SIZE

(XS) S-M (L) XL (2XL) 3XL

MEASUREMENTS

Bust: (100) 119 (129) 138 (143) 152 cm

Length: (50) 52 (52) 54 (54) 56 cm, or suitable

Sleeve length: 48 cm, or suitable

All measurements are for the finished garment = personal body measurements + movement allowance. The measurements are all according to given tension.

THE GARMENT

Work cardigan from neck down and with pattern according to diagram.

Begin to cast on sts for the back, and work back and forth with turning rows to shape slanting shoulders. Cont back and forth until underarms. Knit up sts for front parts, and dec and inc to shape neckline. Work fronts back and forth until underarms, then join back and fronts to same circular ndl. Work back and forth until full length and end with ribbing.

Knit up sts on armholes for sleeves. Work sleeves in rnds according to diagram to full length, end with ribbing. Work front bands and neckband.

Work garment with double yarn = 1 strand Alpakka Ull + 1 strand Alpakka Følgetråd.

YARN

ALPAKKA ULL (60 % alpaca, 40 % wool, 50 g = 100 m)

ALPAKKA FØLGETRÅD (100 % alpaca, 50 g = 400 m)

YARN REQUIRED

ALPAKKA ULL

Scarlet red #4018: (9) 11 (12) 13 (14) 15 balls

ALPAKKA FØLGETRÅD

Scarlet red #4018: (2) 3 (3) 3 (4) 4 balls

NOTIONS

5 buttons

SUGGESTED KNITTING NEEDLES

Circular 4 mm and 4.5 mm

Small circular 4 mm and 4.5 mm for sleeves

Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle.

TENSION

17 sts and 26 rnds diagram with double yarn and 4.5 mm ndls = 10 cm

GSR = GERMAN SHORT ROWS

After each turning always sl first st p-wise with yarn in front of work, lead yarn over right ndl and pull yarn firmly at the back until 2 loops on ndl. The 2 loops count as 1 st. When working rows/rnds with loops work loops tog to 1 st.

INC RIGHT

From back insert left ndl under yarn between 2 sts and k the new stitch.

INC LEFT

From front insert left ndl under yarn between 2 sts and k tbl the new stitch.

INC P1

From back insert left ndl under yarn between 2 sts and p the new stitch.

Edge sts: knit every row

BACK

With double yarn and 4.5 mm circular ndl cast on (70) 86 (94) 102 (102) 110 sts.

Place marker (24) 32 (36) 40 (40) 44 sts in from each side (= shoulders).

Work diagram A inside 1 edge st on each side, and turn with GSR as shown in diagram. First row from WS.

When (6) 8 (9) 10 (10) 11 times of turnings are finished and all sts are knitted, work diagram A further back and forth inside 1 edge st on each side, until back meas (18) 19 (20) 21 (22) 22 cm, meas at armhole side.

Tips: Make a mark on diagram for last row worked,

and end fronts with the same row in diagram.

Next RS row inc sts for armholes as follows:

Row 1 (= RS): Work 1 edge st, inc left, work diagram A until 1 st rem, inc right, work 1 edge st = 2 sts inc.

Row 2 (= WS): Work 1 edge st, work diagram A until 1 st rem, 1 edge st.

Work row 1 - 2, (4) 4 (4) 4 (6) 6 times = (78) 94 (102) 110 (114) 122 sts.

Note: For size (XS) work new sts in diagram as they arise. For size S-M (L) XL (2XL) 3XL work p over new sts.

Cut yarn, put back aside and work fronts.

RIGHT FRONT



With double yarn and 4.5 mm circular ndl knit up (24) 32 (36) 40 (40) 44 sts on slanting shoulder, from armhole towards neck.

Work diagram B for right front inside 1 edge st on each side, first row from WS. Turn with GSR, dec and inc as shown in diagram.



When all sts are inc, there are (34) 42 (46) 50 (50) 54 sts on ndl.

Work diagram back and forth inside 1 edge st on each side until armhole meas approx (20) 21 (22) 23 (24) 25 (25) cm.

Note: End with same row as the back.



B RIGHT FRONT



Next RS row inc sts for armhole as follows:

Row 1 (= RS): Work 1 edge st, inc left, work diagram, end with 1 edge st = 1 st inc.

Row 2 (= WS): Work 1 edge st, work diagram, end with 1 edge st.

Work row 1 - 2, (4) 4 (4) 4 (6) 6 times = (38) 46 (50) 54 (56) 60 sts.

Note: For size (XS) work new sts in diagram as they arise. For size S-M (L) XL (2XL) 3XL work p over new sts.

Cut yarn, put back aside and work left side front.

LEFT FRONT

With double yarn and 4.5 mm circular ndl knit up (24) 32 (36) 40 (40) 44 sts on slanting shoulder, from neck towards armhole using the short yarn tail, for first row to be worked from RS.

Work diagram B for left front inside 1 edge st on each side. Turn with GSR, dec and inc as shown in diagram. When all sts have been inc, there are (34) 42 (46) 50 (50) 54 sts on ndl.

Work diagram back and forth inside 1 edge st on each side until garment meas approx (21) 22 (23) 24 (25) 25 cm.

Note: End with same row as the back.

K ON RS, P ON WS

P ON RS, K ON WS



CAST ON 1 NEW STITCH

 P2TOG

Next RS row, inc sts for armhole as follows:

Row 1 (= RS): Work 1 edge st, work diagram until 1 st rem, inc right, work 1 edge st = 1 st inc.

Row 2 (= WS): Work 1 edge st, work diagram, end with 1 edge st.

Work row 1 - 2, (4) 4 (4) 4 (6) 6 times = (38) 46 (50) 54 (56) 60 sts.

Note: For size (XS) work new sts in diagram as they arise. For size S-M (L) XL (2XL) 3XL work p over new sts.

Join fronts and back as follows:

Work 1 edge st, work diagram B over left front, end with 1 edge st, cast on 6 new underarm sts, 1 edge st, work diagram A over sts for back, end with 1 edge st, cast on 6 new underarm sts, 1 edge st, work diagram B over right front, end with 1 edge st.

BACK AND FRONT

= (166) 198 (214) 230 (238) 254 sts.

Work 1 row from WS and place 6 markers as follows: Work 1 edge st, place marker, work 38 sts diagram B over right front, place marker, knit (4) 20 (28) 36 (40) 48 sts, place marker, work 80 sts diagram C over back, place marker, knit (4) 20 (28) 36 (40) 48 sts, place marker, work 38 sts diagram B over left front, place marker, 1 edge st.

Note: Markers show beg and end for diagram. Work p over side sts on every row.

Work back and forth in this order until garment meas (42) 44 (44) 46 (46) 48 cm, or until 8 cm before suitable length, meas straight down from cast on at neck back.

End with at least 3 rows without cable twisting.

Work one RS row before ribbing, with dec and inc as follows:

Work 1 edge st, work last row for diagram B over left front, work (1) 9 (13) 17 (19) 23 p sts, inc p1, work p2, inc p1, work p until next marker, work last row of diagram C, work (1) 9 (13) 17 (19) 23 p sts, inc p1, work p2, inc p1, work p to next marker, work last row of diagram B over right front, 1 edge st = (148) 180 (196) 212 (220) 236 sts.

Change to 4 mm circular ndl and work 8 cm ribbing

back and forth as follows:

(First row = WS): Work 1 edge st, k2, *p2, k2*, rep from *-* to end of row, end with 1 edge st.

Work Italian cast-off.

Tips: By use of an extra ndl move sts to be arranged as k1, p1 on ndl and work regular Italian cast-off.

SLEEVES

Beg at middle underarm. With double yarn and small 4.5 mm circular ndl knit up 1 st in every st on armhole edge.

Place marker at middle underarm = beg of rnd.

Knit 1 rnd, at the same time adjust number of sts to (80) 80 (84) 84 (94) 94.

Cont in rnds according to diagram C as follows:

Work (10) 10 (12) 12 (17) 17 p sts, work 60 sts diagram C, work p to beg of rnd.

Cont in rnds in this order until sleeve meas 36 cm, or until 12 cm before suitable length.

End with at least 3 rnds without cable twisting.

FOR SIZE (XS) S-M (L) XL

Work 1 rnd with dec and inc before ribbing as follows:

Work p1, inc p1, work p until marker, work last rnd of diagram C until marker, work p until 1 st before beg of rnd, inc p1, p1 = (76) 76 (80) 80 sts.

FOR SIZE (2XL) 3XL

Work 1 rnd with dec and inc before the ribbing as follows:

Work p until marker, work last rnd of diagram C, work p until marker, work last rnd of diagram C, work p until beg of rnd = (88) 88 sts.

FOR SIZE (XS) S-M

Change to small 4 mm circular ndl and work 12 cm ribbing in rnds as follows:

Work k1, *p2, k2*, rep from *-*, end with k1.

FOR SIZE (L) XL (2XL) 3XL

Change to 4 mm circular ndl and work 12 cm ribbing as follows:

Work p1, *k2, p2*, rep from *-* in the rnd, end with p1.

ALL SIZES

Work Italian cast-off.

Tips: By use of an extra ndl move sts to be arranged as k1, p1 on ndl, and work regular Italian cast-off.

LEFT FRONT BAND

With double yarn and 4 mm circular ndl knit up 1 st in every st/row, but miss every 5th st/row = approx (80) 84 (84) 88 (88) 92 sts.

Number of sts a multiple of 4.

Work 4 cm ribbing back and forth as follows:

(First row = WS): Work 1 edge st, p2, *k2, p2*, rep from *-* to end of row, end with 1 edge st.

Work Italian cast-off as for back/front.





RIGHT FRONT BAND

Knit up sts in same manner as for left front band, but place markers for 5 buttonholes as follows:

Place marker approx 2 cm from lower edge of ribbing, between 2 p sts. The upper buttonhole will be worked on neckband. This is done later. Place markers for 3 buttonholes evenly spaced between the upper and lower, and always between 2 p sts.

Work in same manner as left front band, but work buttonhole by markers when band meas 2 cm as follows:

Row 1 (= RS): Work 1 edge st, *work ribbing until 2 sts before marker, work k2tog tbl, 1 yo, p1*, rep from *-* a total of 4 times, work ribbing to end of row, end with 1 edge st.

Row 2 (= WS): Work 1 edge st, work ribbing to end of row, 1 edge st.

NECKBAND

With double yarn and 4 mm circular ndl knit up 1 st in every st/row on neck edge = approx 80 sts.

Number of sts a multiple of 4.

Place marker for 5th buttonhole in line with the others, and between 2 p sts.

Work 4 cm ribbing back and forth as follows:

(First row = WS): Work 1 edge st, p2, *k2, p2*, rep from *-* to end of row, end with 1 edge st.

Note: Work buttonhole when band meas 2 cm.

Work Italian cast-off as for front bands.
