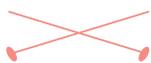

SUGGESTED NEEDLES

Main Fabric: US 3/3.25 mm - 32-40"/80-100 cm circular (2 sets for 3 Needle BO)

Ribbing: US 1/2.25 mm - 32-40"/80-100 cm circular and preferred needles for small circumference knitting for armholes and collar.
(Use the needle size you need to achieve gauge, going down two US sizes for the ribbing.)



NOTIONS

2 stitch markers, 9 (9, 9, 9)(**9, 9, 10**)(10, 10, 10, 10) (cropped) to 11 (11, 11, 11)(**11, 11, 12**)(12, 12, 12, 12) (full length) - 5/8"/15 mm buttons, sewing needle & matching thread to attach buttons, tapestry needle, spare needle, stitch holders or waste yarn to hold stitches



GAUGE

31 sts & 43 rows = 4"/10 cm
Measured over stitch pattern knit flat using the Main Fabric needle, after blocking.

Knitting for Olive Cotton Merino - 70% Cotton/30% Merino (50 g/274 yds/250 m)



SUGGESTED
YARN

CROPPED

MC: 2 (3, 3, 3)(**4, 4, 4**)(5, 5, 6, 6) balls Cream

CC: 1 (2, 2, 2)(**2, 2, 2**)(3, 3, 3, 3) balls Red Currant

FULL LENGTH

MC: 3 (3, 3, 3)(**4, 4, 5**)(5, 6, 6, 6) skein/s

CC: 2 (2, 2, 2)(**2, 2, 3**)(3, 3, 3, 4) skeins

- To pick your size, measure around your full chest, then add or subtract your desired ease to that number. Pick the size closest to that from the *FINISHED CHEST CIRCUMFERENCE* on page 2 - DETAILS.
 - This cardigan is worked flat from the bottom up. The shoulders are shaped with short rows and finished using the 3 needle bind off. The sleeves & button band are then picked up from the body and knit.
 - To swatch, I recommend casting on a minimum of 39 sts (depending on how large you like to make your swatch, you need to cast on enough sts for a 10 + 9 pattern repeat) and using the Body Pattern Repeat on pg. 5.
 - There is no need to break yarn colors as you work; simply carry them up the inside/edge of the cardigan.
 - While this top is totally reversible, the pattern is written with the intention that the buttons will be worn in the back.

{ } - Repeat

DS - Double Stitch: move yarn to front between needles, slip stitch from the LHN, pull yarn up and over the top of the needle to the back so that the legs of the lower stitch are pulled up onto the needle - creating the appearance of 2 strands of yarn for the stitch instead of just one. (If purling, return the yarn to the front between the 2 needle tips.)

EST - Established

K - Knit

K2TOG - Knit 2 stitches together as one. [1 st dec'd]

LHN - Left hand needle

M - Marker

MC - Main color

P - Purl

PM - Place marker

PREV - Previous

REM - Remain/ing

RHN - Right hand needle

RM - Remove marker

REP - Repeat

RND/S - Round/s

RS - Right side

SL - Slip stitch purlwise

SM - Slip marker

ST/S - Stitch/es

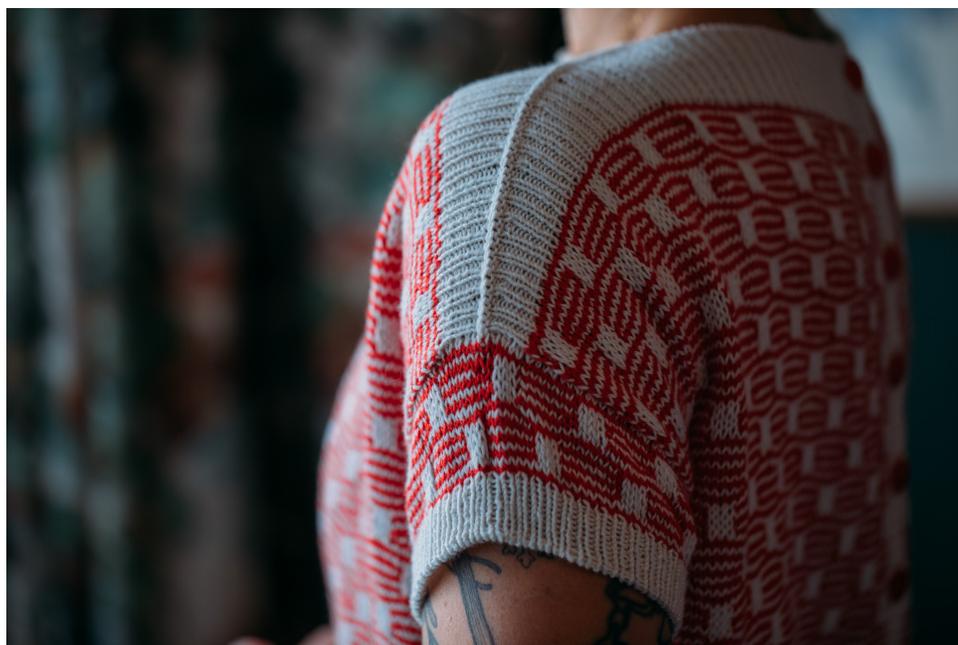
SSK - Slip, slip, knit: Slip two stitches, one at a time, as if to knit, insert LHN into these stitches and knit them together thru the back loops. [1 st dec'd]

TBL - Thru the back loop

WS - Wrong side

WYIF - With yarn in front

WYIB - With yarn in back

HEM

With MC & the Ribbing needle, CO 249 (269, 309, 329)(**369, 389, 429**)(469, 489, 529, 549) sts using the Long Tail Tubular Cast On method. Do not join to work in the rnd. *If you prefer to sub in a different CO method, skip the Tubular Setup Rows and go straight to Ribbing Row 1.*

Tubular Setup Row 1 (WS): Sl1 wyif, {k1-tbl, sl1 wyif} to the end.

Tubular Setup Row 2 (RS): K1, {sl1 wyif, k1} to the end.

Ribbing Row 1 (WS): P1, {k1, p1} to the end.

Ribbing Row 2 (RS): K1, {p1, k1} to the end.

Rep [Ribbing Rows 1 & 2] until hem measures 1.5"/4 cm from the CO edge, ending with a RS row.

BODY

Change to Main Fabric needle.

Setup Row (WS): Using MC, purl.

BODY PATTERN REPEAT

Each row will be worked twice, sliding the sts back to the original needle tip after each CC row, and turning after each MC row.

Row 1 (RS): Join/Using CC, knit. Do NOT turn, slide the sts back to the beginning of the row.

Row 2 (RS): Using MC, knit. Turn.

Row 3 (WS): Using CC, p3, {sl3 wyif, p7} to the last 6 sts, sl3 wyif, p3. Do not turn, slide.

Row 4 (WS): Using MC, purl. Turn.

Row 5: Using CC, k3, {sl3 wyib, k7} to the last 6 sts, sl3 wyib, k3. Do not turn, slide.

Row 6: Using MC, knit. Turn.

Rows 7 & 8: Rep [Rows 3 & 4].

Row 9: Using CC, knit. Do not turn, slide.

Row 10: Using MC, knit. Turn.

Row 11: Using CC, p8, {sl3 wyif, p7} to the last st, p1. Do not turn, slide.

Row 12: Using MC, purl. Turn.

Row 13: Using CC, k8, {sl3 wyib, k7} to the last st, k1. Do not turn, slide.

Row 14: Using MC, knit. Turn.

Rows 15 & 16: Rep [Rows 11 & 12].

Rep [Rows 1-16] until the body of the cardigan measures approx. 10"/25.5 cm for the cropped length or 12.5"/62 cm for full length (the cardigan will grow a bit post-blocking, approx. 0.5"/1 cm) from the CO edge, ending with Row 8 of the Body Pattern Repeat.

HELPFUL TIP: KEEP TRACK OF EXACTLY HOW MANY ROWS YOU WORK FOR THE BACK, FROM THE YOKE SEPARATION UNTIL YOU BEGIN THE SHOULDER RIBBING, SO THAT YOU WORK THE SAME AMOUNT OF ROWS FOR THE OTHER BACK AND THE FRONT.

LEFT BACK YOKE (as worn)

Setup Row 1 (RS/CO): Using CC, k62 (67, 77, 82)(**92, 97, 107**)(117, 122, 132, 137), using the Backwards Loop Method, CO 7 sts. Pause.

Place rem sts on hold for Front & Right Back using a spare needle or waste yarn while the Left Front is finished.

Slide Left Back sts back to the beginning of the needle.

69 (74, 84, 89)(**99, 104, 114**)(124, 129, 139, 144) sts on needle for Left Back.

Setup Row 2 (RS): Using MC, knit. Turn.

LEFT BACK YOKE PATTERN REPEAT - Sizes 1 (-, -, 4)(5, -, -)(-, 9,10, -) ONLY

Row 1 (WS): Using CC, p8, {sl3 wyif, p7} to the last st, p1. Do not turn, slide.

Row 2 (WS): Using MC, purl. Turn.

Row 3 (RS): Using CC, k8, {sl3 wyib, k7} to the last st, k1. Do not turn, slide.

Row 4 (RS): Using MC, knit. Turn.

Rows 5 & 6: Rep [Rows 1 & 2].

Row 7: Using CC, knit. Do not turn, slide.

Row 8: Using MC, knit. Turn.

Row 9: Using CC, p3, {sl3 wyif, p7} to the last 6 sts, sl3 wyif, p3. Do not turn, slide.

Row 10: Using MC, purl. Turn.

Row 11: Using CC, k3, {sl3 wyib, k7} to the last 6 sts, sl3 wyib, k3. Do not turn, slide.

Row 12: Using MC, knit. Turn.

Rows 13 & 14: Rep [Rows 9 & 10].

Row 15: Using CC, knit. Do not turn, slide.

Row 16: Using MC, knit. Turn.

Rep [Rows 1-16] until the yoke measures approx. 5.5 (-, -, 6.5)(7.25, -, -)(-, 9.75, 10.25, -) / 14 (-, -, 16.5)(18.5, -, -)(-, 25, 26, -) cm from the undearm edge, ending with Row 8 or 16 of the pattern repeat. Break CC.

Proceed to Shoulder Ribbing.

LEFT BACK YOKE PATTERN REPEAT - Sizes - (2, 3 -)(-, 6, 7)(8, -, -, 11) ONLY

Row 1 (WS): Using CC, p3, {sl3 wyif, p7} to the last st, p1. Do not turn, slide.

Row 2 (WS): Using MC, purl. Turn.

Row 3 (RS): Using CC, k8, {sl3 wyib, k7} to the last 6 sts, sl3 wyib, k3. Do not turn, slide.

Row 4 (RS): Using MC, knit. Turn.

Rows 5 & 6: Rep [Rows 1 & 2].

Row 7: Using CC, knit. Do not turn, slide.

Row 8: Using MC, knit. Turn.

Row 9: Using CC, p8, {sl3 wyif, p7} to the last 6 sts, sl3 wyif, p3. Do not turn, slide.

Row 10: Using MC, purl. Turn.

Row 11: Using CC, k3, {sl3 wyib, k7} to the last st, k1. Do not turn, slide.

Row 12: Using MC, knit. Turn.

Rows 13 & 14: Rep [Rows 9 & 10].

Row 15: Using CC, knit. Do not turn, slide.

Row 16: Using MC, knit. Turn.

Rep [Rows 1-16] until the yoke measures approx. - (6, 6, -)(-, 7.75, 8.5)(9, -, -, 10.25) / - (15, 15, -)(-, 19.5, 21.5)(23, -, -, 26) cm from the undearm edge, ending with Row 7 or 15 of the pattern repeat. Break CC.

Next Row (RS/DEC): Using MC, k2tog, knit to the end. Turn. [1 st dec'd; - (73, 83, -)(-, 103, 113)(123, -, -, 143) sts rem]

Proceed to Shoulder Ribbing.

SHOULDER RIBBING - All Sizes

Change to Ribbing needle.

Ribbing Row 1 (WS): P1, {k1, p1} to the end.

Ribbing Row 2 (RS): K1, {p1, k1} to the end.

Rep [Ribbing Rows 1 & 2] twice more.

Rep [Ribbing Row 1] once more.

SHOULDER SHAPING

Short Row 1 (RS): Work in the est ribbing to the last 3 (6, 7, 7)(8, 8, 10)(10, 13, 12, 14) sts, turn.

Short Row 2 (WS): DS, work in rib to end.

Short Row 3: Work in rib to 4 (4, 5, 6)(7, 8, 9)(10, 11, 13, 13) sts before prev DS. Turn.

Short Row 4: DS, work in rib to end.

Rep [Short Rows 3 & 4] 5 more times.

_____ DIRECTIONS _____

The next 2 rows will prep the Back Neck sts for a Tubular Bind Off. If you prefer not to use the Tubular Bind Off method, just work those sts in the est ribbing pattern, omitting the slipped sts.

Row 15 (RS): {K1, sl1 wyif} 17 (17, 18, 18) **(19, 19, 19)**(20, 20, 20, 20) times, cont in rib to end of row, resolving DS as they are encountered by working them as a k2tog or p2tog to stay in rib.

Row 16 (WS): Work in rib for 35 (39, 47, 53)**(61, 65, 75)**(83, 89, 99, 103) sts, {k1, sl1 wyif} 17 (17, 18, 18)**(19, 19, 19)**(20, 20, 20, 20) times.

If you are not using the Tubular Bind Off method, bind off 34 (34, 36, 36)**(38, 38, 38)** (40, 40, 40, 40) Back Neck sts using your preferred method. Break yarn & place the rem 35 (39, 47, 53)**(61, 65, 75)**(83, 89, 99, 103) sts on hold for the shoulder.

To continue the Tubular Bind Off method, break MC leaving a 20"/51 cm tail and BO the first 34 (34, 36, 36)**(38, 38, 38)**(40, 40, 40, 40) Back Neck sts using Kitchener stitch. (You can find a tutorial for Kitchener Stitch on One Needle in the Notes on pg. 3. If preferred, you can separate the stitches on to 2 needles. With RS facing, slip each st purlwise, slipping the knit sts onto the working needle and the purl sts onto a spare needle which should be held parallel with the working needle, but behind it.)

Place the rem 35 (39, 47, 53)**(61, 65, 75)**(83, 89, 99, 103) sts on hold for the shoulder.

FRONT YOKE

With RS facing, return the first 125 (135, 155, 165)**(185, 195, 215)**(235, 245, 265, 275) sts back to the Main Fabric needle and join CC. (The rem sts can be left on hold for the Right Back Yoke.)

Setup Row 1 (RS/CO): Using the Cable CO method, CO 7 sts, knit across these new sts and the Front sts, using the Backwards Loop CO method, CO 7 more sts. Do not turn, slide.

139 (149, 169, 179)**(199, 209, 229)**(249, 259, 279, 289) Front Yoke sts

Setup Row 2 (RS): Join MC, knit. Turn.

FRONT YOKE PATTERN REPEAT -

Sizes 1 (-, -, 4)(5, -, -)(-, 9,10, -) ONLY

Row 1 (WS): Using CC, p3, {sl3 wyif, p7} to the last 6 sts, sl3 wyif, p3. Do not turn, slide.

Row 2 (WS): Using MC, purl. Turn.

Row 3 (RS): Using CC, k3, {sl3 wyib, k7} to the last 6 sts, sl3 wyib, k3. Do not turn, slide.

Row 4 (RS): Using MC, knit. Turn.

Rows 5 & 6: Rep [Rows 1 & 2].

Row 7: Using CC, knit. Do not turn, slide.

Row 8: Using MC, knit. Turn.

Row 9: Using CC, p8, {sl3 wyif, p7} to the last st, p1. Do not turn, slide.

Row 10: Using MC, purl. Turn.

Row 11: Using CC, k8, {sl3 wyib, k7} to the last st, k1. Do not turn, slide.

Row 12: Using MC, knit. Turn.

Rows 13 & 14: Rep [Rows 9 & 10].

Row 15: Using CC, knit. Do not turn, slide.

Row 16: Using MC, knit. Turn.

Rep [Rows 1-16] until the yoke measures approx. 5.5 (-, -, 6.5)**(7.25, -, -)**(-, 9.75, 10.25, -)/14 (-, -, 16.5)**(18.5, -, -)**(-, 25, 26, -) cm from the undearm edge, ending with Row 7 or 15 of the pattern rep. Break CC.

— DIRECTIONS —

Next Row (RS): Using MC, k35 (-, -, 53)(**61**, -, -)(-, 89, 99, -), PM, k69, (-, -, 73)(**77**, -, -)(-, 81, 81, -), PM, knit to end.

Proceed to Shoulder Ribbing.

FRONT YOKE PATTERN REPEAT -

Sizes - (2, 3 -)(-, 6, 7)(8, -, -, 11) ONLY

Row 1 (WS): Using CC, p8, {sl3 wyif, p7} to the last st, p1. Do not turn, slide.

Row 2 (WS): Using MC, purl. Turn.

Row 3 (RS): Using CC, k8, {sl3 wyib, k7} to the last st, k1. Do not turn, slide.

Row 4 (RS): Using MC, knit. Turn.

Rows 5 & 6: Rep [Rows 1 & 2].

Row 7: Using CC, knit. Do not turn, slide.

Row 8: Using MC, knit. Turn.

Row 9: Using CC, p3, {sl3 wyif, p7} to the last 6 sts, sl3 wyif, p3. Do not turn, slide.

Row 10: Using MC, purl. Turn.

Row 11: Using CC, k3, {sl3 wyib, k7} to the last 6 sts, sl3 wyib, k3. Do not turn, slide.

Row 12: Using MC, knit. Turn.

Rows 13 & 14: Rep [Rows 9 & 10].

Row 15: Using CC, knit. Do not turn, slide.

Row 16: Using MC, knit. Turn.

Rep [Rows 1-16] until the yoke measures approx. - (6, 6, -)(-, **7.75, 8.5**)(9, -, -, 10.25)" / - (15, 15, -)(-, **19.5, 21.5**)(23, -, -, 26) cm from the undearm edge, ending with Row 7 or 15 of the pattern rep. Break CC.

Next Row (RS/DEC): Using MC, k2tog, k- (38, 46, -)(-, **64, 74**)(82, -, -, 102), PM, k- (69, 73, -)(-, **77, 77**)(81, -, -, 81), PM, knit to the last 2 sts, ssk. [2 sts dec'd; - (147, 167, -)(-, **207, 227**)(247, -, -, 287) sts rem]

Proceed to Shoulder Ribbing.

SHOULDER RIBBING - All Sizes

Change to Ribbing needle.

Ribbing Row 1 (WS): P1, {k1, p1} to the end.

Ribbing Row 2 (RS): K1, {p1, k1} to the end.

Rep [Ribbing Rows 1 & 2] twice more.

Rep [Ribbing Row 1] once more.

SHOULDER SHAPING

Short Row 1 (RS): Work in the est ribbing to the last 3 (6, 7, 7)(**8, 8, 10**)(10, 13, 12, 14) sts, turn.

Short Row 2 (WS): DS, work in the est ribbing to the last 3 (6, 7, 7)(**8, 8, 10**)(10, 13, 12, 14) sts, turn.

Short Row 3: DS, work in rib to 4 (4, 5, 6)(**7, 8, 9**)(10, 11, 13, 13) sts before prev DS.
Rep [Short Row 3] 11 *more* times.

The next 2 rows will prep the Back Neck sts, located between the 2 st markers, for a Tubular Bind Off. If you prefer not to use the Tubular Bind Off method, just work those sts in the est ribbing pattern, omitting the slipped sts.

Short Row 15 (RS): DS, work to marker in rib if any sts rem before it, sm, {sl1 wyif, k1} to 1 st before M, sl1 wyif, sm, cont in rib to end of row, resolving DS as they are encountered by working them as a k2tog or p2tog to stay in rib.

Row 16 (WS): Work in rib to M, sm, {k1, sl1 wyif} to 1 st before M, k1, sm, work in rib to end of row, resolving DS as they are encountered by working them as a k2tog or p2tog to stay in rib. Break yarn.

Place 35 (39, 47, 53)(**61, 65, 75**)(83, 89, 99, 103) sts from either side of neck on hold for the shoulders & remove markers.

DIRECTIONS

BIND OFF FRONT NECK

With RS facing, join a length of MC roughly 4 times the length of the sts to be bound off. BO all sts using Kitchener st, pulling the yarn thru the final odd st to secure. (You can find a tutorial for Kitchener Stitch on One Needle in the Notes on pg. 3. If preferred, you can separate the sts on to 2 needles as follows: with RS facing, sl each st purlwise, slipping the knit sts onto the working needle and the purl sts onto a spare needle which should be held parallel with the working needle, but behind it.)

RIGHT BACK YOKE (as worn)

With RS facing, return the final 62 (67, 77, 82)(92, 97, 107)(117, 122, 132, 137) held sts of the Right Back Yoke to the Main Fabric needle and join CC.

Setup Row 1 (RS/CO): Using the Cable CO method, CO 7 sts, knit across new sts and all Right Back Yoke sts to end. Do not turn, slide.

69 (74, 84, 89)(99, 104, 114)(124, 129, 139, 144) sts on needle for Right Back.

Setup Row 2 (RS): Join MC, knit. Turn.

RIGHT BACK YOKE PATTERN REPEAT - Sizes 1 (-, -, 4)(5, -, -)(-, 9,10, -) ONLY

Row 1 (WS): Using CC, p8, {sl3 wyif, p7} to the last st, p1. Do not turn, slide.

Row 2 (WS): Using MC, purl. Turn.

Row 3 (RS): Using CC, k8, {sl3 wyib, k7} to the last st, k1. Do not turn, slide.

Row 4 (RS): Using MC, knit. Turn.

Rows 5 & 6: Rep [Rows 1 & 2].

Row 7: Using CC, knit. Do not turn, slide.

Row 8: Using MC, knit. Turn.

Row 9: Using CC, p3, {sl3 wyif, p7} to the last 6 sts, sl3 wyif, p3. Do not turn, slide.

Row 10: Using MC, purl. Turn.

Row 11: Using CC, k3, {sl3 wyib, k7} to the last 6 sts, sl3 wyib, k3. Do not turn, slide.

Row 12: Using MC, knit. Turn.

Rows 13 & 14: Rep [Rows 9 & 10].

Row 15: Using CC, knit. Do not turn, slide.

Row 16: Using MC, knit. Turn.

Rep [Rows 1-16] until the yoke measures approx. 5.5 (-, -, 6.5)(7.25, -, -)(-, 9.75, 10.25, -) / 14 (-, -, 16.5)(18.5, -, -)(-, 25, 26, -) cm from the undearm edge, ending with Row 8 or 16 of the pattern repeat. Break CC.

Proceed to Shoulder Ribbing - pg. 10

RIGHT BACK YOKE PATTERN REPEAT - Sizes - (2, 3 -)(-, 6, 7)(8, -, -, 11) ONLY

Row 1 (WS): Using CC, p8, {sl3 wyif, p7} to the last 6 sts, sl3 wyif, p3. Do not turn, slide.

Row 2 (WS): Using MC, purl. Turn.

Row 3 (RS): Using CC, k3, {sl3 wyib, k7} to the last st, k1. Do not turn, slide.

Row 4 (RS): Using MC, knit. Turn.

Rows 5 & 6: Rep [Rows 1 & 2].

Row 7: Using CC, knit. Do not turn, slide.

Row 8: Using MC, knit. Turn.

Row 9: Using CC, p3, {sl3 wyif, p7} to the last st, p1. Do not turn, slide.

Row 10: Using MC, purl. Turn.

Row 11: Using CC, k8, {sl3 wyib, k7} to the last 6 sts, sl3 wyib, k3. Do not turn, slide.

Row 12: Using MC, knit. Turn.

Rows 13 & 14: Rep [Rows 9 & 10].

Row 15: Using CC, knit. Do not turn, slide.

Row 16: Using MC, knit. Turn.

Rep [Rows 1-16] until the yoke measures approx. - (6, 6, -)(-, 7.75, 8.5)(9, -, -, 10.25) / - (15, 15, -)(-, 19.5, 21.5)(23, -, -, 26) cm from the undearm edge, ending with Row 7 or 15 of the pattern repeat. Break CC.

Next Row (RS/DEC): Using MC, knit to the last 2 sts, ssk. [1 st dec'd; - (73, 83, -)(-, 103, 113)(123, -, -, 143) sts rem]

SHOULDER RIBBING - All Sizes

Change to Ribbing needle.

Ribbing Row 1 (WS): P1, {k1, p1} to the end.

Ribbing Row 2 (RS): K1, {p1, k1} to the end.

Rep [Ribbing Rows 1 & 2] 3 more times.

SHOULDER SHAPING

Short Row 1 (WS): Work in the est ribbing to the last 3 (6, 7, 7)(**8, 8, 10**)(10, 13, 12, 14) sts, turn.

Short Row 2 (RS): DS, work in rib to end.

Short Row 3: Work in rib to 4 (4, 5, 6)(**7, 8, 9**)(10, 11, 13, 13) sts before prev DS, turn.

Short Row 4: DS, work in rib to end.

Rep [Short Rows 3 & 4] 4 more times.

Rep [Short Row 3] once more.

The next 2 rows will prep the Back Neck sts for a Tubular Bind Off. If you prefer not to use the Tubular Bind Off method, just work those sts in the est ribbing pattern, omitting the slipped sts.

Row 14 (RS): DS, work in rib to the last 34 (34, 36, 36)(**38, 38, 38**)(40, 40, 40, 40) sts, {sl1 wyif, k1} to end.

Row 15 (WS): {Sl1 wyif, k1} 17 (17, 18, 18)(**19, 19, 19**)(20, 20, 20, 20) times, cont in rib to end of row, resolving DS as they are encountered by working them as a k2tog or p2tog to stay in rib.

*If you are not using the Tubular Bind Off method, break yarn and place 35 (39, 47, 53)(**61, 65, 75**)(83, 89, 99, 103) sts on hold for the shoulder. Reattach MC & BO rem 34 (34, 36, 36)(**38, 38, 38**)(40, 40, 40, 40) Back Neck sts using your preferred method.*

Break yarn and place 35 (39, 47, 53)(**61, 65, 75**)(83, 89, 99, 103) shoulder sts on hold for the shoulder bind off.

To continue the Tubular Bind Off method, attach 20"/51 cm length of MC and BO the rem 34 (34, 36, 36)(**38, 38, 38**)(40, 40, 40, 40) Back Neck sts using Kitchener stitch. (You can find a tutorial for Kitchener Stitch on One Needle in the Notes on pg. 3. If preferred, you can separate the stitches on to 2 needles. With RS facing, slip each st purlwise, slipping the knit sts onto the working needle and the purl sts onto a spare needle which should be held parallel with the working needle, but behind it.)

SHOULDER BIND OFF

Return Right & Left Back Shoulder sts to one needle, and place the held Front sts on a spare needle. With RS facing (and the WS sandwiched together to create an exposed seam), beginning at the Left Shoulder (as worn), join MC and BO 35 (39, 47, 53)(**61, 65, 75**)(83, 89, 99, 103) shoulder sts using the 3-Needle Bind Off method as follows: Line up the shoulder sts from the front and the back of the cardigan on parallel needles. Using a third needle, insert needle tip knitwise into the first st on the front needle and then knitwise into the first st on the back needle, and knit them together; *knit the next st from each needle together, pass the first st over the second; rep from * until all shoulder sts have been bound off. Break yarn and pull tail thru the final loop to secure. Rep for the Right Shoulder.

SLEEVES (same for both)

Using Mattress stitch with RS facing, use MC to seam the 7 sts that were CO to the Front armhole edge to the 7 sts that were CO to the Back armhole edge, which creates the beginning of the sleeve. (See Tutorial on pg. 3.)

Using Main Fabric needle in your preferred method for small circumference knitting, join MC at the underarm seam and pick up and knit 90 (100, 100, 110)(**120, 130, 140**) (150, 160, 170, 170) sts around the sleeve opening. Place a BOR M and join to work in the rnd.

The sleeves will mirror each other. It does not matter which sleeve you knit on which side of the cardigan, as long as you do one of each.

SLEEVE #1

Rnd 1: Join CC, knit.

Rnd 2: Using MC, knit.

Rnd 3: Using CC, k6, {sl3 wyib, k7} to the last 4 sts, sl3 wyib, k1.

Rnd 4: Using MC, knit.

Rep [Rnds 3 & 4] twice more.

Rnd 9: Using CC, knit.

Rnd 10: Using MC, knit.

Rnd 11: Using CC, k1, {sl3 wyib, k7} to the last 9 sts, sl3 wyib, k6.

Rnd 12: Using MC, knit.

Rep [Rnds 11 & 12] twice more.

Rnd 17: Using CC, knit. Break CC.

Rnd 18: Using MC, knit.

Proceed to Cuff.

SLEEVE #2

Rnd 1: Join CC, knit.

Rnd 2: Using MC, knit.

Rnd 3: Using CC, k1, {sl3 wyib, k7} to the last 9 sts, sl3 wyib, k6.

Rnd 4: Using MC, knit.

Rep [Rnds 3 & 4] twice more.

Rnd 9: Using CC, knit.

Rnd 10: Using MC, knit.

Rnd 11: Using CC, k6, {sl3 wyib, k7} to the last 4 sts, sl3 wyib, k1.

Rnd 12: Using MC, knit.

Rep [Rnds 11 & 12] twice more.

Rnd 17: Using CC, knit. Break CC.

Rnd 18: Using MC, knit.

Proceed to Cuff.

CUFF

Change to Ribbing needle.

Ribbing Rnd: {K1, p1} to end of rnd.

Rep [Ribbing Rnd] 9 more times. (*If you prefer not to do a Tubular BO, work one more rnd of ribbing, then BO all sts using your preferred method*)

Tubular BO Rnd 1: {K1, sl1 wyif} to end of rnd.

Tubular BO Rnd 2: {Sl1 wyib, p1} to end of rnd.

Sl each st purlwise, slipping the knit sts onto the working needle and the purl sts onto a spare needle, OR reference the Kitchener Stitch on One Needle Tutorial linked in the Notes on pg. 3 to skip this step.

Break yarn, leaving a tail 4 times the length of the sts to be bound off, and BO all sts using the Kitchener stitch.

Repeat for the other sleeve, using Sleeve #2.



HEY SAILOR!

_____ DIRECTIONS _____

BUTTON BAND - LEFT BACK (as worn)

Using the Ribbing needle and starting at the lower Left Back Side (as worn), with RS facing, use MC to pick up and knit 139 (145, 145, 149)(**155, 159, 163**)(169, 175, 179, 179) sts for the Cropped Length or 159 (165, 165, 169)(**175, 179, 183**)(189, 195, 199, 199) sts for the Full Length.

Ribbing Row 1 (WS): Sl1 wyif, {p1, k1} to the last 2 sts, p2.

Ribbing Row 2 (RS): Sl1 wyib, {k1, p1} to the last 2 sts, k2.

Rep [Ribbing Rows 1 & 2] once more.

Cropped Length Buttonhole Row (WS):

Sl1 wyif, {p1, k1} 1 (2, 2, 1)(**1, 2, 3**)(2, 1, 2, 2) times, p0 (1, 1, 1)(**0, 0, 0**)(0, 1, 1, 1), *work 5-Stitch Buttonhole, work 11 (11, 11, 12)(**13, 13, 11**)(12, 13, 13, 13) sts in rib pattern; rep from * 7 (7, 7, 7)(**7, 7, 8**)(8, 8, 8, 8) more times, work one more 5-st Buttonhole, work in rib to end.

Full Length Buttonhole Row (WS):

Sl1 wyif, {p1, k1} 3 (2, 2, 3)(**2, 3, 2**)(1, 3, 1, 1) times, p0 (0, 0, 0)(**0, 0, 1**)(1, 0, 1, 1), *work 5-Stitch Buttonhole, work 9 (10, 10, 10)(**11, 11, 10**)(11, 11, 12, 12) sts in rib pattern; rep from * 9 (9, 9, 9)(**9, 9, 10**)(10, 10, 10, 10) more times, work one more 5-st Buttonhole, work in rib to end.

5-STITCH BUTTONHOLE

See pg. 3 for a link to a video tutorial. Move yarn to front (if it is not already there), sl1, return yarn to back, *sl1, pass first slipped st over the 2nd to BO 1 st; rep from * 3 more times. Sl rem st from RHN to LHN and turn work. With RS facing, CO 5 sts using the Cable Cast On, BEFORE placing the 5th st up on the LHN, bring yarn to front then place the st on the needle, turn work. Sl1 knitwise, pass the last st that was CO over the slipped st and off the needle.

Return to working the est ribbing pattern for 3 more rows.

(If you prefer not to do a Tubular BO, cont the ribbing for 1 extra row, then BO in pattern.)

Tubular BO Row 1 (WS): Sl2 wyif, {k1, sl1 wyif} to the last 2 sts, sl1 wyif, p1.

Tubular BO Row 2 (RS): Sl1 wyib, {k1, sl1 wyif} to the last 2 sts, k1, sl1 wyib.

Sl each st purlwise, treating the first and last sts as knit sts, slipping the knit sts onto the working needle and the purl sts onto a spare needle, OR reference the Kitchener Stitch on One Needle Tutorial linked in the Notes on pg. 3 to skip this step.

Break yarn, leaving a tail 4 times the length of the sts to be bound off, and BO all sts using the Kitchener stitch.



HEY SAILOR!

— DIRECTIONS —

BUTTON BAND - Right Back (as worn)

Using the Ribbing needle and starting at the upper Right Back Side (as worn), with RS facing, use MC to pick up and knit 139 (145, 145, 149)(**155, 159, 163**)(169, 175, 179, 179) sts for the Cropped Length or 159 (165, 165, 169)(**175, 179, 183**)(189, 195, 199, 199) sts for the Full Length.

Ribbing Row 1 (WS): Sl1 wyif, {p1, k1} to the last 2 sts, p2.

Ribbing Row 2 (RS): Sl1 wyib, {k1, p1} to the last 2 sts, k2.

Rep [Ribbing Rows 1 & 2] 3 more times.

(If you prefer not to do a Tubular BO, cont the ribbing for 1 extra row, then BO in pattern.)

Tubular BO Row 1 (WS): Sl2 wyif, {k1, sl1 wyif} to the last 2 sts, sl1 wyif, p1.

Tubular BO Row 2 (RS): Sl1 wyib, {k1, sl1 wyif} to the last 2 sts, k1, sl1 wyib.

Sl each st purlwise, treating the first and last sts as knit sts, slipping the knit sts onto the working needle and the purl sts onto a spare needle, OR reference the Kitchener Stitch on One Needle Tutorial linked in the Notes on pg. 3 to skip this step.

Break yarn, leaving a tail 4 times the length of the sts to be bound off, and BO all sts using the Kitchener stitch.

FINISHING

Weave in loose ends.

Wet block cardigan by letting it soak in lukewarm bath with wool wash for at least 15 minutes.

Gently squeeze the excess water from your cardigan. Sandwich cardigan between clean towels and step on top to remove as much moisture as possible without distorting your cardigan. Repeat with fresh towels if necessary.

Lay cardigan flat to dry using the Schematic to help achieve the desired shape and measurements.

Trim yarn tails, sew on buttons and wear!

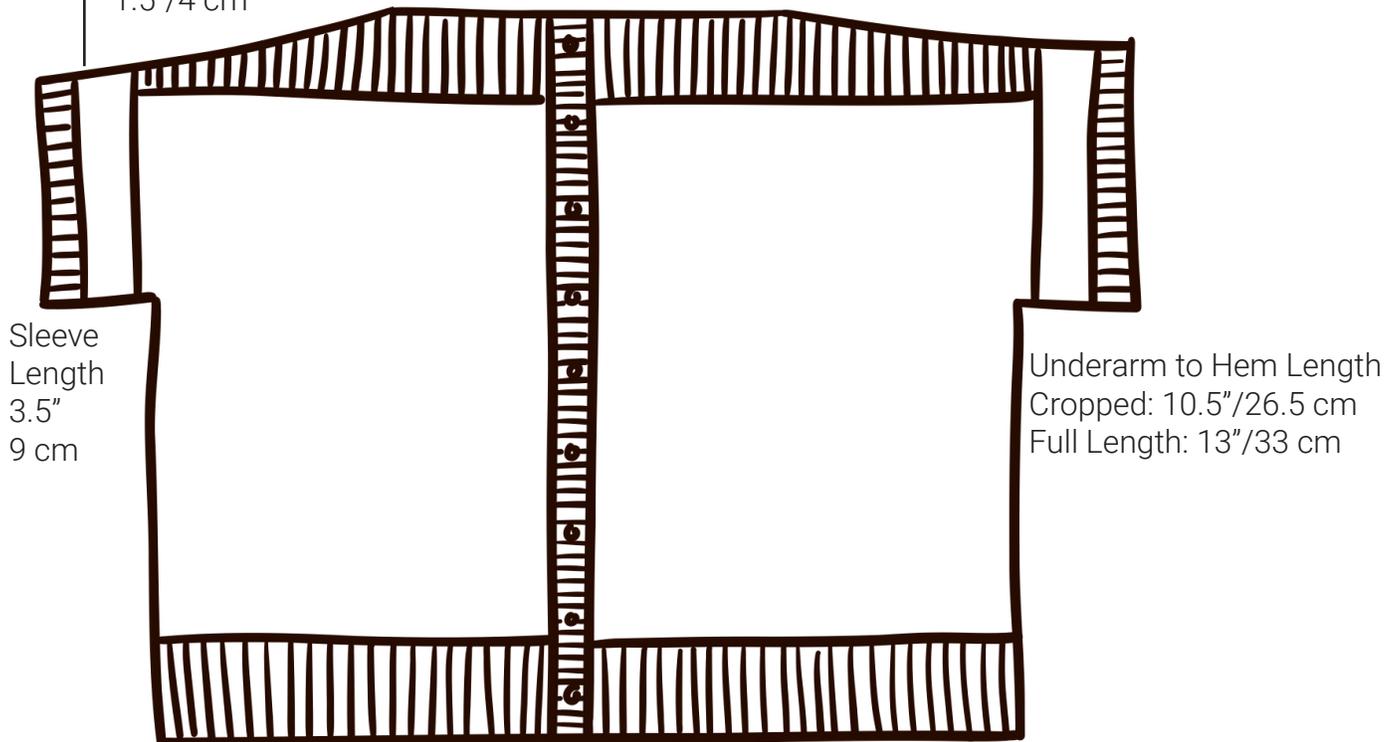
