

JOLIE SWEATER

JOLIEGENSER / NO 10 / INSTRUCTION: HEGE MELKEVIG
KNITTING SKILL LEVEL ** EASY

SIZE

(XS) S (M) L (XL) 2XL (3XL)

MEASUREMENTS

Bust: (105) 112 (116) 120 (124) 131 (135) cm

Length: approx. (58) 59 (61) 62 (63) 65 (66) cm

Sleeve length: (47) 47 (47) 47 (46) 46 (46) cm

All measurements are for the finished garment = personal body measurements + movement allowance. The measurements are all according to given tension.

THE GARMENT

Sweater is moderate oversized. Work with stripes from hem up, and with double yarn (2 strands TYNN SILK MOHAIR). Work sleeves separately, join to back/front and work yoke. Dec for raglan and work extra height at back for a deeper front neckline. Pick up sts at neck and work neckband.

YARN

TYNN SILK MOHAIR (57% mohair, 28% silk, 15% wool, 25 g = 212 m).

YARN REQUIRED

Main color

Natural #1012: (8) 9 (10) 11 (12) 13 (14) balls

Color A

Brown sugar #2543: 2 balls each size

Color B

Powder pink #3511: 2 balls each size

SUGGESTED KNITTING NEEDLES

Circular and double pointed 4 mm

Small circular 2.5 mm

Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle

TENSION

19 sts stripe pattern with double yarn (2 strands TYNN SILK MOHAIR) and 4 mm ndls = 10 cm.

INC LEFT

From front insert left ndl under yarn between 2 sts

and k tbl the new stitch.

INC RIGHT

From back insert left ndl under yarn between 2 sts and k the new stitch.

STRIPE PATTERN

3 rnds St-st in main color

Purl 1 rnd with color A

3 rnds St-st with main color

Purl 1 rnd with color B

Repeat these 8 rnds

BACK AND FRONT

With double yarn in main color and 4 mm circular ndl cast on (200) 212 (220) 228 (236) 248 (256) sts. Insert marker at each side = (100) 106 (110) 114 (118) 124 (128) sts for each part.

Join and work 6 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds. Cont with stripe pattern until work meas 35 cm.

Work 1 rnd stripe pattern, at the same time cast off 8 sts at each side for armholes (= 4 sts at each side of markers) and (184) 196 (204) 212 (220) 232 (240) sts rem on ndl. Put garment aside and work sleeves.

SLEEVES

With double yarn in main color and 4 mm double pointed ndls cast on (62) 64 (66) 68 (70) 72 (74) sts. Join and work 6 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds. Insert marker around first and last st on rnd.

Work stripe pattern, at the same time inc 1 st at each side of marker on first rnd as follows:

Work 1 st, inc left, work until 1 st rem, inc right, work last st. Rep inc every (8) 7 (6) 5 (4½) 4 (3½) cm until (72) 76 (80) 84 (88) 92 (96) sts on ndl. Cont until sleeve meas approx (47) 47 (47) 47 (46) 46 (46) cm, end with the same pattern rnd as back/front, at the same time cast off 8 middle underarm sts = (64) 68 (72) 76 (80) 84 (88) sts. Put aside and work other sleeve in the same manner.

RAGLAN

Transfer sleeve sts to the circular 4 mm garment ndl, placing one sleeve above each armhole cast-off = (312) 332 (348) 364 (380) 400 (416) sts.

Insert marker at each junction, and rnd beg by the junction on right side of the back. Work 1 rnd stripe pattern. Dec for raglan on next rnd as follows: k2tog after each marker, and k2tog tbl before each marker = 8 sts dec.

Cont stripe pattern and rep dec on alt rnds (23) 25 (27) 28 (30) 32 (34) times = (128) 132 (132) 140 (140) 144 (144) sts on ndl.

Cast off the (16) 18 (18) 20 (20) 22 (22) middle front sts for neck, work to end of rnd, cut yarn and beg again at neck.

Cont back and forth and cast off at neck 5 sts once, 4 sts once, 3 sts once, 1 st once at beg of every row at each side (= 13 sts cast off at each side), at the same time cont dec for raglan on alt rnds when possible. Leave rem sts on ndl for neckband.

NECKBAND

With double yarn in main color knit up 1 st in each st on neck edge. Change to small 2.5 mm circular ndl, k 1 rnd, at the same time adjust number of sts to (150) 150 (150) 154 (154) 158 (158) sts. Work 4 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds, p 1 rnd (= folding rnd), and work 4 cm ribbing k1, p1 for facing. Cast off loosely rib-wise.

FINISHING

Fold neckband to WS and sew loosely with hidden sts. TIPS: For a closer hold of neckband, pass a thin, elastic band inside neckband before closing the seam. Sew underarm openings and fasten all yarn ends.
