



Misty Mountains Melody Sweater



This sweater consists of the **back piece**, the **front piece**, the **sleeves**, the **collar**, **tassels and embroidery**. Start by knitting the front and back pieces, and join them together by the shoulders. After that, knit and sew the sleeves to the sides of the body. Next, pick up stitches around the neckline to work on the collar. Lastly, put on tassels and embroider the pattern.



Size (cm)	Cloth Length	Bust	Sleeve Length
S	60	61	35.5
L	62.5	65	37

The handcrafted measurements may have an error of 1 to 2cm. Due to variations in individual tension, the size of the sample is for reference only.

Chart references **A B C** ... align with video's **A B C** ...

Chart Key


- P on RS, K on WS:** purl on right side, knit on wrong side
- K on RS, P on WS:** knit on right side, purl on wrong side
- dsl:** double legs slip stitch, slip the stitch purlwise and bring the yarn to the back and pull it tightly, so that both legs of the stitch in the row below are on the needle.
- LLI:** left lifted increase
- RLI:** right lifted increase
- k2tog:** knit 2 stitches together
- skp(o):** slip 1 stitch knitwise, knit next stitch, pass slipped stitch over

Materials: Susan's Family Morandi 6#, South African Soft Mohair Mixed Hand-Knitting Yarn, Lamb Wool


Needles: 4.00 mm circular needle (80 cm), 4.00 mm straight needles (25cm*4) for the S size.
4.50 mm circular needle (80 cm), 4.50 mm straight needles (25cm*4) for the L size.

Note: This pattern is written using **American terminology**. All measurements in charts are in cm.

Garment Structure Diagram



Before you start knitting, make a gauge sample.



Gauge: 10x10cm in pattern st
[S: 23 sts, 31 rows]
[L: 22 sts, 30 rows]

- Notes:**
- The collar is worked using straight needles, and the rest is worked using circular needles.
 - The left and right on the charts refer to the actual left and right when worn.
 - On the wrong side, work the stitches opposite to those shown in the pattern chart.





Note: Mainly use the intarsia knitting, a few use the stranded knitting.

left shoulder: connect to the back piece (44sts)



Reserve about 2m yarn long tail cast on 144 sts





Part 3 Sleeves and sewing

After the sleeves are completed, use the remaining yarn to sew the sides together. Then, sew the sleeve to the armhole and sew the sides of the front and back pieces together.

The tassels on the top and sleeves, the length of the thread used is 6-7 cm.

Part 5 Tassels and embroidery **E**

Once the sweater is finished, you'll need to put on the tassels and embroider the birds.

Remaining positions	Hold 2 Lamb Wool together	17#Quiet Gray	01#Whisper White	16#Iceberg Green



The front tassels of right sleeve




The back tassels of right sleeve



Secure a round of tassels on the left sleeve

[Embroider the flying birds]

The small birds can be embroidered using the outline stitch, with 1 South African Soft Mohair Mixed Hand-Knitting Yarn or 1 Lamb Wool.




The big birds can be embroidered using the outline stitch, with 2 South African Soft Mohair Mixed Hand-Knitting Yarn or 2 Lamb Wool hold together.

On the front piece, embroider various sizes of flying birds randomly (The embroidery thread colors just need to be different from the fabric piece's color).

For large birds, using the outline stitch, with 2 South African Soft Mohair Mixed Hand-Knitting Yarn or 2 Lamb Wool hold together. Once done, fill in the space of the outlines.

[Single tassel making process diagram]

① Take a piece of yarn with the proper length, fold the yarns in half.



② Draw the tails through the loops, give it a gentle tug to tighten.



③ Finished.
