2) st(s), p0 (0, 1, 1, 0, 1, 1), k1.

Repeat the last 2 rows until the ribbing measures 1½" from the beginning, end with a WS row.

Set-up Row 1 (RS): Work 14 (20, 27, 33, 40, 46, 53) sts in established ribbing, M1p, k1, k2tog, p1, k1, M1p, (p1, k1) 11 times, p1, M1p, k1, p1, k1, k2tog, (p1, k1) twice, M1p, (p1, k1) 4 times, k1 – 62 (68, 75, 81, 88, 95, 101) sts.

Size XS only

Set-up Row 2 (WS): Work first 7 sts and place on holder, p1f&b, pm, k2, p8, k2, pm, (p1, k1) 4 times, p5, (k1, p1) 4 times, pm, k2, p4, k2, pm, (p1, k1) 4 times, p4, k1 – 56 sts remain.

Sizes S (L, 2XL) only

Set-up Row 2 (WS): Work first 7 sts and place on holder, p1f&b, pm, k2, p8, k2, pm, (p1, k1) 4 times, p5, (k1, p1) 4 times, pm, k2, p4, k2, pm, [(p1, k1) 4 times, p5, k1] 1 (2, 3) time(s), (p1, k1) 2 (1, 1) time(s), p0 (1, 0), k1 – 62 (75, 89) sts remain.

Sizes M (XL, 3XL) only

Set-up Row 2 (WS): Work first 7 sts and place on holder, p1f&b, pm, k2, p8, k2, pm, (p1, k1) 4 times, p5, (k1, p1) 4 times, pm, k2, p4, k2, pm, [(p1, k1) 4 times, p5, k1] 1 (2, 3) time(s), (p1, k1) 4 times, p3 (2, 1), k1 – 69 (82, 95) sts remain.

All Sizes

Change to the larger needles.

Next Row (RS): K1, working Row 1 of the Left Front Chart, work the first 12 (4, 11, 3, 10, 2, 9) for your size before the repeat, work the 14-st repeat 0 (1, 1, 2, 2, 3, 3) time(s), then work to the end of the row and slip markers as you come to them.

Continue in the established pattern until the piece measures 14" from the beginning, end with a WS row.

Shape Armhole

Bind off at the beginning of RS rows 4 (6, 8, 10, 12, 14, 16) sts once, 0 (0, 0, 0, 4, 4, 5) sts 0 (0, 0, 0, 1, 1, 1) time, 3 sts 0 (1, 1, 1, 1, 1, 1) time, 2 sts 1 (1, 1, 2, 1, 2, 2) time(s), then 1 st 3 (2, 4, 3, 3, 4, 6) times – 47 (49, 52, 55, 58, 60, 61) sts remain.

Continue even until the armhole measures 6 (6, 6½, 6½, 7, 7, 7½)", end with a RS row.

Shape Neck

Bind off at the beginning of WS rows 11 (11, 11, 12, 12, 13, 13) sts once, 5 sts once, 3 sts once, 2 sts once, then decrease at the end of RS rows 1 st 3 (4, 4, 4, 5, 6, 6) times – 23 (24, 27, 29, 31, 31, 32) sts remain.

AT THE SAME TIME, when the armhole measures 7¼ (7¾, 8¼, 8¾, 9¼, 9¾, 10¼)", end with a RS row.

Shape Shoulder

Continue any remaining neck shaping.

Short Row 1 (WS): Work to the last 5 (6, 6, 7, 7, 7, 8) sts, w&t.

Short Rows 2, 4 and 6 (RS): Work to the neck.

Short Rows 3 and 5: Work to 6 (6, 7, 7, 8, 8, 8) sts before the last turn, w&t.

Next Row: Work to the end and hide wraps. Place the remaining 23 (24, 27, 29, 31, 31, 32) sts on a holder.

Button Band

With the circular needle and RS facing, pick up the edge loops of every other row along the front edge to the held sts, then return the 7 held sts to the circular needle.

Join the yarn to begin with a RS row.

Row 1 (RS): (P1, k1) 3 times, k1.

Row 2 (WS): Sl 1 wyif, (p1, k1) twice, p1, k2tog, turn.

Row 3: Sl 1 wyif, (k1, p1) twice, k2.

Repeat the last 2 rows until all the picked up stitches along the left front have been decreased out of work, ending with a WS row – 7 sts remain. Place the remaining sts on a holder.

Right Front

With the smaller needles, cast on 60 (66, 73, 79, 86, 93, 99) sts.

Row 1 (WS): K2 (2, 1, 1, 2, 1, 1), *p1, k1; repeat from * to the last 2 sts, p2.

Row 2 (RS): Sl 1 wyif, *k1, p1; repeat from * to the last 1 (1, 2, 2, 1, 2, 2) st(s), k1 (1, 2, 2, 1, 2, 2).

Repeat the last 2 rows until ribbing measures 1½" from the beginning, end with a WS row.

Set-up Row 1 (RS): Sl 1 wyib, k1, p1, ssk, yo, (k1, p1) twice, M1p, (k1, p1) twice, k1, k2tog, p1, k1, M1p, (p1, k1) 11 times, p1, M1p, k1, p1, k1, k2tog, M1p, work in the established ribbing to the end – 62 (68, 75, 81, 88, 95, 101) sts.

Size XS only

Set-up Row 2 (WS): K1, p4, (k1, p1) 4 times, pm, k2, p4, k2, pm, (p1, k1) 4 times, p5, (k1, p1) 4 times, pm, k2, p8, k2, pm, p1f&b, place the remaining 7 sts on a holder – 56 sts remain.

Size S only

Set-up Row 2 (WS): K2, (p1, k1) twice, p5, (k1, p1) 4 times, pm, k2, p4, k2, pm, (p1, k1) 4 times, p5, (k1, p1) 4 times, pm, k2, p8, k2, pm, p1f&b, place the remaining 7 sts on a holder – 62 sts remain.

Size M (XL, 3XL) only

Set-up Row 2 (WS): K1, p3 (2, 1), (k1, p1) 4 times, [k1, p5, (k1, p1) 4 times] 1 (2, 3) time(s), pm, k2, p4, k2, pm, (p1, k1) 4 times, p5, (k1, p1) 4 times, pm, k2, p8, k2, pm, p1f&b, place the remaining 7 sts on a holder – 69 (82, 95) sts remain.

Sizes L (2XL) only

Set-up Row 2 (WS): K1 (2), p1, k1 (0), p1 (0), [k1, p5, (k1, p1) 4 times] 2 (3) times, pm, k2, p4, k2, pm, (p1, k1) 4 times, p5, (k1, p1) 4 times, pm, k2, p8, k2, pm, p1f&b, place the remaining 7 sts on a holder – 75 (89) sts remain.

All Sizes

Change to the larger needles.

Next Row (RS): Working Row 1 of the Right Front Chart, work the first 43 sts of chart and slip markers as you come to them, work the 14-st repeat 0 (1, 1, 2, 2, 3, 3) time(s), work the remaining 12 (4, 11, 3, 10, 2, 9) sts after the repeat for your size, then k1.

Continue in the established pattern until piece measures 14" from the beginning, end with a RS row.



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Shape Armhole

Bind off at the beginning of WS rows 4 (6, 8, 10, 12, 14, 16) sts once, 0 (0, 0, 0, 4, 4, 5) sts 0 (0, 0, 0, 1, 1, 1) time, 3 sts 0 (1, 1, 1, 1, 1, 1) time, 2 sts 1 (1, 1, 2, 1, 2, 2) time(s), then 1 st 3 (2, 4, 3, 3, 4, 6) times – 47 (49, 52, 55, 58, 60, 61) sts remain.

Continue even until the armhole measures 6 (6, 6½, 6½, 7, 7, 7½)", end with a WS row.

Shape Neck

Bind off at the beginning of RS rows 11 (11, 11, 12, 12, 13, 13) sts once, 5 sts once, 3 sts once, 2 sts once, then decrease at the beginning of RS rows 1 st 3 (4, 4, 4, 5, 6, 6) times – 23 (24, 27, 29, 31, 31, 32) sts remain.

AT THE SAME TIME, when the armhole measures 7¼ (7¾, 8¼, 8¾, 9¼, 9¾, 10¼)", end with a WS row.

Shape Shoulder

Continue any remaining neck shaping.

Short Row 1 (RS): Work to the last 5 (6, 6, 7, 7, 7, 8) sts, w&t.

Short Rows 2, 4 and 6 (WS): Work to the neck.

Short Rows 3 and 5: Work to 6 (6, 7, 7, 8, 8, 8) sts before the last turn, w&t.

Next Row: Work to the end and hide wraps. Place the remaining 23 (24, 27, 29, 31, 31, 32) sts on a holder.

Buttonhole Band

With the circular needle and RS facing, pick up the edge loops of every other row along the front edge to the held sts. Place 6 (6, 7, 7, 7, 7, 7) markers evenly along edge to mark buttonholes (the last buttonhole will be worked in the neckband).

Return the 7 held sts to the circular needle.

Join the yarn to begin with a WS row.

Row 1 (WS): Sl 1 wyif, (p1, k1) twice, p2.

Row 2 (RS): Sl 1 wyif, (k1, p1) twice, k1, p2tog, turn.

Repeat the last 2 rows to 1 st before a marker, end with a WS row.

Buttonhole Row (RS): Sl 1 wyif, k1, p1, ssk, yo, k1, p2tog, turn.

Continue as established until all the picked up stitches along the left front have been decreased out of work, end with a RS row – 7 sts remain. Do not cut yarn. Place the remaining sts on a holder.

Sleeves (make 2)

With the smaller needles, cast on 61 (65, 69, 73, 81, 87, 91) sts.

Row 1 (WS): K2 (2, 2, 2, 2, 1, 1), *p1, k1; repeat from * to the last 1 (1, 1, 1, 1, 0, 0) st(s), k1 (1, 1, 1, 1, 0, 0).

Row 2 (RS): K1 (1, 1, 1, 1, 2, 2), *p1, k1; repeat from * to the last 0 (0, 0, 0, 0, 1, 1) st(s), k0 (0, 0, 0, 0, 1, 1).

Work 3 more rows in the established ribbing, end with a WS row.

Set-up Row 1 (RS): Work 26 (28, 30, 32, 36, 39, 41) sts in established ribbing, M1p, (k1, p1) twice, k1, k2tog, p1, k1, M1p, then work to end in established ribbing – 62 (66, 70, 74, 82, 88, 92) sts.

Sizes XS (S, 2XL, 3XL) only

Set-up Row 2 (WS): K1, p2 (4, 1, 3), [(k1, p1) 4 times, k1, p5] 1 (1, 2, 2) time(s), (k1, p1) 4 times, pm, k2, p8, k2, pm, [(p1, k1) 4 times, p5, k1] 1 (1, 2, 2) time(s), (p1, k1) 4 times, p2 (4, 1, 3), k1.

Size M only

Set-up Row 2 (WS): K1, [k1, p5, (k1, p1) 4 times] twice, pm, k2, p8, k2, pm, [(p1, k1) 4 times, p5, k1] twice, k1.

Sizes L (XL) only

Set-up Row 2 (WS): K1, (k1, p1) 1 (3) time(s), [k1, p5, (k1, p1) 4 times] twice, pm, k2, p8, k2, pm, [(p1, k1) 4 times, p5, k1] twice, (p1, k1) 1 (3) time(s), k1.

All Sizes

Next row (RS): K1, working from the Right Sleeve Chart for the right sleeve, and from the Left Sleeve Chart for the left sleeve, work the 10 (12, 0, 2, 6, 9, 11) sts before the first repeat for your size, work the 14-st repeat 1 (1, 2, 2, 2, 2, 2) time(s), sm, work the next 12 sts, sm, work the 14-st repeat 1 (1, 2, 2, 2, 2, 2) time(s), work the 10 (12, 0, 2, 6, 9, 11) sts after the second repeat for your size, then k1.

Continue in the established chart pattern.

Shape Sleeve

AT THE SAME TIME, increase 1 st each end of the 3rd row, every 6 (6, 6, 6, 6, 6, 4) rows 2 (7, 7, 5, 8, 2, 10) times, then every 8 (0, 0, 4, 0, 4, 2) rows 3 (0, 0, 3, 0, 9, 4) times – 74 (82, 86, 92, 100, 112, 122) sts. Work the new sts into the rib pattern.

Continue even until the sleeve measures 8½ (9, 9½, 10, 10½, 10½, 11)", end with a WS row.

Shape Cap

Bind off 4 (6, 8, 10, 12, 14, 16) sts at the beginning of the next 2 rows, 0 (0, 0, 0, 4, 4, 5) at the beginning of the next 0 (0, 0, 0, 2, 2, 2) rows, 3 sts at the beginning of the next 2 rows, then 2 sts at the beginning of the next 8 (8, 8, 8, 6, 10, 10) rows – 44 (48, 48, 50, 50, 50, 54) sts remain.

Decrease 1 st at each end of every RS row 4 (6, 6, 7, 7, 6, 6) times – 36 (36, 36, 36, 36, 38, 42) sts remain.

Bind off 2 sts at the beginning of the next 2 rows, 3 sts at the beginning of the next 2 rows, then 4 sts at the beginning of the next 2 rows – 18 (18, 18, 18, 18, 20, 24) sts remain.

Bind off the remaining sts.

Finishing

Weave in ends. Block to measurements.

Join shoulders using Three-Needle Bind-Off.

With the smaller needles and RS facing, return held 7 sts from buttonhole band to needle, using attached yarn, pick up and knit an odd number of sts along the right neck edge and line up sts for knit and purl sts along the front neck shaping, work the held 31 (33, 33, 35, 37, 39, 41) back neck sts in K1P1 Rib to match sts, pick up and knit an odd number of sts along the left neck edge and line up sts for knit and purl sts along the front neck shaping, then work the remaining 7 sts from the button band.

Row 1 (WS): Sl 1 wyif, *k1, p1; repeat from * to the last 5 sts, yo, ssp, k1, p2.

Row 2 (RS): Sl 1 wyif, *k1, p1; repeat from * to the last 2 sts, k2.

Work 3 more rows in established ribbing.

Bind off all sts in ribbing.

Sew buttons to button band opposite buttonholes.

Sew in sleeves. Sew side and underarm seams.

Retro Cardigan Chart Key

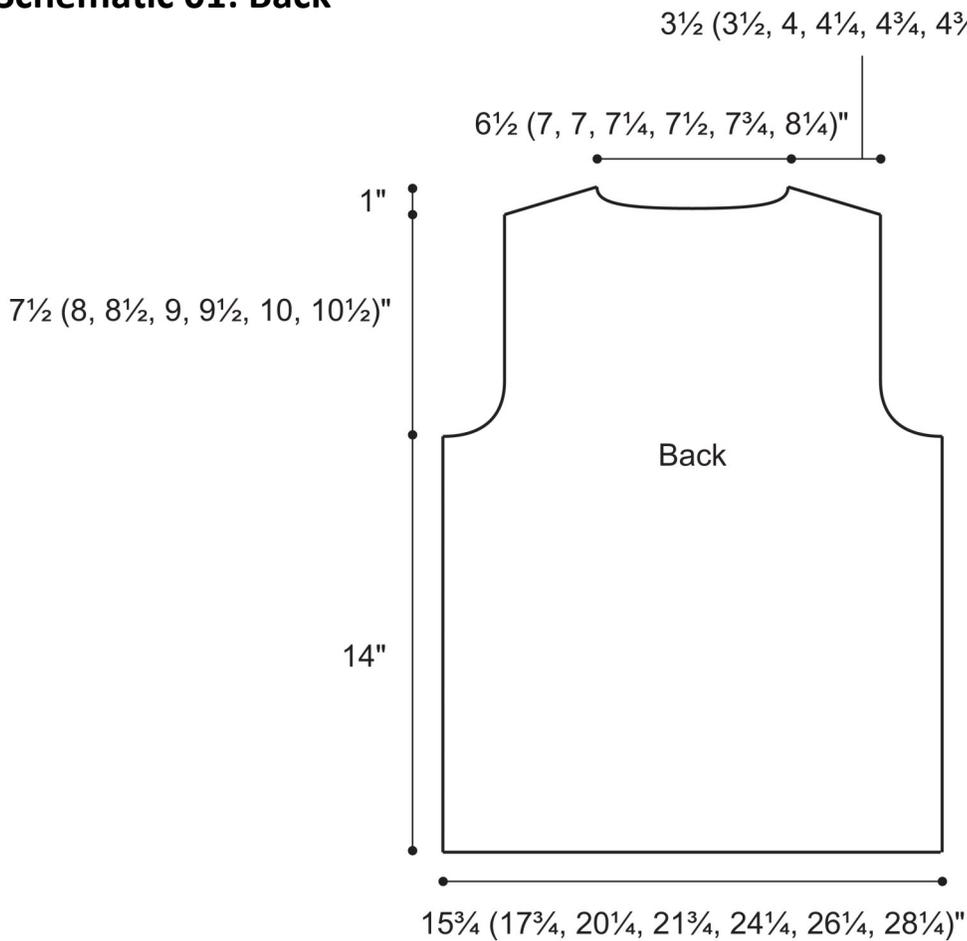
Right Front Chart



Right Sleeve Chart

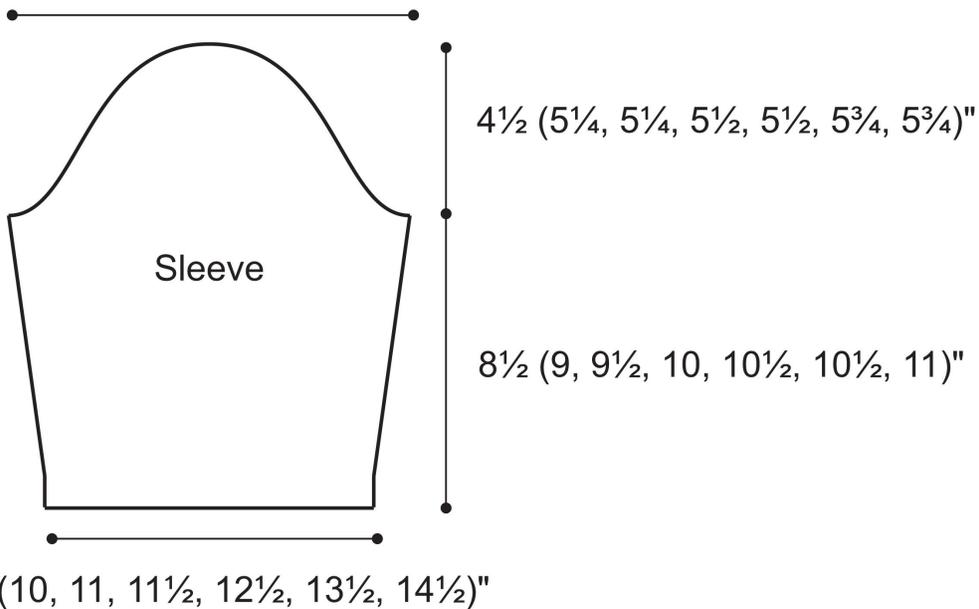


Schematic 01: Back
