Introduction

BAGGU Pouch N°3 is first knitted flat, then by knitting the sides you will give it its final shape. The small squares in the pattern are there to help you count the rows.

Size

Unique size : width 13 cm / 5" x height 14 cm / 5.5" x depth 6.5 cm / 2.4"

Gauge

Stockinette sts blocked 10 x 10 cm / 4 x 4" with 2.25 mm / 1 US needles = 32 sts x 48 rows

Material

Yarns : Yarns used for the sample, fingering weight :

- **Color A :** Mominoki Yarn - Finnwool 100 g / 360 m / 394 yards -
Mocha : **30 g / 110 m / 120 yds**

- **Color B :** Mominoki Yarn - Finnwool 100 g / 360 m / 394 yards -
Teak : **26 g / 94 m / 103 yds**

- **Color C :** Mominoki Yarn - Silk mohair 25 g / 210 m / 230 yards -
Ashes : **12 g / 94 m / 103 yds**

Circular needles : 2.25 mm / 1 US needles. If you don't have the right gauge, it doesn't matter. The important thing is to use two identical sizes of yarn for A and B and a needle size that corresponds. You can even intentionally use heavier weight yarn to get a bigger pouch.

Notions :

- 9 markers
- 2 x 80 cm / 32" of vegetable leather cord 3x1,5mm like :
- 4 stop cord like :
- Piece of cardboard : 6.5 x 36.5 cm / 2.4 x 14.15" 1mm thick
- 2 x 2m50 / 2 x 3 yds of contrasting fingering yarn



Abbreviations

CO : Cast on.

R : Row

RS : Right Side.

WS : Wrong Side.

inc : Increase.

dec : Decrease.

k : Knit.

p : Purl.

A : yarn color A.

B : yarn color B.

C : yarn color C.

BC : yarn B and C held together.

M : Marker.

PM : Place marker.

slm : Slip marker.

sl3wyif : Slip 3 sts purlwise with yarn in front.

sl1wyif : Slip 1 st purlwise with yarn in front.

sl1wyib : Slip 1 st purlwise with yarn in back.

TFL : Through the front loop.

TBL : Through the back loop.

p1tbl : Purl 1 st through the back loop.

sl : Slip purlwise.

sl1 : Slip 1 st purlwise.

k2togTBL : Knit 2 sts together through the back loop.

p2tog : Purl 2 sts together.

M1L : Make one Left : With the left needle, take the horizontal strand between the two stitches from front to back, then knit this stitch through the back loop.



M1Rp : Make one Right : With the left needle, take the horizontal strand between the two stitches from back to front, then purl this stitch through the front loop.

ssp : Slip, slip, purl : slip the first stitch knitwise, slip the second stitch knitwise, put the 2 sts back on the left needle then purl them together through the back loop.

m1 : Make one : Make a new st with the backloop method.

Construction


-> Start knitting the pattern chart, If you prefer text, go to R4 :



- Knit on RS and purl on WS
- Purl on RS and knit on WS
- sl1wyif
- sl1wyib

Section 1 : outer pouch base

I-Cord CAST-ON : With A CO 3 sts, (put these 3 sts back on left needle, k3) repeat 25 times. With the 3 sts on the right needle, turn the work 90°, pick up and knit 24 sts along the I-Cord edge. Turn the work 90° again, pick up and knit 1 st along the I-Cord CO edge (28 sts)

- R1 (WS) :** k3, sl1wyif, p to 3 sts before end, sl3wyif.
- R2 (RS) :** k3, sl1wyib, make a lateral braid : (k the second st TBL k the first st TFL, then drop them both from the left needle, slip the last st back to the left needle, repeat to 5 sts before end), k the second st TBL, k the first st TFL, then drop them both from the left needle, sl3wyif.
- R3 (WS) :** k3, sl1wyif, p1tbl to 4 sts before end, p1, sl3wyif.

- R4 (RS) :** k3, sl1wyib, (k9, p1) repeat to 4 sts before the end, k1, sl3wyif.
- R5 (WS) :** k3, sl1wyif, (p1, k1, p7, k1) repeat to 4 sts before end, p1, sl3wyif.
- R6 (RS) :** k3, sl1wyib, (p2, k5, p1, k2) repeat to 4 sts before the end, k1, sl3wyif.
- R7 (WS) :** k3, sl1wyif, (p3, k1, p3, k3) repeat to 4 sts before end, p1, sl3wyif.
- R8 (RS) :** k3, sl1wyib, (p4, k1, p1, k4) repeat to 4 sts before the end, k1, sl3wyif.
- R9 (WS) :** k3, sl1wyif, (p5, k5) repeat to 4 sts before end, p1, sl3wyif.
- R10 (RS) :** k3, sl1wyib, (p4, k6) repeat to 4 sts before the end, k1, sl3wyif.
- R11 (WS) :** k3, sl1wyif, (p7, k3) repeat to 4 sts before end, p1, sl3wyif.
- R12 (RS) :** k3, sl1wyib, (p2, k8) repeat to 4 sts before the end, k1, sl3wyif.
- R13 (WS) :** k3, sl1wyif, (p9, k1) repeat to 4 sts before end, p1, sl3wyif.
- R14 (RS) :** k3, sl1wyib, (k1, p1, k7, p1) repeat to 4 sts before the end, k1, sl3wyif.

□ **R15 (WS)** : k3, sl1wyif, (k2, p5, k1, p2) repeat to 4 sts before end, p1, sl3wyif.

□ **R16 (RS)** : k3, sl1wyib, (k3, p1, k3, p3) repeat to 4 sts before the end, k1, sl3wyif.

□ **R17 (WS)** : k3, sl1wyif, (k4, p1, k1, p4) repeat to 4 sts before end, p1, sl3wyif.

□ **R18 (RS)** : k3, sl1wyib, (k5, p5) repeat to 4 sts before the end, k1, sl3wyif.

□ **R19 (WS)** : k3, sl1wyif, (k4, p6) repeat to 4 sts before end, p1, sl3wyif.

□ **R20 (RS)** : k3, sl1wyib, (k7, p3) repeat to 4 sts before the end, k1, sl3wyif.

□ **R21 (WS)** : k3, sl1wyif, (k2, p8) repeat to 4 sts before end, p1, sl3wyif.

-> Repeat from R4 to R21 9 more times :

-> Repeat R2 and R3 1 time :

□ **R22 (RS)** : k2, sl1 knit-wise, sl1 purl-wise, knit these two slipped sts together, put the 3 stitches back on the left needle, k3, put the 3 stitches back on the left needle, k2, sl1 knit-wise, sl1 purl-wise, knit these two slipped stitches together, put the 3 stitches back on the left needle, (k2, k2togTBL, put the 3 sts back on the left needle) repeat to 3 sts left and connect them to the 3 stitches of the left I-cord edge.

Section 2 : inner pouch base

I-Cord CAST-ON : Proceed in the same way as « I-Cord cast-on section 1 » but this time use yarn B.

-> Repeat R1, R2 and R3 from section 1 :

R1 : □

□ **R23 (RS)** : k3, sl1wyib, k to 3 sts before the end, sl3wyif.

□ **R24 (WS)** : k3, sl1wyif, p to 3 sts before end, sl3wyif.

-> Repeat R23 and R24 until you get the same number of rows as for section 1.

-> Repeat R2 and R3 1 time :

R2 : □

-> Repeat R22 1 time : □

-> Block the two parts to the same dimensions : 8 cm x 38 cm / 3.15 x 15".

Section 3 : assembly

-> Cut out a piece of cardboard : 6.5 x 36.5 cm / 2.4 x 14.15" 1mm thick and give it a rounded shape as in the photo helping yourself with a table edge :



-> With a 2m50 / 2.2 yds leftover of contrasting yarn and a tapestry needle, join the two lengths of the pouch bases :



-> Let the cardboard aside and place the two wrong sides of the pouch bases facing each other.



-> Use the slipped stitch border to help you know where to insert the tapestry needle.



-> Make 93 rings of contrastant yarn along the first length. Keep 25 cm / 10" of contrasting yarn at the end to close the short side later.

-> Proceed in the same way for the other length and keep the ends open.



Section 4 : sides



-> Place the 93 rings from the first length on your working needles, the pouch base 1 facing you.



-> With B and C held together CO2 on your right needle.

□ **R25 (RS)** : with BC k the first 2 rings, (m1, k the next 4 rings) 22 times, m1, k3, CO2. (27 sts inc : 120 sts)

□ **R26 (WS)** : p20, PM, (p10, PM) 8 times, p to 3 sts before end, sl3wyif.

□ **R27 (RS)** : k6, yo, k2tog, (k to 1 st before M, sl1, slm, ssk) 4 times, k to 1 st before M, sl1, slm, sl1, (k to 2 sts before M, k2tog, slm, sl1) 4 times, k to 8 sts before end, k2tog, yo, k3, sl3wyif. (8 sts dec : 112 sts)

□ **R28 (WS)** : k3, p to 3 sts before end slipping all markers, sl3wyif.

□ **R29 (RS)** : (k to 1 st before M, sl1, slm, ssk) 4 times, k to 1 st before M, sl1, slm, sl1, (k to 2 sts before M, k2tog, slm, sl1) 4 times, k to 3 sts before end, sl3wyif. (8 sts dec : 104 sts)

□ **R30 (WS)** : k3, p to 3 sts before end slipping all markers, sl3wyif.

-> Repeat R29 to R30 2 more times :
R29 (RS) : □ (96) □ (88)
R30 (WS) : □ □

-> Repeat R27 1 time : □ (80)

-> Repeat R30 1 time : □

-> Repeat R29 to R30 2 more times :
R29 (RS) : □ (72) □ (64)
R30 (WS) : □ □

□ **R31 (RS)** : k6, yo, k2tog, k to 1 st before M, (sl1, slm, ssk) 4 times, sl1, slm, sl1, (k2tog, slm, sl1) 4 times, k to 8 sts before end, k2tog, yo, k3, sl3wyif. (8 sts dec : 56 sts)

-> Repeat R30 1 time : □

□ **R32 (RS)** : k to 1 st before M, sl1, slm, (ssk, RM) 3 times, ssk, slm, (k2tog, RM) 3 times, k2tog, slm, sl1, k to 3 sts before end, sl3wyif. (8 sts dec : 48 sts + 3 markers)


-> Repeat R30 1 time : □

□ **R33 (RS)** : k to 1 st before M, sl1, RM, ssk 2 times, slm, k2tog 2 times, RM, sl1, k to 3 sts before end, sl3wyif. (4 sts dec : 44 sts + 1 halfway marker)

-> Repeat R30 1 time : □



-> Divide the stitches in two halves and place them on each needle. Remove the last marker.



-> On the wrong side, the 2 right sides facing each other, bind off these sts with the 3 needles method :

-> (If you don't have a third needle 2.25 mm / 1 US, use size 2 mm / 0 US or 2.5 mm / 1.5 US). With this third needle, knit the first two stitches on each needle together, (with the third needle, knit the first two stitches on each needle together then, on the right needle, pass the first knitted st over the last knitted st to bind off) repeat to the end, cut BC and pass the yarns through the last st.

-> Repeat the process for the other side.

Section 5 : finishes

-> Wave in ends and slide the cardboard between the two pouch bases.



-> Close the ends with the contrasting yarn, making rings as for the lengths.
