## Augustins no. 29

**Size:** a-b (c-d) e-f (g-h).

**Your bust circumference:** approx. 80-90 (100-110) 120-130 (140-150) cm.

**The circumference of the cardigan:** approx. 115 (135) 155 (175) cm.

**Full length, measured CB below the neckline:** approx. 52 (57) 62 (67) cm.

**Positive ease:** This cardigan has a positive ease of approximately 25-35 cm, depending on your bust circumference. When deciding which size to knit, choose the one which corresponds to your own actual bust circumference. If in between sizes, opt for the smaller size.

**Gauge:** 14 sts x 18 rows = 10 x 10 cm at needle size 7 mm in twisted ribbing.

**Needle size:** Circular needles 6 + 7 mm (the lengths 60 and 80 cm are recommended).

**Yarn:** "Hyrdegarn", Hjelholts Uldspinderi (125m per 100g).

**Amount:** 800 (850) 900 (950)g.

**Extra:** 3 (3) 4 (4) buttons with a diameter of approx. 2-3 cm + 1 sewing needle.

**Process:** The body and yoke of the cardigan is knitted back and forth, following a textured rib + lace pattern. Round along the front, an I-cord border is knitted onto the neck- and front pieces. Along the edge of the back and front pieces, sts are picked up in each side for sleeves. The sleeves are knitted in the round in the same rib + lace structure as the body and yoke. The edges of both the body and sleeves are knitted in twisted ribbing, and to finish the cardigan, buttons are sewn onto the frontal I-cord border.

# Opskrift

## Before you begin

- Please read the entire pattern before casting on.
- Be sure to make a swatch before beginning, to ensure the right gauge.
- Edge sts: as long as the cardigan is knitted back and forth, k the first and last st of each row.
- In this pattern, these methods are used: Italian cast on and bind off, I-cord, backstitches when sewing the front- and back pieces of the body together.

## Back piece

At needle size 6 mm and using the Italian cast on method, cast on 81 (95) 109 (123) sts. To create the edge, knit back and forth in twisted ribbing in the following way:

1. row (WS): k 1 (edge st), k 1, \*p 1 tbl, k 1\*, repeat \*-\* until 1 st remains, k 1 (edge st).
2. row (RS): k 1 (edge st) p 1, \*k 1 tbl, p 1\*, repeat \*-\* until 1 st remains, 1 r (km).

Repeat the 1.-2. row until the edge measures 7 cm - let the last knitted row be from the WS.

Change to circular needles 7 mm.

At the next row, **Panel 1** (which consists of the following 10 rows) begins:

1. row (RS): k all sts.
2. row (WS): k all sts.
3. row (RS): k 1 (edge st), \*k2tog, yo\*, repeat \*-\* until 2 sts remain, k 1, k 1 (edge st).
4. row (WS): k all sts.
5. row (RS): k all sts.
6. row (WS): k 1 (edge st), k 1, \*p 1 tbl, k 1\*, repeat \*-\* until 1 st remains, k 1 (edge st).
7. row (RS): k 1 (edge st), p 1, \*k 1 tbl, p 1\*, repeat \*-\* until 1 st remains, k 1 (edge st).
8. row (WS): k 1 (edge st), k 1, \*p 1 tbl, k 1\*, repeat \*-\* until 1 st remains, k 1 (edge st).
9. row (RS): k 1 (edge st), p 1, \*k 1 tbl, p 1\*, repeat \*-\* until 1 st remains, k 1 (edge st).
10. row (WS): k 1 (edge st), k 1, \*p 1 tbl, k 1\*, repeat \*-\* until 1 st remains, k 1 (edge st).

Knit **Panel 1** (1.-10. row), in a total of 8 (9) 10 (11) times.

The back piece is now approx. 51 (56) 61 (66) cm, measured from the cast on row.

## Neckline

Over the next rows, the transition between the back- and front pieces must be knitted, whilst at the same time binding off sts for the neckline.

This is done in the following way:

1. row (RS): k all sts.
2. row (WS): k all sts.
3. row (RS): k 1 (edge st), \*k2tog, yo\*, repeat \*-\* until 2 sts remain, k 1, k 1 (edge st).
4. row (WS): k all sts.
5. row (RS): k all sts.
6. row (WS): k 1 (edge st), \*k 1, p 1 tbl\*, knit \*-\* in a total of 10 (12) 16 (19) times, k 2 (right front piece), bind off 35 (37) 39 (41) sts in purl, k 1, \*k 1, p 1 tbl\*, knit \*-\* in a total of 10 (12) 16 (19) times, k 2 (left front piece).

There are now a total of 23 (29) 35 (41) sts for each of the 2 front pieces.

Place the sts of the right-side front piece on a thread and let the sts rest, whilst knitting the left-side front piece.

### Front pieces

To finish the transition between the front and back of the cardigan, knit the next 9 rows in the following way:

1. row (RS): k 1 (edge st) p 1, \*k 1 tbl, p 1\*, repeat \*-\* until 1 st remains, k 1 (edge st).
2. row (WS): k 1 (edge st) k 1, \*p 1 tbl, k 1\*, repeat \*-\* until 1 st remains, k 1 (edge st).  
place a sM in the last edge st and let this rest in the work - the sM will later be used, when picking up sts for sleeves.
3. row (RS): k 1 (edge st) p 1, \*k 1 tbl, p 1\*, repeat \*-\* until 1 st remains, k 1 (edge st).
4. row (WS): k 1 (edge st) k 1, \*p 1 tbl, k 1\*, repeat \*-\* until 1 st remains, k 1 (edge st).
5. row (RS): k all sts.
6. row (WS): k all sts.
7. row (RS): k 1 (edge st), \*k2tog\*, yo\*, repeat \*-\* until 2 sts remain, k 1, k 1 (edge st).
8. row (WS): k all sts.
9. row (RS): k all sts.

At the next row, **Panel 2** (which consists of the following 10 rows) begins:

1. row (WS): k 1 (edge st) k 1, \*p 1 tbl, k 1\*, repeat \*-\* until 1 st remains, k 1 (edge st).
2. row (RS): k 1 (edge st) p 1, \*k 1 tbl, p 1\*, repeat \*-\* until 1 st remains, k 1 (edge st).
3. row (WS): k 1 (edge st) k 1, \*p 1 tbl, k 1\*, repeat \*-\* until 1 st remains, k 1 (edge st).
4. row (RS): k 1 (edge st) p 1, \*k 1 tbl, p 1\*, repeat \*-\* until 1 st remains, k 1 (edge st).
5. row (WS): k 1 (edge st) k 1, \*p 1 tbl, k 1\*, repeat \*-\* until 1 st remains, k 1 (edge st).
6. row (RS): k all sts.
7. row (WS): k all sts.
8. row (RS): k 1 (edge st), \*k2tog\*, yo\*, repeat \*-\* until 2 sts remain, k 1, k 1 (edge st).
9. row (WS): k all sts.
10. row (RS): k all sts.

Knit **Panel 2** (1.-10. row), in a total of 8 (9) 10 (11) times.  
Change to circular needles 6 mm.

Now, the finishing edge in twisted ribbing must be knitted in the following way:

1. row (WS): k 1 (edge st), k 1, \*p 1 tbl, k 1\*, repeat \*-\* until 1 st remains, k 1 (edge st).
2. row (RS): k 1 (edge st) p 1, \*k 1 tbl, p 1\*, repeat \*-\* until 1 st remains, 1 r (km).

Repeat the 1.-2. row until the edge measures 7 cm - let the last knitted row be from the WS. Using the Italian bind off method, bind off all sts.

*Knit the right-side front pice in the same way as the left-side font piece.*

### Sleeves

Now, sts must be picked up along the outer left edge of the cardigan, to create sts for the left sleeve. This is done in the following way:

From the RS and starting 30 (32) 34 (36) 38 sts to the right of the sM, pick up 60 (64) 68 (72) sts with circular needles 7 mm for the sleeve - to center the sleeve correctly on the cardigan, be sure to pick up the sts evenly, so that there are 30 (32) 34 (36) 38 sts on each side of the sM.

Gather work and place a M between the first and last picked up st = BOR.

At the next rnd, **Panel 3** (which consists of the following 10 rnds) begins:

1. rnd: k all sts.
2. rnd: p all sts.
3. rnd: \*k2tog, yo\*, repeat \*-\* throughout the rnd.
4. rnd: p all sts.
5. rnd: k all sts.
- 6.-10. rnd: \*k 1 tbl, p 1\*, repeat \*-\* throughout the rnd.

Knit **Panel 3** (1.-10. rnd), in a total of 5 times.

To finish the panel of the sleeve, knit the 1.-5. rnd again.

Change to circular needles 6 mm.

Now, the finishing edge in twisted ribbing must be knitted:

1. rnd: \*k 1 tbl, p 1\*, repeat \*-\* throughout the rnd.

Repeat the 1. rnd until the edge measures 7 cm - the total length of the sleeve is now approx. 32 cm. Using the Italian bind off method, bind off all sts.

*Knit the right-side sleeve in the same way as the left-side sleeve.*

## **Finishing**

Now, the left side of the body must be sewn together from the WS using the method “backstitches” - start from the bottom edge, and sew together until reaching the armpit. When you sew, make sure that the front- and back pieces are correctly aligned, to secure the panel texture is parallel on each side.

*Sew together the right side of the body in the same way.*

Weave in all ends and rinse the cardigan in luke warm water with wool soap, and then let it dry laying flat.

## **I-cord border**

Now, the I-cord border must be knitted onto the frontal border of the cardigan, following its 2 front pieces and neckline.

This is done in the following way:

With circular needles 7 mm and starting RS in the lower corner of the left-side front piece, pick up 1 st per 2nd vertical row, up along the left-side front piece, then along the neckline and finally down along the right-side front piece.

Break the yarn and let the sts rest on the needle.

Now, from the RS, cast on 5 sts onto the right-side needle and p the 5 sts.

The 5 sts are now at the left-side needle and are placed in continuation of the previously established cardigan edge sts.

Continue by knitting the i-cord in the following way:

\*k 4, k2tog tbl (1 st from the i-cord + 1 st from the cardigan), slip the r sts back onto the left side needle\*.

Repeat \*-\* until all sts from the cardigan have been knitted.

Break the yarn, pull the thread through the 5 remaining sts and tighten.

To finish the I-cord, weave in the ends in each side, so that they are aligned with corner of the twisted ribbing edge of the cardigan.

## *Buttons and holes*

Now, 3 (3) 4 (4) buttons must be sewn onto the left side of the I-cord border.

Place the 1st button right above the twisted ribbing edge of the cardigan, right next to the 1st eyelet laced row.

Place the 2nd right next to the 3rd eyelet laced row.

Place the 3rd right next to the 5th eyelet laced row.

(Place the 4rd right next to the 7th eyelet laced row).

To create the button holes, use a size 10-12 mm needle to push it through the centered st of the I-cord border which is parallel in height to each of the 3 (3) 4 (4) buttons - this will widen the loop between the st and form the hole.
