Knitting skill level: *** Medium

Instruction: Anita B. Benzenberg

Size:

(XS) S (M) L (XL) 2XL (3XL) 4XL

Measurements:

Bust: (99) 105 (112) 118 (125) 130 (138) 143 cm

Length: (51) 52 (53) 53 (54) 54 (55) 55 cm

Sleeve length: 50 cm, or suitable length

All measurements are for the finished garment = personal body measurements + movement allowance. The measurements are all according to given tension.

Description:

Work cardigan from neck down and inc for raglan and v-neck.

Work front bands in double knitting, in one long band. Sew band to front edges at finish.

Work garment with double yarn = 1 strand DOUBLE SUNDAY + 1 strand TYNN SILK MOHAIR.

Yarn:

DOUBLE SUNDAY (100% Merino wool, 50 g = 108 m)

TYNN SILK MOHAIR (57 % mohair, 28 % silk, 15 % wool, 25 g = 212 m)

Yarn required:

DOUBLE SUNDAY:

Evening sky #6051: (7) 8 (9) 10 (11) 12 (13) 14 balls

TYNN SILK MOHAIR:

Pastel blue #6012: (4) 4 (5) 5 (6) 6 (7) 7 balls

Notions:

3 buttons

Suggested knitting needles:

Circular and double pointed 4.5 mm and 5 mm

Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle

Tension:

17 sts x 24 rows St-st with double yarn and 5 mm ndls = 10 x 10 cm

Inc right:

From the back insert left ndl under yarn between 2 sts and k the new stitch.

Inc left:

From front insert left ndl under yarn between 2 sts and k tbl the new stitch.

Edge st: k every row

Yoke:

With double yarn and 5 mm circular ndl cast on (63) 63 (65) 65 (67) 67 (69) 69 sts.

Work 1 row from WS and insert markers for raglan as follows:

Work 1 edge st, p1, insert marker around the next 7 sts and work these sts (k1, k1 tbl), p7 sts (= sleeve), insert marker around the next 7 sts and work these sts (k1, k1 tbl), p(17) 17 (19) 19 (21) 21 (23) 23 sts (= the back), insert marker around the next 7 sts and work these sts (k1, k1 tbl), p7 sts (= sleeve), insert marker around the next 7 sts and work these sts (k1, k1 tbl), p1, 1 edge st.

Cont ribbing over sections of 7 sts ribbing with (p1, k1 tbl) on RS, (k1, p1 tbl) on WS. Cont St-st back and forth and on next row inc for raglan as follows:

Work 1 edge st, *work until marker, **inc right**, work 7 sts ribbing, **inc left***, rep from *-* in the row, end with 1 edge st = 8 sts inc.

Rep raglan inc on alt rows twice = (79) 79 (81) 81 (83) 83 (85) 85 sts.

Next row inc for v-neck and raglan as follows:

Work 1 edge st, **inc right**, *work until marker, **inc right**, work 7 sts ribbing, **inc left***, rep from *-* in the row, end with **inc left**, 1 edge st.

Cont raglan inc on alt rows and for v-neck every 4th row until a total of (21) 23 (25) 27 (29) 31 (33) 35 times for raglan and (10) 11 (12) 13 (14) 15 (16) 17 times for v-neck = (251) 269 (289) 307 (327) 345 (365) 383 sts.

Yoke meas approx (24) 25 (27) 29 (30) 32 (34) 35 cm, meas straight down from shoulder.

Tips: Place garment flat with front

neckline facing and meas from highest point of shoulder.

Divide sts for sleeves, back and front as follows:

Work (40) 43 (46) 49 (52) 55 (58) 61 sts (= front), transfer (49) 53 (57) 61 (65) 69 (73) 77 sts to spare ndl for sleeve and cast on 5 new underarm sts, work (73) 77 (83) 87 (93) 97 (103) 107 sts (= the back), transfer (49) 53 (57) 61 (65) 69 (73) 77 sts to spare ndl for sleeve and cast on 5 new underarm sts, work (40) 43 (46) 49 (52) 55 (58) 61 sts (= front).

Back and front:

= (163) 173 (185) 195 (207) 217 (229) 239 sts.

Cont St-st back and forth inside 1 edge st at each side until garment meas approx (45) 46 (47) 47 (48) 48 (49) 49 cm, or until 6 cm before suitable length.

Change to 4.5 mm circular ndl.

Work 6 cm ribbing back and forth as follows:

Row 1: (= RS) 1 edge st, k1 tbl, *p1, k1 tbl*, rep from *-* end with 1 edge st.

Row 2: (= WS) 1 edge st, p1 tbl, *k1, p1 tbl*, rep from *-* end with 1 edge st.

Cast off rib-wise, or work Italian cast-off.

Sleeves:

Transfer sleeve sts to 5 mm double pointed ndls, and with double yarn knit up 1 st in each new underarm st = (54) 58 (62) 66 (70) 74 (78) 82 sts.

Insert marker around the middle underarm st.

Cont St-st in rnds over all sts, and when sleeve meas 2 cm dec 1 st at each side of marked st as follows:

Work marked st, sl 1 k-wise, k1, pssso, work until 2 sts before marker, k2tog.

Rep dec approx every (6) 5½ (4½) 4 (3) 3 (2½) 2½ cm until (40) 42 (42) 44 (44) 46 (48) 48 sts rem.

Cont until sleeve meas 44 cm, or 6 cm before suitable length.

Change to 4.5 mm double pointed ndls.

Work 6 cm ribbing k1 tbl, p1 in rnds.

Cast off rib-wise, or work Italian cast-off, .

Finishing:

Insert 3 markers for buttonholes on right front edge as follows: 1 on top at beg of yoke, 1 approx 2 cm from cast off row, and 1 in middle.

Front band:

With double yarn, 5 mm double pointed ndl cast on 14 sts and work double knitting back and forth as follows: Sl first

st with yarn in front of work (as working p1), *k1, sl 1 p-wise with yarn in front of work*, rep from *-* end with k1.

Rep this row until band reaches the length of right front edge, the neck back and left front edge with band slightly stretched.

Remember to work buttonholes according to markers on right side.

Buttonholes: Cont double knitting and cast off the 6 middle sts.

Next row: Cast on 6 sts above the cast-off, and cont double knitting further.

Cast off in double knitting.

Tips: Sew front band to front edge while knitting. Ensure front band is suitable firm and smooth the entire length.

Sew buttons on.
