



# SIDE-TO-SIDE CABLED PULLOVER

Design by Robin Melanson for Naturally Yarns

**Chart notes:** Read RS (odd-numbered) rows from right to left and WS (even-numbered) rows from left to right.

## BACK

Garment is knit side-to-side, beginning with the upper sleeve, working across the front or back, and ending with the opposite upper sleeve. The lower sleeves and body are picked up and knitted down afterwards. Please read through all instructions as shaping is worked concurrently.

\* With 5mm straight needles, cast on 35 (35, 37, 47, 47, 49) sts.

FIRST 3 SIZES ONLY: Next Row: (WS) P6, k12, p6, place marker (pm), k2, p9 (9, 11).

LAST 3 SIZES ONLY: Next Row: (WS) K6, p12, k12, p6, pm, k2, p9 (9, 11).

## ALL SIZES

Next Row: (RS) K1 (1, 3, 1, 1, 3), work Row 1 of Chart 1 over next 8 sts, p2, work Row 1 of Chart 2 over next 24 (24, 24, 36, 36, 36) sts.  
Next Row: (WS) Work even as est, working Row 2 of Charts where est.  
Next Row: (RS – Inc Row) K1, M1R, work as est to end.

Rep Inc Row every 4 rows 6 (11, 12, 13, 14, 15) times, then every 6 rows 3 (0, 0, 0, 0, 0) times, working new sts in Stst. AT THE SAME TIME, when piece measures 5.5cm, end with a RS row, cast on 6 (6, 6, 8, 8, 8) sts at beg of next 5 WS rows, then 5 (5, 5, 7, 7, 7) sts at beg of foll WS row, working new sts into Chart 2 patt until there are 48 (48, 48, 72, 72, 72) sts worked in Chart 2 patt, pm and work rem 11 sts as folls (RS): p2, work Chart 1 over next 8 sts, k1 – 80 (82, 85, 108, 109, 112) sts when all shaping is complete.

Work even as est until piece measures 20.5 (23, 24, 26.5, 28.5, 30) cm from beg, end with a WS row. \*

Place waste yarn marker at Right edge of piece to mark Back neck. Work even until piece measures 20.5 (20.5, 23, 23, 24, 26.5) cm from waste yarn marker, and place another waste yarn marker at Right edge.

Work even until piece measures 2.5 (4, 4, 5, 5, 5) cm from last waste yarn marker.

\*\* Next Row: (RS – Dec Row) K1, ssk, work as est to end.

Rep Dec Row every 6 rows 3 (0, 0, 0, 0, 0) times then every 4 rows

6 (11, 12, 13, 14, 15) times, AT THE SAME TIME, when piece measures 40.5 (45.5, 51, 56, 61, 66) cm from last cast-on at Left edge of piece, end with a RS row, cast off 5 (5, 5, 7, 7, 7) sts at beg of next WS row, then 6 (6, 6, 8, 8, 8) sts at beg of next 5 WS rows – 35 (35, 37, 47, 47, 49) sts rem when all shaping is complete.

Work even until piece measures 20.5 (23, 24, 26.5, 28.5, 30) cm from second waste yarn marker. Cast off rem sts.

## LOWER BACK

With 5mm straight needles, pick up and knit 72 (82, 90, 100, 108, 118) sts evenly along Left edge (shorter edge) of Back.

Work in Stst until piece measures 18cm from picked-up sts. Cast off all sts. \*\*

## FRONT

Work as for Back from \* to \*.

## Shape Front Neck

Next Row: (RS) Cast off 2 sts, work as est to end – 78 (80, 83, 106, 107, 110) sts.

Next Row: (WS) work even.

Next Row: (RS – Dec Row) K1, ssk, work as est to end.

Rep Dec Row every other row 6 (8, 10, 10, 11, 12) more times – 71 (71, 72, 95, 95, 97) sts.

Work even until piece measures 14.5 (12.5, 14, 14, 14.5, 16) cm from beg of neck shaping, end with a WS row.

## WHAT YOU'LL NEED

### Yarn

5 (6, 7, 8, 9, 10) x 100gm balls Naturelle 10ply, 100% Pure NZ Wool in shade #158

### Needles

5mm straight and circular needles 60cm  
Cable needle (cn)  
Stitch markers  
Stitch holders

### Tension

18 sts over Stst on 5mm needles = 10cm  
23 sts over Cable pattern on 5mm needles = 10cm

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## SIDE-TO-SIDE CABLED PULLOVER



Next Row: (RS – Inc Row) K1, M1R, work as est to end.

Rep Inc Row every other row 6 (8, 10, 10, 11, 12) more times – 78 (80, 83, 106, 107, 110) sts.

Cast on 2 sts at beg of next RS row – 80 (82, 85, 108, 109, 112) sts.

Work even until piece measures 2.5 (4, 4, 5, 5, 5) cm from end of neck shaping.

Complete as for Back from \*\* to \*\*.

### MAKING UP

Block pieces to measurements. Sew right shoulder/upper arm seam, matching Back neck marker to Front neck shaping.

### COLLAR

With 5mm circular needle and RSF,

beg at left side of Front neck edge, pick up and knit 42 (42, 50, 50, 54, 62) evenly around front neck edge, and 36 (36, 40, 40, 42, 48) sts along Back neck edge – 78 (78, 90, 90, 96, 110) sts.

Do not join; work back and forth in rows. Stst until collar measures 7.5cm.

Cast off loosely all sts.

Sew left shoulder/upper arm/collar seam.

### LOWER SLEEVES

With 5mm (US 8) straight needles, pick up and knit 54 (54, 58, 74, 74, 76) sts evenly across sleeve edge.

Work 11 rows Stst, end with a WS row.

Next Row: (RS – Dec Row) K1, ssk,

k to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1.

Rep Dec Row every 10 rows once more – 50 (50, 54, 70, 70, 72) sts.

Stst even until piece measures 18cm from picked-up sts.

Cast off all sts.

Rep for other sleeve.

Sew sleeve/side seams. Note that lower body and sleeves should be allowed to roll up approximately 2.5cm.

Yarns available.



### KEY

- K on RS; p on WS
- P on RS; k on WS
-  Sl 2 sts to cn, hold to front; p2, k2 from cn
-  Sl 2 sts to cn, hold to back; k2, p2 from cn
-  Sl 2 sts to cn, hold to back; k2, k2 from cn
-  Sl 2 sts to cn, hold to back; k4, k2 from cn
-  Sl 4 sts to cn, hold to front; k2, k4 from cn
-  Sl 4 sts to cn, hold to front; p2, k4 from cn
-  Sl 2 sts to cn, hold to back; k4, p2 from cn
-  Sl 4 sts to cn, hold to back; k4, k4 from cn
- Pattern repeat
