**This crochet pattern will help you make a crocheted Easter eggs.**

**This tutorial is easy to follow.**

**It includes 16 pages of descriptions of how to make a amigurumi easter eggs and 30 step-by-step photos of the process.**

**Difficulty: medium, but you should know the basic stitches: single crochet, double crochet, increase, decrease.**

**Please note that you can use yarn of any color.**

**The materials offered in this template will help you create a amigurumi easter eggs that will be identical to the one shown in the photos.**

**If you decide to use the suggested materials and tools, your easter eggs will be about 3.14-3.93 inches (8-10 cm) in height if made with a 1.75 hook.**

## Materials and tools

- **Sport weight/4ply yarn Alize Cotton gold (100g/330m)**  
**216** yellow, **493** brown, **55** white, **56** red, **60** black, **21** grey, **514** light blue
- Crochet hook - 1.75 mm or any type you prefer
- Fiberfill
- Scissors
- Needle for embroidery and sewing pieces
- Pins for attaching details
- Markers



**These materials are only a list of my recommendation to help you create the toy like mine. You could use any type/size of the yarn and the hook, but you must understand it will affect the toy's final look.**

# Abbreviations

**MR** - Magic ring

**sc** - single crochet

**dc** - double crochet

**inc** - increase

**dec** - decrease

**sl st** - slip stitch

**ch** - chain

**\*6** - number of repeats

**(12)** - total number of stitches in a round

Choose the correct hook size which is appropriate for the yarn you are going to use. Your choice can be different from mine, but please pay attention to the fact, that the size of the toy will be different when you use other yarn and other hook size.

Use a stitch marker for your convenience and rounds counting.

Stuff all the pieces as you go, firmly (unless otherwise stated), gradually adding small portions of stuffing and forming necessary shapes of pieces.



# Bee

## BASE

**Start crocheting with brown thread. Stuff with fiberfill in the process.**

**1.** 6 sc in MR

**2.** 6 inc (12)

**3.** (1 sc, inc) \* 6 (18)

**Change color to yellow.**

**4.** (2 sc, inc) \* 6 (24)

**5.** (3 sc, inc) \* 6 (30)

**6.** 30 sc

**Change color to brown.**

**7.** (4 sc, inc) \* 6 (36)

**8-9.** 36 sc (2 rounds)

**Change color to yellow.**

**10.** (5 sc, inc) \* 6 (42)

**11-12.** 42 sc (2 rounds)

**Change color to brown.**

**13.** (6 sc, inc) \* 6 (48)

**14-15.** 48 sc (2 rounds)

**Change color to yellow.**

**16-18.** 48 sc (3 rounds)

**Change color to brown.**

**19-21.** 48 sc (3 rounds)



**Change color to yellow.**

**22.** (4 sc, dec) \* 8 (40)

**23.** (3 sc, dec) \* 8 (32)

**24.** (2 sc, dec) \* 8 (24)

**Change color to brown.**

**25.** (1 sc, dec) \* 8 (16)

**26.** 8 dec (8)

**Cut the yarn, fasten off, sew the hole and hide the yarn tail inside the detail. (photo 1, 2)**

## **Insect antennae (make 2)**

**Start crocheting with brown thread.**

**Make chain 8, start to crochet on the third chain from the hook:**

**1.** 2 dc, 4 sl st

**Cut the yarn, fasten off, leaving a long thread for sewing. (photo 3)**



## Wings (make 2)

**Start crocheting with white thread. Don't stuff!**

1. 6 sc in MR
2. 6 inc (12)
3. 12 sc
4. (2 sc, dec) \* 3 (9)
5. 9 sc
6. (1 sc, dec) \* 3 (6)

Cut the yarn, fasten off, leaving a long thread for sewing. (photo 4)



## Flower

**Start crocheting with yellow thread.**


1. 5 sc in MR

Change color to white.

2. In one stitch: (sl st, ch 2, 2 dc, ch 2, sl st) \* 5

Cut the yarn, fasten off, leaving a long thread for sewing.

(photo 5-7)



**Sew the Insect antennae symmetrically to the base between 1st and 2nd Rounds. (photo 8)**

**Sew the wings symmetrically to the base between 6th and 7th Rounds. (photo 9, 10)**

**Sew the flower to the bee. (photo 11)**



# Ladybug

## BASE

**Start crocheting with black thread. Stuff with fiberfill in the process.**

**1.** 6 sc in MR

**2.** 6 inc (12)

**3.** (1 sc, inc) \* 6 (18)

**Change color to red.**

**4.** (2 sc, inc) \* 6 (24)

**5.** (3 sc, inc) \* 6 (30)

**6.** 30 sc

**7.** (4 sc, inc) \* 6 (36)

**8-9.** 36 sc (2 rounds)

**10.** (5 sc, inc) \* 6 (42)

**11-12.** 42 sc (2 rounds)

**13.** (6 sc, inc) \* 6 (48)

**14-21.** 48 sc (8 rounds)

**22.** (4 sc, dec) \* 8 (40)

**23.** (3 sc, dec) \* 8 (32)

**24.** (2 sc, dec) \* 8 (24)

**25.** (1 sc, dec) \* 8 (16)

**26.** 8 dec (8)

**Cut the yarn, fasten off, sew the hole and hide the yarn tail inside the detail. (photo 12, 13)**



## Insect antennae (make 2)

Start crocheting with black thread.

Make chain 8, start to crochet on the third chain from the hook:

1. 2 dc, 4 sl st

Cut the yarn, fasten off, leaving a long thread for sewing. (photo 14)



## Wings (make 2)

Start crocheting with white thread. Don't stuff!

1. 6 sc in MR

2. 6 inc (12)

3. 12 sc

4. (2 sc, dec) \* 3 (9)

5. 9 sc

6. (1 sc, dec) \* 3 (6)

Cut the yarn, fasten off, leaving a long thread for sewing. (photo 15)



## Specks (make 9)

**Start crocheting with black thread.**

**1. 5 sc in MR**

**Cut the yarn, fasten off, leaving a long thread for sewing. (photo 16)**



## Flower

**Start crocheting with yellow thread.**

**1. 5 sc in MR**

**Change color to light blue.**

**2. In one stitch: (sl st, ch 2, 2 dc, ch 2, sl st) \* 5**

**Cut the yarn, fasten off, leaving a long thread for sewing. (photo 17)**



Sew the Insect antennae symmetrically to the base between 1st and 2nd Rounds. (photo 18)

Sew the wings symmetrically to the base between 6th and 7th Rounds. (photo 19, 20)

Sew the specks to the base. (photo 21, 22)

Sew the flower to the ladybug. (photo 23)



# Bunny

## BASE

**Start crocheting with grey thread. Stuff with fiberfill in the process.**

1. 6 sc in MR
2. 6 inc (12)
3. (1 sc, inc) \* 6 (18)
4. (2 sc, inc) \* 6 (24)
5. (3 sc, inc) \* 6 (30)
6. 30 sc
7. (4 sc, inc) \* 6 (36)
- 8-9. 36 sc (2 rounds)
10. (5 sc, inc) \* 6 (42)
- 11-12. 42 sc (2 rounds)
13. (6 sc, inc) \* 6 (48)
- 14-21. 48 sc (8 rounds)
22. (4 sc, dec) \* 8 (40)
23. (3 sc, dec) \* 8 (32)
24. (2 sc, dec) \* 8 (24)
25. (1 sc, dec) \* 8 (16)
26. 8 dec (8)



**Cut the yarn, fasten off, sew the hole and hide the yarn tail inside the detail. (photo 24)**

## Ears (make 2)

**Start crocheting with grey thread. Don't stuff!**

1. 6 sc in MR
2. 6 inc (12)
3. (3 sc, inc) \* 3 (15)

**4-13. 15 sc (10 rounds)**

**Straighten your ears and align the stitches side by side.**

**Close the open end with a hook 7 sc across. (photo 25)**

**Fold in half again and crochet 3 sc.**

**Cut the yarn, fasten off, leaving a long thread for sewing. (photo 26)**



## Flowers (make 8)

**Start crocheting with yellow thread.**

1. 5 sc in MR

**Change color to white or light blue.**

2. In one stitch: (sl st, ch 2, 2 dc, ch 2, sl st) \* 5

**Cut the yarn, fasten off, leaving a long thread for sewing. (photo 27)**

Sew the ears to the base between 2nd and 3rd Rounds. (photo 28)  
Sew the flowers to the bunny. (photo 29, 30)
