MATERIALS AND TOOLS

- Yarn: Plush/velvet/chenille yarn (I used Himalaya Velvet, Himalaya Dolphin baby 120m/100gr)

#White: 1 skein , #Dark grey: 1 skein.

- Crochet hook 4.00mm
- Safety eyes 14mm or crocheted eyes (video tutorial)
- Stuffing (Polyester fiber fill)
- Tapestry needle
- Scissors
- Pins
- Stitch marker or contrast color yarn
- Finished size: 35 cm (~14")

ABBREVIATIONS

- MR: Magic Ring
- ch: chain
- sc: single crochet
- inc: increase
- dec: decrease (Invisible decrease)
- Rnd: round
- st/sts: stitch/stitches

NOTES

- Work in a continuous spiral unless otherwise stated. Do not join rounds.
- Use a stitch marker or a piece of yarn to mark the beginning of round.
- Proper stuffing is an important step in creating a well-shaped and appealing crochet animal. Take your time, use small amounts of stuffing at a time, and shape and adjust as needed to achieve the desired result. Insert more fluffy stuffing into the part of your crochet animal that you want to stuff, such as the cheeks or belly.

CHANGE COLOR

With the two loops from the previous yarn on the hook, wrap the new yarn around the hook, then pull the new yarn through the two loops of the stitch. When the color changes are widely spread, I usually cut a inside strands and tie them together.




HEAD

Begin with White yarn

Ch 5, start in second chain from the hook. Working on both sides of a chain (working on a foundation chain (at 2:59):

- **Rnd 1:** 1 inc, 2 sc, 4 sc into the last stitch, continue the other side of the foundation chain: 2sc, 1 inc. (12)
- **Rnd 2:** 2 inc, 2 sc, 4 inc, 2 sc, 2 inc. (20)
- **Rnd 3:** 20 sc. (20)
- **Rnd 4-5:** White (W) 3 sc, Grey (G) 4 sc, (W) 13 sc. (2 rnds) (20)
- **Rnd 6:** (W) inc, 1 sc, (G) inc, 1 sc, 4 inc, 1sc, inc, (W) 1sc, inc, 8 sc. (28)
- **Rnd 7:** (W) inc, 1 sc, (G) inc, 3 sc, (W) inc, (G) 1 sc, inc, 2 sc, inc, 1 sc, (W) inc, (G) 3 sc, inc, (W) 1 sc, inc, 8 sc. (36)
- **Rnd 8:** (W) inc, 2 sc, inc, (G) 4 sc, (W)1 sc, inc, (G)2 sc, inc, (W) 2 sc, (G) inc, 2 sc, (W) inc, 1 sc, (G) 4 sc, (W) inc, 2 sc, inc, 8 sc (44)
- **Rnd 9:** (W) 2 sc, (inc, 1 sc) x 2 times, 2 sc, (G) 2 sc, (W) 3 sc, (G) 4 sc, (W) 3 sc, (G) 4 sc, (W) 3 sc, (G) 2 sc, (W) 2 sc, (1 sc, inc) x 2 times, 9 sc. (48)
- **Rnd 10:** (W) 10 sc, (G) 9 sc, (W) 3 sc, (G) 9 sc, (W) 17 sc.(48)

HEAD (cont.)

Insert the safety eyes between round 7 and 8, the distance between 2 eyes is 13 sts.

(Rnd 7: Skip the 7 stitches from the beginning, attach the first eye)

- **Rnd 11:** (W) 10 sc, (G) 9 sc, (W) 3 sc, (G) 10 sc, (W) 16 sc.(48)
- **Rnd 12:** (W) 10 sc, (G) 10 sc, (W) 2 sc, (G) 10 sc, (W) 16 sc.(48)
- **Rnd 13:** (W) 9 sc, (G) 11 sc, (W) 1 sc, (G) 12 sc, (W) 15 sc.(48)
- **Rnd 14:** (W) 8 sc, (G) 27 sc, (W) 13 sc. (48)
- **Rnd 15:** (W) 7 sc, (G) 30 sc, (W) 11 sc. (48)
- **Rnd 16:** (W) 6 sc, (G) 42 sc. (48) --> **cut white yarn**
- **Rnd 17:** 48 sc. (48)
- **Rnd 18:** (dec, 6 sc) x 6 times. (42)
- **Rnd 19:** (5sc, dec) x 6 times. (36)
- **Rnd 20:** (2 sc, dec, 2 sc) x 6 times. (30)

Start stuffing the head.

- **Rnd 21:** (3 sc, dec) x 6 times. (24)
- **Rnd 22:** (1 sc, dec, 1 sc) x 6 times. (18)

Stuff the head firmly with fiberfill (video: <https://youtu.be/leJ9mh6pkJo>)

- **Rnd 23:** (1 sc, dec) x 6 times. (12)

Fasten off and leave a long tail. Embroider the eyelashes and the nose first. Then weave the yarn tail through the front loops of the last round and pull it tight to close the hole.

You can use black cotton yarn for embroider the nose and the eyelashes.

- Embroider the nose with dark brown yarn (around Rnd 1-2), 5 stitches wide.

EARS (make 2)

Begin with Grey yarn.

Rnd 1: 4 sc into a MR. (4)

Rnd 2: (W) 2 inc, (G) 2 inc. (8)

Rnd 3: (W) (1 sc, inc) x 2 times, (G) (1 sc, inc) x 2 times. (12)

Rnd 4: (W) (1 sc, inc, 1 sc) x 2 times, (G) (1 sc, inc, 1 sc) x 2 times.

(16)

Rnd 5: (W) (3 sc, inc) x 2 times, (G) (3 sc, inc) x 2 times. (20)

Rnd 6: (W) (2 sc, inc, 2 sc) x 2 times, (G) (2 sc, inc, 2 sc) x 2 times.

(24)

Rnd 7: (W) (5 sc, inc) x 2 times, (G) (5 sc, inc) x 2 times. (28)

Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing. Bring the ending yarn to sew the open side of the ear together. (video:

Sew the ears on the head between Rnd 15-19, the distance between 2 ears is 3 stitches.



BACK PAWS

Right back paw:

Begin with white yarn.

Ch 6, start in second chain from the hook. Working on both sides of a chain.

- **Rnd 1:** 1 inc, 3 sc, 3 sc into the last stitch, continue the other side of the foundation chain: 4 sc. (12)
- **Rnd2:** 2 inc, 3 sc, 3 inc, 3 sc, 1 inc. (18)
- **Rnd 3:** (1 sc, inc) x 2 times, 3 sc, (1 sc, inc) x 3 times, 4 sc, inc. (24)
- **Rnd 4 -5:** 24 sc. (2 rnds) (24)
- **Rnd 6:** (1 dec, 10 sc) * repeat 2 times. (22)
- **Rnd 7:** (1 dec, 9 sc) * repeat 2 times. (20)

Fasten off and weave in ends.

Left back paw: Do the same as the right paw until round 7 but DO NOT cut the yarn.

Join the paws together to make the body. (video:

BODY

- **Rnd 8:** 10 sc on left paw , chain 4, 20 sc around right paw, 4 sc on back bump of the chains between 2 paws, 10 sc on left paw. (48) (video)
- **Rnd 9:** 48 sc. (48)
- **Rnd 10:** (7 sc, inc) x 6 times. (54)
- **Rnd 11:** (4 sc, inc, 4 sc) x 6 times. (60)
- **Rnd 12:** (W) 30 sc, (G) 30 sc. (60)
- **Rnd 13:** (G) 2 sc, (W) 26 sc, (G) 32 sc. (60)
- **Rnd 14:** (G) 4 sc, (W) 22 sc, (G) 34 sc. (60)
- **Rnd 15 - 17:** (G) 6 sc, (W) 18 sc, (G) 36 sc. (3 rnds) (60)

Stuff the paws lightly with fiberfill.



BODY (cont.)

- **Rnd 18:** (G) 5 sc, (W) 20 sc, (G) 35 sc. (60)
- **Rnd 19:** (G) 4 sc, (W) dec, 18 sc, dec, (G) 34 sc. (58)
- **Rnd 20:** (G) 3 sc, (W) dec, 18 sc, dec, (G) 33 sc. (56)
- **Rnd 21:** (G) 2 sc, (W) dec, 18 sc, dec, (G) 32 sc. (54)
- **Rnd 22:** (G) 3 sc, (W) 18 sc, (G) 33 sc. (54)
- **Rnd 23:** (G) 4 sc, (W) 16 sc, (G) 34 sc. (54)
- **Rnd 24-29:** (G) 5 sc, (W) 14 sc, (G) 35 sc. (6 rnds) (54)
- **Rnd 30:** (G) 4 sc, (W) 16 sc, (G) 34 sc. (54)
- **Rnd 31:** (G) 3 sc, (W) 18 sc, (G) 33 sc. (54)
- **Rnd 32:** (G) 2 sc, (W) 20 sc, (G) 32 sc. (54)
- **Rnd 33:** (G) 1 sc, (W) 22 sc, (G) 31 sc. (54)
- **Rnd 34-35:** (W) 24 sc, (G) 30 sc. (2 rnds) (54) --> **cut grey yarn**
- **Rnd 36:** (W) 54 sc. (54)
- **Rnd 37:** (dec, 7 sc) x 6 times. (48)
- **Rnd 38:** (3sc, dec, 3 sc) x 6 times. (42)

Stuff the body lightly with fiberfill. (video: <https://youtu.be/leJ9mh6pkJo>)

FRONT PAWS (make 2)

To make the front paws, divide the work, identifying 1 stitch for the central space between the paws, 1 stitch for the back and 20 stitches for each paw.

- **Rnd 39:** 20 sc. (20)
- **Rnd 40:** (9 sc, inc) x 2 times. (22)
- **Rnd 41:** (10 sc, inc) x 2 times. (24)
- **Rnd 42-44:** 24 sc. (3 rnds) (24)



FRONT PAWS (cont.)

- **Rnd 45:** (1 sc, dec, 1 sc) x 6 times. (18)
- **Rnd 46:** (1 sc, dec) x 6 times. (12)

Stuff the paws lightly with fiberfill.

Join the new strand of white yarn to make another paw.

Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing. Bring the ending yarn to sew the open side of the paw together.



TAIL

Begin with White yarn.

- **Rnd 1:** 6 sc into a MG. (6)
- **Rnd 2:** 6 inc. (12)
- **Rnd 3:** (1 sc, inc) x 6 times. (18)

Change to grey yarn.

- **Rnd 4-6:** 18 sc. (3 rnds) (18)

Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.

ASSEMBLY

*****Please watch the video carefully to make similar puppy*****

- Sew the ears on the head between Rnd 15-19, the distance between 2 ears is 3 sts.
- Sew the head (Rnd 16) on the body (Rnd 35).
- Sew the tail on the body between Rnd 13-17.
