FALL FESTIVAL ACORNS

DESCRIPTION:

Knit acorns to accompany your knit leaves and pumpkins. Using just one Fall Festival bundle, you can create colorful décor for everyone's favorite season.

EXPERIENCE LEVEL:

ADVANCED BEGINNER

GAUGE:

In stockinette st, 6 sts and 7 rows = 1"

SIZES:

ONE

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS:

CIRCUMFERENCE: 4" after stuffing

HEIGHT: 3" including stem

MATERIALS:

YARN:

WOOLSTOK (WORSTED) BUNDLE

(100% Fine Highland Wool, 21 mini hanks; 5g/12yds):
1 bundle (Fall Festival)

NEEDLES:

SIZE 6 (4mm) double pointed needles, or size needed
to obtain gauge

MOSSY GREEN

OTHER TOOLS:

Stuffing & tapestry needle.

NOTES

Pattern is written for solid acorn. Add color work as desired using photos as inspiration. One mini hank will make one complete acorn.

STEP NO. 1:

ACORN

ACORN NUT

With 1 dpn, CO 3 sts.

RND 1: slide sts to other end of needle, k3. (as if working i-cord)

RND 2: Divide onto 3 dpns as follows; (1st) kfb, (2nd) kfb, (3rd) kfb. (6 sts)

RND 3: k.

RND 4: *k1, LLI, RLI, k1; rep from * to end. (12 sts)

RND 5: k.

RND 6: * k1, LLI, k2, RLI, k1; rep from * to end. (18 sts)

RND 7: k.

RND 8: * k1, LLI, k4, RLI, k1; rep from * to end. (24 sts)

RNDS 9-12: k.

RND 13: k. (these rnds will be under acorn cap, change colors if desired)

RND 14: *k2, k2tog; rep from * to end. (18 sts)

RND 15: *k1, k2tog; rep from * to end. (12 sts)

RND 16: *k2tog, rep from * to end. (6 sts)

Cut yarn leaving 8" tail, thread through rem sts but do not close. Weave in ends (if necessary inside nut), stuff then pull to close.

ACORN CAP

CO 21 sts, divide evenly onto 3 dpns.

RND 1: [(k1, p1) 3 times, kfb] 3 times. (24 sts)

RND 2: *p1, k1; rep from * to end.

RND 3: *k1, p1; rep from * to end.

Rep last 2 rnds once more, then rnd 2 one more time.

RND 7: *k1, p1, p2tog; rep from * to end. (18 sts)

RND 8: *p1, k2tog; rep from * to end. (12 sts)

RND 9: *p2tog; rep from * to end. (6 sts)

RND 10: *p2tog; rep from * to end. (3 sts)

RNDS 11-15: place 3 sts on 1 dpn, work 3 sts purl l-cord.

Cut yarn. Using tapestry ndl, thread end through rem sts, pull tight and tie off to secure. Weave in ends.

STEP NO. 2:

FINISHING

Weave in ends. Block as desired.

STEP NO. 3:

CARE

Hand wash or dry clean. Wash in tepid water using a mild soap. Do not twist. Shape and dry flat on a towel.
Store folded, do not hang.

SPECIAL METHODS

3-STITCH PURL I-CORD:

ROW 1 (RS): p3; do not turn. Slide 3 sts to other end of needle.

Rep Row 1 until i-cord is desired length.

ABBREVIATIONS

CO: cast on
dec: decrease
dpns: double pointed needles
k: knit
k2tog: knit 2 stitches together
kfb: knit into the front and back of
stitch
LLI (left lifted increase): Insert the
left needle into the stitch two
rows below the last stitch on the
right needle from back to front.
Knit through the back loop.
ndl(s): needle(s)

p: purl
p2tog: purl 2 stitches together
rem: remaining
rep: repeat
RLI (right lifted increase): Insert the
right needle into the stitch one
row below the next stitch on the
left needle. Place this stitch
onto the left needle and knit.
rnd(s): round(s)
st(s): stitch(es)
*: repeat the directions between
the asterisks as many times as
indicated
