EXPERIENCE LEVEL

- Intermediate

MATERIALS

- Woolstok (Worsted) Bundle (100% Fine Highland Wool, 21 mini hanks: 5g/12yds each): 1 bundle (Fall Festival)
- Size 6 (4mm) needles, or size needed to obtain gauge
- Size 6 (4mm) double pointed needles, or size needed to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle

SIZE

- One

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

- Birch: 4¼" height by 3" width
 - Maple: 3½" height by 4½" width
 - Oak: 4¾" height by 3½" width
- Height does not include stem

GAUGE

In garter stitch, 20 sts and 18 rows = 4"

ABBREVIATIONS

BO:	bind off
CO:	cast on
FO:	fasten off
k:	knit
k2tog:	knit 2 stitches together

LLI (left lifted increase): insert left needle
into top of stitch one row below first stitch on
right needle; knit this loop

M1L (make one left): insert left needle from front
to back under strand between last stitch worked
and next stitch on left needle; knit this loop
through the back

M1R (make one right): insert left needle from back
to front under strand between last stitch
worked and next stitch on left needle; knit this
loop through the front

p: purl

pso: pass stitch over

RLI (right lifted increase): insert right needle
into top of stitch one row below next stitch on
left needle, knit this loop

RS: right side

s2kp2: slip 2 stitches knitwise as if to knit 2
together, k1, pass 2 slipped stitches over the
knit stitch

sk2p: slip 1 stitch knitwise, knit 2 stitches
together, pass the slipped stitch over the 2
stitches knit together

ssk (slip, slip, knit): slip 2 stitches separately
knitwise, insert left needle in front of 2
slipped stitches, knit 2 slipped stitches
together

st(s): stitch(es)

WS: wrong side

NOTES: Leave short (3") tail when casting on. When Binding Off, slip the first stitch without working it. One leaf can be completed using 1 mini. If you run short due to gauge or want longer stems use another mini to complete.

CO 9 sts.

ROW 1 (WS): k4, p1, k4.

ROW 2 (RS): k1, LLI, k to last st, RLI, k1. (11 sts)

ROW 3: k5, p1, k5.

ROW 4: k1, LLI, k to last st, RLI, k1. (13 sts)

ROW 5: k6, p1, k6.

ROW 6: k1, LLI, k to last st, RLI, k1. (15 sts)

ROW 7: k7, p1, k7.

ROW 8: k1, LLI, k to last st, RLI, k1. (17 sts)

ROW 9: k8, p1, k8.



ROW 10: k1, LLI, k to last st, RLI, k1. (19 sts)

ROW 11: k9, p1, k9.

ROW 12: k1, ssk, k to the last 3 sts, k2tog, k1. (17 sts)

ROW 13: k8, p1, k8.

ROW 14: k to end.

ROW 15: k8, p1, k8.

ROW 16: k1, ssk, k to the last 3 sts, k2tog, k1. (15 sts)

ROW 17: k7, p1, k7.

ROW 18: k to end.

ROW 19: k7, p1, k7.

ROW 20: k1, ssk, k to the last 3 sts, k2tog, k1. (13 sts)

ROW 21: k6, p1, k6.

ROW 22: k to end.

ROW 23: k6, p1, k6.

ROW 24: k1, ssk, k to the last 3 sts, k2tog, k1. (11 sts)

ROW 25: k5, p1, k5.

ROW 26: k to end.

ROW 27: k5, p1, k5.

ROW 28: k1, ssk, k to the last 3 sts, k2tog, k1. (9 sts)

ROW 29: k4, p1, k4.

ROW 30: k to end.

ROW 31: k4, p1, k4.

ROW 32: k1, ssk, k to the last 3 sts, k2tog, k1. (7 sts)

ROW 33: k3, p1, k3.

ROW 34: k to end.

ROW 35: k3, p1, k3.

ROW 36: k1, ssk, k to the last 3 sts, k2tog, k1. (5 sts)

ROW 37: k2, p1, k2.

ROW 38: ssk, k1, k2tog. (3 sts)

ROW 39: k3.

ROW 40: sk2p. (1 st)

FO last st.

MAPLE

CO 27 sts

ROW 1, 3, 5, 7 (WS): k6, p1, k6, p1, k6, p1, k6.

ROW 2, 4, 6 (RS): k1, RLI, k4, s2kp2, k5, M1L, k1, M1R, k5, s2kp2, k4, LLI, k1.

ROW 8: BO 5 sts, k2tog, pso, k5, M1L, k1, M1R, k5, s2kp2, k4, LLI, k1. (21 sts)

ROW 9: BO 6 st, k5, p3, k6. (15 sts)

ROW 10: k7, M1L, k1, M1R, k7. (17 sts)

ROW 11: k6, p1, k1, p1, k1, p1, k6.

ROW 12: k8, M1L, k1, M1R, k8. (19 sts)

ROW 13: k6, p1, k2, p1, k2, p1, k6.

ROW 14: k9, M1L, k1, M1R, k9. (21 sts)

ROW 15: k6, p1, k3, p1, k3, p1, k6.

ROW 16: BO 6 sts, k14. (15 sts)

ROW 17: BO 6 sts, k3, p1, k4. (9 sts)

ROW 18: ssk, k5, k2tog. (7 sts)

ROW 19: k3, p1, k3.

ROW 20: ssk, k3, k2tog. (5 sts)

ROW 21: k2, p1, k2.

ROW 22: ssk, k1, k2tog. (3 sts)

ROW 23: k3.

ROW 24: sk2p. (1 st)

CO 5 sts

ROW 1 (WS): k2, p1, k2.

ROW 2 (RS): k1, LLI, k to last st, RLI, k1. (7 sts)

ROW 3: k3, p1, k3.

ROW 4: k1, LLI, k to last st, RLI, k1. (9 sts)

ROW 5: k4, p1, k4.

ROW 6: k1, LLI, k to last st, RLI, k1. (11 sts)

ROW 7: k5, p1, k5.

ROW 8: BO 3 sts, k7. (8 sts)

ROW 9: BO 3, sts, k1, p1, k2. (5 sts)

ROW 10: CO 6 sts, k11. (11 sts)

ROW 11: CO 6 sts, k8, p1, k8. (17 sts)

ROW 12, 14: k17.

ROW 13, 15: k8, p1, k8.

ROW 16: BO 5 sts, k11. (12 sts)

ROW 17: BO 5 sts, k2, p1, k3. (7 sts)

ROW 18: CO 6 sts, k13. (13 sts)

ROW 19: CO 6 sts, k9, p1, k9. (19 sts)

ROW 20, 22: k19.

ROW 21, 23: k9, p1, k9.

ROW 24: BO 6 sts, k12. (13 sts)

ROW 25: BO 6 sts, k2, p1, k3. (7 sts)

ROW 26: CO 4 sts, k 11. (11 sts)

ROW 27: CO 4 sts, k7, p1, k7. (15 sts)

ROW 28, 30: k15.

ROW 29, 31: k7, p1, k7.

ROW 32: BO 5 sts, k9. (10 sts)

ROW 33: BO 5 sts, k1, p1, k2. (5 sts)

ROW 34: CO 2 sts, k7. (7 sts)

ROW 35: CO 2 sts, k4, p1, k4. (9 sts)

ROW 36: ssk, k to last 2 sts, k2tog. (7sts)

ROW 37: k3, p1, k3.

ROW 38: ssk, k to last 2 sts, k2tog. (5 sts)

ROW 39: k2, p1, k2.

ROW 40: ssk, k1, k2tog. (3 sts)

ROW 41: k to end.

ROW 42: sk2p. (1 st)

FO.

STEM (OPTIONAL)

Using DPN's, at stem placement pick up and k 3 sts. I-cord for 1 inch. 6 rows. FO.

FINISHING

Weave in ends. Block as desired.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS: Hand wash or dry clean. Wash in tepid water using a mild soap. Do not twist. Shape and dry flat on a towel. Store your little treasure neatly, after all, it may be a family heirloom.
