


ALCHEMY LATTICE GAUNTLET

The perfect accessory for everyday errands, a little gardening, or your morning walk, the fast & easy-to-knit fingerless mitts offer the perfect balance of warmth, comfort, & sublime style.

FINISHED SIZE

To fit women's medium. Approx. 6" long and 7" around palm.

MATERIALS

Alchemy Yarns **Sanctuary** (30% silk/70% wool; 125 yds/50 g): 1 skein.

Shown in 114c *Mighty Redwood*; OR

Alchemy Yarns **Temple** (100% superfine superwash merino; 128 yds/50g): 1 skein.

Set of 4 US Size 5 (3.75 mm) double pointed needles, *or size needed to obtain gauge*
Cable Needle; small amount of smooth waste yarn

GAUGE

24 sts and 28 rows = 4" in Twisted Lattice Stitch

ABBREVIATIONS

BO	bind off
CO	cast on
incr	increase
k	knit
m 1	make 1
p	purl
pm	place marker on needle
rev st st	reverse stockinette stitch
sl	slip
st(s)	stitches

NOTE

- The **Twisted Lattice Stitch** is a 6 stitch repeat. In order to maintain the continuity of the stitch around the hand, the marker indicating the beginning of the round should be moved 1 stitch to the right at the beginning of round 6, then moved back to its original position at the beginning of round 11.

DIRECTIONS

CO 42 sts. Arrange on three needles and join to work in the round.

Work rounds 1 – 16 of Twisted Lattice Chart, then work rounds 1-9 again.

Next round: Work 21 sts in established pattern, pm, m 1, pm, work in pattern to end of round.

Work 1 round without shaping, continuing in pattern as established, but keep st(s) between markers in rev st st throughout.

Next round (Incr round): Work to marker, sl marker, m 1, p to marker, m 1, sl marker, work to end of round.

Work incr round every other round twice, then every third round 4 times – 13 sts between markers.

Work 1 more round without shaping.

Next round: Work in pattern to marker, remove marker, place next 13 sts on waste yarn for holding, remove marker, work to end of round.

Continue in pattern for approx 1", ending with round 8. BO loosely

Return held sts to needles. Reattach yarn and pick up and k 2 sts at palm – 15 sts. P 1 round.

BO loosely.

FINISHING

Weave in ends, using ends from thumb opening to close up any little holes where thumb joins palm.

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
