FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Bust: (36, 40, 44) [48, 52, 56] {60, 64, 68}" / (91.5, 101.5, 112) [122, 132, 142] {152.5, 162.5, 173} cm

Length: (23, 23½, 23½) [24, 24, 24½] {25, 25½, 26}" / (58.5, 59.5, 59.5) [61, 61, 62] {63.5, 65, 66} cm

Shown in size 40" / 101.5 cm.

Recommended ease: 2–4" / 5–10 cm positive ease.

YARN

BERROCO LUCCA (50 grs): (7, 8, 9) [9, 10, 11] {12, 13, 14} balls #5807 Pewter

NEEDLES and NOTIONS

Knitting needles, sizes 6 / 4 mm and 7 / 4.5 mm or size to obtain gauge

16" / 40 cm circular needle, size 6 / 4 mm

4 stitch markers

Waste yarn to hold stitches

GAUGE

18 sts and 32 rows = 4" / 10 cm in Garter St on larger needles

20 sts and 32 rows = 4" / 10 cm

over Sleeve Chart on larger needles
15 sts = 3" / 7.5 cm over Body Chart on larger needles

Gauge shown is after blocking.

To save time and ensure accurate measurements, take time to check gauge.

BACK

With smaller needles, cast on (85, 93, 103) [111, 121, 129] {139, 147, 157} sts.

Beginning with a purl row, work even in St st for 1" / 2.5 cm, end on WS.

Change to larger needles.

Establish Chart: Row 1 (RS): Knit (9, 11, 13) [14, 15, 16] {17, 18, 19}, pm, work Row 1 of Body Chart over 15 sts, pm, knit (37, 41, 47) [53, 61, 67] {75, 81, 89}, pm, work Row 1 of Body Chart over 15 sts, pm, knit to end.

Row 2 (WS): Knit to first marker, sm, work Row 2 of Body Chart to next marker, sm, knit to next marker, sm, work Row 2 of Body Chart to last marker, sm, knit to end.

Work even in pattern as established until piece measures 12" / 30.5 cm from first garter ridge, end on WS.

Make a note of the chart row you ended with for matching with the sleeve pattern.

Shape Raglan Armholes: Bind off (4, 4, 5) [5, 6, 6] {7, 8, 10} sts at beginning of the next 2 rows—(77, 85, 93) [101, 109, 117] {125, 131, 137} sts.

Note: As you decrease, when there are not enough stitches to work a yo with its corresponding SSK or k2tog, omit the yo and work the extra stitches in St st. When all chart stitches have been decreased, remove markers and work all stitches in Garter St.

Work (2, 2, 2) [2, 2, 2] {2, 2, 0} rows even, end on WS.

Dec Row (RS): K2, SSK, work in pattern as established to the last 4 sts, k2tog, k2—2 sts dec'd.

Rep Dec Row every 4th row (15, 13, 9) [8, 4, 2] {1, 0, 0} times more, then every RS row (4, 10, 18) [22, 30, 36] {40, 44, 47} times, end on WS—(37, 37, 37) [39, 39, 39] {41, 41, 41} sts. Bind off.

FRONT

Work as for back until there are (47, 47, 47) [49, 49, 49] {51, 51, 51} sts on needle, end on WS.

Divide for Neck: Next Row (RS): K2, SSK, knit (16, 16, 16) [17, 17, 17] {18, 18, 18} sts, slip these stitches to waste yarn for left side, bind off center 7 sts, then knit to the last 4 sts, SSK, k2—(19, 19, 19) [20, 20, 20] {21, 21, 21} sts.





Right Neck Edge (WS): Row 1 and all WS rows: Knit.

Row 2 (RS): Bind off 4 sts (neck edge), knit to the last 4 sts, SSK, k2—(14, 14, 14) [15, 15, 15] {16, 16, 16} sts.

Row 4: Bind off (2, 2, 2) [3, 3, 3] {4, 4, 4} sts, knit to the last 4 sts, SSK, k2—11 sts.

Row 6: Bind off 4 sts, knit to the last 4 sts, SSK, k2—6 sts.

Row 8: Bind off 2 sts, knit to the last 4 sts, SSK, k2—3 sts. Bind off remaining sts.

Left Neck Edge: Slip (19, 19, 19) [20, 20, 20] {21, 21, 21} sts from waste yarn to larger needle and join yarn to WS. Knit 2 rows, end on RS.

Row 3 (WS): Bind off 4 sts (neck edge), knit to end—(15, 15, 15) [16, 16, 16] {17, 17, 17} sts.

Row 4 (RS): K2, k2tog, knit to end—(14, 14, 14) [15, 15, 15] {16, 16, 16} sts.

Row 5 (WS): Bind off (2, 2, 2) [3, 3, 3] {4, 4, 4} sts, knit to end—12 sts.

Row 6 (RS): K2, k2tog, knit to end—11 sts.

Row 7 (WS): Bind off 4 sts, knit to end—7 sts.

Row 8 (RS): K2, k2tog, knit to end—6 sts.

Row 9 (WS): Bind off 2 sts, knit to last 4 sts, k2tog, k2—3 sts. Bind off remaining sts.

SLEEVES

With smaller needles, cast on 45 sts.

Beginning with a purl row, work even in St st for 1" / 2.5 cm, end on WS.

Change to larger needles.

Next Row (RS): Knit.

Next Row (WS): P1, knit to the last stitch, p1.

Rep these 2 rows until sleeve measures 2" / 5 cm from beginning (with rolled edge flattened out), end on WS.

Inc Row (RS): K2, M1R, knit to the last 2 sts, M1L, k2—2 sts inc'd.

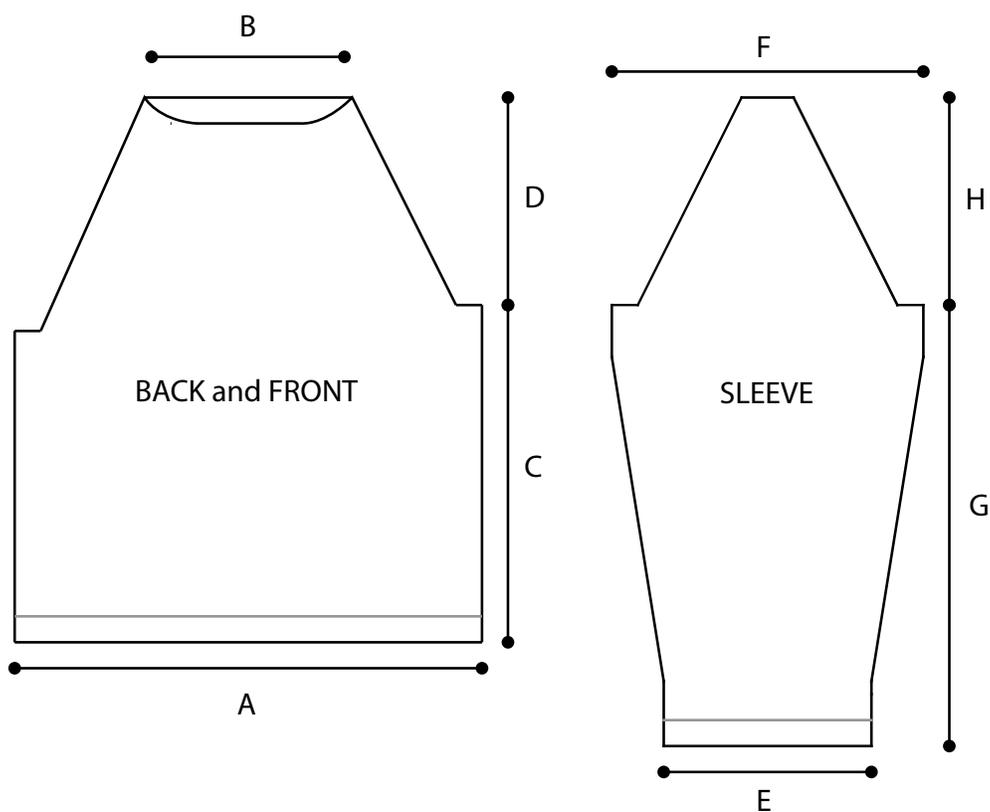
Rep Inc Row every 10th row 4 times more—55 sts.

Next Row (WS): P1, k3, pm, k47, pm, knit to last stitch, p1.

Establish Chart: **Next Row (RS):** Work in pattern as established to first marker, sm, work Row 1 of Sleeve Chart to last marker, sm, work in pattern as established to end. Continuing in pattern as established, work Rows 1–16 of chart once then repeat Rows 17–24 through the rest of the sleeve and raglan shaping.

AT THE SAME TIME, rep Inc Row every (14th, 10th, 10th) [8th, 6th, 6th] {6th, 4th, 4th} row (2, 4, 6) [8, 11, 11] {13, 15, 17} times more, working incs in Garter St—(59, 63, 67) [71, 77, 77] {81, 85, 89} sts.

A (Back and Front Width): (18, 20, 22) [24, 26, 28] {30, 32, 34}" / (46, 51, 56) [61, 66, 71] {76, 81, 86} cm

B (Back Neck Width): (8¼, 8¼, 8¼) [8¾, 8¾, 8¾] {9, 9, 9}" / (21, 21, 21) [22, 22, 22] {23, 23, 23} cm

C (Length to Underarms): 13" / 33 cm

D (Raglan Armhole Length): (9, 9½, 9½) [10, 10, 10½] {11, 11½, 12}" / (23, 24, 24) [25.5, 25.5, 26.5] {28, 29, 30.5} cm

E (Sleeve Cuff Width): 10" / 25.5 cm

F (Upper Sleeve Width): (12, 13, 14) [15, 16, 16] {17, 18, 19}" / (30.5, 33, 35.5) [38, 40.5, 40.5] {43, 46, 48} cm

G (Sleeve Length to Cap): 17" / 43 cm

H (Raglan Cap Length): (9, 9½, 9½) [10, 10, 10½] {11, 11½, 12}" / (23, 24, 24) [25.5, 25.5, 26.5] {28, 29, 30.5} cm



STANDARD ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

beg: beginning

CC: contrasting color

CDD: Centered Double Decrease—Slip 2 together (as if to k2tog), knit 1, pass the 2 slipped stitches over

cn: cable needle

dec: decrease

dpn(s): double pointed needle(s)

end on WS: end having just completed a Wrong Side row.

end on RS: end having just completed a Right Side row

Garter St: Knit EVERY row when working back and forth in rows. Knit 1 round, purl 1 round when working in the round.

inc: increase

k: knit

k tbl: knit through the back loop(s)

k2tog: knit 2 stitches together

k3tog: knit 3 stitches together

kfb: knit in the front and back of the next st

LH: left hand

LLI: Left Lifted Increase—Insert LH needle into the purl bump one row below the st just worked on the RH needle and knit into this st (1 st inc'd)

M1: Make 1—Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).

M1L: Make 1 Left—Work as for M1.

M1p: Make 1 purl—Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).

M1pL: Make 1 purl Left—Work as for M1p.

M1pR: Make 1 purl Right—Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).

M1R: Make 1 Right—Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).

MC: main color

p: purl

p tbl: purl through the back loop(s)

p2tog: purl 2 stitches together

p3tog: purl 3 stitches together

pat(s): pattern(s)

pm: place marker

pssso: pass slipped stitch over knit stitch

rep: repeat

Rev St st: Reverse Stockinette Stitch—Purl 1 row, knit 1 row alternately when working back and forth in rows. The purl side is the right side of the work. Purl EVERY round when working in the round.

RH: right hand

RLI: Right Lifted Increase—Insert RH needle into the purl bump of the next st on the LH needle and knit into this st (1 st inc'd)

rnd(s): round(s)

RS: right side

sl: slip

sm: slip marker

SSK: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2 together.

SSP: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, transfer these 2 stitches back to left hand needle, purl 2 together through the back loops.

SSSK: Slip 3 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 3 stitches and knit 3 together.

st(s): stitch(es)

St st: Stockinette Stitch—Knit 1 row, purl 1 row alternately when working back and forth in rows. The knit side is the right side of work. Knit EVERY round when working in the round.

tbl: through back loop(s)

w&t: wrap and turn, a method of concealing a hole created in short row shaping. On RS rows: With yarn held in front, slip next stitch purlwise, then bring yarn between needles to the back. Slip that same stitch back to the left needle. Turn your work. On WS Rows: With yarn held in back, slip next stitch purlwise, then bring yarn between needles to the front. Slip that same stitch back to the left needle. Turn your work. Unless otherwise indicated, each time you come to a wrapped stitch when working subsequent rows, slip the wrap back over stitch and onto needle, then work the wrap together with its accompanying stitch.

WS: wrong side

wyib: with yarn in back

wyif: with yarn in front

yo: yarn over
