

Amanita muscaria Doll - pdf knitting pattern. Tanoshi series toy.

The toy is knitted round and that is why the pattern is recommended for *Advanced Beginner Knitters*.

Toy related knit stitch.

The finished doll is approximately 5,9" / 15 cm / tall.

Abbreviations

K = knit

P = purl

Sts = stitches

Kfb = knit into front and back of stitch

K2tog = knit 2 sts together

P2tog = purl 2 sts together

CO = cast on

RND = round

Materials needed

- 4 double-pointed needles in a size suitable for the yarn weight you are using. I recommend using needles a size or two smaller than the yarn calls for, to produce a firm fabric. I used Needles size US 2½ (3mm).
- Vanilla colored yarn for head. I used Nako baby Hoşgeldin / 60% bambu, 40% polyamid ; 100gr – 230m /
- White colored yarn for body. I used Nako Bonbon Amigurumi / 100% acrylic ; 100gr – 170m /
- Red colored yarn for hat. I used Nako Vizon / 100% Acrylic, 100gr = 195
- Green colored yarn for body. I used Nako Bonbon Amigurumi / 100% acrylic ; 100gr – 170m /
- Toy stuffing
- Yarn needle
- Stitch holder
- 2 plastic eyes
- White colored felt

All time I am working in the round. This help avoids the ugly seams .

Head

Knitted with vanilla colored yarn.



Cast on 6 stitches. Distribute among 3 needles and join to work in the round, being careful not to twist sts. Place marker.

RND1: Kfb (6times) (12 sts)

RND2: Kfb, K1 (6times) (18 sts)

RND3: Kfb, K2 (6times) (24 sts)

RND4:Kfb, K3 (6times) (30 sts)

RND5:Kfb, K4 (6times) (36 sts)

RND6:Kfb, K5 (6times) (42 sts)

RND7-19: 13 Rnds K all (42 sts)

RND20: K2tog, K5 (6times) (36 sts)

RND21: K2tog, K4 (6times) (30 sts)

RND22: K2tog, K3 (6times) (24 sts)

Work decrease rounds, adding stuffing as you go

RND23: K2tog, K2 (6times) (18 sts)

RND24: K2tog, K1 (6times) (12 sts)

RND25: K2tog (6times) (6 sts)

*Cut yarn and thread through six remaining sts (add more stuffing if required).
Weave in ends.*

Body

Start to knit with green colored yarn.



Cast on 6 stitches. Distribute among 3 needles and join to work in the round, being careful not to twist sts. Place marker.

RND1: Kfb (6times) (12 sts)

RND2: Kfb, K1 (6times) (18 sts)

RND3: Kfb, K7, Kfb (2times) (22 sts)

RND4: Kfb, K9, Kfb (2times) (26 sts)

RND5: P all (26 sts)

Change yarn over white color

RND6-8: K all (26 sts)

RND9: K2tog, K9, K2tog (2times) (22 sts)

RND10: K all (22 sts)

RND11: K2tog, K7, K2tog (2times) (18 sts)

RND12-13: 2 Rnds K all (18 sts)

RND14: K2tog, K5, K2tog (2times) (14 sts)

RND15-16: 2 Rnds K all (14 sts)

Work decrease rounds, adding stuffing as you go

RND17: K2tog, K3, K2tog (2times) (10 sts)

RND18-26: 9 Rnds K all (10 sts)

RND27: K2tog, K8 (9 sts)

RND28-33: 6 Rnds K all (9 sts)

*Cut yarn and thread through remaining 9 sts (add more stuffing if required).
Weave in ends.*

Arms (make2 pieces)

Knitted with vanilla colored yarn.



Cast on 3 stitches. Distribute among 3 needles and join to work in the round, being careful not to twist sts. Place marker.

Or you can knit it as i-cord (it will be more easy).

RND1-10: 10 Rnds K all (3 sts)

Do not stuff.

Cut yarn and thread through 3 remaining sts.
Weave in ends.

Sleeves (make2 pieces)

Knitted with white colored yarn.



Cast on 5 stitches. Distribute among 3 needles and join to work in the round, being careful not to twist sts. Place marker. Or you can knit it as i-cord (it will be more easy)

RND1-7: 7 Rnds K all (5 sts)

Bind off. Weave in ends.

Peruke Hair.

Knitted with white colored yarn.



Cast on 6 stitches. Distribute among 3 needles and join to work in the round, being careful not to twist sts. Place marker.

<i>RND7:Kfb, K13</i>	<i>(3times)</i>	<i>(45 sts)</i>	
<i>RND8-17: 10 Rnds K all</i>		<i>(45 sts)</i>	
<i>RND18:P12, K33</i>		<i>(45 sts)</i>	
<i>RND19:Bind off 12 sts, K32</i>		<i>(33 sts)</i>	
<i>Start to knit flat now</i>			
<i>Row20:P1, K1, P29, K1, P1</i>		<i>(33 sts)</i>	
<i>Row21:K1, P1, K29, P1, K1</i>		<i>(33 sts)</i>	
<i>Row22:P1, K1, P29, K1, P1</i>		<i>(33 sts)</i>	
<i>Row23:K1, P1, K29, P1, K1</i>		<i>(33 sts)</i>	
<i>Row24:P1, K1, P29, K1, P1</i>		<i>(33 sts)</i>

<i>Row32:P1, K1, P9, P2tog, P3, P2tog, P9, K1, P1</i>			<i>(27 sts)</i>
<i>Row33:K1, P1, K23, P1, K1</i>		<i>(27 sts)</i>	

Row34:P1, K1, P6, K1, P1, bind off 7sts, K1, P6, K1, P1 (20 sts)

Now we are knitting one ear part. We are working with 10 sts.

Row35:K1, P1, K2tog, K2, K2tog, P1, K1 (8 sts)

Row36:P1, K1,2P2tog, K1, P1 (6 sts)

Row37:K1, P1, K2tog, P1, K1 (5 sts)

Row38:P2tog, P1, P2tog (3 sts)

Row39:K3tog (1 sts)

Bind off.

Mushroom hat.

Start to knit with white yarn.



Cast on 44 stitches. Distribute among 3 needles and join to work in the round, being careful not to twist sts. Place marker.

RND1-2: K1, P1 (22 times) (44 sts)

RND3:Kfb, K10 (4times) (48 sts)

RND4:Kfb, K5 (8times) (56 sts)

RND5:Kfb, K6 (8times) (64 sts)

RND6:Kfb, K7 (8times) (72 sts)

RND7:Kfb, K8 (8times) (80 sts)

RND8:Kfb, K9 (8times) (88 sts)

RND9:Kfb, K10 (8times) (96 sts)

RND10:Kfb, K11 (8times) (104 sts)

<i>RND11:Kfb, K12 (8times)</i>	<i>(112 sts)</i>
<i>RND12:Kfb, K13 (8times)</i>	<i>(120 sts)</i>
<i>Change yarn over red color</i>	
<i>RND13: P all</i>	<i>(120 sts)</i>
<i>RND14: K all</i>	<i>(120 sts)</i>
<i>RND15: K2tog, K13 (8times)</i>	<i>(112 sts)</i>
<i>RND16-17: 2 Rnds K all</i>	<i>(112 sts)</i>
<i>RND18: K2tog, K12 (8times)</i>	<i>(104 sts)</i>
<i>RND19-20: 2 Rnds K all</i>	<i>(104 sts)</i>
<i>RND21: K2tog, K11 (8times)</i>	<i>(96 sts)</i>
<i>RND22: K all</i>	<i>(96 sts)</i>
<i>RND23: K2tog, K10 (8times)</i>	<i>(88 sts)</i>
<i>RND24: K all</i>	<i>(88 sts)</i>
<i>RND25: K2tog, K9 (8times)</i>	<i>(80 sts)</i>
<i>RND26: K2tog, K8 (8times)</i>	<i>(72 sts)</i>
<i>RND27: K all</i>	<i>(72 sts)</i>
<i>RND28: K2tog, K7 (8times)</i>	<i>(64 sts)</i>
<i>RND29: K all</i>	<i>(64 sts)</i>
<i>RND30: K2tog, K6 (8times)</i>	<i>(56 sts)</i>
<i>RND31: K2tog, K5 (8times)</i>	<i>(48 sts)</i>
<i>RND32: K2tog, K4 (8times)</i>	<i>(40 sts)</i>
<i>RND33: K2tog, K3 (8times)</i>	<i>(32 sts)</i>
<i>RND34: K2tog, K2 (8times)</i>	<i>(24 sts)</i>
<i>RND35: K2tog, K1 (8times)</i>	<i>(16 sts)</i>
<i>RND36: K all</i>	<i>(16 sts)</i>
<i>RND37: K2tog (8times)</i>	<i>(8 sts)</i>
<i>RND38: K all</i>	<i>(8 sts)</i>

Cut yarn and thread through remaining 8 sts .
Weave in ends.

Small mushroom.

Start to knit with red yarn



Cast on 6 stitches. Distribute among 3 needles and join to work in the round, being careful not to twist sts. Place marker.

RND1: Kfb, K1 (3times) (9 sts)

RND2: Kfb, K2 (3times) (12 sts)

RND3-4: 2 Rnds K all (12 sts)

RND5: Kfb, K3 (3times) (15 sts)

RND6: K all (15 sts)

Change yarn over white color

RND7: P all (15 sts)

RND8: K all (15 sts)

RND9: K2tog, K3 (3times) (12 sts)

Work decrease rounds, adding stuffing as you go

RND10: K2tog, K2 (3times) (9 sts)

RND11: K2tog, K1 (3times) (6 sts)

RND12: P all (6 sts)

RND13-17: 7 Rnds K all (6 sts)

Stuff it.

*Cut yarn and thread through six remaining sts (add more stuffing if required).
Weave in ends.*

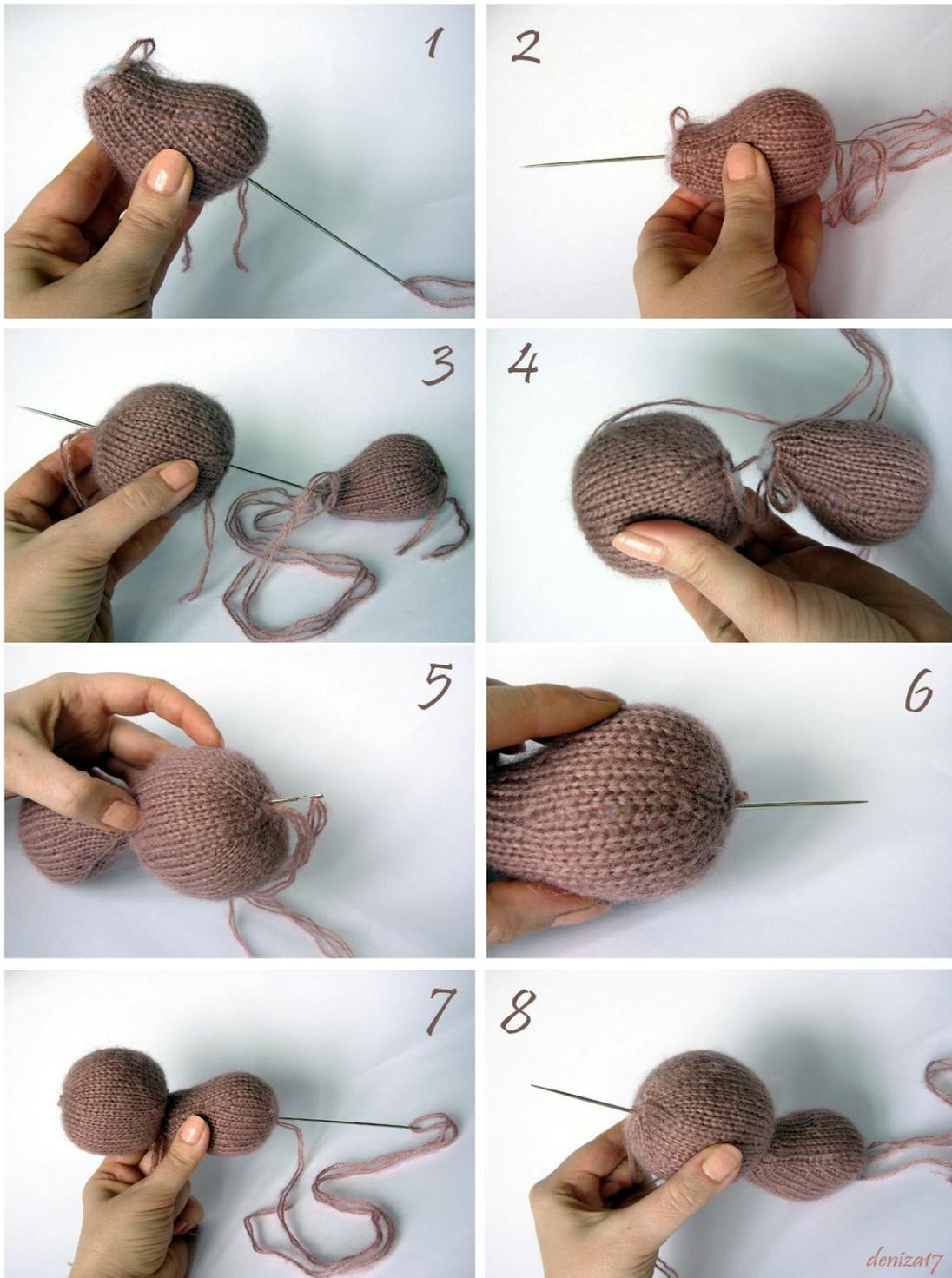
Decorate the mushroom with beads.

FINISHING DOLL.

Fixing head and body.

Use a long needle with a yard of strong *thread*, doubled and knotted at the end.

Start at the underside of the body. Push the needle thru to the outside of the torso.



Push the needle thru the head and out on the opposite side. Go back thru to the inside of the head taking a small stitch on the outside. Repeat this procedure thru the head and body gently pulling the thread to tighten the joint with each pass thru, one or two more times, but do not indent too deeply. End on the underside of the body. Bury the thread into the body.



Now put arms into the sleeves.

I used crochet for this.



How I am fixing arms.

Sew arms through the body. With doubled thread, start at the underside of one of the limbs, leaving a five or six inch long tail and push the needle thru to the outside of the limb. Go back thru to the inside of the limb taking a small stitch on the outside. Push the needle thru the body and out on the opposite side. Go thru the other limb from the inside to the outside. Taking a small stitch, go back thru the limb to the inside, back thru the body and thru to the outside of the first limb. Repeat this procedure thru the limbs and body gently pulling the thread to tighten the joint with each pass thru, one or two more times, but do not indent too deeply. End on the inside between the body and the first limb. Tie off with the tail of the original thread.





Put the peruke to the head and sew on it



Cut the circles from white felt and glue them to the hat.



Take a lace and place a basting stitch along the top edge of it. The length of the lace depends of how many frills you want.





Sew on frills to the doll's neck.

Glue the plastic eyes to the head.

Apply pink blush .



With green thread embroider the flowers onto the down part of the body



You can use ribbon or beads also.



That's all 8)))
