

SIZE

36/37 38/39 40/41 42/43 44/45

Instructions are for smallest size, with changes for larger sizes noted in different colors. When only one figure is given, it applies for all sizes.

MATERIALS

REGIA 4-fädig Uni, 100 g ball
Col. 01980 (graublau meliert) 1 ball
Double pointed Needles 2.5 - 3.0 mm
1 tapestry needle for weaving in ends

BASIC PATTERN

Ribbed pattern: k1 tbl, p1, repeat to the end.

Stockinette stitch:

In Rows: RS: knit all sts, WS: purl all sts.

In Rd: knit all sts.

Knit-purl-pattern:

Multiples of 4 stitches.

Rd 1 and 2: k1.

Rd 3 and 4: * k1, p3, repeat from * to the end.

Rd 5 and 6: k1.

Rd 7 and 8: p2, k1, * p3, k1, repeat from * to the end, end with p1.

Repeat Rd 1 - 8 throughout.

GAUGE

Stockinette stitch, size 2.5 - 3.0 mm needles:

30 sts and 42 R/Rd = 10 x 10 cm

Knit-purl-pattern, size 2.5 - 3.0 mm needles:

30 sts and 48 R/Rd = 10 x 10 cm

If your gauge differs from the given gauge, use needles of a larger or smaller size accordingly.

INSTRUCTIONS

Cast on 60/60/64/64/68 st, divide the st evenly over 4 needles and join to work in the round (= 15/15/16/16/17 st on each needle).

For the cuff, work in ribbed pattern for 4 cm, then continue working the leg shaft in the knit/purl pattern.

When you have worked 14 cm = 68 Rd from the end of the cuff, work a boomerang heel over the 30/30/32/32/34 st

on Needles 1 and 4, following the tutorial "Knitting Socks with a Boomerang Heel."

Stitch division for the boomerang heel: 10/10/10 10/10/10 10/12/10/10/12/10/11/12/11st.

After you complete the boomerang heel, continue working across all st.

Work the st on Needles 1 and 4 in stockinette st for the sole; continue working the st on Needles 2 and 3 in knit/purl pattern for the instep.

When the foot measures 18.5/20/21/22/23 cm, continue working all 60/60/64/64/68 st in stockinette st;

AT THE SAME TIME, work the toe shaping following the tutorial "Knitting Socks with a Boomerang Heel."

After the 1st decrease round, repeat the toe decreases as follows: once in the following 4th Rd, 2x in every following 3rd Rd, 3/3/3/3/4x in every other Rd and 6/6/7/7/7 x in every Rd.

FINISHING

Thread the working yarn through the 8 remaining stitches and pull to close. Weave in the end.

Work the second sock in the same way.

ABBREVIATIONS

k = knit
p = purl
RS = right side
st(s) = stitch(es)
WS = wrong side
