

JUNE SWEATER

#JUNEGENSER / NO 2 / INSTRUCTION: ANITA B. BENZENBERG
KNITTING SKILL LEVEL *** MEDIUM

SIZE

(XS) S (M) L (XL) 2XL (3XL) 4XL

MEASUREMENT

Bust: (101) 106 (110) 115 (125) 130 (139) 144 cm

Length: (56) 56 (58) 58 (60) 60 (62) 62 cm

Sleeve length: 50 cm, or suitable length

All measurements are for the finished garment = personal body measurements + movement allowance. The measurements are all according to given tension.

THE GARMENT

Work garment from neck down.

Beg with the back and work until underarms, Cast on new sts for armholes before transfer sts to spare thread. Knit up sts on each shoulder for left and right front.

Cast on new sts at neck side before the 2 fronts are joined tog to 1 front.

Work front until underarms, cast on new sts for armholes before front is joined to the back. Cont back and front in rnds ending with ribbing.

Knit up sts at edge of each armhole, and work sleeves in rnds with diagram, ending with ribbing. Work neckband in ribbing.

YARN

MANDARIN PETIT (100 % cotton, 50 g = 180 m)

ALTERNATIVE YARN:

MINI ALPAKKA, ALPAKKA SILKE, TYNN

MERINOULL, BABYULL LANETT, SISU

NOTE: If alternative yarn is chosen be sure to check the yardage on label. The image of garment might change by using alternative yarn.

YARN REQUIRED

Dusty lt.green #9041: (8) 9 (10) 11 (12) 13 (14) 15 balls

SUGGESTED KNITTING NEEDLES

Circular and double pointed 2.5 mm and 3 mm

Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle

TENSION

25 sts diagram with 3 mm ndls = 10 cm

Edge st: k every row

BACK

With 3 mm circular ndl cast on (117) 123 (129) 135 (147) 153 (165) 171 sts, and purl 1 row inside 1 edge st at each side.

Work diagram inside 1 edge st at each side until back meas approx (20) 20 (21) 22 (22) 23 (24) 24 cm.

Cont diagram back and forth, and cast on 1 st once, 2 sts once at end of every row = 3 sts inc at each side = (123) 129 (135) 141 (153) 159 (171) 177 sts on ndl.

Work new sts in pattern when enough sts for a full pattern repeat.

Cut yarn, transfer sts to spare thread and work fronts.

LEFT FRONT

Beg by neck, and with 3 mm circular ndl knit up (33) 33 (39) 39 (45) 45 (51) 57 sts on left shoulder.

Purl 1 row inside 1 edge st at each side.

Work (6) 6 (6) 6 (7) 7 (7) 7 cm diagram inside 1 edge st at each side.

Cont diagram and cast on 1 st 3 times, 2 sts 3 times, 3 sts twice at end of row on neck side = (48) 48 (54) 54 (60) 60 (66) 72 sts.

Work new sts in pattern when enough sts for a full pattern repeat.

Cut yarn, transfer sts to spare thread and work right front.

RIGHT FRONT

Beg at outer point of right shoulder, and with 3 mm circular ndl knit up (33) 33 (39) 39 (45) 45 (51) 57 sts towards neck.

Purl 1 row inside 1 edge st at each side.

Work (6) 6 (6) 6 (7) 7 (7) 7 cm diagram inside 1 edge st at each side.

Cont diagram and cast on 1 st 3 times, 2 sts 3 times, 2 sts twice at end of row at neck side = (48) 48 (54) 54 (60) 60 (66) 72 sts.

Work new sts in pattern when enough sts for a full pattern repeat.

Join the 2 fronts tog as follows:

Work sts for right front, cast on (21) 27 (21) 27 (27) 33 (33) 27 sts, work sts for left front.

FRONT

= (117) 123 (129) 135 (147) 153 (165) 171 sts.

Cont diagram back and forth, inside 1 edge st at each side, until front meas approx (20) 20 (21) 22 (22) 23 (24) 24 cm.

Cont diagram back and forth, and cast on 1 st once, 2 sts once at end of every row = 3 sts inc on each side = (123) 129 (135) 141 (153) 159 (171) 177 sts on ndl.

Work new sts in diagram when enough sts for a full pattern repeat.

Join front and back tog in this manner:

Work sts for front, cast on 3 new sts, work sts for back and cast on 3 new sts.

BACK AND FRONT

= (252) 264 (276) 288 (312) 324 (348) 360 sts.

Cont diagram in rnds over all sts until work meas approx (51) 51 (53) 53 (55) 55 (57) 57 cm, meas from cast on at back, end with 3 rnds St-st.

Change to 2.5 mm circular ndl and work 5 cm ribbing k1 tbl, p1 in rnds.

Work Italian cast-off, or cast off rib-wise.

SLEEVES

Beg at middle underarm.

With small 3 mm circular ndl knit up (102) 102 (108) 114 (114) 120 (126) 126 sts on armhole edge.

Insert marker at middle underarm.

Work diagram in rnds and when sleeve meas approx 5 cm, dec 1 st at each side of marker as follows:

sl 1, k1, pssso after marker, and k2tog before marker.

Rep dec approx every (7½) 7½ (4½) 4½ (4½) 3.(3) 3 cm until (90) 90 (90) 96 (96) 96 (102) 102 sts rem.

Cont until work meas approx 45 cm, end with 3 rnds St-st.

Change to 2.5 mm double pointed ndls and work 5 cm ribbing k1 tbl, p1 in rnds.

Work Italian cast-off, or cast off rib-wise.


FINISHING

NECKBAND

With small 2.5 mm circular ndl or double pointed ndls knit up sts on neck edge.

Work 3 cm ribbing k1 tbl, p1 in rnds, and adjust number of sts to (132) 134 (136) 138 (140) 142 (144) 146 sts on first rnd.

Work Italian cast-off, or cast off rib-wise.
