DESCRIPTION:

Create your own colorful fungi using just one Fall Festival bundle. Knit them with simple color changes at the cap, solid, or add stripes and make them unique. Each mushroom can be your own distinct combination.

EXPERIENCE LEVEL:

ADVANCED BEGINNER

GAUGE:

In stockinette st, 6 sts and 7 rows = 1"

SIZES:

SMALL, MEDIUM, LARGE

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS:

SMALL CIRCUMFERENCE: approx 5½" after stuffing at largest area

SMALL HEIGHT: approx 3"

MEDIUM CIRCUMFERENCE: 7¾" after stuffing at largest area

MEDIUM HEIGHT: approx 3½"

LARGE CIRCUMFERENCE: 9" after stuffing at largest area

LARGE HEIGHT: approx 4 ¼"

MATERIALS:

YARN:

WOOLSTOK (WORSTED) BUNDLE

(100% Fine Highland Wool, 21 mini hanks; 5g/12yds):
1 bundle (Fall Festival)

NEEDLES:

SIZE 6 (4mm) double pointed needles, or size needed to obtain gauge

OTHER TOOLS:

Stitch marker(s) in contrasting colors, tapestry needle & stuffing.

NOTES

All mushrooms are knit from the bottom up, weaving in ends as you go.

Our stems have been filled with plastic pellets and the tops with fiber fill, stuffed as desired.

Grams used per mushroom:

SMALL: approx 8 grams

MEDIUM: approx 10 grams

LARGE: approx 15 grams

STEP NO. 1:

MUSHROOMS

SMALL MUSHROOM

STEM

CO 6 sts. Divide onto 3 dpns evenly and join in the rnd being careful not to twist sts.

RND 1: k.

RND 2: *k1, LLl; rep from * to end of rnd. (12 sts)

RNDS 3: k.

RND 4: *k2, LLl; rep from * to end of rnd. (18 sts)

RND 5: k.

RND 6: *k1, k2tog; rep from * to end of rnd. (12 sts)

RND 7: k.

RND 8: *k2, k2tog; rep from * to end. (9 sts)

RNDS 9: k.

RIBS

RND 10: *kfb; rep from * to end of rnd. (18 sts)

RND 11: *k1, p1; rep from * to end of rnd.

RND 12: *k1, p1, M1P; rep from * to end of rnd. (27 sts)

RND 13: *k1, p2; rep from * to end of rnd.

CAP (CHANGE COLOR IF DESIRED)

RND 14: *k1, LLI, k2; rep from * to end of rnd. (36 sts)

RND 15: p.

RNDS 16-17: k.

RND 18: *k2, k2tog; rep from * to end of rnd. (27 sts)

RNDS 19-20: k.

RND 21: *k1, k2tog; rep from * to end of rnd. (18 sts)

RNDS 22-23: k.

RND 24: *k1, k2tog; rep from * to end of rnd. (12 sts)

RNDS 25-26: k.

RND 18: *k2tog; rep from * to end of rnd. (6 sts)

See finishing instructions.

MEDIUM MUSHROOM

STEM

CO 6 sts. Divide onto 3 dpns evenly and join in the rnd being careful not to twist sts.

RND 1: k.

RND 2: *k1, LLI; rep from * to end of rnd. (12 sts)

RND 3: k.

RND 4: *k2, LLI; rep from * to end of rnd. (18 sts)

RND 5: k.

RND 6: *k3, LLI; rep from * to end of rnd. (24 sts)

RNDS 7-9: k.

RND 10: *k4, k2tog; rep from * to end of rnd. (20 sts)

RNDS 11-13: k.

RND 14: *k3, k2tog; rep from * to end of rnd. (16 sts)

RNDS 15-17: k.

RND 18: *k2, k2tog; rep from * to end of rnd. (12 sts)

RNDS 19-21: k.

RIBS

RND 22: *kfb; rep from * to end of rnd. (24 sts)

RND 23: *k1, p1; rep from * to end of rnd.

RND 24: *k1, p1, M1P; rep to end of rnd. (36 sts)

RND 25: *k1, p2; rep from * to end of rnd.

RND 26: *k1, p2, M1P; rep to end of rnd. (48 sts)

CAP (CHANGE COLOR IF DESIRED)

RNDS 27-31: k.

RND 32: *k2, k2tog; rep from * to end of rnd. (36 sts)

RNDS 33-35: k.

RND 36: *k1, k2tog; rep from * to end of rnd. (24 sts)

RNDS 37-39: k.

RND 40: *k2tog; rep from * to end of rnd. (12 sts)

RND 41: *k2tog; rep from * to end of rnd. (6 sts)

See finishing instructions.

LARGE MUSHROOM

STEM

CO 6 sts. Divide onto 3 dpns evenly and join in the rnd being careful not to twist sts.

RND 1: k.

RND 2: *k1, LLI; rep from * to end of rnd. (12 sts)

RND 3: k.

RND 4: *k2, LLI; rep from * to end of rnd. (18 sts)

RND 5: k.

RND 6: *k3, LLI; rep from * to end of rnd. (24 sts)

RND 7: k.

RND 8: *k4, LLI; rep from * to end. (30 sts)

RNDS 9-13: k.

BLUE SKY FIBERS

RND 14: *k3, k2tog; rep from * to end of rnd. (24 sts)

RNDS 15-17: k.

RND 18: *k2, k2tog; rep from * to end of rnd. (18 sts)

RNDS 19-21: k.

RND 22: *k1, k2tog; rep from * to end of rnd. (12 sts)

RND 23-25: k.

RIBS (CHANGE COLOR IF DESIRED)

RND 26: *kfb; rep from * to end of rnd. (24 sts)

RND 27: *k1, p1; rep from * to end of rnd.

RND 28: *k1, p1, M1P; rep from * to end of rnd. (36 sts)

RND 29: *k1, p2; rep from * to end of rnd.

RND 30: *k1, p2, M1P; rep from * to end of rnd. (48 sts)

RND 31: *k1, p3; rep from * to end of rnd.

RND 32: *k1, p3, M1P; rep from * to end of rnd. (60 sts)

RND 33: *k1, p4; rep from * to end of rnd.

RND 34: *k1, p4, M1P; rep from * to end of rnd. (72 sts)

RND 35: *k1, p5; rep from * to end of rnd.

CAP (CHANGE COLOR IF DESIRED)

RND 36: k.

RNDS 37-38: p.

RND 39: k.

RND 40: *k4, k2tog; rep from * to end of rnd. (60 sts)

RND 41: *k3, k2tog; rep from * to end of rnd. (48 sts)

RND 42: *k2, k2tog; rep from * to end of rnd. (36 sts)

RND 43: *k1, k2tog; rep from * to end of rnd. (24 sts)

RND 44: *k2tog; rep from * to end of rnd. (12 sts)

RND 45: *k2tog; rep from * to end of rnd. (6 sts)

STEP NO. 2:

FINISHING

All sizes: Cut yarn leaving 8" tail, thread through rem sts but do not close. Fill stem with plastic pellets and stuff top with fiber fill. Pull to close then weave in rem end.

STEP NO. 3:

CARE

Hand wash or dry clean. Wash in tepid water using a mild soap. Do not twist. Shape and dry flat on a towel.

ABBREVIATIONS

approx: approximately
dpns: double pointed needles
k: knit
k2tog: knit 2 stitches together
kfb: knit into the front and back of
stitch
LLI (left lifted increase): insert left
needle into top of stitch one row
below first stitch on right
needle; knit this loop
M1P (make one purlwise): insert left
needle from back to front under
strand between last stitch worked
and next stitch on left needle;
purl this loop through the front

ndl(s): needle(s)
p: purl
rem: remaining
rep: repeat
rnd(s): round(s)
st(s): stitch(es)
*: repeat the directions between
the asterisks as many times as
indicated
