Introduction

Seamless and fun to knit, BAGGU is a small bag, pouch, purse, whatever you wish for ! You can use it to store your needles, accessories or other treasured items. You can put a click clack metal clasp, add a small chain or simply put a ribbon. The small squares in the pattern are there to help you count the rows.

Sizes

2 Sizes : **a.** 6 x 6 " / 15 x 15 cm, **b.** 8 x 6 " / 20 x 15 cm

Gauge

Stockinette stitch blocked with 2.5 mm / 1.5 US needles : 10 cm x 10 cm / 4" x 4" = 36 sts x 48 rows.

Material

Yarn : fingering 100g = 366m / 400 yds.

Yarn used in the sample for the sample size a :

- **Color A outer face** : LITLG yarn - Singles - Terrain - 150 m / 160 yds / 40 g
- **Color B inner face** : LITLG yarn - Singles - Bronze - 150 m / 160 yds / 40 g

Yarn used in the sample for the sample size b :

- **Color A outer face** : LITLG yarn - Singles - Silica - 165 m / 180 yds / 45 g
- **Color B inner face** : LITLG yarn - Singles - Earthenware - 165 m / 180 yds / 45 g

Needles : 2 sets of circular needles 2.5 mm / 1.5 US (or size to get gauge)
+ 2.75 mm / 2 US or 3 mm / 2.5 US to bind off.

Accessories : 6"/15 cm click clack metal clasp for size a. (from the CraftSurprises shop on Etsy or your local haberdashery)
8"/20 cm click clack metal clasp for size b.
or an 31" / 80 cm ribbon

Notion : 4 markers.

Abbreviations

CO : Cast on.

R : Row

RS : Right Side.

WS : Wrong Side.

inc : Increase.

dec : Decrease.

k : Knit.

p : Purl.

A : yarn color A.

B : yarn color B.

M : Marker.

Mbor : Marker beginning of round.

PM1 : Place marker N°1.

PMbor : Place marker beginning of round.

RM1 : Remove marker N°1.

RMbor : Remove marker beginning of round.

slm : Slip marker.

slMbor : Slip marker beginning of the round.

sl3wyif : Slip 3 sts with yarn in front : bring yarn forward and slip the next 3 stitches purlwise.

sl3wyib : Slip 3 sts with yarn in back : let yarn forward and slip the next 3 stitches purlwise.

k1TBL : Knit 1 st through the back loop.

p1TBL : Purl 1 st through the back loop.

kfb : Knit front and back : knit into the front of the stitch and then without dropping it off the needle, knit into the back of the stitch = one stitch increased.

ssk : Slip, slip, knit : slip the first stitch knitwise, slip the second stitch kntwise, then slide the left-hand needle into the front part of both stitches and knit them together.

ssp : Slip, slip, purl : slip the first stitch knitwise, slip the second stitch kntwise, put the 2 sts back on the left needle then purl them together through the back loop.


k2tog : Knit 2 sts together.

k3tog : Knit 3 sts together.

p2tog : Purl 2 sts together.

yo : Yarn over.

Construction



-> Then leave sts B aside for now.



SECTION 1 : borders

-> CO : with A and the 2.5 mm / 1.5 US needles, using the long tail method, CO size a.55 sts or size b.71 sts.

-> For the next row, on the back of the work, make sure to keep yarn B on the right and yarn A on the left (do not cross yarns) to keep a regular pattern on the back.

□ **R1 (RS)** : with A k3, with B k1tbl, (A p1, bring yarn in back, B k1tbl) repeat to 3 sts before end, A sl3wyif.

-> For the next row, on the front of the work, make sure to keep yarn B on the left and yarn A on the right (do not cross yarns) to keep a regular pattern on the back.

□ **R2 (WS)** : A k3, bring yarn in front, B p1tbl, (A k1, bring yarn in front, B p1tbl) repeat to 3 sts before end, A sl3wyif.

□ **R3 (RS)** : A k3, B kfb, (A kfb, B kfb) repeat to 3 sts before end, A sl3wyif. (a.49 sts inc = 104 sts / b.65 sts inc = 136 sts)

-> Don't cut B.

□ **R4 (WS)** : A k3, bring yarn in front, put the 2 sts B on hold on another set of needles in front of you, (A p2, put the 2 sts B on hold) repeat to 3 sts before end, sl3wyif. (a.54 sts A and 50 sts B / b.70 sts A and 66 sts B)

□ **R5 (RS)** : A k3, kfb on each st to 3 sts before end, sl3wyif. (a.48 sts inc = 102 sts / b.64 sts inc = 134 sts)

□ **R6 (WS)** : A k3, p to 3 sts before end, sl3wyif.

□ **R7 (RS)** : A k to 3 sts before end, sl3wyif.

-> Repeat R6 and R7 2 more times, then R6 1 more time :

R6 : □ □ □

□ **R8 (RS)** : A k3, k2tog to 3 sts before end, sl3wyif. (a.48 sts dec = 54 sts / b.64 sts dec = 70 sts)

-> Leave A sts aside for now, don't cut A and take back the sts B.

□ **R9 (RS)** : B k3, kfb on each st to 3 sts before end, sl3wyif. (a.44 sts inc = 94 sts / b.60 sts inc = 126 sts)

□ **R10 (WS)** : B k3, p to 3 sts before end, sl3wyif.

□ **R11 (RS)** : B k to 3 sts before end, sl3wyif.

-> Repeat R10 and R11 2 more times, then R10 1 more time :

R10 : □ □ □

R11 : □ □

□ **R12 (RS)** : B k3, k2tog to 3 sts before end, sl3wyif. (a.44 sts dec = 50 sts / b.60 sts dec = 66 sts)



-> Position the needle with stitches A in front of the needle with stitches B, keep A in front of you as follows :



□ **R13 (RS)** : with the third needle and yarn B, k the first st A, k the second st A, then (k one st A of the first needle with one st B of the second needle together) repeat to the 2 last sts, k2. (a.54 sts / b.70 sts)



-> Cut A and B. Leave this border aside on the needles and repeat from CO to knit a second border. (don't cut A and B after the second border)

SECTION 2 : join the two borders

After you have finished the second border, sts A in front of you, PMbor and continue with A and B by knitting the first border sts as follows :



□ **R14 (RS)** : A k3, (B kfb, A kfb) repeat to 3 sts before end of the first border, A k3, PM1, (your second needles set is now free), join in round, A k3, (B kfb, A kfb) repeat to 3 sts before Mbor, A k3, slm.

-> Separate the outer face (sts A) and the inner face (sts B) :

□ **R15 (RS)** : with A, k sts A and put sts B on hold on the second needle set (placed at the back of the work) to Mbor, slm. (a.108 sts A and 96 sts B / b.140 sts A and 128 sts B)



-> Leave sts B aside for now. Don't cut B.

SECTION 3 : outer face

□ **R16 (RS)** : A k1tbl, k to 1 st before M1, k1tbl, slm, k1tbl, k to 1 st before Mbor, k1tbl, slm.

□ **R17 (RS)** : k1tbl, k2, (yo, k4, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, k3, k2tog) repeat to 3 sts before M1, k2, k1tbl, slm, k1tbl, k2, (yo, k4, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, k3, k2tog) repeat to 3 sts before Mbor, k2, k1tbl, slm.

□ **R18 (RS)** : repeat R16.

□ **R19 (RS)** : k1tbl, k2, (k4, k2tog, yo, k5, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo) repeat to 3 sts before M1, k2, k1tbl, slm, k1tbl, k2, (k4, k2tog, yo, k5, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo) repeat to 3 sts before Mbor, k2, k1tbl, slm.

□ **R20 (RS)** : repeat R16.

□ **R21 (RS)** : k1tbl, k2, (k3, k2tog, yo, k7, yo, k3tog, yo, k1) repeat to 3 sts before M1, k2, k1tbl, slm, k1tbl, k2, (k3, k2tog, yo, k7, yo, k3tog, yo, k1) repeat to 3 sts before Mbor, k2, k1tbl, slm.

□ **R22 (RS)** : repeat R16.

□ **R23 (RS)** : k1tbl, k2, (k2, k2tog, yo, k8, k2tog, yo, k2) repeat to 3 sts before M1, k2, k1tbl, slm, k1tbl, k2, (k2, k2tog, yo, k8, k2tog, yo, k2) repeat to 3 sts before Mbor, k2, k1tbl, slm.

□ **R24 (RS)** : repeat R16.

□ **R25 (RS)** : k1tbl, k2, (k1, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk,

k5, k2tog, yo, k3) repeat to 3 sts before M1, k2, k1tbl, slm, k1tbl, k2, (k1, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k5, k2tog, yo, k3) repeat to 3 sts before Mbor, k2, k1tbl, slm.

□ R26 (RS) : repeat R16.

□ R27 (RS) : k1tbl, k2, (k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, k3, k2tog, yo, k4) repeat to 3 sts before M1, k2, k1tbl, slm, k1tbl, k2, (k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, k3, k2tog, yo, k4) repeat to 3 sts before Mbor, k2, k1tbl, slm.

□ R28 (RS) : repeat R16.

□ R29 (RS) : k1tbl, k1, (k2tog, yo, k5, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k4) repeat to 4 sts before M1, k3, k1tbl, slm, k1tbl, k1, (k2tog, yo, k5, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k4) repeat to 4 sts before Mbor, k3, k1tbl, slm.

□ R30 (RS) : repeat R16.

□ R31 (RS) : k1tbl, k2, (k1, yo, ssk, k4, yo, k3tog, yo, k4, k2tog, yo) repeat to 3 sts before M1, k2, k1tbl, slm, k1tbl, k2, (k1, yo, ssk, k4, yo, k3tog, yo, k4, k2tog, yo) repeat to 3 sts before Mbor, k2, k1tbl, slm.

□ R32 (RS) : repeat R16.

□ R33 (RS) : k1tbl, k2, (k2, yo, ssk, k4, yo, ssk, k3, k2tog, yo, k1) repeat to 3 sts before M1, k2, k1tbl, slm, k1tbl, k2, (k2, yo, ssk, k4, yo, ssk, k3, k2tog, yo, k1) repeat to 3 sts before Mbor, k2, k1tbl, slm.

□ R34 (RS) : repeat R16.

□ R35 (RS) : k1tbl, k2, (k3, yo, ssk, k4, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k2) repeat to 3 sts before M1, k2, k1tbl, slm, k1tbl, k2, (k3, yo, ssk, k4, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k2) repeat to 3 sts before Mbor, k2, k1tbl, slm.

□ R36 (RS) : repeat R16.

□ R37 (RS) : k1tbl, k2, (k4, yo, ssk, k4, yo, k3tog, yo, k3) repeat to 3 sts before M1, k2, k1tbl, slm, k1tbl, k2, (k4, yo, ssk, k4, yo, k3tog, yo, k3) repeat to 3 sts before Mbor, k2, k1tbl, slm.

□ R38 (RS) : repeat R16.

□ R39 (RS) : k1tbl, k2, (k5, yo, ssk, k4, yo, ssk, k3) repeat to 3 sts before M1, k2, k1tbl, slm, k1tbl, k2, (k5, yo, ssk, k4, yo, ssk, k3) repeat to 3 sts before Mbor, k2, k1tbl, slm.

□ R40 (RS) : repeat R16.

□ R41 (RS) : k1tbl, k2, (k3, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k4, yo, ssk, k2) repeat to 3 sts before M1, k2, k1tbl, slm, k1tbl, k2, (k3, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k4, yo, ssk, k2) repeat to 3 sts before Mbor, k2, k1tbl, slm.

□ R42 (RS) : repeat R16.

□ R43 (RS) : k1tbl, k2, (k2, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, k4, yo, ssk, k1) repeat to 3 sts before M1, k2, k1tbl, slm, k1tbl, k2, (k2, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, k4, yo, ssk, k1) repeat to 3 sts before Mbor, k2, k1tbl, slm.

□ R44 (RS) : repeat R16.

□ R45 (RS) : k1tbl, k2, (k1, k2tog, yo, k5, yo, ssk, k4, yo, ssk) repeat to 3 sts before M1, k2, k1tbl, slm, k1tbl, k2, (k1, k2tog, yo, k5, yo, ssk, k4, yo, ssk) repeat to 3 sts before Mbor, k2, k1tbl, slm.

□ R46 (RS) : repeat R16.

□ R47 (RS) : k1tbl, k1, (k3tog, yo, k4, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k4, yo) repeat to 4 sts before M1, k3, k1tbl, slm, k1tbl, k1, (k3tog, yo, k4, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k4, yo) repeat to 4 sts before Mbor, k3, k1tbl, slm.



SECTION 4 : outer face size a.

-> For size b, skip this section and go to section 5.

-> From now on, work back and forth on the outer face first side (54 sts)

-> Turn to work on WS.

□ R48 (WS) : k3, p2tog, p to 5 sts before M1, ssp, sl3wyif. Turn to work on RS. (2 sts dec = 52 sts)

□ R49 (RS) : k6, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, k3, k2tog, yo, k4, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, k3, k2tog, yo, k4, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, k4, sl3wyif. Turn to work on WS.

□ R50 (WS) : repeat R48. (50 sts)

□ R51 (RS) : k4, k2tog, yo, k5, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k4, k2tog, yo, k5, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k4, k2tog, yo, k5, yo, ssk, k2, sl3wyif. Turn.

□ R52 (WS) : repeat R48. (48 sts)

□ R53 (RS) : k4, yo, k7, yo, k3tog, yo, k4, k2tog, yo,

k7, yo, k3tog, yo, k4, k2tog, yo, k7, k2tog, sl3wyif. Turn.

□ **R54 (WS)** : repeat R48. (46 sts)

□ **R55 (RS)** : k11, k2tog, yo, k4, k2tog, yo, k8, k2tog, yo, k4, k2tog, yo, k8, sl3wyif. Turn.

□ **R56 (WS)** : repeat R48. (44 sts)

□ **R57 (RS)** : k9, k2tog, yo, k4, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k5, k2tog, yo, k4, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k5, sl3wyif. Turn.

□ **R58 (WS)** : repeat R48. (42 sts)

□ **R59 (RS)** : k7, k2tog, yo, k4, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, k3, k2tog, yo, k4, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, k3, sl3wyif. Turn.

□ **R60 (WS)** : repeat R48. (40 sts)

□ **R61 (RS)** : k5, k2tog, yo, k4, k2tog, yo, k5, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k4, k2tog, yo, k5, yo, ssk, k1, sl3wyif. Turn.

□ **R62 (WS)** : repeat R48. (38 sts)

□ **R63 (RS)** : k3, k2tog, yo, k4, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k4, yo, k3tog, yo, k4, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k5, sl3wyif. Turn.

□ **R64 (WS)** : repeat R48. (36 sts)

□ **R65 (RS)** : k7, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, k4, yo, ssk, k3, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, k3, sl3wyif. Turn.

□ **R66 (WS)** : repeat R48. (34 sts)

□ **R67 (RS)** : k5, k2tog, yo, k5, yo, ssk, k4, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k5, yo, ssk, k1, sl3wyif. Turn.

□ **R68 (WS)** : repeat R48. (32 sts)

□ **R69 (RS)** : k3, k2tog, yo, k7, yo, ssk, k4, yo, k3tog, yo, k8, sl3wyif. Turn.

□ **R70 (WS)** : repeat R48. (30 sts)

□ **R71 (RS)** : k12, yo, ssk, k4, yo, ssk, k7, sl3wyif. Turn.

□ **R72 (WS)** : repeat R48. (28 sts)

□ **R73 (RS)** : k9, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k4, yo, ssk, k5, sl3wyif. Turn.

□ **R74 (WS)** : repeat R48. (26 sts)

□ **R75 (RS)** : k7, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, k4, yo, ssk, k3, sl3wyif. Turn.

□ **R76 (WS)** : repeat R48. (24 sts)

□ **R77 (RS)** : k5, k2tog, yo, k5, yo, ssk, k4, yo, ssk, k1, sl3wyif. Turn.

□ **R78 (WS)** : repeat R48. (22 sts)

□ **R79 (RS)** : k9, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k5, sl3wyif. Turn.

□ **R80 (WS)** : repeat R48. (20 sts)

-> Cut A and put these sts on hold.

-> Take back the outer face second side sts (54 sts) and join A.

-> Repeat R48 to R80 reversing M1 and Mbor indications :

SECTION 5 : outer face size b.

-> For size a, skip this section and go to section 6.

-> From now on, work back and forth on the outer face first side (70 sts)

-> Turn to work on WS.

□ **R48 (WS)** : k3, p2tog, p to 5 sts before M1, ssp, sl3wyif. Turn on the work RS. (2 sts dec = 68 sts)

R49 (RS) : k6, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, k3, k2tog, (yo, k4, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, k3, k2tog) 2 times, yo, k4, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, k4, sl3wyif. Turn.

R50 (WS) : repeat R48. (66 sts)

R51 (RS) : (k4, k2tog, yo, k5, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo) 3 times, k4, k2tog, yo, k5, yo, ssk, k2, sl3wyif. Turn.

R52 (WS) : repeat R48. (64 sts)

R53 (RS) : k4, yo, k7, yo, k3tog, yo, k1, (k3, k2tog, yo, k7, yo, k3tog, yo, k1) 2 times, k3, k2tog, yo, k7, k2tog, sl3wyif. Turn.

R54 (WS) : repeat R48. (62 sts)

R55 (RS) : k11, k2tog, yo, k2, (k2, k2tog, yo, k8, k2tog, yo, k2) 2 times, k2, k2tog, yo, k8, sl3wyif. Turn.

R56 (WS) : repeat R48. (60 sts)

R57 (RS) : k9, k2tog, yo, k3, (k1, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k5, k2tog, yo, k3) 2 times, k1, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k5, sl3wyif. Turn.

R58 (WS) : repeat R48. (58 sts)

R59 (RS) : k7, k2tog, yo, k4, (k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, k3, k2tog, yo, k4) 2 times, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, k3, sl3wyif. Turn.

R60 (WS) : repeat R48. (56 sts)

R61 (RS) : k5, k2tog, yo, k4, (k2tog, yo, k5, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k4) 2 times, k2tog, yo, k5, yo, ssk, k1, sl3wyif. Turn.

R62 (WS) : repeat R48. (54 sts)

R63 (RS) : k3, k2tog, yo, k4, k2tog, yo, (k1, yo, ssk, k4, yo, k3tog, yo, k4, k2tog, yo) 2 times, k1, yo, ssk, k5, sl3wyif. Turn.

R64 (WS) : repeat R48. (52 sts)

R65 (RS) : k7, k2tog, yo, k1, (k2, yo, ssk, k4, yo, ssk, k3, k2tog, yo, k1) 2 times, k2, yo, ssk, k3, sl3wyif. Turn.

R66 (WS) : repeat R48. (50 sts)

R67 (RS) : k5, k2tog, yo, k2, (k3, yo, ssk, k4, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k2) 2 times, k3, yo, ssk, k1, sl3wyif. Turn.

R68 (WS) : repeat R48. (48 sts)

R69 (RS) : k3, k2tog, yo, k3, (k4, yo, ssk, k4, yo, k3tog, yo, k3) 2 times, k5, sl3wyif. Turn.

R70 (WS) : repeat R48. (46 sts)

R71 (RS) : k7, (k5, yo, ssk, k4, yo, ssk, k3) 2 times, k4, sl3wyif. Turn.

R72 (WS) : repeat R48. (44 sts)

R73 (RS) : k6, (k3, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k4, yo, ssk, k2) 2 times, k3, sl3wyif. Turn.

R74 (WS) : repeat R48. (42 sts)

R75 (RS) : k5, (k2, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, k4, yo, ssk, k1) 2 times, k2, sl3wyif. Turn.

R76 (WS) : repeat R48. (40 sts)

R77 (RS) : k4, (k1, k2tog, yo, k5, yo, ssk, k4, yo, ssk) 2 times, k1, sl3wyif. Turn.

R78 (WS) : repeat R48. (38 sts)

R79 (RS) : k3, k2tog, yo, k4, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k4, yo, k3tog, yo, k4, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k5, sl3wyif. Turn.

R80 (WS) : repeat R48. (36 sts)

-> Cut A and put these sts on hold.

-> Take back the outer face second side sts (70 sts) and join A.



SECTION 6 : inner face

-> Turn the work inside out and take back the a.96 / b.128 sts B on the second needle set. Start where yarn B is.




□ **R81 (RS)** : with B CO 2 sts, PM1, CO 2 sts, k a.48 / b.64 sts, CO 2 sts, PMbor. (6 sts inc : a.102 sts / b.134 sts)

□ **R82 (RS)** : CO 2 sts, k to M1, slm, k to Mbor, slm. (2 sts inc : a.104 sts / b.136 sts)

□ **R83 (RS)** : k1tbl, k to 1 st before M1, k1tbl, slm, k1tbl, k to 1 st before Mbor, k1tbl slm.


-> Repeat R83 until you reach the same length as the outer face :



SECTION 7 : close the pouch

-> Turn the two faces inside out. Put half of the stitches B (a. 52 sts / b. 68 sts) on 1 needle and the other half (a. 52 sts / b. 68 sts) on the other needle, RM1 and RMbor.

-> Reverse the needle direction of stitches A :




-> Knit with three needles: with B and 2.75 mm / 2 US needles, knit together the first two stitches B on each needle. Repeat on the next 15 stitches B.



-> Knit with five needles: with B and 2.75 mm / 2 US needles, knit together the first four stitches of each needle B and A. Repeat on the following a.19 / b.35 stitches A and B.



-> Knit with three needles: with B and 2.75 mm / 2 US needles, knit together the first two stitches B on each needle. Repeat on the last 15 stitches B.




16 sts with 3 needles a.20 sts / b.36 sts with 5 needles 16 sts with 3 needles

-> Bind off and block the pouch to the right dimensions :
a. 6 x 6 " / 15 x 15 cm, **b.** 8 x 6 " / 20 x 15 cm
