

# “Gingerbread ornaments”

The pattern is written in English using US crochet terminology. Instructions are easy to follow if you are familiar with basic crochet techniques.

## Materials:

- 2.5 mm hook
  - Cotton yarn
- I used Scheepjes Catona:  
white (106, you need 64 gr), topaz (179, you need 125 gr), leftover red (115), light blue (173) and pink (238)
- Brown, pink embroidery thread
  - Safety eyes 6.00 mm
  - Stuffing
  - Yarn needle
  - Stitch marker
- I used black thread

The toys are approximately 14-16 cm height. It may vary though depending on the kind of yarn and hook size used.

You can also use any color of yarn.

Feel free to add accessories to your very own Christmas Gingerbread Ornaments.

## Abbreviations:

- ch – chain
- sc – single crochet
- st/sts - stitch/stitches
- inc – increase
- hdc – half double crochet
- inc hdc – half double crochet increase (*2 hdc in one stitch*)
- dec – decrease
- slst - slip stitch
- 5 dc-shell stitch – 5 dc in one stitch
- BLO – use the back loop only
- FLO – use the front loop only



"Gingerbread snowflake"

**BODY** (make 2)

Use topaz (179) yarn.

**Rnd 1:** 5 sc in magic ring [5]

**Rnd 2:** (inc) x5 [10]

**Rnd 3:** (sc, 3 sc in next stitch) x5, (fig 1, 2) [20]

•3 sc in next stitch: it means, crochet 3 sc together in one stitch.



3 sc in one stitch



**Rnd 4:** 2 sc, (3 sc in next stitch, 3 sc) x4, 3 sc in next st, sc [30]

**Rnd 5:** 3 sc, (3 sc in next stitch, 5 sc) x4, 3 sc in next st, 2 sc [40]

**Rnd 6:** dec, 2 sc, (3 sc in next stitch, 2 sc, dec, 3 sc) x4, 3 sc in next st, 3 sc, (fig 3) [45]



**Rnd 7:** 4 sc, (3 sc in next stitch, 8 sc) x4, 3 sc in next st, 4 sc [55]

**Rnd 8:** sc (fig 4), (put your stitch marker here. It will be the new beginning), 4 sc, (3 sc in next stitch, 4 sc, dec, 4 sc) x4, 3 sc in next st, 4 sc, dec [60]

•in this round, we replace our stitch marker one stitch forward.



**Rnd 9:** 5 sc, (3 sc in next stitch, 11 sc) x4, 3 sc in next st, 6 sc [70]

**Rnd 10:** sc, (put your stitch marker here. It will be the new beginning), 5 sc, (3 sc in next stitch, 6 sc, dec, 5 sc) x4, 3 sc in next st, 6 sc, dec, (fig 5) [75]

Cut the yarn, leave a yarn tail.

Fasten off in the invisible way.



How to invisible fasten off:

Use the needle, insert it in both loops of the second stitch after the last stitch (fig 6). Then, insert it only in the back loop and bar

of the last stitch (fig 7). Secure the yarn and hide the tail (8).



Now we are going to connect two pieces together.

Lay the two pieces together so that the wrong side of each piece will be outside (fig 9). Insert the hook in the top stitch of each piece (you can choose any top stitch of the five), pick up the yarn and pull it through (fig 10-12). Make a combination (chain 1 + sc in this stitch (top stitch (fig 13)), slst in next 15 st), repeat it 5 times (fig 14, 16).

- make a slip stitch loosely.



Stuff the start lightly (fig 15).

Cut the yarn, leave a tail. Fasten off in the invisible way.





Using the white yarn, embroider a main line from magic ring to the top (fig 17, 18). Make a small line from the main line on the right and left side (fig 19). Then, insert your needle 3 stitches below and embroider one petal on the right and left side (fig 20-21). See the short video and photo tutorials below:





"Christmas Trees"

### BODY (first type)

Use white (106) yarn.

**Chain 4.** Make sure that your chains are not twisted.

**Rnd 1:** start in second chain from the hook, inc in this stitch, sc, 3 sc in last stitch.

Continue on the other side of the foundation chain, 2 sc, slst in first st (fig 1) [8]



**Rnd 2:** ch 1, 2 inc, sc, 3 inc, sc, inc, slst in first st [14]

**Rnd 3:** ch 1, (sc, inc) x2, sc, (sc, inc) x3, 2 sc, inc, slst in first st, (fig 2) [20]

**Rnd 4:** ch 1, sc around, slst in first st [20]

**Rnd 5:** ch 1, sc, 3 inc, 7 sc, 3 inc, 6 sc, slst in first st [26]

**Rnd 6:** ch 1, sc around, slst in first st [26]

**Rnd 7:** ch 1, 3 sc, 3 inc, 10 sc, 3 inc, 7 sc, slst in first st [32]

**Rnd 8:** ch 1, sc around, slst in first st [32]

**Rnd 9:** ch 1, 5 sc, 3 inc, 13 sc, 3 inc, 8 sc, slst in first st [38]

**Rnd 10:** ch 1, sc around, slst in first st [38]

**Rnd 11:** ch 1, 2 sc, 6 dec, 7 sc, 6 dec, 5 sc, slst in first st [26]

**Rnd 12:** ch 1, 2 sc, 3 dec, 7 sc, 3 dec, 5 sc, slst in first st, (fig 3) [20]



**Rnd 13:** ch 1, 2 sc, 3 inc, 7sc, 3 inc, 5 sc, slst in first st [26]

**Rnd 14:** ch 1, sc around, slst in first st [26]

**Rnd 15:** ch 1, 4 sc, 3 inc, 10 sc, 3 inc, 6 sc, slst in first st [32]

**Rnd 16:** ch 1, sc around, slst in first st [32]

**Rnd 17:** ch 1, 6 sc, 3 inc, 13 sc, 3 inc, 7 sc, slst in first st [38]

**Rnd 18:** ch 1, sc around, slst in first st [38]

**Rnd 19:** ch 1, 8 sc, 3 inc, 16 sc, 3 inc, 8 sc, slst in first st [44]


**Rnd 20:** ch 1, sc around, slst in first st [44]

**Rnd 21:** ch 1, 10 sc, 3 inc, 19 sc, 3 inc, 9 sc, slst in first st [50]

**Rnd 22:** ch 1, sc around, slst in first st [50]

**Rnd 23:** ch 1, 7 sc, 6 dec, 13 sc, 6 dec, 6 sc, slst in first st [38]

**Rnd 24:** ch 1, 7 sc, 3 dec, 13 sc, 3 dec, 6 sc, slst in first st, (fig 4) [32]



**Rnd 25:** ch 1, 7 sc, 3 inc, 13 sc, 3 inc, 6 sc, slst in first st [38]

**Rnd 26:** ch 1, sc around, slst in first st [38]

**Rnd 27:** ch 1, 9 sc, 3 inc, 16 sc, 3 inc, 7 sc, slst in first st [44]

**Rnd 28:** ch 1, sc around, slst in first st [44]

**Rnd 29:** ch 1, 11 sc, 3 inc, 19 sc, 3 inc, 8 sc, slst in first st [50]

**Rnd 30:** ch 1, sc around, slst in first st [50]

**Rnd 31:** ch 1, 13 sc, 3 inc, 22 sc, 3 inc, 9 sc, slst in first st [56]

**Rnd 32:** ch 1, sc around, slst in first st [56]

**Rnd 33:** ch 1, 10 sc, 6 dec, 16 sc, 6 dec, 6 sc, slst in first st [44]

Crochet 13 sc more (fig 5) after you've finished the last round to bring yarn at the corner of the body.

Cut the yarn, leaving a yarn tail.

Stuff the tree lightly.



***How to finish:***

Using the long tail of yarn, start from the first loop. Sew the opening through front loops by going across each stitch (fig 6-8).

Weave in the yarn tail.

Embroider the sugar sprinkles on the Christmas tree using the French knots and two different color of yarns.

### BODY (second type)

Use white (106) and topaz (179) yarn.

Start with white yarn, follow the pattern body from round 1 to 18 on page 5.

**Rnd 19:** ch 1, 8 sc, 3 inc, 16 sc, 3 inc, 8 sc, change the yarn to topaz and place the white yarn on the front of your work (We will use the white yarn later to make the glaze) (fig 1-3), slst in first st [44]

**Rnd 20:** ch 1, BLO (use only back loops): sc around, slst in first st, (fig 4) [44]

To make the next rounds, follow the pattern body on page 5 and 6.





## GLAZE

Use white (106) yarn.

Lay the body with back side so that the tip is at the top and away from your face (fig 6). Then, insert your hook in last front loop of round 19 (fig 7). Pick up the yarn and pull it through. Chain 3, start in second chain from hook: 2 slst, slst in next two front loops of the body (fig 8, 9).

Chain 4, start in second chain from the hook: 3 slst, slst in next 2 front loops of the body;

Chain 2 – 1 slst, slst in next 2 body loops;

Chain 3 – 2 slst, slst in next 2 body loops;

Chain 2 – 1 slst, slst in next 2 body loops, repeat it 3 times;

Chain 3 – 2 slst, slst in next 2 body loops;

Chain 4 – 3 slst, slst in next 2 body loops;

Chain 2 – 1 slst, slst in next 2 body loops;

Chain 3 – 2 slst, slst in next 2 body loops;

Chain 4 – 3 slst, slst in next 2 body loops;

Chain 3 – 2 slst, slst in next 2 body loops;

Chain 4 – 3 slst, slst in next 2 body loops;

Chain 2 – 1 slst, slst in next 2 body loops, repeat it 3 times;

Chain 3 – 2 slst, slst in next 2 body loops;

Chain 4 – 3 slst, slst in next 2 body loops;

Chain 2 – 1 slst, slst in next 2 body loops;

Chain 4 – 3 slst, slst in next 2 body loops;

Chain 3 – 2 slst, slst in last loop;

Cut the yarn, leaving a long tail.

Use the needle, sew each piece of the glaze to the body (fig 11-13).



Use the two different color of yarn, embroider the sugar sprinkles on the body with the French knots (fig 14).



## HEART

Use white (106) and topaz (179) yarn.

Start with white yarn:

Make 2 pieces:

**Rnd 1:** 6 sc in magic ring [6]

**Rnd 2:** (inc) x6 [12]

**Rnd 3:** (inc, sc) x6 [18]

**Rnd 4:** (2 sc, inc) x6 [24]

**Rnd 5:** sc around [24]

**Rnd 6:** (inc, 3 sc) x6 [30]


**Rnd 7-8:** sc around [30], **2 rounds**

Cut the yarn, leaving a tail.

Fasten off in the invisible way (fig 1, 2).

Now we are going to connect two pieces together (fig 3).







Insert your hook first into the right piece then into the left from the wrong side (*you could choose any stitch*). Pick up the yarn and pull it through (fig 5). Chain 1, insert your hook again into the same stitch of left piece and make a single crochet (fig 6). Put your stitch marker here, it will be the new beginning of round 9. Follow the pattern below:



**Rnd 9:** two pieces together: 30 sc around the left piece, 30 sc around the right piece, (fig 7) [60]

**Rnd 10:** sc around [60]



**Rnd 11:** (dec, 8 sc) x6 [54]

**Rnd 12-14:** sc around, (fig 8) [54], **3 rounds**

**Change the yarn to topaz and place the white yarn on the front of your work after changing the yarn.**

We will use it later to make the glaze.

**Rnd 15: BLO (use only back loops):** sc around [54]

**Rnd 16:** (dec, 7 sc) x6 [48]

**Rnd 17-18:** sc around [48], **2 rounds**

**Rnd 19:** (dec, 6 sc) x6, (fig 9) [42]



**Rnd 20-21:** sc around [42], **2 rounds**

**Rnd 22:** (dec, 5 sc) x6 [36]

**Rnd 23:** sc around [36]

**Rnd 24:** (dec, 4 sc) x6 [30]

Start to stuff the heart.

**Rnd 25:** sc around [30]

**Rnd 26:** (dec, 3 sc) x6 [24]

**Rnd 27:** sc around [24]

**Rnd 28:** (dec, 2 sc) x6 [18]

**Rnd 29:** (dec, sc) x6 [12]

Cut the yarn, leaving a tail.

Finish stuffing. Close the end of the round.

How to close the end of the round: with a darning needle, insert the remaining yarn through all the front loops of the stitches on the last round (fig 10, 10a). Pull all together at once and hide the yarn inside the heart (fig 11).

## GLAZE

*Use white (106) yarn.*

Lay the body with back side so that the tip is at the top and away from your face. Then, insert your hook in last front loop of round 14 (fig 13). Pick up the yarn and pull it through. Chain 4, start in second chain from hook: 3 slst, slst in next two front loops of the body (fig 14, 15).

Chain 3, start in second chain from the hook: 2 slst, slst in next 2 front loops of the body;

Chain 4 – 3 slst, slst in next 2 body loops;

Chain 2 – slst, slst in next 2 body loops;

Chain 4 – 2 slst, slst in next 2 body loops, repeat it 2 times;

Chain 3 – 2 slst, slst in next 2 body loops;

Chain 4 – 3 slst, slst in next 2 body loops;  
 Chain 5 – 4 slst, slst in next 2 body loops;  
 Chain 3 – 2 slst, slst in next 2 body loops,  
 repeat it 2 times;  
 Chain 4 – 3 slst, slst in next 2 body loops;  
 Chain 5 – 4 slst, slst in next 2 body loops;  
 Chain 3 – 2 slst, slst in next 2 body loops,  
 repeat it 2 times;  
 Chain 4 – 3 slst, slst in next 2 body loops;  
 Chain 2 – slst, slst in next 2 body loops;  
 Chain 4 – 3 slst, slst in next 2 body loops;  
 Chain 3 – 2 slst, slst in next 2 body loops,  
 repeat it 2 times;  
 Chain 5 – 4 slst, slst in next 2 body loops;  
 Chain 3 – 2 slst, slst in next 2 body loops;  
 Chain 2 – slst, slst in last front loop.  
 Cut the yarn, leaving a long tail (fig 16).  
 Use the needle, sew the each glaze piece to  
 the body (fig 17-18).

Embroider the sugar sprinkles on the body  
 using the French knots and two different  
 color of yarn (fig 19-20).





"Gingerbread houses"

## BODY

Use topaz (179) yarn.

**Chain 5. Make sure that your chains are not twisted.**

**Rnd 1:** start in second chain from the hook, inc in this stitch, 2 sc, 3 sc in last stitch.

Continue on the other side of the foundation chain, 3 sc, slst in first st [10]

**Rnd 2:** ch 1, 2 inc, 2 sc, 3 inc, 2 sc, inc, slst in first st [16]

**Rnd 3:** ch 1, (sc, inc) x2, 2 sc, (sc, inc) x3, 3 sc, inc, slst in first st [22]

**Rnd 4:** ch 1, sc around, slst in first st [22]

**Rnd 5:** ch 1, sc, 3 inc, 8 sc, 3 inc, 7 sc, slst in first st [28]

**Rnd 6:** ch 1, sc around, slst in first st [28]

**Rnd 7:** ch 1, 3 sc, 3 inc, 11 sc, 3 inc, 8 sc, slst in first st [34]

**Rnd 8:** ch 1, sc around, slst in first st, (fig 1) [34]



**Rnd 9:** ch 1, 5 sc, 3 inc, 14 sc, 3 inc, 9 sc, slst in first st [40]

**Rnd 10:** ch 1, sc around, slst in first st [40]

**Rnd 11:** ch 1, 7 sc, 3 inc, 17 sc, 3 inc, 10 sc, slst in first st [46]

**Rnd 12:** ch 1, sc around, slst in first st [46]

**Rnd 13:** ch 1, 9 sc, 3 inc, 20 sc, 3 inc, 11 sc, slst in first st [52]

**Rnd 14:** ch 1, sc around, slst in first st [52]

**Rnd 15:** ch 1, 11 sc, 3 inc, 23 sc, 3 inc, 12 sc, slst in first st [58]

**Rnd 16:** ch 1, sc around, slst in first st [58]

**Rnd 17:** ch 1, 13 sc, 3 inc, 26 sc, 3 inc, 13 sc, slst in first st [64]

**Rnd 18:** ch 1, sc around, slst in first st [64]

**Rnd 19:** ch 1, 10 sc, 6 dec, 20 sc, 6 dec, 10 sc, slst in first st [52]

**Rnd 20:** ch 1, 10 sc, 3 dec, 20 sc, 3 dec, 10 sc, slst in first st, (fig 2) [46]



**Rnd 21-30:** ch 1, sc around, slst in first st [46], **10 rounds**

**Rnd 31:** ch 1, 9 sc, (dec, sc) x2, dec, 15 sc, (dec, sc) x2, dec, 6 sc, slst in first st [40]

**Rnd 31:** ch 1, 9 sc, 3 dec, 14 sc, 3 dec, 5 sc, slst in first st [34]

Crochet 10 sc more after you've finished the last round to bring yarn at the corner of the body.

Cut the yarn, leaving a yarn tail.

Stuff the body lightly.

Close the opening in the same way as the Christmas tree (fig 3-6).



Cut the yarn, leaving a tail for sewing.

Fasten off in the invisible way (fig 7).

Lay the door horizontally facing you. Attach

the white yarn in the back loop in the corner (fig 8). Chain 1, slst in next loop, repeat this combination (ch 1 + slst) in each loop

around the door (fig 9-10). Fasten off.



## DOOR

*Use topaz (179) and white (106) yarn.*

**Chain 7. Make sure that your chains are not twisted.**

**Rnd 1:** start in second chain from the hook: dc in this stitch, 4 dc, 6 dc in last stitch.

Continue on the other side of the foundation chain, 4 dc, ch 2 + slst in last chain st [16]

---

## PINWHEEL CANDY

---

Use white (106) and red (115) yarn.

Start with white:

**Rnd 1:** in magic ring: ch 1, (white yarn: 2 dc, red yarn: 2 dc) x4 [16]

Cut the white and red yarn, fasten off (fig 11, 12).

Leave a tail for sewing.

## WREATH and BOW

---

Use white (106) and red (115) yarn.

Start with white:

**Chain 12**, join with slst in first chain st.

**Rnd 1:** ch 2, (inc dc) x12 [24]

Cut the yarn, leaving a tail.

Fasten off in the invisible way (fig 13).



**Bow (red yarn):** in magic ring: (ch 2 + 2 dc + ch 2 + slst)x2

Cut the yarn, leaving a tail.

Wrap the yarn around the bow few times, secure it with knot.

Sew the bow on the bottom of the wreath (fig 14-15). After finished it, leave two small tails.



---

## CANDY CANE (make 2)

---


Use white (106) yarn.

**Chain 11.** Make sure that your chains are not twisted.

**Rnd 1:** start in second chain from hook: slst in each back ridge loop, (fig 16-18) [10]

Cut the yarn, leaving a tail.

Make a hook shape form from the one end of our lace by curving it inside (fig 19).





### ROOF DECORATION *(make 2)*

Use white (106) yarn.

**Chain 16.** Make sure that your chains are not twisted.

**Rnd 1:** start in second chain from hook: slst in each back ridge loop, (fig 20) [15]

Cut the yarn, leaving a tail.

Curve up our lace in the shape of a figure eight when the one end has one direction and the other end in the opposite as shown on photo 21.



### OUTLINE LACE *(long)*

Use white (106) yarn.

**Chain 78.**

Cut the yarn, leaving a long tail.



### ASSEMBLING:

Place the lace with wrong side so that it represents the outline of the house, then use the pins secure it to the body (fig 23-26). Do it 3-5 mm from the edges.

Then, use the remaining yarn tail, sew the lace to the body across few stitches as shown on photo 27-30.

Place the door, wreath and pinwheel candy as shown on photo 31. Sew them the body using the back loops (fig 32-36).

Place the candy canes on the both sides from the door as shown on photo. Sew them to the body using back loops (fig 37-39). After we've finished, make few lines on the candy using the red yarn (fig 40, 41).

At last, sew the figure eight roof decoration on both sides from the wreath. Sew them by using back loops (fig 42-44).

•to make another gingerbread house, use the pattern body and door on page 13-14. Pattern roof, icicles and window is below.

## ROOF

Use white (106) yarn.

**Chain 38.** Make sure that your chains are not twisted.

**Rnd 1:** start in second chain from the hook: inc in this stitch, 35 sc, 3 sc in last stitch. Continue on the other side of the foundation chain, 36 sc, slst in last chain st [76]

**Rnd 2:** ch 1, **BLO (use only back loops):** sc, (skip next loop, 5 dc-shell stitch, skip next loop, sc in next loop) x9 (fig 2-4), 4 sc, continue working on the other side, (skip next loop, 5 dc-shell stitch, skip next loop, sc in next loop) x9 (fig 5, 6), slst in first st. Cut the yarn, leaving a long tail.



## WINDOW

Use topaz (179) and (106) yarn.

Start with topaz yarn:

**Rnd 1:** in magic ring: ch 1 + 15 dc. Fasten off in the invisible way (fig 7).

**Rnd 2:** attach the white yarn to the back loop: ch 1, sc in this loop, sc in next 15 loops.

Fasten of in the invisible way, leaving a tail.



## ICICLES

*Use white (106) yarn.*

Chain 3, start in second chain from the hook: 2 slst

(Chain 4, start in second chain from the hook: 2 slst), repeat it 11 times.

Chain 3, start in second chain from hook: 2 slst.

Cut the yarn, leaving a tail.



## ASSEMBLING:

Place and sew the door to the body between round 23 and 31 (fig 13).



Place the white glaze roof with wrong side outside on the top and on the sides of the body (fig 14, 15). You should sewn the roof only on the shell stitches using back loops (fig 16-17).





Sew the window to the body between round 10 and 16 using the back loops (fig 18).



Sew the icicles to the body on round 18 (fig 19, 20).



At last, use the white yarn, embroider the sugar sprinkles on the roof with the french knots (fig 21, 22).





"Gingerbread Candy Cane"

## CANDY CANE

Use topaz (179) and white (106) yarn.

Before to crochet the candy, take a piece of metal wire (around 36-38 cm long), fold it in half and wrap the tape around. We will put it inside of the body later (fig 1, 2).



**Rnd 1:** topaz yarn: 6 sc in magic ring [6]

**Rnd 2:** topaz yarn: (inc) x6 [12]

**Rnd 3:** topaz yarn: (3 sc, inc) x2, 4 sc [14]

**Rnd 4:** (white yarn: 2 sc, topaz yarn: 3 sc) x2, white yarn: 2 sc, topaz yarn: 2 sc [14]

**Rnd 5:** topaz yarn: sc, (white yarn: 2 sc, topaz yarn: 3 sc) x2, white yarn: 2 sc, topaz yarn: sc, [14]



**Rnd 6:** topaz yarn: 2 sc, (white yarn: 2 sc, topaz yarn: 3 sc) x2, white yarn: 2 sc [14]

**Rnd 7:** (topaz yarn: 3 sc, white yarn: 2 sc) x2, topaz yarn: 3 sc, white yarn: sc [14]

**Rnd 8:** white yarn: sc, (topaz yarn: 3 sc, white yarn: 2 sc) x2, topaz yarn: 3 sc, (fig 3) [14]

Insert the metal wire inside of the body and crochet next rounds in spiral. In other way your body will be twisted.



Repeat 8 more times the combination of round 4-5-6-7-8 (fig 4).

Cut the white yarn and continue with topaz.

...**Rnd...** topaz yarn: (5 sc, dec) x2 [12]

...**Rnd...** topaz yarn: sc around [12]

Cut the yarn, leaving a tail.

Fasten off in the invisible way.

I don't stuff the candy, metal wire with tape is enough for body.

Fold the body making the hook form.



### ARMS (make 2)

Use topaz (179) yarn.

**Rnd 1:** 6 sc in magic ring [6]

**Rnd 2:** (inc) x6 [12]

**Rnd 3:** (3 sc, inc) x3 [15]

**Rnd 4:** sc around [15]

**Rnd 5-6-7:** dec, 6 sc, inc, 6 sc [15]

Cut the yarn, leaving a tail.

Fasten off in the invisible way (fig 1-3).



### FOOT (make 2)

Use topaz (179) yarn.

**Rnd 1:** 6 sc in magic ring [6]

**Rnd 2:** (inc) x6 [12]

**Rnd 3:** (inc, sc) x5, 2 inc [19]

**Rnd 4:** sc around [19]

**Rnd 5-6-7-8-9:** dec, 8 sc, inc, 8 sc [19]

Cut the yarn, leaving a tail.

Fasten off in the invisible way (fig 4).



Now we are going to connect the foot together.

### BODY

Continue with topaz yarn.

In the next round, we will connect the feet.


**Namely, we will use the increase stitch (11<sup>th</sup> stitch, after fasten off) (fig 5, 6).**

Insert hook from wrong side of the right foot out to the left (fig 7-9). Pick up the yarn and pull in through. Chain 1, insert your hook again the connecting stitch of the left foot and crochet sc (fig 10). It will be a first stitch of the body. Place your stitch marker here.



**Rnd 1:** two foot together: chain 1, sc in the connecting st of the left foot, sc in next 18 st (fig 11), sc in the connecting st of the right foot (fig 12), sc in next 18 st [38]



**Rnd 2:** 9 sc, dec, 17 sc, dec, 8 sc [36]

**Rnd 3:** sc around [36]

**Rnd 4:** 9 sc, dec, 16 sc, dec, 7 sc, (fig 13) [34]

**Rnd 5-6:** sc around [34], **2 rounds**

**Rnd 7:** 10 sc, attach the left arm, insert your hook in the increase stitch (9<sup>th</sup> stitch after fasten off), sc in this stitch (fig 14, 15), sc in next 14 st of the arm (fig 16), continue crochet on the body: 17 sc, attach the right arm, insert your hook in the increase stitch (9<sup>th</sup> stitch after fasten off) (fig 17), sc in this stitch, sc in next 14 st of the arm, continue on the body: 7 sc, (fig 18) [64]

**Rnd 8:** 17 sc, dec, 30 sc, dec, 13 sc [62]

**Rnd 9:** 9 sc, dec, 13 sc, dec, 14 sc, dec, 13 sc, dec, 5 sc [58]

Stuff the feet, arms and body lightly.

**Rnd 10:** 8 sc, dec, 6 sc, dec, 5 sc, dec, 12 sc, dec, 6 sc, dec, 5 sc, dec, 4 sc [52]

**Rnd 11:** 7 sc, dec, 12 sc, dec, 10 sc, dec, 12 sc, dec, 3 sc [48]

**Rnd 12:** 6 sc, (dec, 5 sc) x2, dec, 8 sc, (dec, 5 sc) x2, dec, 2 sc [42]

**Rnd 13:** 5 sc, dec, 11 sc, dec, 6 sc, dec, 11 sc, dec, sc [38]

**Rnd 14:** 4 sc, dec, 5 sc, (dec, 4 sc) x2, dec, 5 sc, dec, 4 sc, dec, (fig 19) [32]



**Rnd 15:** sc (fig 20), place your stitch marker here. It will be the new beginning, 2 sc, dec, 10 sc, dec, 2 sc, dec, 10 sc, dec [26]

**Rnd 16:** sc, place your stitch marker here. It will be the new beginning, (dec, 4 sc) x2, 2 dec, (4 sc, dec) x2 [22]

**Rnd 17:** 2 sc, dec, 3 sc, dec, 4 sc, dec, 3 sc, dec, 2 sc [18]

Stuff the body lightly (fig 21).

Don't cut the yarn, we are going to crochet the head.



## HEAD

*Continue with topaz yarn.*

**Rnd 18:** 4 sc, 3 inc, 6 sc, 3 inc, 2 sc [24]

**Rnd 19:** 4 sc, (sc, inc) x3, 6 sc, (sc, inc) x3, 2 sc [30]

**Rnd 20:** sc, (inc, 4 sc) x5, inc, 3 sc [36]

**Rnd 21-29:** sc around [36], **9 rounds**

Attach the eyes between round 24 and 25 with 6 st between. Skip 17 st from the beginning, attach the first eye, then skip 6 st and attach the second eye (fig 22).



**Rnd 30:** (dec, 4 sc) x6 [30]

**Rnd 31:** sc around [30]

**Rnd 32:** (dec, 3 sc) x6 [24]

Stuff the head lightly.

**Rnd 33:** (dec, 2 sc) x6 [18]

**Rnd 34:** (dec, sc) x6 [12]

Cut the yarn, leaving a tail.

Close the head in the same way as the heart (fig 23).



## BOW

Use white (106) yarn.

In magic ring: (ch 2 + 5 tr +ch 2 + slst) x2

Cut the yarn, leaving a tail.

Wrap the yarn around the bow few times, secure it with knot.



## BUTTONS

Use white (106) yarn.

In magic ring: 7 sc [7]

Invisible fasten off.

## HAIR

Use white (106) yarn.

**Chain 8.** Start in second chain from hook: slst in each back ridge loop [7]

**Chain 11.** Start in second chain from hook: slst in each back ridge loop [10]

Cut the yarn, leaving a tail (fig 25).



## Glage:

Hold the body upside down with the front facing you. Use the white yarn, make a slip stitch in each stitch around the feet on round 4 (fig 27-30) and arms on round 3 (fig 31). You should attached the yarn from the side (fig 26).

Sew the bow and buttons on the front side of the body as shown on photo 32 using the back loops.

Sew the hair on the top of the head (fig 34, 35) using the back loops.

At last, embroider the pink cheeks below the eyes and the mouth using brown thread.



## SKIRT

Use white (106) yarn.

Chain 32, join with slst in first chain st (fig 37).

**Rnd 1:** ch 1, 32 sc, slst in first st [32]

**Row 2:** ch 5, start in second chain from hook: 4 sc, slst in first st, turn, (fig 38, 39) [4]

**Row 3:** BLO: 4 sc, turn, (fig 40) [4]



**Row 4:** BLO: 4 sc, slst in next st, turn, (fig 41-43) [4]

Repeat the combination of the row 3 + row 4 in each stitch.

After finished the last row, connect two sides together with slst (fig 44).
