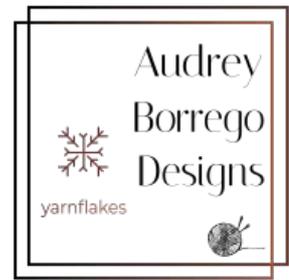


# Atlantica



## Notes

Atlantica is worked from the bottom-up in the round to the underarm. The front and back are then divided and worked separately to the shoulder. The shoulders are joined using the 3-needle cast-off. Sleeves are picked up around the armholes and worked inside out in the round. The hem, cuffs and collar are knit in 1x1 Rib using tubular cast-on and cast-off.

## **Yarn :**

You will need two colours or strands of lace weight yarn, each with the following amount :  
1000 (**1100** / 1250 / **1500** / 1600), **1750** (2000 / **2250** / 2400 / **2500**) meters  
1095 (**1205** / 1370 / **1645** / 1750), **1915** (2190 / **2465** / 2625 / **2735**) yards

The blue sample is knit with Istex Einband in Ash heather and Denim heather held together, while the peach sample is knit with Peach and Light Beige heather held together.

If substituting for a single strand of yarn, plan for once this amount in sport weight yarn.

## **Needles :**

*Main Fabric* : 4 mm (US 6) circular needles with appropriate length to knit in the round and magic loop or DPNs.

*Ribbing* : 3.5 mm (US 4) circular needles with appropriate length to knit in the round and magic loop or DPNs.

or sizes required to get gauge

## **Gauge :**

24 sts x 30 rnds per 10 cm – 4" with larger needles in lace motif after blocking  
20.5 sts x 28 rnds per 10 cm – 4" with larger needles in stockinette after blocking

## **Notions :**

Stitch markers, tapestry needle and scissors

Cable needle (optional)

Crochet hook of the smaller size for the tubular method

Spare needle of the smaller size for the tubular method and 3-needle bind-off

Scrap yarn to place sts on hold, Row counter recommended

## **Techniques used :**

Bottom up drop shoulder sweater

Tubular cast-on & bind-offs

1/1 ribbing

Lace knitting with twisted stitches, eyelets, simple, double and centered decreases

Bobbles (video tutorial provided)

Three needle bind-off for the shoulders

Picking up stitches

German short-row to work the sleeves in stockinette inside out

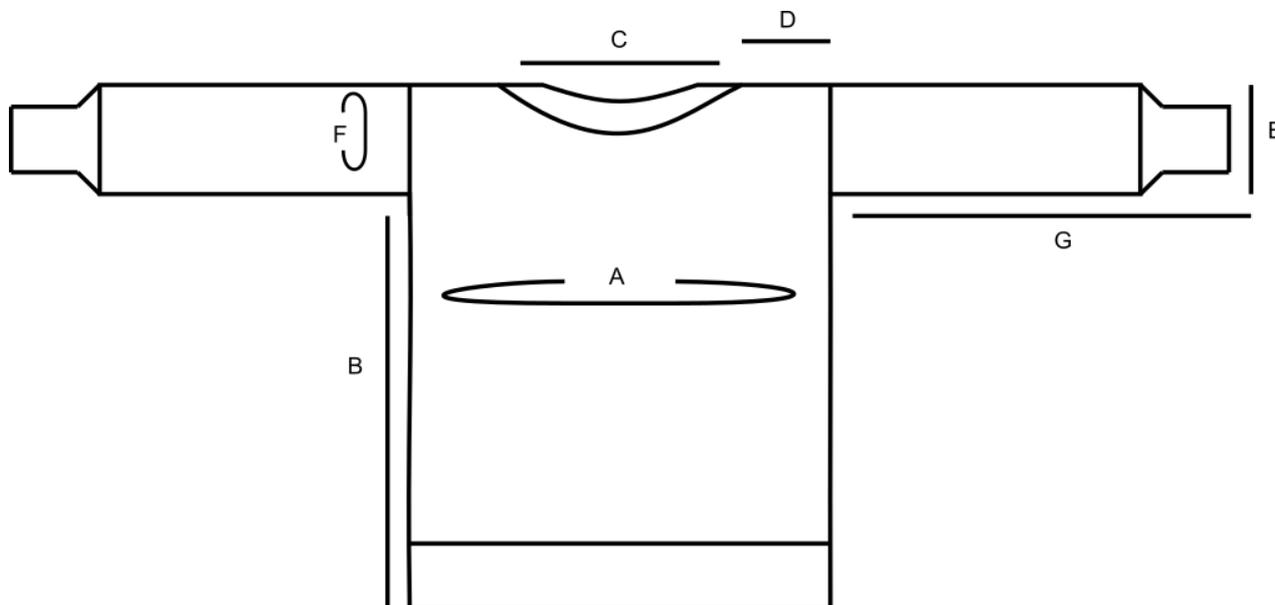
Pattern includes Charted and written instructions

**Sizes : 1 (2 / 3 / 4 / 5), 6 (7 / 8 / 9 / 10)**

All measurements are those of the finished sweater.

Choose a size with up to 25 cm – 10" positive ease at bust.

Shown in size 3 on a 90 cm – 35 1/2" bust (blue sample), and on a 84 cm – 33" bust (peach sample).

## Abbreviations :

- st(s) : stitch(es) / rnd(s) : round(s)
- BOR : beginning of round
- RS : right side / WS : wrong side
- m : marker / pm : place marker / sm : slip marker / rm : remove marker
- inc : increase / dec : decrease
- patt. : work in pattern
- k : knit / p : purl
- sl pwise wyib : slip the st purlwise with yarn in back
- sl pwise wyif : slip the st purlwise with yarn in front
- ktbl : knit the st through its back loop / ptbl : purl the st through its back loop
- yo : yarn over
- MB (see video tutorial below) : ([k1, yo] twice, k1) into next st, yo, pass the 5 bobble sts over the last yo. From the WS of the work pick up the first horizontal thread below the bobble and knit it tog with the st on the right hand needle
- 1/1 LPT : slip 1 st to cable needle, hold in front, p1, k1tbl from cable needle
- 1/1 RPT : slip 1 st to cable needle, hold in back, k1tbl, p1 from cable needle
- 1/1/1 LPT : slip 2 sts to cable needle, hold in front, k1tbl, slip leftmost stitch from cable needle back onto left hand needle, p1, k1tbl from cable needle
- k2tog (k3tog) : knit the next 2 (3) sts together (1 (2) dec)
- ssk : slip the next two sts knitwise separately then knit them together through their back loop (1 dec)
- s2kpo : slip the next 2 sts together knitwise, k1, pass the slipped sts over (2 dec)
- DS : double stitch for German short rows (counts as only 1 st)
- \*-\* : repeat instructions between asterisks

## Reading the Chart

When knitting in the round, always read the Charts from right to left.

When knitting flat, read the Charts back and forth : RS rows from right to left and WS rows from left to right.

## Hem

### Tubular cast-on :

You will cast-on 214 (**238** / 262 / **286** / 314), **334** (358 / **382** / 406 / **430**) sts on smaller needles with one strand of each colour held together throughout as follows :

Using the [crochet method](#), provisionally cast on half the required sts above with waste yarn.

*(Provisional Cast-On using a crochet hook by Very Pink Knits)*

Join to work in the round being careful not to twist. PM to indicate BOR.

With the working yarn, work as follows:

Round 1: [K1, yo] to end.

Round 2: [K1, sl1 pwise wyif] to end.

Round 3: [Sl1 pwise wyib, p1] to end.

Rep rounds 2-3 once more.

*After a few rounds of the following ribbing, you can remove the waste yarn by unravelling the provisional cast-on.*

PM after 107 (**119** / 131 / **143** / 157), **167** (179 / **191** / 203 / **215**) sts to indicate side.

Work in 1x1 Rib until piece measures 10cm – 4" from cast-on edge.

## Body

Change to larger needles.

Set-up round: \*P2 (**8** / 2 / **8** / 3), **8** (2 / **8** / 2 / **8**), PM, knit to 2 (**8** / 2 / **8** / 3), **8** (2 / **8** / 2 / **8**) sts before marker, PM, p to marker, SM; rep from \* once more.

Next round: P to marker, SM, work row 1 of Chart to marker, SM, [p to marker, SM] twice, work row 1 of Chart to marker, SM, p to end.

Continue in patt, working next row of Chart each time, until piece measures 38cm – 15" from cast-on edge, ending with any even-numbered round.

Make a note of the last Chart round worked.

Divide front and back as follows :

Next row (RS): P to marker, SM, work next row of Chart to marker, SM, p to marker, remove marker and turn.

Place remaining sts on hold for Front.

107 (**119** / 131 / **143** / 157), **167** (179 / **191** / 203 / **215**) back sts

## Back

Work flat from Chart as follows:

Row 1 (WS): K to marker, SM, work next row of Chart to marker, SM, k to end.

Row 2 (RS): P to marker, SM, work next row of Chart to marker, SM, p to end.

Rep rows 1-2, working next row of Chart each time, until back measures 13 (**14** / 15 / **16.5** / 17), **19** (20 / **21** / 22 / **23**) cm – 5 (**5½** / 6 / **6½** / 6¾), **7½** (7¾ / **8¼** / 8¾ / **9**)" from underarm, ending with a WS row.

Make a note of the last Chart row worked.

Next row (RS): Patt across 36 (**42** / 48 / **52** / 58), **62** (66 / **72** / 78 / **82**) sts for right shoulder, cast off 35 (**35** / 35 / **39** / 41), **43** (47 / **47** / 47 / **51**) sts for back neck, patt to end.

Place right shoulder sts on hold.

36 (**42** / 48 / **52** / 58), **62** (66 / **72** / 78 / **82**) left shoulder sts

## Back Left Shoulder

### Notes on decreasing in lace motif:

*During neck shaping you will be casting off sts while maintaining the lace motif pattern.*

*When working a yarnover or a decrease, if you do not have enough sts to work the corresponding decrease or yarn over, omit the yarnover and work the decrease stitches as knit (RS) or purl (WS).*

*When working a 1/1 LPT, 1/1 RPT or 1/1/1 LPT if you do not have enough stitches to*

*work the full cable: work the twisted stitches as knit (RS) or p1tbl (WS) and the purl stitches as purl (RS) or knit (WS).*

Row 1 (WS): K to marker, SM, patt to end.

Row 2 (RS): Cast off 4 sts, patt to marker, SM, p to end.

Rows 3-7: Rep rows 1-2 twice more, then rep row 1 only once more.

24 (**30** / 36 / **40** / 46), **50** (54 / **60** / 66 / **70**) sts

Break yarn and place sts on hold, removing marker.

## Back Right Shoulder

With WS facing, rejoin yarn to right shoulder sts. Resume working from Chart.

36 (**42** / 48 / **52** / 58), **62** (66 / **72** / 78 / **82**) right shoulder sts

Row 1 (WS): Cast off 4 sts, patt to marker, SM, k to end.

Row 2 (RS): P to marker, SM, patt to end.

Rows 3-6: Rep rows 1-2 twice more.

24 (**30** / 36 / **40** / 46), **50** (54 / **60** / 66 / **70**) sts

Row 7 (WS): Patt to marker, SM, k to end.

Break yarn and place sts on hold, removing marker.

## Front

With RS facing, rejoin yarn to 107 (**119** / 131 / **143** / 157), **167** (179 / **191** / 203 / **215**) held Front sts.

Work flat from Chart as follows:

Row 1 (RS): P to marker, SM, work next row of Chart to marker, SM, p to end.

Row 2 (WS): K to marker, SM, work next row of Chart to marker, SM, k to end.

Rep rows 1-2, working next row of Chart each time, until front measures 9 (**10** / 11 / **12.5** / 13), **14** (15 / **16** / 16.5 / **17**) cm – 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> (**4** / 4<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> / **5** / 5<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>), **5<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>** (6 / **6<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>** / 6<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> /

**6<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>**)" from underarm, ending with a WS row.

Make a note of the last Chart row worked.

Next row (RS): Patt across 42 (**48** / 54 / **58** / 64), **68** (74 / **80** / 86 / **92**) sts for left shoulder, cast off 23 (**23** / 23 / **27** / 29), **31** (31 / **31** / 31 / **31**) sts for front neck, patt to end.

Place left shoulder sts on hold.

42 (**48** / 54 / **58** / 64), **68** (74 / **80** / 86 / **92**) right shoulder sts

## Front Right Shoulder

Row 1 (WS): K to marker, SM, patt to end.

Row 2 (RS): Cast off 4 sts, patt to marker, SM, p to end.

Rows 3-7: Rep rows 1-2 twice, then rep row 1 only once more.

30 (**36** / 42 / **46** / 52), **56** (62 / **68** / 74 / **80**) sts

Row 8 (RS): Cast off 2 sts, patt to marker, SM, p to end.

Row 9 (WS): K to marker, SM, patt to end.

Rows 10-13: Rep rows 8-9 twice.

24 (**30** / 36 / **40** / 46), **50** (56 / **62** / 68 / **74**) sts

Sizes 7, 8, 9 & 10 ONLY

Next row (RS): Cast off 1 st, patt to marker, SM, p to end.

Next row (WS): K to marker, SM, patt to end.

Rep last two rows a further 1 (**1** / 1 / **3**) times.

54 (**60** / 66 / **70**) sts

ALL sizes again

Work straight in patt until front armhole length matches back, ending after same WS row.

Break yarn, leaving a long tail for joining shoulders, and place sts on hold, removing marker.

## Front Left Shoulder

With WS facing, rejoin yarn to 42 (**48** / 54 / **58** / 64), **68** (74 / **80** / 86 / **92**) held front left shoulder sts.

Work flat from Chart as follows:

Row 1 (WS): Cast off 4 sts, patt to marker, SM, k to end.

Row 2 (RS): P to marker, SM, patt to end.

Rows 3-6: Rep rows 1-2 twice.

**30** (**36** / 42 / **46** / 52), **56** (62 / **68** / 74 / **80**) sts

Row 7 (WS): Cast off 2 sts, patt to marker, SM, k to end.

Row 8 (RS): P to marker, SM, patt to end.

Rows 9-12: Rep rows 7-8 twice.

**24** (**30** / 36 / **40** / 46), **50** (56 / **62** / 68 / **74**) sts

Sizes 7, 8, 9 & 10 ONLY

Next row (WS): Cast off 1 st, patt to marker, SM, k to end.

Next row (RS): P to marker, SM, patt to end.

Rep last two rows a further 1 (**1** / 1 / **3**) times.

**54** (**60** / 66 / **70**) sts

ALL sizes again

Next row (WS): Patt to marker, SM, k to end.

Work straight in patt until front armhole length matches back, ending after same WS row and removing marker on last row.

Do not break yarn.

## Joining Shoulders

Place corresponding front and back shoulder sts on two needles with RS together. Join shoulders using the [three-needle bind-off method](#).

*(3-needle bind-off tutorial by Very Pink Knits)*

## Sleeves

With RS facing, using larger needles suitable for working small circumferences in the round and beginning at centre of underarm, pick up and knit 58 (**64** / 66 / **72** / 76), **86** (90 / **94** / 98 / **102**) sts around armhole.

Join to work in the round and PM to indicate BOR.

**58** (**64** / 66 / **72** / 76), **86** (90 / **94** / 98 / **102**) sts

Here is a [helpful tutorial](#) on how to make Double Stitches.

*(German short-rows tutorial by Very Pink Knits)*

Turn the work inside out to knit the sleeves with WS facing. Close the gap at BOR by working a German short-row Double Stitch as follows:

Next round: Create DS, k to end.

Resolving the DS as you pass it on first round, knit every round until sleeve measures 36 cm – 14<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" from underarm.

### Cuff :

Dec round: K2 (**4** / 0 / **0** / 4), **2** (2 / **4** / 2 / **6**), \*k2tog, k2 (**1** / 1 / **1** / 1), **1** (2 / **1** / 2 / **2**); rep from \* to end.

**44** (**44** / 44 / **48** / 52), **58** (68 / **64** / 74 / **78**) sts

Sizes 6, 7, 8, 9 & 10 ONLY

Dec round : K**2** (8 / **0** / 4 / **6**), \*k2tog, k**12** (3 / **6** / 3 / **2**), rep from \* to end.

**54** (56 / **56** / 60 / **60**) sts

ALL sizes again

Change to smaller needles.

Work in 1x1 Rib until cuff measures 12 cm – 4<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>".

### Tubular bind-off :

Round 1: [K1, sl1 pwise wyif] to end.

Round 2: [Sl1 pwise wyib, p1] to end.

Rep rounds 1-2 once more.

Slip each st pwise, leaving the knit sts on the working needle and placing the purl sts

onto a spare needle.

Cut yarn, leaving a tail approx. 4 times the work circumference.

Use the tail to loosely graft the two sets of sts together using the [kitchener stitch](#).

*(Kitchener stitch tutorial by Very Pink Knits)*

## **Collar**

Using smaller needles and starting at the right shoulder seam with RS facing, pick up and knit 86 (**88** / 88 / **92** / 94), **98** (100 / **106** / 108 / **110**) sts around the neckline.

Join to work in the round and PM to indicate BOR.

86 (**88** / 88 / **92** / 94), **98** (100 / **106** / 108 / **110**) sts

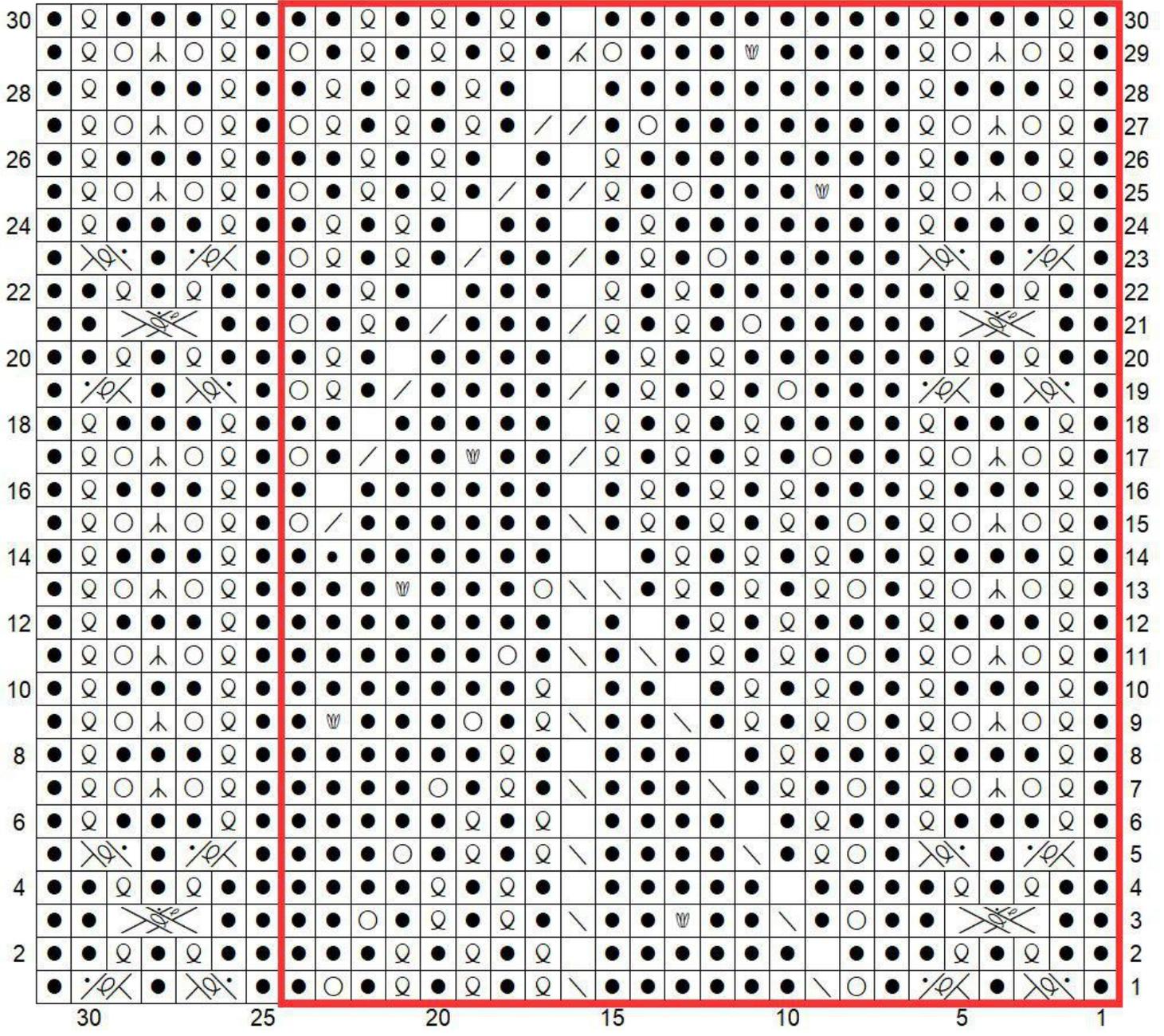
Work in 1x1 rib until collar measures 3 cm – 1¼".

Cast off using the tubular cast-off method like you did for the sleeves cuff.

## **Finishing**

Weave in ends and block to measurements.

Round 2: \*P2, [k1tbl, p1] twice, p2, k1, p6, k1, [k1tbl, p1] 3 times, p2; rep from \* to last 7 sts, p2, k1tbl, p1, k1tbl, p2.

Round 3: \*P2, 1/1/1 LPT, p2, yo, p1, ssk, p2, MB, p2, ssk, p1, [k1tbl, p1] twice, yo, p2; rep from \* to last 7 sts, p2, 1/1/1 LPT, p2.

Round 4: \*P2, k1tbl, p1, k1tbl, p4, k1, p5, k1, p1, [k1tbl, p1] twice, p3; rep from \* to last 7 sts, p2, k1tbl, p1, k1tbl, p2.

Round 5: \*P1, 1/1 RPT, p1, 1/1 LPT, p1, yo, k1tbl, p1, ssk, p4, ssk, [k1tbl, p1] twice, yo, p3; rep from \* to last 7 sts, p1, 1/1 RPT, p1, 1/1 LPT, p1.

Round 6: \*P1, k1tbl, p3, k1tbl, p2, k1tbl, p1, k1, p4, k1, [k1tbl, p1] twice, p4; rep from \* to last 7 sts, p1, k1tbl, p3, k1tbl, p1.

Round 7: \*P1, k1tbl, yo, s2kpo, yo, k1tbl, p1, yo, p1, k1tbl, p1, ssk, p3, ssk, p1, k1tbl, p1, yo, p4; rep from \* to last 7 sts, p1, k1tbl, yo, s2kpo, yo, k1tbl, p1.

Round 8: \*P1, [k1tbl, p3] twice, k1tbl, p1, k1, p3, k1, p1, k1tbl, p6; rep from \* to last 7 sts, p1, k1tbl, p3, k1tbl, p1.

Round 9: \*P1, k1tbl, yo, s2kpo, yo, k1tbl, p1, yo, [k1tbl, p1] twice, ssk, p2, ssk, k1tbl, p1, yo, p3, MB, p1; rep from \* to last 7 sts, p1, k1tbl, yo, s2kpo, yo, k1tbl, p1.

Round 10: \*P1, k1tbl, p3, k1tbl, p2, [k1tbl, p1] twice, k1, p2, k1, k1tbl, p7; rep from \* to last 7 sts, p1, k1tbl, p3, k1tbl, p1.

Round 11: \*P1, k1tbl, yo, s2kpo, yo, k1tbl, p1, yo, p1, [k1tbl, p1] twice, [ssk, p1] twice, yo, p6; rep from \* to last 7 sts, p1, k1tbl, yo, s2kpo, yo, k1tbl, p1.

Round 12: \*P1, [k1tbl, p3] twice, [k1tbl, p1] twice, [k1, p1] twice, p7; rep from \* to last 7 sts, p1, k1tbl, p3, k1tbl, p1.

Round 13: \*P1, k1tbl, yo, s2kpo, yo, k1tbl, p1, yo, [k1tbl, p1] 3 times, [ssk] twice, yo, p3, MB, p3; rep from \* to last 7 sts, p1, k1tbl, yo, s2kpo, yo, k1tbl, p1.

Round 14: \*P1, k1tbl, p3, k1tbl, p2, [k1tbl, p1] 3 times, k2, p8; rep from \* to last 7 sts, p1, k1tbl, p3, k1tbl, p1.

Round 15: \*P1, k1tbl, yo, s2kpo, yo, k1tbl, p1, yo, p1, [k1tbl, p1] 3 times, ssk, p6, k2tog, yo; rep from \* to last 7 sts, p1, k1tbl, yo, s2kpo, yo, k1tbl, p1.

Round 16: \*P1, [k1tbl, p3] twice, [k1tbl, p1] 3 times, k1, p6, k1, p1; rep from \* to last 7 sts, p1, k1tbl, p3, k1tbl, p1.

Round 17: \*P1, k1tbl, yo, s2kpo, yo, k1tbl, p2, yo, [p1, k1tbl] 3 times, k2tog, p2, MB, p2, k2tog, p1, yo; rep from \* to last 7 sts, p1, k1tbl, yo, s2kpo, yo, k1tbl, p1.

Round 18: \*P1, [k1tbl, p3] twice, [p1, k1tbl] 3 times, k1, p5, k1, p2; rep from \* to last 7 sts, p1, k1tbl, p3, k1tbl, p1.

Round 19: \*P1, 1/1 LPT, p1, 1/1 RPT, p3, yo, p1, [k1tbl, p1] twice, k2tog, p4, k2tog, p1, k1tbl, yo; rep from \* to last 7 sts, p1, 1/1 LPT, p1, 1/1 RPT, p1.

Round 20: \*P2, k1tbl, p1, k1tbl, p6, [k1tbl, p1] twice, k1, p4, k1, p1, k1tbl, p1; rep from \* to last 7 sts, p2, k1tbl, p1, k1tbl, p2.

Round 21: \*P2, 1/1/1 LPT, p5, yo, [p1, k1tbl] twice, k2tog, p3, k2tog, p1, k1tbl, p1, yo; rep from \* to last 7 sts, p2, 1/1/1 LPT, p2.

Round 22: \*P2, [k1tbl, p1] twice, p5, [p1, k1tbl] twice, k1, p3, k1, p1, k1tbl, p2; rep from \* to last 7 sts, p2, k1tbl, p1, k1tbl, p2.

Round 23: \*P1, 1/1 RPT, p1, 1/1 LPT, p5, yo, p1, k1tbl, p1, k2tog, p2, k2tog, [p1, k1tbl] twice, yo; rep from \* to last 7 sts, p1, 1/1 RPT, p1, 1/1 LPT, p1.

Round 24: \*P1, k1tbl, p3, k1tbl, p7, k1tbl, p1, k1, p2, k1, [p1, k1tbl] twice, p1; rep from \* to last 7 sts, p1, k1tbl, p3, k1tbl, p1.

Round 25: \*P1, k1tbl, yo, s2kpo, yo, k1tbl, p2, MB, p3, yo, p1, k1tbl, [k2tog, p1] twice, [k1tbl, p1] twice, yo; rep from \* to last 7 sts, p1, k1tbl, yo, s2kpo, yo, k1tbl, p1.

Round 26: \*P1, k1tbl, p3, k1tbl, p8, k1tbl, [k1, p1] twice, [k1tbl, p1] twice, p1; rep from \* to last 7 sts, p1, k1tbl, p3, k1tbl, p1.

Round 27: \*P1, k1tbl, yo, s2kpo, yo, k1tbl, p7, yo, p1, [k2tog] twice, [p1, k1tbl] 3 times, yo; rep from \* to last 7 sts, p1, k1tbl, yo, s2kpo, yo, k1tbl, p1.

Row 28: K1, p1tbl, k3, p1tbl, k1, \*k1, [p1tbl, k1] 3 times, p2, k9, p1tbl, k3, p1tbl, k1; rep from \* to end.

Row 29: \*P1, k1tbl, yo, s2kpo, yo, k1tbl, p4, MB, p3, yo, k3tog, [p1, k1tbl] 3 times, p1, yo; rep from \* to last 7 sts, p1, k1tbl, yo, s2kpo, yo, k1tbl, p1.

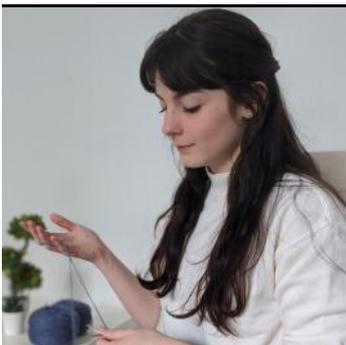
