MATERIALS

MC:

Cashmere People Yarns
Sport Cashmere (100% handspun cashmere)
260-359 yards [238-328 meters]/100 grams
sport weight

CC1:

Spincycle Yarns
Nocturne (100% superwashed American wool)
200 yards [183 meters]
sport weight

CC2:

Spincycle Yarns
Dyed in the Wool (100% non-superwashed American wool)
200 yards [183 meters]
sport weight

Colors used in sample:

MC: Pamirs
CC1: Moonflower
CC2: Devilish Grin

Needles:

Note that needle sizes are suggested only. You may need to use a different size to achieve gauge.

Ribbing: US 2 [2.75 mm]
Main: US 3 [3.25 mm]

Notions: Stitch marker, scrap yarn or stitch holders, tapestry needle, cable needle, row counter (optional)

GAUGE

24 sts and 32 rounds = 4" [10 cm] in colorwork on main needles after blocking

Note- You should always knit your swatch the same way that the pattern is knit—in this case, in the round. Block your swatch as you will your finished garment and allow it to dry fully before measuring.

Northerly is a circular yoke sweater knit seamlessly from the top down. Featuring colorwork, cables and lace, this is a fun and engaging knit. I was inspired by the colors of winter in Alaska and creating an updated take on classic Scandinavian style sweaters. I knit mine with elbow length sleeves and a cropped body length but these are both adjustable to your preference.



Sizes: 1 (2, 3, 4, 5, 6) {7, 8, 9}

Recommended ease: 2-10" [5-25 cm] of positive ease at the bust. Be sure to check the sleeve measurement of the size you choose to ensure a good fit. See schematic on page 8 for full fit details.

Sweater shown is size 3 on a 35" [89 cm] bust with 5" [13 cm] of ease.

Finished bust circumference: 30 (35, 40, 45, 50, 55) {60, 65, 70}" [76 (89, 101.5, 114.5, 127, 139.5) {152.5, 165, 178} cm]

Yardage: Please note that yardage is estimated, and can vary between knitters.

MC: 690 (805, 920, 1035, 1150, 1265) {1380, 1495, 1610} yards [631 (736, 841, 946, 1052, 1157) {1262, 1367, 1472} meters]

CC1: 324, 378, 432, 486, 540, 594) {648, 702, 756} yards [297 (346, 395, 445, 494, 543) {593, 642, 691} meters]

CC2: 216 (252, 288, 324, 360, 396) {432, 468, 504} yards [198 (231, 264, 297, 330, 362) {395, 428, 461} meters]

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DIRECTIONS

NECKLINE

With ribbing needles and CC1, CO 100 (104, 104, 108, 112, 116) {116, 120, 120} sts using your preferred stretchy cast-on method. Sample uses Long Tail Cast-On. Join in the round and place a unique marker to indicate BOR, taking care not to twist sts. BOR is at the center back.

2x2 Ribbing

Round 1: *K2, p2; repeat from * to BOR.
Break CC1. With MC, continue working in 2x2 ribbing pattern until work measures 1.5" [4 cm] from cast on edge.

Change to main needle. Continue using MC.

Yoke

Knit 1 round.

Increase Round 1:

Size 1: K2, (m1L, k5) 19 times, m1L, k3. 20 sts increased

Size 2: K2, (m1L, k3) 12 times, (m1L, k4) 7 times, (m1L, k3) 12 times, m1L, k2. 32 sts increased

Size 3: K1, (m1L, k3) 12 times, (m1L, k2) 15 times, (m1L, k3) 12 times, m1L, k1. 40 sts increased

Size 4: K1, (m1L, k3) 10 times, (m1L, k2) 23 times, (m1L, k3) 10 times, m1L, k1. 44 sts increased

Size 5: K1, (m1L, k3) 8 times, (m1L, k2) 31 times, (m1L, k3) 8 times, m1L, k1. 48 sts increased

Size 6: K1, (m1L, k1) 2 times, (m1L, k2) 55 times, (m1L, k1) 2 times, m1L, k1. 60 sts increased

Size 7: K1, (m1L, k1) 18 times, (m1L, k2) 39 times, (m1L, k1) 18 times, m1L, k1. 76 sts increased

Size 8: K1, (m1L, k1) 28 times, (m1L, k2) 31 times, (m1L, k1) 28 times, m1L, k1. 88 sts increased

Size 9: K1, (m1L, k1) 36 times, (m1L, k2) 23 times, (m1L, k1) 36 times, m1L, k1. 96 sts increased

120 (136, 144, 152, 160, 176) {192, 208, 216} sts

Next Round: K.

Short Rows

Wrap and turn short rows are worked flat using the wrap and turn method. You can substitute your preferred short row method if desired.

Row 1 (RS): From BOR, k 32 (36, 38, 40, 42, 46) {50, 54, 56} sts, wrap and turn.

Row 2 (WS): **P to BOR**, sm, p 32 (36, 38, 40, 42, 46) {50, 54, 56} sts, wrap and turn.

Row 3 (RS): K to 4 sts before wrapped st, wrap and turn.

Row 4 (WS): P to 4 sts before wrapped st, wrap and turn.

Repeat [Rows 3 and 4] 1 (2, 2, 2, 3, 3) {3, 3, 3} time(s) more.

End short rows and resume knitting in the round.

Knit to BOR, sm, knit one round, picking up and knitting wraps with their corresponding sts as you come to them.

Knit 0 (1, 1, 1, 1, 1) {2, 1, 2} round(s).

Yoke Chart

Begin working Yoke Chart as shown on page 5, making increases and changing colors as shown. Be sure to follow the correct chart for your size.

After completing yoke chart break all but MC.

285 (323, 360, 380, 440, 484) {528, 598, 621} sts

Sizes 1, 2, 4, 6 and 9, work Increase Round 2 as described on next page.

Sizes 3, 5, 7 and 8: K one round. Move ahead to Sleeve Separation.

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Increase Round 2:

Size 1, 2 and 9: M1L, k approximately one third of sts, m1L, k approximately one third of sts, m1L, k to BOR. *3 sts increased*

Size 4: K19, (m1L, k38) 9 times, m1L, k19. *10 sts increased*

Size 6: M1L, k approximately half of sts, m1L, k to BOR. *2 sts increased*

288 (326, -, 390, -, 486){-, -, 624} sts

Sleeve Separation

From BOR, k 43 (50, 57, 63, 70, 76) {84, 93, 100} sts, place next 57 (62, 66, 69, 80, 90) {96, 112, 111} sts on holder for right sleeve, cast on 3 (4, 6, 9, 10, 12) {12, 8, 9} sts for underarm using the backwards loop method, k 87 (101, 114, 126, 140, 153) {168, 187, 201} sts, place next 57 (62, 66, 69, 80, 90) {96, 112, 111} sts on holder for left sleeve, cast on 3 (4, 6, 9, 10, 12) {12, 8, 9} sts for underarm using the backwards loop method, k to BOR.

180 (210, 240, 270, 300, 330) {360, 390, 420} body sts

BODY

Body Chart A

With main needle, begin working Body Chart A as shown on page 6, changing colors as shown.

Body Chart B

Work Body Chart B as shown on page 6, changing colors as shown. If you wish to add length to the body (see schematic for length information) you can work repeat section as many times as desired. Each repeat adds approximately .75" [2 cm] of length. Please keep in mind that making adjustments will impact the yardage requirements.

After working all rounds of chart, break all but CC1.

Sizes 1, 3, 5, 7 and 9: Knit 1 round with CC1.

Sizes 2, 4, 6 and 8: K2tog, knit approximately halfway around, k2tog, k to BOR. *2 sts decreased*

180 (208, 240, 268, 300, 328) {360, 388, 420} body sts

Switch to ribbing needles.

2x2 Hem Ribbing

Round 1: *K2, p2; repeat from * to BOR,

Repeat Round 1 until hem ribbing measures 1" [2.5 cm].

Bind off in pattern using a stretchy bind off. Sample uses Jeny's Surprisingly Stretchy Bind Off.

SLEEVES (Both worked the same):

Move held sleeve sts onto main needle. Join MC at underarm to begin knitting around. Knit all sts, picking up and knitting 3 (4, 6, 9, 10, 12) {12, 8, 9} underarm sts when you come to them, pm in approximate center of underarm sts for BOR.

60 (66, 72, 78, 90, 102) {108, 120, 120} sleeve sts

Sleeve Chart

Begin working Sleeve Chart as shown on page 6, changing colors and making increase as shown. Work repeat section [Rounds 35-40] as many times as desired for the sleeve length you want. Sample shown works repeat section four times total. Each repeat adds approximately .75" [2 cm] of length. Total sleeve length as knit for sample is 14" [35.5 cm]. Length can also be added to solid section before cuff. Please keep in mind that making adjustments will impact the yardage requirements.

After working all rounds of chart, break all but CC1.

70 (77, 84, 91, 105, 119) {126, 140, 140} sleeve sts

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Decrease Round

Size 1: K1, (k2tog, k2) 8 times, k2tog, k1, (k2tog, k2) 8 times, k2tog. *18 sts decreased*

Size 2: K1, (k2tog, k2) 4 times, (k2tog, k1) 14 times, (k2tog, k2) 4 times, k2tog. *23 sts decreased*

Size 3: K1, (k2tog, k1) 27 times, k2tog. *28 sts decreased*

Size 4: K1, (k2tog) 4 times, (k2tog, k1) 24 times, (k2tog) 5 times. *33 sts decreased*

Size 5: K1, (k2tog) 15 times, (k2tog, k1) 14 times, k2tog 16 times. *45 sts decreased*

Size 6: K1, *k2tog; repeat from * to BOR. *59 sts decreased*

Size 7: *K1, (k2tog) 31 times; repeat from * once to BOR. *62 sts decreased*

Sizes 8 and 9: *K2tog; repeat from * to BOR. *70 sts decreased*

52 (54, 56, 58, 60, 60) {64, 70, 70} sts

Switch to ribbing needles.

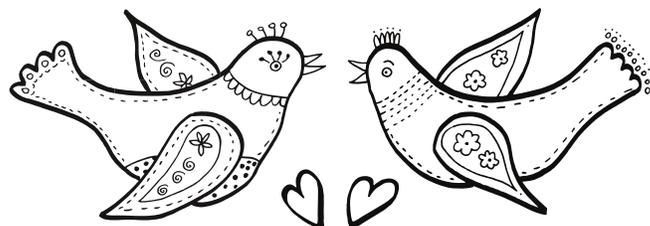
1x1 Cuff Ribbing

Round 1: *K2, p2; repeat from * to BOR,
Repeat Round 1 until cuff ribbing measures 1" [2.5 cm].

Bind off in pattern using a stretchy bind off. Sample uses Jeny's Surprisingly Stretchy Bind Off.

Finishing

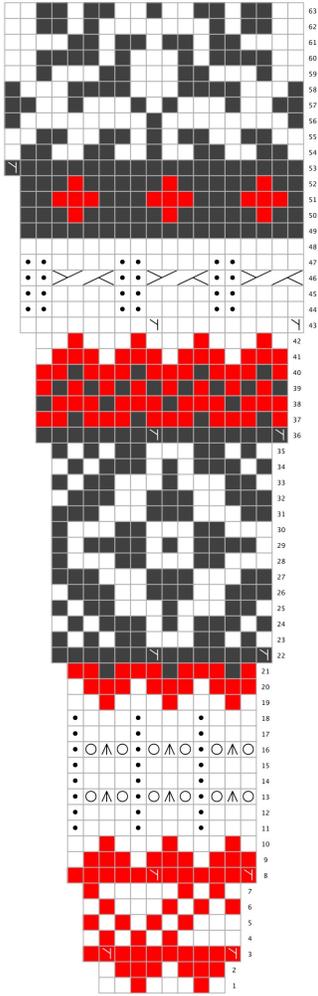
Weave in ends and block. Enjoy your sweater!



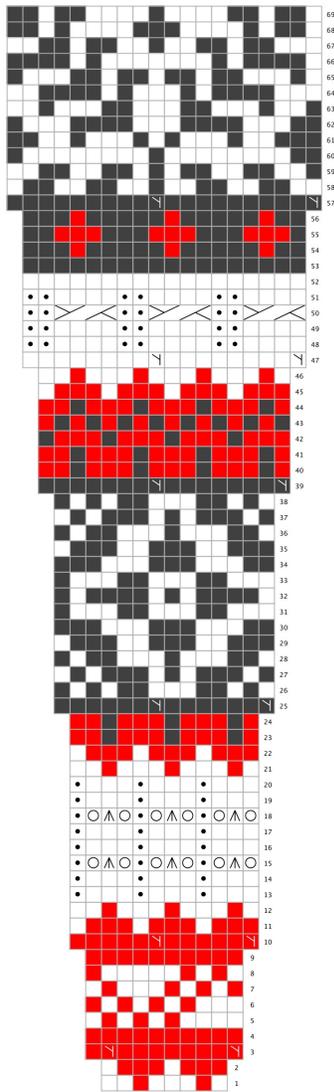

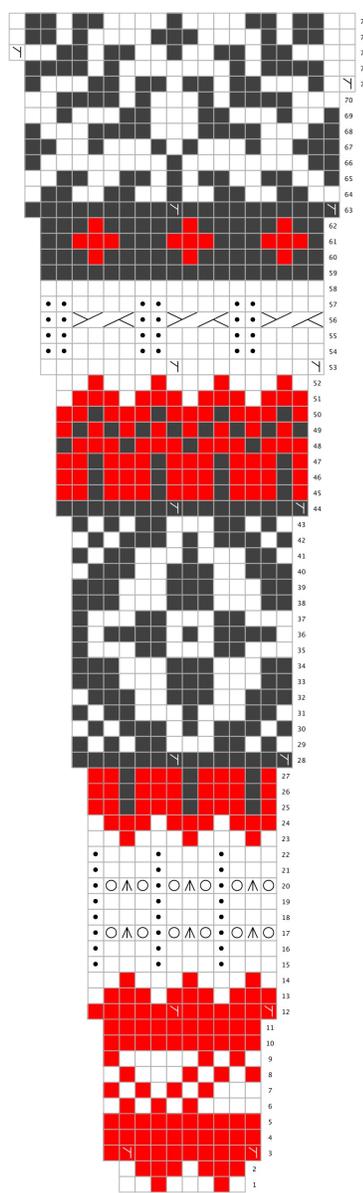
sizes 1&2



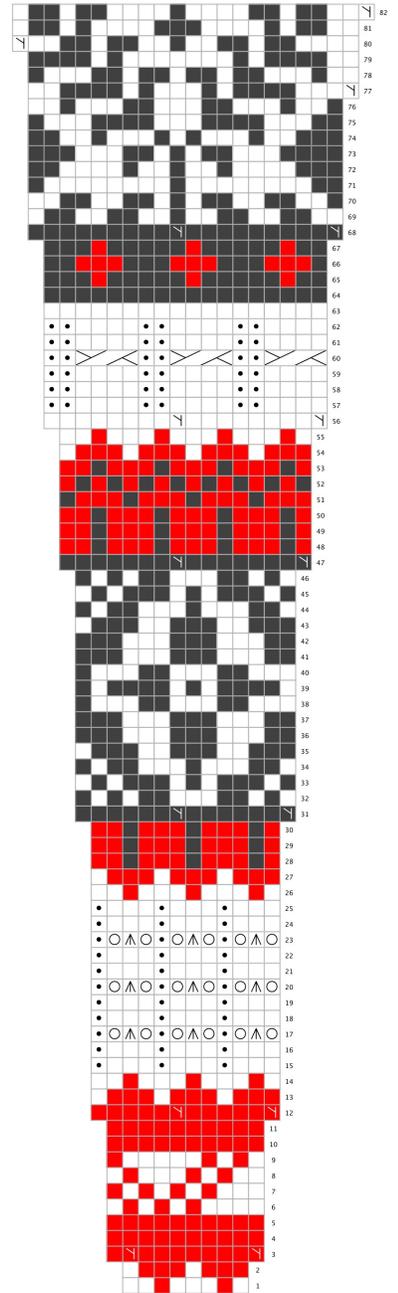

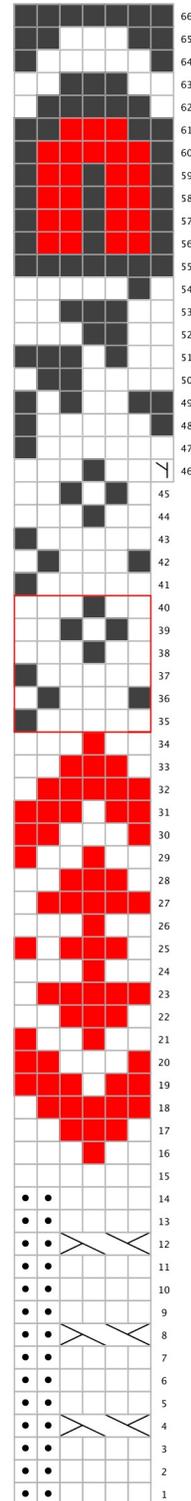

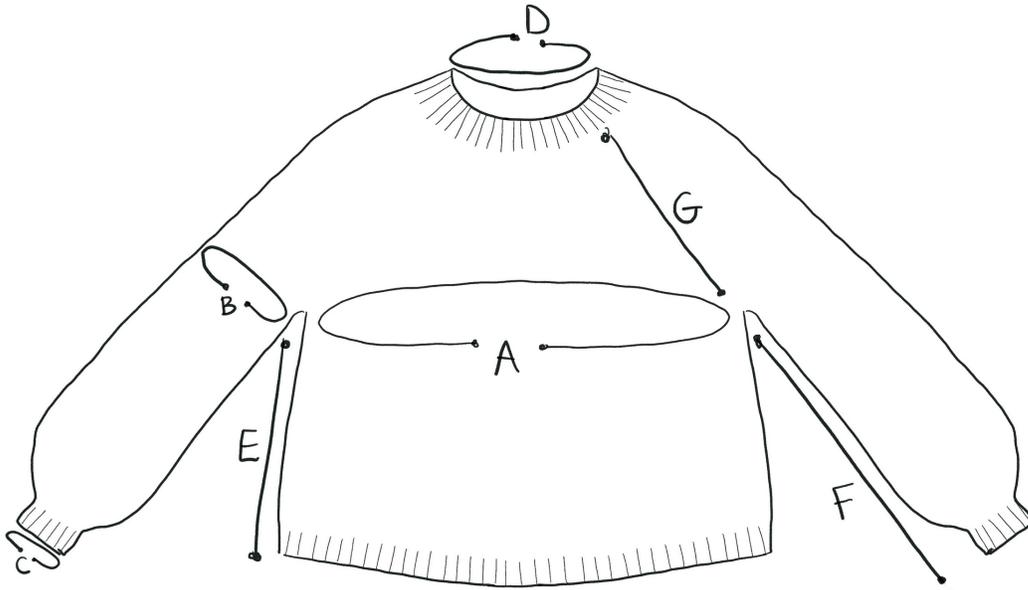
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abbreviations

2/2 LC	Slip 2 sts onto a cable needle and hold in front, k2, then k2 from cable needle.
2/2 RC	Slip 2 sts onto a cable needle and hold in back, k2, then k2 from cable needle.
CC1 (2)	Contrast color 1 (2)
cdd	Center double decrease- Slip two stitches to right needle as if to knit them together, knit the next stitch, then insert the left needle from left to right into the two slipped stitches and pass them over the knit stitch
K	knit
k2tog	knit 2 together
MC	Main color
m1L	Make one left leaning
P	purl
pm	Place marker
RS	Right side
sm	slip marker
ssk	slip, slip, knit
st(s)	stitch(es)
WS	Wrong side
yo	Yarn over
