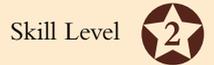

CROCHET HOOK

3.00mm (no 11) (US C2/D3) crochet hook

TENSION

25 sts and 24 rows to 10cm measured over patt using 3.00mm (US C2/D3) crochet hook.

CROCHET ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain; **dc** = double crochet; **sp(s)** = space(s); **ss** = slip stitch; **tch** = turning chain.

Pattern note: The number of sts varies whilst working patt. All st counts given relate to the basic number of sts and do NOT include the extra 1 st made after working patt rows 5 and 6.

BACK

Using 3.00mm (US C2/D3) crochet hook, make 136 [148: 160: 172: 186] ch.

Foundation row (WS): 1 dc into 2nd ch from hook, *1 ch, miss 1 ch, 1 dc into next ch, rep from * to end, turn.

135 [147: 159: 171: 185] sts.

Now work in patt as folls:

Row 1 (RS): 1 ch (counts as 1 st), miss first dc, *2 dc into next ch sp, miss next dc, rep from * to last ch sp, 1 dc into last ch sp, 1 dc into last dc, miss tch, turn.

Row 2: 1 ch (counts as 1 st), miss first dc, 1 dc into next dc, *1 ch, miss 1 dc, 1 dc into next dc, rep from * until only tch remains, 1 dc into tch, turn.

Row 3: 1 ch (counts as 1 st), miss first 2 dc, *2 dc into next ch sp, miss next dc, rep from * until only tch remains, 2 dc into tch, turn.

Row 4: As row 2.

Row 5: 1 ch (counts as 1 st), 1 dc into first dc, *miss next dc, 2 dc into next ch sp, rep from * to end, ending last rep in tch, turn. (See pattern note.)

Row 6: 1 ch (counts as 1 st), miss first dc, *1 dc into next dc, 1 ch, miss 1 dc, rep from * until only tch remains, 1 dc into tch, turn.

Row 7: 1 ch (counts as 1 st), miss first dc, 1 dc into next ch sp, *miss 1 dc, 2 dc into next sp, rep from * to last dc, miss last dc, 1 dc into tch, turn. (See pattern note.)

Row 8: 1 ch (counts as 1 st), 1 dc into first dc, *1 ch, miss 1 dc, 1 dc into next dc, rep from * to end working last dc into top of tch, turn. These 8 rows form patt.

Keeping patt correct (throughout) work 0 [0: 4: 4: 6] rows.

Shape sides

Next row: Ss across next st, patt to end, turn. 134 [146: 158: 170: 184] sts.

Next row: Ss across next st, patt to end, turn. 133 [145: 157: 169: 183] sts.

Work 4 rows.

Next row: Ss across next st, patt to end, turn. 132 [144: 156: 168: 182] sts.

Next row: Ss across next st, patt to end, turn. 131 [143: 155: 167: 181] sts.

Work 2 rows.

Rep last 10 rows to 115 [127: 139: 151: 165] sts.

115 [127: 139: 151: 165] sts.

Cont in patt until work meas approx 28 [28.5: 29: 29.5: 30] cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape armholes

Next row (RS): Ss across next 6 [6: 8: 8: 8] sts, patt to end, turn. 109 [121: 131: 143: 157] sts.

Next row: Ss across next 6 [6: 8: 8: 8] sts, patt to end, turn. 103 [115: 123: 135: 149] sts.

Next row: Ss across next st, patt to end, turn. 102 [114: 122: 134: 148] sts.

Next row: Ss across next st, patt to end, turn. 101 [113: 121: 133: 147] sts.

Rep last 2 rows 13 [15: 16: 18: 20] times more. 75 [83: 89: 97: 107] sts.**

Cont in patt until armhole meas approx 15 [16.5: 18: 19.5: 21] cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape back neck

Next row: Patt 16 [18: 20: 24: 28], turn.

Next row: Ss across next st, patt to end, turn.

Next row: Patt.

Rep last 2 rows 3 times more, then first row once more.

11 [13: 15: 19: 23] sts.

Fasten off.

With RS facing, miss next 43 [47: 49: 49: 51] sts, rejoin yarn and patt to end.

Complete to match first side, reversing shapings.

FRONT

Work as given for back to **.

Cont in patt until armhole meas approx 12 [13.5: 15: 16.5: 18] cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape front neck

Next row: Patt 16 [18: 20: 24: 28], turn.

Next row: Ss across next st, patt to end, turn.

Next row: Patt.

Rep last 2 rows 3 times more, then first row once more.

11 [13: 15: 19: 23] sts.

Cont in patt until front matches back to shoulder, ending with RS facing for next row.

Fasten off.

With RS facing, miss next 43 [47: 49: 49: 51] sts, rejoin yarn and patt to end.

Complete to match first side, reversing shapings.

MAKING UP

Press as described on the information page.

Join both shoulder seams.

Neck edging

With RS facing and using 3.00mm (US C2/D3) crochet hook, attach yarn at neck edge of left shoulder seam, 1 ch (does NOT count as st), work 1 round of crab st (dc worked from left to right, instead of right to left) evenly around entire neck edge, ending with ss to first dc.

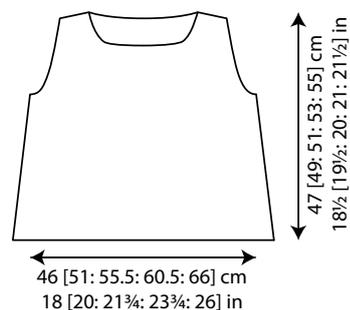
Fasten off.

Join both side seams.

Armhole edgings (both alike)

Work as given for neck edging, attaching yarn at underarm seam.

CROCHET HOOK

3.50mm (no 9) (US E4) crochet hook

BUTTONS – 6 x BN1979 from Bedecked. Please see information page for contact details.

TENSION

29 sts and 28 rows to 10 cm measured over patt using 3.50mm (US E4) crochet hook.

CROCHET ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain; **dc** = double crochet; **sp(s)** = space(s); **ss** = slip stitch.

BACK

Using 3.50mm (US E4) crochet hook and yarn A, make 134 [150: 164: 176: 192] ch.

Foundation row (RS): 1 dc into 2nd ch from hook, *1 ch, miss next ch, 1 dc into next ch, rep from * to end, turn. 133 [149: 163: 175: 191] sts. Break off yarn A and join in yarn B.

Row 1: 1 ch (does NOT count as 1 dc), *1 dc into 1 ch sp, 1 ch, rep from * to end, 1 dc into turning ch, turn.

Last row sets patt.

Break off yarn B and join in yarn C.

Work 1 row.

Break off yarn C and join in yarn A.

Work 1 row.

Last 3 rows set stripe sequence.

Work in patt and stripe sequence (throughout) until work meas approx. 27 [27.5: 28: 28.5: 29] cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape armholes

Next row (RS): Ss across next 8 [8: 10: 10: 12] sts, starting in next st patt to end, turn. 125 [141: 153: 165: 179] sts.

Next row: Ss across next 8 [8: 10: 10: 12] sts, starting in next st patt to end, turn. 117 [133: 143: 155: 167] sts.

Sizes 91-97 cm, 102-107 cm, 112-117 and 122-127 cm only

Next row: Ss across next 2 sts, starting from next st patt to last 2 sts, turn. - [129: 139: 151: 163] sts.

Rep last row - [2: 2: 3: 3] times more. - [121: 131: 139: 151] sts.

All sizes

Work 0 [1: 1: 0: 0] rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Next row (RS): Ss to next ch sp, 1 ch (does not count as 1 dc), 1 ch, *1 dc into 1 ch sp, 1 ch, rep from * to last dc, ss into last dc. 115 [119: 129: 137: 149] sts.

Next row: 1 ch (does not count as 1 st), *1 dc into next st, 1 ch, rep from * to last 2 ch, 1 dc into next ch, ss into last ch.

Rep last 2 rows 4 [4: 5: 4: 5] times more. 107 [111: 119: 129: 139] sts.

Cont in patt until armhole meas approx 18.5 [20: 21.5: 23: 24.5] cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape back neck

Next row: Patt 34 [36: 40: 44: 46], turn, leaving rem sts unworked.

Next row: Ss across next 2 sts, starting in next st patt to end.

32 [34: 38: 42: 44] sts.

Work 1 row.

Next row: Ss across next 2 sts, starting in next st patt to end 30 [32: 36: 40: 42] sts.

Fasten off.

With RS facing, return to last complete row worked, miss centre 39 [39: 39: 41: 47] sts, rejoin yarn and patt to end.

Complete to match first side, reversing shapings.

Fasten off.

LEFT FRONT

Using 3.50mm (US E4) crochet hook and yarn A, make 66 [74: 82: 88: 96] ch.

Work foundation row as given for back. 65 [73: 81: 87: 95] sts.

Work in patt and stripe sequence as given for back (throughout) until work meas approx. 27 [27.5: 28: 28.5: 29] cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape armholes

Next row: Ss across next 8 [8: 10: 10: 12] sts, patt to end, turn.

57 [65: 71: 77: 83] sts.

Work 1 row.

Working all armhole decreases in same way as for back, cont as folls:

Sizes 91-97 cm, 102-107 cm, 112-117 and 122-127 cm only

Dec 2 sts at armhole edge of next - [3: 3: 4: 4] rows. - [59: 65: 69: 75] sts.

All sizes

Dec 1 st at armhole edge of next [2nd: 2nd: next: next] and every foll alt row to 52 [54: 59: 64: 69] sts.

Cont in patt until armhole meas approx 13 [14.5: 16: 17.5: 19] cm, ending with **WS** facing for next row.

Shape front neck

Next row: Patt 34 [36: 40: 44: 46], turn leaving rem sts unworked.

Next row: Ss across next 2 sts, patt to end. 32 [34: 38: 42: 44] sts.

Work 1 row.

Next row: Ss across next 2 sts, patt to end. 30 [32: 36: 40: 42] sts.

Cont in patt until armhole meas approx. 20 [21.5: 23: 24.5: 26] cm, ending with **RS** facing for next row.

Fasten off.

Mark positions for 6 buttons along left front opening edge – first button to come 2 cm up from lower edge, last button to come 2 cm below beg of neck shaping, and rem 4 buttons evenly spaced between.

RIGHT FRONT

Work to match left front, reversing all shaping and making buttonholes to correspond with positions marked for buttons as follows:

Buttonhole row 1 (RS): Patt 1 st, 2 ch, miss next 2 sts, patt to end.

Buttonhole row 2 (WS): Patt to end, working patt into 2 ch from previous row.

SLEEVES

Using 3.50mm (US E4) crochet hook and yarn A, make 64 [66: 72: 74: 76] ch.

Work foundation row as given for back. 63 [65: 71: 73: 75] sts.

Now work in patt as given for back as follows:

Work 6 [6: 6: 4: 4] rows.

Working incs by working 1 more dc into first and last dc of each end of inc rows, and taking inc sts into patt, inc 1 st at each end of next and every foll 6th [6th: 6th: 6th: 4th] row to 71 [89: 93: 109: 87] sts, then on every foll 8th [8th: 8th: 8th: 6th] row to 93 [99: 105: 111: 117] sts.

Cont in patt until sleeve meas approx.

45 [45: 46: 46: 46] cm, ending with **RS** facing for next row.

Shape top

Next row: Ss across next 8 [8: 10: 10: 12] sts, patt to end, turn.

85 [91: 95: 101: 105] sts.

Next row: Ss across next 8 [8: 10: 10: 12] sts, patt to end, turn.

77 [83: 85: 91: 93] sts.

Next row: Ss across next 2 sts, patt to last 2 sts, turn. 73 [79: 81: 87: 89] sts.

Rep last row 3 [4: 4: 4: 3] times more. 61 [63: 65: 71: 77] sts.

Work 1 row.

Working decs by working 1 less dc at each end of dec rows, dec 1 st at each end of next and every foll alt row to 33 [37: 35: 37: 37] sts.

Work 1 row.

Next row: Ss across next 2 sts, patt to last 2 sts, turn. 29 [33: 31: 33: 33] sts.

Rep last row 4 [4: 4: 5: 5] times. 13 [17: 15: 13: 13] sts.

For 92-97 cm size only

Work 1 row.

Next row: Ss across next 2 sts, patt to last 2 sts, turn. 13 sts.

For 102-107 cm size only

Work 1 row.

Work 1 row dec 1 st at each end of row. 13 sts.

For all sizes

Fasten off.

POCKETS

Using 3.50mm (US E4) crochet hook and yarn A, make 34 ch.

Work in patt as set for back until work meas approx. 12 cm, ending after one row using yarn A and with **RS** facing for next row.

Fasten off.

MAKING UP

Press as described on the information page.

Join both shoulder seams.

Neck, Front opening and hem edging.

With **RS** facing, using 3.50mm (US E4) crochet hook and yarn A, attach yarn at base of right front opening edge and cont as follows:

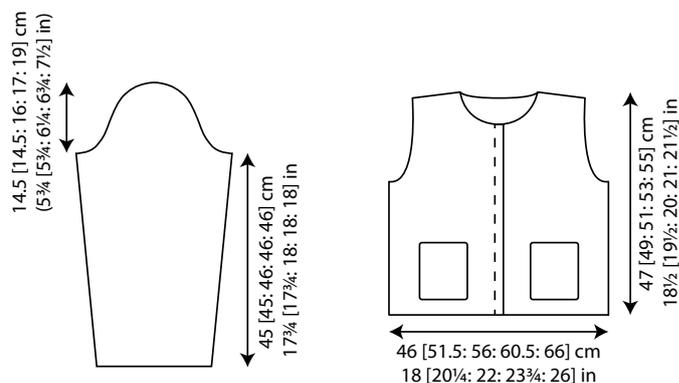
Round 1 (RS): 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 1dc into point where yarn was attached, work 1 round of dc evenly up right front opening edge, around entire neck edge, and down left front opening edge to base of left front opening edge, then across entire hem edge, ss to dc at beg of round, do NOT turn.

Now work 1 round of crab st as follows:

Next round (RS): 1 ch, 1 dc into same st, *1 dc into st to **right** of current st, rep from * to end.

Fasten off.

See information page for finishing instructions, setting in sleeves using the set-in method. Sew on pockets.

CROCHET HOOK

4.00mm (no 8) (US G6) crochet hook

BUTTONS – 6 x BN1800 from Bedecked. Please see information page for contact details.

TENSION

15 sts and 8.5 rows to 10 cm measured over tr fabric using 4.00mm (US G6) crochet hook.

CROCHET ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain; **dc** = double crochet; **ERd (Embossed Roundel)** = work (1 tr, 2 ch) 9 times all into same st, remove hook from working loop, insert hook from back through top of first tr of Roundel and, keeping sts of Roundel at back of fabric (RS), pick up working loop again and draw through to close Roundel; **sp(s)** = space(s); **ss** = slip stitch; **tr** = treble; **tr2tog** = (yoh and insert hook in next st, yoh and draw loop through, yoh and draw through 2 loops) twice, yoh and draw through all 3 loops on hook; **yoh** = yarn over hook.

BODY (Worked in one piece to armhole)

Using 4.00mm (US G6) crochet hook make 142 [158: 170: 186: 202] ch.

Row 1 (WS: RS: RS: RS: RS): 1 tr into 4th ch from hook, 1 tr into each ch to end, turn. 140 [156: 168: 184: 200] sts.

Row 2: 3 ch (counts as 1 tr), miss tr at base of 3 ch, 1 tr into each tr to end, working last tr into top of 3 ch at beg of last row, turn. Last row forms tr fabric.

Cont in tr fabric for a further 3 [2: 2: 4: 6] rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Next row (RS): 3 ch (counts as 1 tr), miss tr at base of 3 ch, 1 tr into each of next 32 [36: 39: 43: 47] tr, (tr2tog over next 2 tr) twice, 1 tr into each of next 66 [74: 80: 88: 96] tr, (tr2tog over next 2 tr) twice, 1 tr into each tr to end, working last tr into top of 3 ch at beg of last row, turn. 136 [152: 164: 180: 196] sts.

Work 1 row in tr fabric.

Next row (RS): 3 ch (counts as 1 tr), miss tr at base of 3 ch, 1 tr into each of next 31 [35: 38: 42: 46] tr, (tr2tog over next 2 tr) twice, 1 tr into each of next 64 [72: 78: 86: 94] tr, (tr2tog over next 2 tr) twice, 1 tr into each tr to end, working last tr into top of 3 ch at beg of last row, turn. 132 [148: 160: 176: 192] sts.

Work 1 row in tr fabric.

Next row (RS): 3 ch (counts as 1 tr), miss tr at base of 3 ch, 1 tr into each of next 30 [34: 37: 41: 45] tr, (tr2tog over next 2 tr) twice, 1 tr into each of next 62 [70: 76: 84: 92] tr, (tr2tog over next 2 tr) twice, 1 tr into each tr to end, working last tr into top of 3 ch at beg of last row, turn. 128 [144: 156: 172: 188] sts.

Work 1 row in tr fabric.

Next row (RS): 3 ch (counts as 1 tr), miss tr at base of 3 ch, 1 tr into each of next 29 [33: 36: 40: 44] tr, (tr2tog over next 2 tr) twice, 1 tr into each of next 60 [68: 74: 82: 90] tr, (tr2tog over next 2 tr) twice, 1 tr into each tr to end, working last tr into top of 3 ch at beg of last row, turn. 124 [140: 152: 168: 184] sts.

Work 3 rows in tr fabric.

Next row (RS): 3 ch (counts as 1 tr), miss tr at base of 3 ch, 1 tr into each of next 29 [33: 36: 40: 44] tr, (2tr into next tr) twice, 1 tr into each of next 60 [68: 74: 82: 90] tr, (2tr into next tr) twice, 1 tr into each tr to end, working last tr into top of 3 ch at beg of last row, turn. 128 [144: 156: 172: 188] sts.

Work 1 row in tr fabric.

Next row (RS): 3 ch (counts as 1 tr), miss tr at base of 3 ch, 1 tr into each of next 30 [34: 37: 41: 45] tr, (2tr into next tr) twice, 1 tr into each of next 62 [70: 76: 84: 92] tr, (2tr into next tr) twice, 1 tr into each tr to end, working last tr into top of 3 ch at beg of last row, turn. 132 [148: 160: 176: 192] sts.

Work 1 row in tr fabric.

Next row (RS): 3 ch (counts as 1 tr), miss tr at base of 3 ch, 1 tr into each of next 31 [35: 38: 42: 46] tr, (2tr into next tr) twice, 1 tr into each of next 64 [72: 78: 86: 94] tr, (2tr into next tr) twice, 1 tr into each tr to end, working last tr into top of 3 ch at beg of last row, turn. 136 [152: 164: 180: 196] sts.

Cont straight in tr fabric for 1 [3: 3: 1: 1] rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Break yarn and fasten off.

Shape front neck

Miss first 27 [31: 34: 38: 42] tr (for right front neck), re-attach yarn to next tr and cont as folls:

Next row (RS): 3 ch (counts as 1 tr), miss tr at base of 3 ch, 1 tr into each tr to last 27 [31: 34: 38: 42] tr and turn, leaving rem sts unworked (for left front neck).

Next row: 2 ch (does NOT count as st), miss tr at base of 2 ch - 1 st decreased, 1 tr into each tr to last 2 tr, tr2tog over last 2 sts - 1 st decreased, turn.

Rep last row twice more. 76 [84: 90: 98: 106] sts.

Fasten off.

Place markers 4 sts in from each end of last row - 4 sts before the first marker form right front, 68 [76: 82: 90: 98] sts between the markers form the back and the rem 4 sts after 2nd marker form left front.

SLEEVES

Using 4.00mm (US G6) crochet hook make 36 [36: 38: 38: 40] ch.

Note: The sleeves are worked in rounds BUT the work is **turned** at the end of each round so that alternating RS and WS rows are worked and the tr fabric formed will match the tr fabric on the body.

Round 1 (RS): 1 tr into 4th ch from hook, 1 tr into each ch to end, ss to top of 3 ch at beg of round, turn. 34 [34: 36: 36: 38] sts.

Round 2: 3 ch (counts as 1 tr), miss st at base of 3 ch, 1 tr into each tr to end, ss to top of 3 ch at beg of round, turn.

Last round forms tr fabric.

Round 3: 3 ch (counts as 1 tr), 1 tr into st at base of 3 ch - 1 st increased, 1 tr into each tr to last tr, 2 tr into last tr - 1 st increased, ss to top of 3 ch at beg of round, turn.

Last round sets the increases.

Working increases as set, cont in tr fabric, shaping sleeve by inc 1 st at each end of every foll 4th [2nd: 2nd: 2nd: 2nd] row to 42 [38: 40: 48: 54] sts, then on every foll 6th [4th: 4th: 4th: 4th] row until there are 48 [52: 54: 58: 62] sts.

Cont straight until sleeve meas 44 [44: 45: 45: 45] cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

Fasten off.

YOKE

With RS facing, using 4.00mm (US G6) crochet hook attach yarn at right front opening edge and to top of first st missed for right front neck shaping, 3 ch, miss st at base of 3 ch, 1 tr into each of next 26 [30: 33: 37: 41] tr of right front neck, work 7 [7: 6: 7: 7] tr evenly up right side of front neck and 1 tr into first of 4 sts before marker, work across sts of right sleeve as folls: miss first 3 sts, 1 tr into each of next 42 [46: 48: 52: 56] tr, miss last 3 tr, miss next 6 tr of body (for right underarm - marker is at centre of these 6 missed sts), 1 tr into each of next 62 [70: 37: 84: 92] tr of back, (tr2tog over next 2 tr of back) 0 [0: 1: 0: 0] times, 1 tr into each of next 0 [0: 37: 0: 0] tr of back, work across sts of left sleeve as folls: miss first 3 sts, 1 tr into each of next 42 [46: 48: 52: 56] tr, miss last 3 tr, miss next 6 tr of body (for left underarm - marker is at centre of these 6 missed sts), work 1 tr into rem 1 st of left front and 7 [7: 6: 7: 7] tr

evenly down left side of front neck, and then work 1 tr into each of the next 27 [31: 34: 38: 42] tr of left front neck.

216 [240: 253: 280: 304] sts.

Sizes 112-117 cm and 122-127 cm only

Next row (WS): 3 ch (counts as 1 tr), miss tr at base of 3 ch, 1 tr into each tr to end, working last tr into top of 3 ch at beg of last row, turn.

Next row: 3 ch (counts as 1 tr), miss tr at base of 3 ch, 1 tr into each of next - [-: -: 2: 6] tr, tr2tog over next 2 tr, (1 tr into each of next - [-: -: 8: 6] tr, tr2tog over next 2 tr, 1 tr into each of next - [-: -: 9: 7] tr, tr2tog over next 2 tr) - [-: -: 13: 17] times, 1 tr into each tr to end, working last tr into top of 3 ch at beg of last row, turn. - [-: -: 253: 269] sts.

Sizes 102-107 cm, 112-117 cm and 122-127 cm only

Next row (WS): 3 ch (counts as 1 tr), miss tr at base of 3 ch, 1 tr into each of next 3 sts, *1 ERd into next tr, 1 tr into each of next 7 sts, rep from * to last st, 1 tr into top of 3 ch at beg of last row, turn.

Next row: 3 ch (counts as 1 tr), miss tr at base of 3 ch, 1 tr into each tr to end, working last tr into top of 3 ch at beg of last row, turn.

All Sizes

Next row: 3 ch (counts as 1 tr), miss tr at base of 3 ch, 1 tr into each tr to end, working last tr into top of 3 ch at beg of last row, turn.

Last row forms tr fabric.

Next row (RS): 3 ch (counts as 1 tr), miss tr at base of 3 ch, 1 tr into each of next 2 [1: 10: 10: 9] tr, tr2tog over next 2 tr, (1 tr into each of next 6 [7: 8: 8: 6] tr, tr2tog over next 2 tr) 26 [26: 23: 23: 31] times, 1 tr into each tr to end, working last tr into top of 3 ch at beg of last row, turn. 189 [213: 229: 229: 237] sts.

Next row (WS): 3 ch (counts as 1 tr), miss tr at base of 3 ch, *1 tr into each of next 7 sts, 1 ERd into next tr, rep from * to last 4 sts, 1 tr into each tr to end, working last tr into top of 3 ch at beg of last row, turn.

Work 2 rows in tr fabric.

Next row (RS): 3 ch (counts as 1 tr), miss tr at base of 3 ch, 1 tr into each of next 1 [1: 5: 4: 8] tr, tr2tog over next 2 tr, (1 tr into each of next 6 [7: 5: 5: 5] tr, tr2tog over next 2 tr) 23 [23: 31: 31: 31] times, 1 tr into each tr to end, working last tr into top of 3 ch at beg of last row, turn. 165 [189: 197: 197: 205] sts.

Next row (WS): 3 ch (counts as 1 tr), miss tr at base of 3 ch, 1 tr into each of next 3 sts, *1 ERd into next tr, 1 tr into each of next 7 sts, rep from * to last st, 1 tr into top of 3 ch at beg of last row, turn.

Work 2 rows in tr fabric, dec 1 [2: 0: 0: 3] sts (by working tr2tog over next 2 tr) evenly across last row and ending with RS facing for next row. 164 [187: 197: 197: 202] sts.

Next row (RS): 3 ch (counts as 1 tr), miss tr at base of 3 ch, 1 tr into each of next 3 [5: 4: 4: 1] tr, tr2tog over next 2 tr, (1 tr into each of next 5 [4: 4: 4: 5] tr, tr2tog over next 2 tr) 22 [29: 31: 31: 28] times, 1 tr into each tr to end, working last tr into top of 3 ch at beg of last row, turn.

141 [157: 165: 165: 173] sts.

Next row (WS): 3 ch (counts as 1 tr), miss tr at base of 3 ch, *1 tr into each of next 7 sts, 1 ERd into next tr, rep from * to last 4 sts, 1 tr into each tr to end, working last tr into top of 3 ch at beg of last row, turn.

Work 2 rows in tr fabric, dec 1 [1: 0: 0: 0] sts (by working tr2tog over 2 tr) at centre of last row and ending with RS facing for next row. 140 [156: 165: 165: 173] sts.

Next row (RS): 3 ch (counts as 1 tr), miss tr at base of 3 ch, 1 tr into each of next 2 [1: 3: 3: 7] tr, tr2tog over next 2 tr, (1 tr into each of next 4 [3: 3: 3: 3] tr, tr2tog over next 2 tr) 22 [30: 31: 31: 31] times, 1 tr into each tr to end, working last tr into top of 3 ch at beg of last row, turn. 117 [125: 133: 133: 141] sts.

Next row (WS): 3 ch (counts as 1 tr), miss tr at base of 3 ch, 1 tr into each of next 3 sts, *1 ERd into next tr, 1 tr into each of next 7 sts, rep from * to last st, 1 tr into top of 3 ch at beg of last row, turn.

Work 2 rows in tr fabric, dec 1 [2: 0: 0: 0] sts (by working tr2tog over 2 tr) evenly across last row and ending with RS facing for next row. 116 [123: 133: 133: 141] sts.

Next row (RS): 3 ch (counts as 1 tr), miss tr at base of 3 ch, 1 tr into each of next 1 [2: 3: 3: 7] tr, tr2tog over next 2 tr, (1 tr into each of next 3 [2: 2: 2: 2] tr, tr2tog over next 2 tr) 22 [29: 31: 31: 31] times, 1 tr into each tr to end, working last tr into top of 3 ch at beg of last row, turn. 93 [93: 101: 101: 109] sts.

Next row (WS): 3 ch (counts as 1 tr), miss tr at base of 3 ch, *1 tr into each of next 7 sts, 1 ERd into next tr, rep from * to last 4 sts, 1 tr into each tr to end, working last tr into top of 3 ch at beg of last row, turn.

Next row (RS): 3 ch (counts as 1 tr), miss tr at base of 3 ch, 1 tr into each of next 6 [6: 7: 7: 3] tr, tr2tog over next 2 tr, (1 tr into next tr, tr2tog over next 2 tr) 26 [26: 28: 28: 33] times, 1 tr into each tr to end, working last tr into top of 3 ch at beg of last row, turn. 66 [66: 72: 72: 75] sts.

Neckband

Next row (WS): 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 1 dc into tr at base of 1 ch, 1 dc into each tr to end, working last dc into top of 3 ch at beg of last row, turn.

Next row: 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 1 dc into dc at base of 1 ch, 1 dc into each dc to end, turn.
Fasten off.

MAKING UP

Press as described on the information page.

Right front edging

With **WS** facing and using 4.00mm (US G6) crochet hook, attach yarn to right front opening edge at top of neckband, 1 ch (does NOT count as st), now work one row of dc evenly along entire front opening edge to base of right front opening edge, turn.

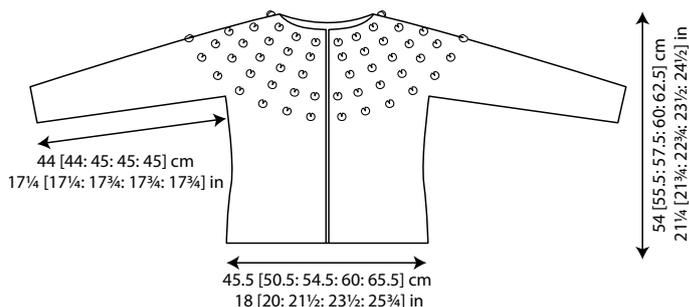

TENSION

14 sts and 10 rows to 10 cm measured over tr and dc fabric using 4.50mm (US 7) crochet hook.

Centre panel (26 sts) meas 18 cm.

CROCHET ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain; **dc** = double crochet; **dc2tog** = (insert hook as indicated, yoh and draw loop through) twice, yoh and draw through all 3 loops on hook; **fpdtr** = (yoh) twice, insert hook from front of work and from right to left around the post of the indicated st, yoh and draw up a loop, (yoh and draw through two loops) 3 times, miss st behind fpdtr; **sp(s)** = space(s); **ss** = slip stitch; **tr** = treble; **tr2tog** = (yoh and insert hook as indicated, yoh and draw loop through, yoh and draw through 2 loops) twice, yoh and draw through all 3 loops on hook; **yoh** = yarn over hook; **tr5tog** = (yoh and insert hook as indicated, yoh and draw loop through, yoh and draw through 2 loops) 5 times, yoh and draw through all 6 loops on hook.

BODY (worked in one piece, beg at front hem edge)

Using 4.50mm (US 7) crochet hook make 78 [86: 92: 100: 106] ch.

Row 1 (RS): 1 tr into 4th ch from hook, 1 tr into each of next 27 [31: 34: 38: 41] ch, (1 ch, miss 1 ch, 1 tr into next ch) 3 times, 1 tr into each of next 7 ch, (1 ch, miss 1 ch, 1 tr into next ch) 3 times, 1 tr into each of last 28 [32: 35: 39: 42] ch, turn. 76 [84: 90: 98: 104] sts.

Row 2: 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 1 dc into each of first 25 [29: 32: 36: 39] tr, *1 dc into each next 4 sts, tr5tog into next ch sp,

1 dc into next tr, 1 dc into next ch sp, 1 dc into next tr, tr5tog into next sp, 1 dc into each next 4 sts, rep from * once more, 1 dc into each tr to end, working last dc into top of 3 ch at beg of last row, turn.

Row 3: 3 ch (counts as 1 tr), miss dc at base of 3 ch, 1 tr into each of next 24 [28: 31: 35: 38] dc, *1 fpdtr around next st 2 rows below, 1 tr into next dc, 1 fpdtr around next st 2 rows below, 1 ch, miss 1 dc, (1 tr into next st, 1 ch, miss 1 dc) 3 times, 1 fpdtr around next st 2 rows below, 1 tr into next dc, 1 fpdtr around next st 2 rows below, rep from * once more, 1 tr into each dc to end, turn.

Row 4: 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 1 dc into each of first 25 [29: 32: 36: 39] tr, *1 dc into each of next 3 sts, 1 dc into next ch sp, 1 dc into next tr, 1 dc into next ch sp, tr5tog into next tr, 1 dc into next ch sp, 1 dc into next tr, 1 dc into next ch sp, 1 dc into each of next 3 sts, rep from * once more, 1 dc into each tr to end, working last dc into top of 3 ch at beg of last row, turn.

Row 5: 3 ch (counts as 1 tr), miss dc at base of 3 ch, 1 tr into each of next 24 [28: 31: 35: 38] dc, *(1 fpdtr around next fpdtr 2 rows below, 1 tr into next dc) twice, (1 ch, miss 1 st, 1 tr into next dc) 3 times, 1 fpdtr around next fpdtr 2 rows below, 1 tr into next dc, 1 fpdtr around next fpdtr 2 rows below, rep from * once more, 1 tr into each tr to end, turn.

Rows 2 to 5 form patt and set the sts - centre panel with tr and dc fabric at sides.

Cont in patt as set for a further 24 [24: 24: 26: 26] rows, ending after patt row 5 [5: 5: 3: 3] and with **WS** facing for next row.

(Front should meas approx 29 [29: 29: 31: 31] cm.)

Shape for cap sleeves

Taking inc sts into tr and dc fabric, cont as folls:

Next row (WS): 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 2 dc into first tr - 1 st increased, patt to last st, 2 dc into top of 3 ch at beg of last row - 1 st increased, turn.

Next row: 3 ch (counts as 1 tr), 1 tr into dc at base of 3 ch - 1 st increased, patt to last dc, 2tr into last dc - 1 st increased, turn.

Rep last 2 rows once more. 84 [92: 98: 106: 112] sts.

Remove hook and leave working loop on a holder, with yarn attached. Using a separate piece of yarn, make 3 ch and attach this length of ch with a ss to top of 3 ch at beg of last row, break yarn and fasten off. Return working loop (left on holder) to hook and cont as folls:

Next row (WS): Ch 4, 1 dc into 2nd ch from hook, 1 dc into each of next 2 ch - 3 sts increased, patt to end, working 1 dc into each of 3 ch attached at beg of last row - 3 sts increased, turn.

90 [98: 104: 112: 118] sts.

Place markers at both ends of last row (to denote base of armhole openings on front).

Cont straight in patt as set for a further 6 [8: 8: 8: 10] rows, ending after patt row 4 [2: 2: 4: 2] and with **RS** facing for next row.

Shape front neck

Next row (RS): 3 ch (counts as 1 tr), miss dc at base of 3 ch, 1 tr into each of next 30 [34: 37: 41: 44] dc, tr2tog over next 2 sts and turn, leaving rem sts unworked. 32 [36: 39: 43: 46] sts.

Work on this set of sts only for first side of neck.

Next row: 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 1 dc into each tr to end, working last dc into top of 3 ch at beg of last row, turn.

Next row: 3 ch (counts as 1 tr), miss dc at base of 3 ch, 1 tr into each dc to last 2 dc, tr2tog over last 2 dc - 1 st decreased, turn.

Rep last 2 rows 2 [2: 3: 3: 3] times more. 29 [33: 35: 39: 42] sts.

Next row (WS): 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 1 dc into each tr to end, working last dc into top of 3 ch at beg of last row, turn.

Next row: 3 ch (counts as 1 tr), miss dc at base of 3 ch, 1 tr into each dc to end, turn.

Last 2 rows form tr and dc fabric.

Now working in tr and dc fabric throughout, cont as folls:

Work 4 rows, ending with **WS** facing for next row.

Fasten off.

Place markers at both ends of last row (to denote left shoulder fold line).

Return to last complete row worked, miss next (centre) 24 sts, attach yarn to next dc and cont as folls:

Next row: 2 ch (does NOT count as st), miss dc at base of 2 ch - 1 st decreased, 1 tr into each dc to end, turn.

Next row: 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 1 dc into each tr to end, turn.

Rep last 2 rows 3 [3: 4: 4: 4] times more.

29 [33: 35: 39: 42] sts.

Work 5 rows, ending with **WS** facing for next row.

Place markers at both ends of last row (to denote right shoulder fold line).

Join sections

Next row (WS): 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 1 dc into each tr to last tr, 2 dc into last tr, ch 29 [29: 31: 31: 31] (for back neck edge) and now work into sts of left shoulder beg at fasten off point as folls: 2 dc into first tr, 1 dc into each tr to end, working last dc into top of 3 ch at beg of last row, turn.

Next row: 3 ch (counts as 1 tr), miss dc at base of 3 ch, 1 tr into each of next 29 [33: 35: 39: 42] dc, 1 tr into each of next 29 [29: 31: 31: 31] ch and 1 tr into each of next 30 [34: 36: 40: 43] dc.

89 [97: 103: 111: 117] sts.

Work 17 [19: 21: 21: 23] rows, ending with RS facing for next row. Place markers at both ends of last row (to denote base of armhole openings on back).

Shape for cap sleeves

Next row (RS): Ss across and into 4th dc, 3 ch (counts as 1 tr), miss dc at base of 3 ch, 1 tr into each dc to last 3 sts, and turn, leaving rem 3 sts unworked. 83 [91: 97: 105: 111] sts.

Next row: 1 ch (does NOT count as st), dc2tog over first 2 tr - 1 st decreased, *1 dc into next tr, rep from * to last 2 sts, dc2tog over last 2 sts - 1 st decreased, turn.

Next row: 2 ch (does NOT count as st), miss dc at base of 2 ch - 1 st decreased, *1 tr into next dc, rep from * to last 2 dc, tr2tog over last 2 sts - 1 st decreased, turn.

Rep last 2 rows once more.

75 [83: 89: 97: 103] sts.

Cont straight for 28 [28: 28: 30: 30] rows, ending with **WS** facing for next row.

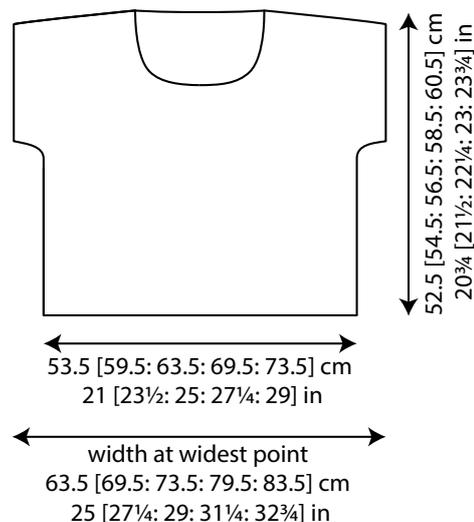

CROCHET ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain; **dc** = double crochet; **htr** = half treble; **sp(s)** = space(s); **ss** = slip stitch; **tr** = treble; **htr2tog** = (yoh and insert hook as indicated, yoh and draw loop through) twice, yoh and draw through all 5 loops on hook; **htr3tog** = (yoh and insert hook as indicated, yoh and draw loop through) 3 times, yoh and draw through all 7 loops on hook; **yoh** = yarn over hook.

BACK

Upper section

Using 4.50mm (US 7) crochet hook make 65 [73: 79: 87: 93] ch.

Row 1 (RS): 1 htr into 3rd ch from hook, 1 htr into each ch to end, turn. 64 [72: 78: 86: 92] sts.

Row 2: 2 ch (counts as 1 htr), miss htr at base of 2 ch, 1 htr into each htr to end, working last htr into top of 2 ch at beg of last row, turn. Last row forms htr fabric.

Cont in htr fabric for a further 14 [12: 12: 10: 10] rows, ending with RS facing for next row. (Back should meas approx 13 [12: 12: 10: 10] cm.)

Shape armholes

Next row (RS): Ss across first 2 [3: 4: 4: 4] htr, and into 3rd [4th: 5th: 5th: 5th] htr, 2 ch (counts as 1 htr), miss htr at base of 2 ch,

1 htr into each htr to last 2 [3: 4: 4: 4] sts and turn, leaving rem 2 [3: 4: 4: 4] sts unworked. 60 [66: 70: 78: 84] sts.

Next row: 2 ch (does NOT count as st), miss htr at base of 2 ch, htr2tog over next 2 sts, *1 htr into next htr, rep from * to last 3 sts, htr3tog over last 3 sts, turn. 56 [62: 66: 74: 80] sts.

Next row: 2 ch (does NOT count as st), miss st at base of 2 ch - 1 st decreased, *1 htr into next htr, rep from * to last 2 sts, htr2tog over last 2 sts - 1 st decreased, turn.

Rep last row a further 2 [4: 5: 7: 7] times.

50 [52: 54: 58: 64] sts.

Cont straight in htr fabric for a further 1 [1: 0: 0: 0] rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Now work in mesh fabric as follows:

Row 1 (RS): 1 ch (does NOT count as st),

1 dc into first htr, (3 ch, miss 2 [2: 0: 1: 0] htr, 1 dc into next htr) 1 [1: 0: 1: 0] times, (3 ch, miss 2 htr, 1 dc into next htr, 3 ch, miss 1 htr, 1 dc into next htr) 8 [9: 10: 11: 12] times, (3 ch, miss 2 htr, 1 dc into next htr) 2 [1: 1: 0: 1] times, working last dc into top of 2 ch at beg of last row, turn. 19 [20: 21: 23: 25] 3-ch sps.

Row 2: 4 ch (counts as 1 tr and 1 ch), *1 dc into next 3-ch sp, 3 ch, rep from * to last 3-ch sp, 1 dc into last 3-ch sp, 1 ch, 1 tr into 1 dc at beg of last row, turn.

Row 3: 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 1 dc into st at base of 1 ch, *3 ch, 1 dc into next 3-ch sp, rep from * to end, working last 1 dc into 3rd of 4 ch at beg of last row, turn.

Rows 2 and 3 form mesh fabric.**

Cont in mesh fabric for a further 15 [15: 16: 16: 17] rows, ending after patt row 2 [2: 3: 3: 2] and with RS [RS: **WS: WS: RS**] facing for next row.

(Armhole should meas approx 20 [21.5: 22.5: 24: 25] cm.)

Shape back neck

Sizes 81-86 cm, 91-97 cm and 122-127 cm only

Next row (RS): 1 ch, 1 dc into st at base of 1 ch, (3 ch, 1 dc into next 3-ch sp) 5 [5: -: -: 7] times and turn, leaving rem sts unworked. 5 [5: -: -: 7] 3-ch sps.

Work on this set of sts only for first side of neck.

Next row: 2 ch (does NOT count as st), *1 dc into next 3-ch sp, 3 ch, rep from * to last 3-ch sp, 1 dc into last ch sp, 1 ch, 1 tr into 1 dc at beg of last row, turn. 4 [4: -: -: 6] 3-ch sps.

Fasten off.

Sizes 102-107 cm and 112-117 cm only

Next row (WS): 4 ch, 1 dc into next 3-ch sp, (3 ch, 1 dc into next 3-ch sp) - [-: 5: 6: -] times and turn, leaving rem sts unworked. - [-: 5: 6: -] 3-ch sps.

Next row: 2 ch (does NOT count as st), miss st at base of 2 ch, *1 dc into next 3-ch sp, 3 ch, rep from * to last 3-ch sp, 1 dc into last

3-ch sp, 3 ch, 1 dc into 3rd of 4 ch at beg of last row, turn.

- [-: 5: 6: -] 3-ch sps.

Fasten off.

All sizes

Return to last complete row worked, miss centre 8 [9: 9: 9: 10]

3-ch sps, attach yarn to next 3-ch sp and cont as folls:

Next row: 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 1 dc into 3-ch sp where yarn was attached, patt to end, turn. 5 [5: 5: 6: 7] 3-ch sps.

Next row: Patt to last 3-ch sp, 1 dc into last 3-ch sp, turn, leaving last dc unworked. 4 [4: 5: 6: 6] 3-ch sps.

Fasten off.

Lower section

With RS facing, attach yarn to one end of foundation ch edge of htr fabric and, working into opposite side of foundation ch, now work in mesh fabric as follows:

Row 1 (RS): 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 1 dc into first st, *3 ch, miss 2 sts, 1 dc into next st, (3 ch, miss 1 st, 1 dc into next st) twice, rep from * to last 0 [8: 0: 8: 0] sts, (3 ch, miss 2 sts, 1 dc into next st, 3 ch, miss 1 st, 1 dc into next st, 3 ch, miss 2 sts, 1 dc into next st) 0 [1: 0: 1: 0] times, turn. 27 [30: 33: 36: 39] 3-ch sps.

Beg with row 2, cont straight in mesh fabric until entire back piece meas 63 [65: 67: 69: 71] cm.

Fasten off.

FRONT

Work as given for back to **.

Cont in mesh fabric for a further 7 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape front neck

Next row (RS): Patt until 1 dc has been worked into 7th [7th: 8th: 9th: 10th] 3-ch sp and turn, leaving rem sts unworked.

7 [7: 8: 9: 10] 3-ch sps.

Work on this set of sts only for first side of neck.

Next row: 2 ch (does NOT count as st), 1 dc into next 3-ch sp, patt to end, turn.

Next row: Patt to last 3-ch sp, 1 dc into last ch sp and turn, leaving last dc unworked.

One 3-ch sp decreased over last 2 rows.

Sizes 81-86 cm, 91-97 cm and 122-127 cm only

Next row (RS): Patt until 1 dc has been worked into last 3-ch sp, 1 ch, 1 tr into dc at beg of last row.

Next row: 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 1 dc into tr at base of 1 ch, 3 ch, miss 1 dc, patt to end.

Rep last 2 rows once more.

Fasten off.

Sizes 102-107 cm and 112-117 cm only

Cont straight in mesh patt for a further 4 rows, ending with WS facing for next row.

Fasten off.

Return to last complete row worked, miss centre 4 [5: 4: 4: 4] 3-ch sps, attach yarn to next ch sp and patt to end. 7 [7: 8: 9: 10] 3-ch sps.

Next row (WS): Patt to last 3-ch sp, 1 dc into last 3-ch sp and turn, leaving last dc unworked.

Next row: 2 ch (does NOT count as st), 1 dc into next 3-ch sp, patt to end, turn.

One 3-ch sp decreased over last 2 rows.

Rep last 2 rows a further 1 [1: 2: 2: 2] times, then first of these rows 1 [1: 0: 0: 1] times more, ending with RS [RS: WS: WS: RS] facing for next row. 4 [4: 5: 6: 6] 3-ch sps.

Sizes 81-86 cm, 91-97 cm and 122-127 cm only

Next row (RS): 4 ch (counts as 1 tr and 1 ch), 1 dc into next 3-ch sp, patt to end, turn.

Next row: Patt to end, working last dc into 3rd of 4 ch at beg of row.

Rep last 2 rows once more.

Fasten off.

Sizes 102-107 cm and 112-117 cm only

Cont straight in mesh patt for a further 4 rows, ending with WS facing for next row.

Fasten off.

Lower section

Work as given for lower section of back.

SLEEVES

Using 4.50mm (US 7) crochet hook make 35 [35: 37: 37: 39] ch.

Row 1 (WS): 1 htr into 3rd ch from hook, 1 htr into each ch to end, turn. 34 [34: 36: 36: 38] sts.

Cont in htr fabric as given for back for a further 4 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Now work in mesh fabric as follows:

Row 1 (RS): 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 1 dc into first htr, (3 ch, miss 2 [1: 0: 1: 1] htr, 1 dc into next htr) 2 [1: 0: 5: 5] times, *3 ch, miss 2 htr, 1 dc into next htr, (3 ch, miss 1 htr, 1 dc into next htr) twice, rep from * to last 6 [3: 0: 4: 6] htr, (3 ch, miss 2 [2: -: 1: 1] htr, 1 dc into next htr) 2 [1: 0: 2: 3] times, working last dc into top of 2 ch at beg of last row, turn. 13 [14: 15: 16: 17] 3-ch sps.

Row 2: 4 ch (counts as 1 tr and 1 ch), *1 dc into next 3-ch sp, 3 ch, rep from * to last 3-ch sp, 1 dc into last 3-ch sp, 1 ch, 1 tr into 1 dc at beg of last row, turn.

Row 3: 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 1 dc into st at base of 1 ch, *3 ch, 1 dc into next 3-ch sp, rep from * to end, working last 1 dc into 3rd of 4 ch at beg of last row, turn.

Rows 2 and 3 form mesh fabric.

Cont in mesh fabric for a further 3 rows, ending after patt row 2 and with RS facing for next row.

Row 7: 4 ch (counts as 1 tr and 1 ch), 1 dc into tr at base of 4 ch - 1/2 patt rep increased, 3 ch, *1 dc into next 3-ch sp, 3 ch, rep from * to last 3-ch sp, 1 dc into last 3-ch sp, 3 ch, miss 1 dc, (1 dc, 1 ch, 1 tr) into 3rd of 4 ch at beg of last row - 1/2 patt rep increased, turn.

Beg with patt row 3, work in mesh fabric for 6 rows, ending after patt row 2.

Rep last 7 rows a further 4 times, then work row 7 once more.

19 [20: 21: 22: 23] 3-ch sps.

Beg with patt row 3, work in mesh fabric until sleeve meas approx 43 [43: 44: 44: 44] cm, ending after patt row 2.

Shape top**Sizes 81-86 cm, 91-97 cm and 102-107 cm only**

Break yarn, miss (1 tr, 1 ch and 1 dc), then re-join yarn to next 3-ch sp (this is first 3-ch sp) - 1 patt rep decreased.

Sizes 112-117 cm and 122-127 cm only

Break yarn, (miss 1 tr, 1 ch, 1 dc, 1 3-ch sp and 1 dc), then re-join yarn to next 3-ch sp (this is second 3-ch sp) - 2 patt reps decreased.

All sizes

Next row (RS): 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 1 dc into st at base of 1 ch, (3 ch, 1 dc into next 3-ch sp) 17 [18: 19: 18: 19] times, and turn, leaving rem sts unworked.

17 [18: 19: 18: 19] 3-ch sps.

Beg with patt row 2, work 1 row.

Next row (RS): 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 1 dc into st at base of 1 ch, *3 ch, 1 dc into next 3-ch sp, rep from * to last 3-ch sp, 1 ch, 1 htr into 3rd of 4 ch at beg of last row to form last sp, turn.

Next row: 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 1 dc into sp at base of 1 ch, *3 ch, 1 dc into next 3-ch sp, rep from * to last 3-ch sp and turn, leaving rem dc unworked.

Next row: 4 ch (counts as 1 tr and 1 ch), *1 dc into next 3-ch sp, 3 ch, rep from * to last 3-ch sp, 1 dc into last 3-ch sp, 1 ch, 1 tr into 1 dc at beg of last row, turn.

Next row: 4 ch, miss (1 tr at base of 4 ch, 1 ch and next dc), *1 dc into next 3-ch sp, 3 ch, rep from * to last 3-ch sp, 1 dc into last 3-ch sp, 1 ch, 1 htr into 3rd of 4 ch at beg of last row, turn.

Last 4 rows decreases 2 patt reps.

Rep last 4 rows a further 0 [0: 0: 2: 2] times.

15 [16: 17: 12: 13] patt reps. (This is 14 [15: 16: 11: 12] 3-ch sps, with an additional partial 1 sp at each end.)

Next row (RS): 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 1 dc into sp (formed by 1 ch, 1 htr) at base of 1 ch, *3 ch, 1 dc into next 3-ch sp, rep from * to last 3-ch sp, 1 dc into last 3-ch sp, 1 ch, 1 htr into 3rd of 4 ch at beg of last row, turn.

Next row: 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 1 dc into sp (formed by

1 ch, 1 htr) at base of 1 ch, *3 ch, 1 dc into next 3-ch sp, rep from * until 1 3-ch sp remains unworked, 1 ch, 1 htr into this (last) 3-ch sp and turn, leaving rem 1 dc unworked.

Rep last row a further 10 [12: 13: 7: 8] times.

4 [3: 3: 4: 4] patt reps. (This is 3 [2: 2: 3: 3] 3-ch sps, with an additional 1 sp at end formed by 1ch and 1 htr.)

Fasten off.

MAKING UP

Press as described on the information page.

Join both shoulder seams using back stitch, or mattress stitch if preferred.

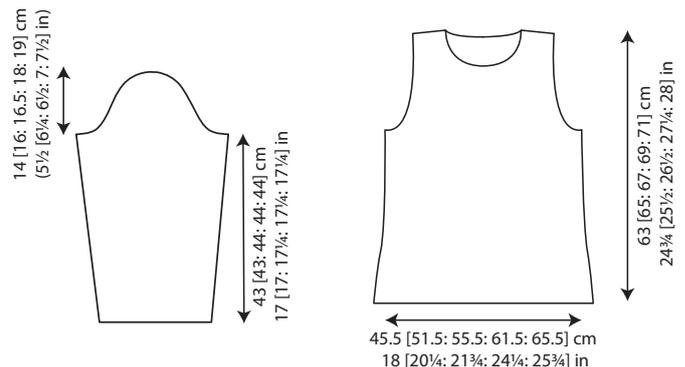

TENSION

21 sts and 27 rows to 10 cm measured over dc using 3.00 mm (US C2/D3) crochet hook.

3 patt repeats to **11 cm** and depth 6 cm measured over hem edging patt using 3.00mm (US C2/D3) crochet hook.

CROCHET ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain; **dc** = double crochet; **PC** = 3 ch, 1 ss into first of these ch; **sp(s)** = space(s); **ss** = slip stitch; **tr** = treble.

BACK

Using 3.00mm (US C2/D3) crochet hook, make 101 [111: 121: 133: 143] ch.

Foundation row (RS): 1 dc into 2nd ch from hook, *1 dc into next ch, rep from * to end, turn. 100 [110: 120: 132: 142] sts.

Row 1: 1 ch (counts as 1 dc), *1 dc into next st, rep from * to end, turn. Last row forms patt.

Cont in patt until work meas approx 20 [20.5: 21: 21.5: 22] cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape armholes

Next row: Ss across next 6 [8: 9: 10: 11] sts, starting from next st patt to last 6 [8: 9: 10: 11] sts, turn, leaving rem sts unworked.

88 [94: 102: 112: 120] sts.

Next row: 1 ch, dc2tog, patt to last 2 sts, dc2tog, turn.

86 [92: 100: 110: 118] sts.

Rep last row 1 [2: 4: 4: 7] times more.

84 [88: 92: 102: 104] sts.

Next row: 1 ch, dc2tog, patt to last 2 sts, dc2tog, turn.

82 [86: 90: 100: 102] sts.

Next row: Patt.

Rep last 2 rows 5 [4: 3: 3: 3] times. 72 [78: 84: 94: 96] sts.**

Cont in patt until armhole meas approx 19 [20.5: 22: 23.5: 25] cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape back neck

Next row: Patt 17 [19: 21: 23: 24] sts and turn, leaving rem sts unworked. Work on this set of sts only for first side of neck.

Next row: Dc2tog, patt to end. 16 [18: 20: 22: 23] sts.

Next row: Patt.

Rep last 2 rows once more, then first row once more.

14 [16: 18: 20: 21] sts.

Fasten off.

With RS facing, return to last complete row worked, miss centre 38 [40: 42: 48: 48] sts, rejoin yarn and patt to end.

17 [19: 21: 23: 24] sts.

Complete to match first side, reversing shapings.

FRONT

Work as given for back to **.

Cont in patt until armhole meas approx 14 [15.5: 17: 18.5: 20] cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape front neck

Next row: Patt 19 [21: 23: 25: 26] and turn, leaving rem sts unworked. Work on this set of sts only for first side of neck.

Next row: Dc2tog, patt to end, turn. 18 [20: 22: 24: 25] sts.

Next row: Patt.

Rep last 2 rows 4 times more. 14 [16: 18: 20: 21] sts.

Cont in patt until front matches back to fasten-off point, ending with RS facing for next row.

Fasten off.

With RS facing, return to last complete row worked, miss centre 34 [36: 38: 44: 44] sts, rejoin yarn and patt to end. 19 [21: 23: 25: 26] sts.

Complete to match first side, reversing shapings.

SLEEVES

Using 3.00mm (US C2/D3) crochet hook, make 79 [85: 91: 95: 99] ch.

Foundation row (RS): 1 dc into 2nd ch from hook, *1 dc into next ch, rep from * to end, turn. 78 [84: 90: 94: 98] sts.

Row 1: 1 ch (counts as 1 dc), *1 dc into next st, rep from * to end, turn. Last row forms patt.

Cont in patt until work meas 8 [8: 9: 9: 9] cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape top

Next row: Ss across next 6 [8: 9: 10: 11] sts, patt to last 6 [8: 9: 10: 10] sts, turn, leaving rem sts unworked. 66 [68: 72: 74: 76] sts.

Working all decreases in same way as back armhole decreases, dec 1 st at each end of next and every foll row to 52 [58: 58: 60: 66] sts, then every foll alt row to 24 sts, then every foll row to 12 sts.

Fasten off.

NECKBAND

Join shoulder seams.

Using 3.00mm (US C2/D3) crochet hook, starting from shoulder seam work an even number of dc around neck, ss to first dc, do NOT turn.

Round 2: 4 ch, miss first dc and next dc, *1 tr into next dc, 1 ch, miss next dc, rep from * to end, ss to first dc.

Round 3: 1 ch, *1 dc into next st, rep from * to end, ss to first dc. Rep last round twice more.

Fasten off.

HEM EDGING

Join side seams.

Using 3.00mm (US C2/D3) crochet hook, starting at side seam, rejoin yarn.

Work a round of dc around lower edge of front and back inc [inc: dec: inc: inc] 0 [4: 0: 0: 4] sts evenly across round, ss to first dc, do NOT turn. 200 [224: 240: 264: 288] sts.

Round 2: 4 ch, miss first dc and next dc, *1 tr into next dc, 1 ch, miss next dc, rep from * to end, ss to first dc.

Round 3: 1 ch, *1 dc into next st, rep from * to end, ss to first dc. Rep last 2 rounds once more.

Round 6: 1 ch, *1 dc into each of next 4 dc, 1PC, 1 dc into each of next 4 dc, turn, 9 ch, ss into first of 8 dc just made, turn, (7 dc, 3PC, 7 dc) into 9 ch sp, rep from * to end, ss to first dc. Fasten off.

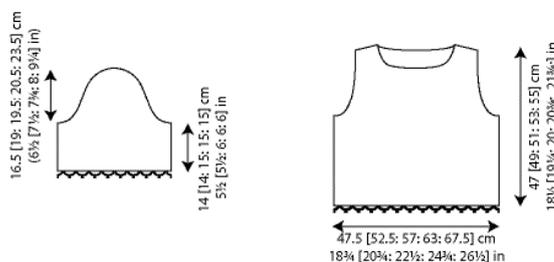

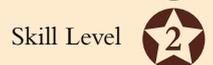

WRAP

Round 1: 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 8 dc into ring, ss to first dc. 8 dc.

Round 2: 2 ch, 1 tr into same place as 2 ch (counts as tr2tog), *3 ch, 1 dc into next dc, 3 ch, tr2tog into next dc, rep from * twice more, 3 ch, 1 dc into next dc, 3 ch, ss to top of 2 ch at beg of round. Fasten off yarn D. Join yarn E with a ss to a tr2tog from previous round.

Round 3: 6 ch (counts as 1 tr and 3 ch), (1 tr, 3 ch) twice into same place as 6 ch, 1 tr into next dc, 3 ch, *(1 tr, 3 ch) 3 times into next tr2tog, 1 tr into next dc, 3 ch, rep from * twice more, ss to 3rd of 6 ch at beg of round.

Fasten off yarn E.

Motif 2

Work as for Motif 1 to end of round 2 using yarn B.

Fasten off yarn B. Join yarn A with a ss to a tr2tog from previous round.

Round 3: 5 ch (counts as 1 tr and 2 ch), ss into corresponding 3ch-sp of motif 1 corner group, 1 ch, (1 tr, 3 ch) twice into same place as 5 ch, 1 tr into next dc, 3 ch, *(1 tr, 3 ch) 3 times into next tr2tog, 1 tr into next dc, 3 ch, rep from * once more, (1 tr, 3 ch, 1 tr) in next tr2tog, 2 ch, ss in 3ch-sp of corresponding corner of motif 1, (1 ch, 1 tr) in same tr2tog, 3 ch, 1 tr in next dc, 3 ch, ss to 3rd of 5 ch at beg of round.

Fasten off yarn A.

Motif 3

Work as for motif 2, using yarn D for rounds

1 to 2, yarn E for round 3 and joining to the left of motif 2.

Motif 4

Work as for motif 2, using yarn B for rounds 1 to 2, yarn A for round 3 and joining to the left of motif 3.

Motif 5

Work as for motif 2, using yarn D for rounds 1 to 2, yarn E for round 3 and joining to the left of motif 4.

Motif 6

Work as for motif 2, using yarn B for rounds 1 to 2, yarn A for round 3 and joining to the left of motif 5.

Motif 7

Work as for motif 2, using yarn D for rounds 1 to 2, yarn E for round 3 and joining to the left of motif 6.

ROW 2**Motif 1**

Work as for row 1, motif 2, using yarn A for rounds 1 to 2, yarn B for round 3 and joining to the bottom of row 1, motif 1.

Motif 2

Work as for row 1, motif 2, using yarn E for rounds 1 to 2, yarn C for round 3 and joining to the left of row 2, motif 1 AND the bottom of row 1, motif 2 in the same way as before on corresponding corner spaces.

Cont in this way, following the colour chart above for colour changes, joining 5 more squares to row 2 then 7 squares for each of rows 3 to 28.

SCARF

The scarf has 3 squares in each row, and 30 rows in total.

ROW 1**Motif 1**

Using 4mm (US G6) crochet hook, make 4 ch, join with ss to make a ring.

Round 1: 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 8 dc into ring, ss to first dc. 8 dc.

Round 2: 2 ch, 1 tr into same place as 2 ch (counts as tr2tog), *3 ch, 1 dc into next dc, 3 ch, tr2tog into next dc, rep from * twice more, 3 ch, 1 dc into next dc, 3 ch, ss to top of 2 ch at beg of round.

Round 3: 6 ch (counts as 1 tr and 3 ch), (1 tr, 3 ch) twice into same place as 6 ch, 1 tr into next dc, 3 ch, *(1 tr, 3 ch) 3 times into next tr2tog, 1 tr into next dc, 3 ch, rep from * twice more, ss to 3rd of 6 ch at beg of round.

Fasten off.

Motif 2

Work as for Motif 1 to end of round 2.

Round 3: 5 ch (counts as 1 tr and 2 ch), ss into corresponding 3ch-sp of motif 1 corner group,

1 ch, (1 tr, 3 ch) twice into same place as 5 ch, 1 tr into next dc, 3 ch, *(1 tr, 3 ch) 3 times into next tr2tog, 1 tr into next dc, 3 ch, rep from * once more, (1 tr, 3 ch, 1 tr) in next tr2tog, 2 ch, ss in 3ch-sp of corresponding corner of motif 1, (1 ch, 1 tr) in same tr2tog, 3 ch, 1 tr in next dc, 3 ch, ss to 3rd of 5 ch at beg of round.

Fasten off.

Motif 3

Work as for motif 2, joining to the left of motif 2.

ROW 2**Motif 1**

Work as for row 1, motif 2, joining to the bottom of row 1, motif 1.

Motif 2

Work as for row 1, motif 2, joining to the left of row 2, motif 1 AND the bottom of row 1, motif 2 in the same way as before on corresponding corner spaces.

Cont in this way, joining 1 more square to row 2, then 3 squares for each of rows 3 to 30.

Repeat rows 3 and 4 until wrap meas approx. 60 cm vertically from the centre start point, ending after a patt row 3.

BACK

Using 4.00mm (US G6) crochet hook make 183 [195: 204: 213: 222] ch.

Foundation row 1 (WS): 1 dc into 6th ch from hook, *2 ch, miss 2 ch, 1 dc into next ch, rep from * to end, turn.

Foundation row 2: 3 ch (counts as 1 tr), 1 tr into first dc, *miss 2 ch, 3 tr into next dc, rep from * until 3 tr have been worked into last dc, miss 2 ch, 2 tr into next ch, turn. 181 [193: 202: 211: 220] sts.

Foundation row 3: 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 1 dc into first tr, *2 ch, miss 2 tr, 1 dc into next tr (this is centre tr of group of 3), rep from * to end, working last dc into top of 3 ch at beg of previous row, turn.

Now work in patt as folls:

Row 1 (RS): 3 ch (counts as 1 tr), 1 tr into first dc, *miss 2 ch,

3 tr into next dc, rep from * to last 3 sts, miss 2 ch, 2 tr into next dc, turn.

Next row (RS): 3 ch (counts as 1 tr), 1 tr into first dc, (miss 2 ch, 3 tr into next dc) 23 [25: 27: 28: 30] times, miss 2 ch, 2 tr into next dc, tr2tog working first "leg" of st into same dc as 2 tr just worked and 2nd "leg" into next dc and turn, leaving rem sts unworked.

Work on this set of sts only for first side of neck.

Next row: 1 ch (does NOT count as st), miss tr2tog at base of 1 ch, 1 dc into next tr, patt to end, turn. 73 [79: 85: 88: 94] sts.

Next row: Patt to last 4 sts, 2 tr into next dc, tr2tog working first "leg" of st into same dc as 2 tr just worked and 2nd "leg" into next dc, turn.

Next row: 1 ch (does NOT count as st), miss tr2tog at base of 1 ch, 1 dc into next tr, patt to end, turn. - 3 sts decreased over last 2 rows. Rep last 2 rows a further 1 [1: 2: 2: 2] times, ending with RS facing for next row. 67 [73: 76: 79: 85] sts.

Fasten off.

With RS facing, return to last complete row worked, miss centre 29 [29: 26: 29: 26] sts (this is 10 [10: 9: 10: 9] 2-ch sps), attach yarn to next dc and cont as folls:

Next row (RS): 2 ch (does NOT count as st), miss 2 ch, 3 tr into next dc, patt to end.

Next row: 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 1 dc into first tr, *2 ch, miss 2 tr, 1 dc into next tr (this is centre tr of group of 3), rep from * to end, turn. 73 [79: 85: 88: 94] sts.

Rep last 2 rows a further 2 [2: 3: 3: 3] times, ending with RS facing for next row. 67 [73: 76: 79: 85] sts.

Fasten off.

SLEEVES (worked from shoulder to cuff)

Place markers along side seam edges 19 [21: 23: 25: 27] rows down from shoulder edge (to denote base of armhole openings) - this is row 2 of patt and marked st should be a dc.

Join both shoulder seams using back stitch.

With RS facing and using 4.00mm (US G6) crochet hook attach yarn at base of armhole and working along row-end edge between markers cont as folls:

Foundation row (RS): 4 ch (counts as 1 htr and 2 ch), 2 dc into next sp formed by tr, *3 ch, miss next dc, 2 dc into next sp formed by tr, rep from * to last tr before next marker (missing both dc rows at shoulder seam), 2 ch, 1 htr into marked dc. 17 [19: 21: 23: 25] 3-ch sps.

Now work in patt as folls:

Row 1: 4 ch (counts as 1 htr and 2 ch), 1 dc into 2-ch sp at base of 4 ch, *miss 2 dc, (1 dc, 3 ch, 1 dc) into next 3-ch sp, rep from * until last 3-ch sp has been worked, miss 2 dc, (1 dc, 2 ch, 1 htr) into last 2-ch sp, turn.

This row forms sleeve patt.

Cont in patt for a further 4 [2: 2: 0: 0] rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Next row: 4 ch (counts as 1 htr and 2 ch), 1 dc into 2-ch sp at base of 4 ch, *miss 2 dc, (1 dc,

3 ch, 1 dc) into next 3-ch sp, rep from * until last 3-ch sp has been worked, miss 2 dc, 1 dc into last 2-ch sp, turn.

Next row: 2 ch (does NOT count as st), miss dc at base of 2 ch and next dc, (1 dc, 3 ch, 1 dc) into next 3-ch sp, *miss 2 dc, (1 dc, 3 ch, 1 dc) into next 3-ch sp, rep from * until last 3-ch sp has been worked, miss 2 dc, 1 dc into last 2-ch sp, turn.

Next row: 2 ch (does NOT count as st), miss dc at base of 2 ch and next dc, (1 dc, 3 ch, 1 dc) into next 3-ch sp, *miss 2 dc, (1 dc, 3 ch, 1 dc) into next 3-ch sp, rep from * until last 3-ch sp remains unworked, miss 2 dc, (1 dc, 2 ch, 1 htr) into last 3-ch sp, turn.

Next row: 4 ch (counts as 1 htr and 2 ch), 1 dc into 2-ch sp at base of 4 ch, *miss 2 dc, (1 dc, 3 ch, 1 dc) into next 3-ch sp, rep from * until last 3-ch sp remains unworked, miss 2 dc, (1 dc, 2 ch, 1 htr) into last 3-ch sp, turn.

2 3-ch sps decreased over last 4 rows.

Work 6 [2: 0: 0: 0] rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Rep last 0 [6: 4: 4: 4] rows 0 [1: 2: 3: 3] times more. 15 [15: 15: 15: 17] 3-ch sps.

Cont in patt for a further 0 [0: 2: 0: 0] rows, ending with RS facing for next row. (Sleeve should meas approx 15 [15: 16: 16: 16] cm.) Fasten off.

MAKING UP

Press as described on the information page.

Neck edging

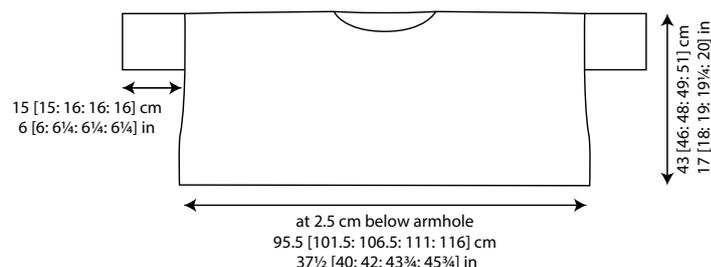
With RS facing and using 4.00mm (US G6) crochet hook, attach yarn at neck edge of one shoulder seam, 1 ch (does NOT count as st), work 1 round of dc evenly around entire neck edge, ending with ss to first dc, do NOT turn.

Now work 1 round of crab st (dc worked from left to right, instead of right to left) around entire neck edge, ending with ss to first dc. Fasten off.

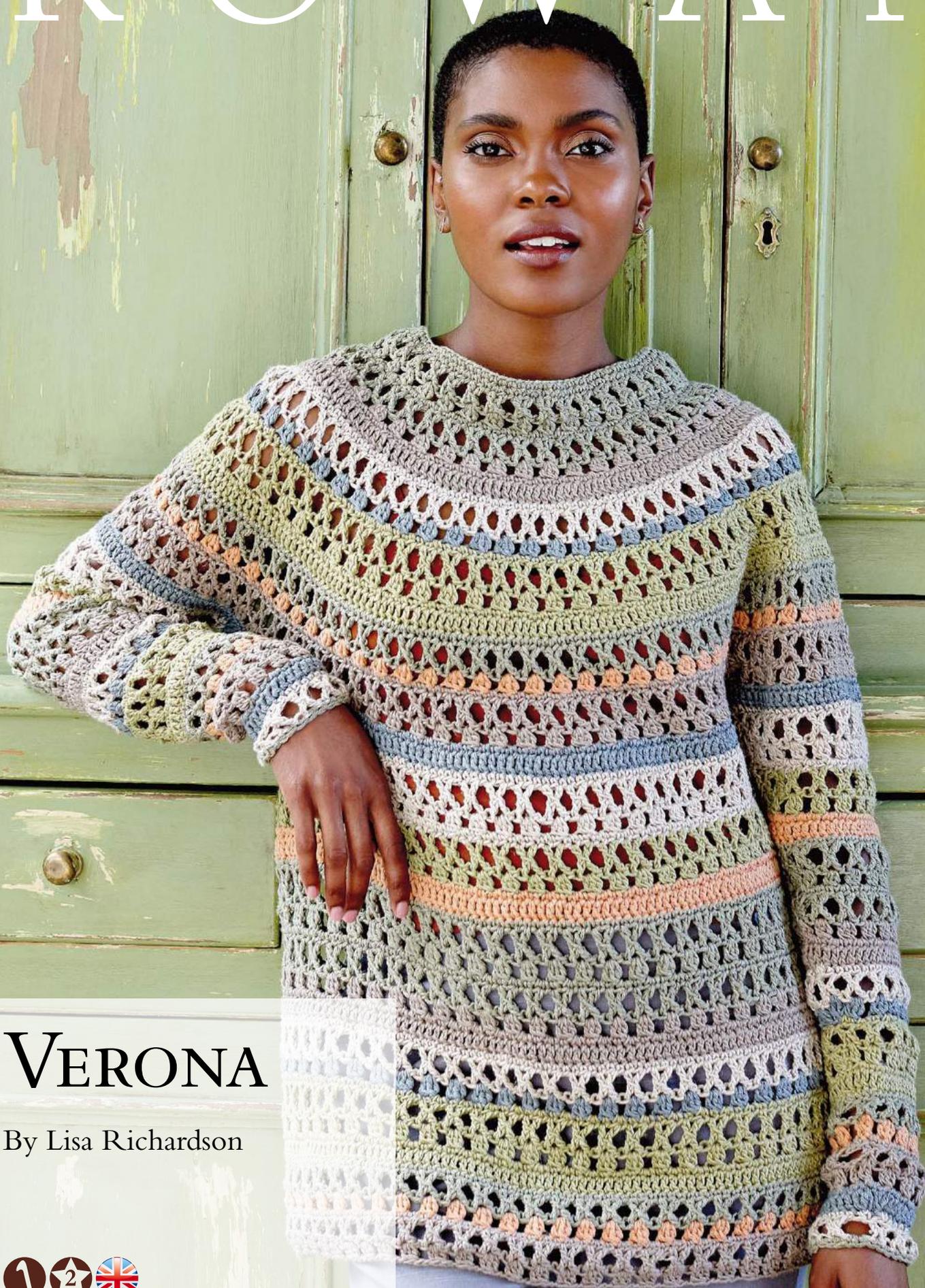
Remove armhole markers.

Place markers (for side slits) along side seams edges 16 cm above hem. Join both underarm and side seams, leaving side seams open below markers.

Next Round: Ss into ch sp formed by 4 ch at beg of last round, 3 ch, tr2tog into ch sp at base of 3 ch (counts as tr3tog), *work tr3tog into next 1 ch sp, 2 ch, rep from * to end, join with ss to starting ch. 76 tr3tog sts, 152 ch.

Next Round: 1 ch (counts as 1 dc), *1 dc into next st, rep from * to end, join with a ss to starting ch.

Next Round: 3 ch (counts as 1 tr), *1 tr into next st, rep from * to end, join with a ss to starting ch.

Next Round: 1 ch (counts as 1 dc), *1 dc into next st, rep from * to end, join with ss to starting ch.

Next Round: BegDtrX over first 3 sts (counts as 1 DtrX), *DtrX over next 3 sts, rep from * to end, ss to 3rd of 4 ch at top of BegDtrX at beg of round. 76 DtrX sts.

Next Round: Ss into ch sp formed by 4 ch at beg of last round, 3 ch, tr2tog into ch sp at base of 3 ch (counts as tr3tog), *work tr3tog into next 1 ch sp, 2 ch, rep from * to end, join with ss to starting ch. 76 tr3tog sts, 152 ch.

Next Round: 1 ch (counts as 1 dc), *1 dc into next ch, rep from * to end, join with ss to starting ch.

Next Round: BegDtrX over first 3 sts (counts as 1 DtrX), *DtrX over next 3 sts, rep from * to end, ss to 3rd of 4 ch at top of BegDtrX at beg of round. 76 DtrX sts.

Next Round: Ss into ch sp formed by 4 ch at beg of last round, 3 ch, tr2tog into ch sp at base of 3 ch (counts as tr3tog), *work tr3tog into next 1 ch sp, 2 ch, rep from * to end, join with ss to starting ch. 76 tr3tog sts, 152 ch.

Next Round: 1 ch (counts as 1 dc), *1 dc into next st, rep from * to end, join with a ss to starting ch.

Next Round: 3 ch (counts as 1 tr), *1 tr into next st, rep from * to end, join with a ss to starting ch.

All sizes

Last 8 rounds set patt. Cont in patt and stripe sequence until work meas approx. 38 [38.5: 39: 39.5: 39.5] cm from armhole.

Fasten off.

SLEEVES (both alike)

With RS facing, starting at centre of underarm, rejoin yarn and keeping patt and stripe sequence correct (throughout) as set on front and back, working all decs by working dc2tog or tr2tog (as indicated by patt) proceed as follows:

Work 6 [6: 4: 4: 1] rounds dec 1 st at beg and end of next round, and 3rd [3rd: 4th: -: -] round, and 6th [6th: -: -] round.

51 [53: 57: 60: 62] sts.

Work 18 [18: 10: 2: 10] rounds dec 1 st at beg and end of 3rd [3rd: 3rd: -: 3rd], then 5th [5th: 5th: -: 5th], and 8th [8th: 8th: -: 8th], and 11th [11th: -: -: -], and 13th [13th: -: -: -], and 16th [16th: -: -: -] rounds. 39 [41: 51: 60: 56] sts.

Work 13 [14: 24: 32: 29] rounds dec 1 st at beg and end of every dc or tr round. 27 [27: 27: 28: 28] sts.

Cont without shaping until sleeve meas approx. 45 [45: 46: 46: 46] cm.

Cuff

Cont using yarn A only.

Next Round: 1 ch (does not count as 1 dc), *1 dc into next st, rep from * to end, join with ss to starting ch.

Fasten off.

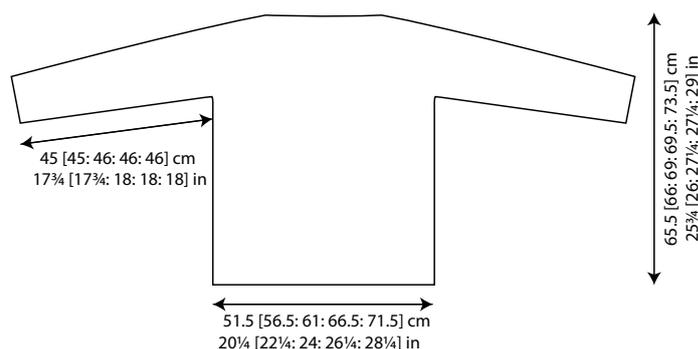
