# MOUNTAIN VISTA HAT

DESIGN BY ALEXANDRA FRANKEL

DESCRIPTION:

Inspired by a mountain vista, this textured hat features a twisted-stitch cable motif emulating the peaks and ridges of the mountains. Knit with two hanks of warm and soft Woolstok, which color will be your favorite?

EXPERIENCE LEVEL:

INTERMEDIATE

GAUGE:

In cable pattern, 24½ sts and 32 rnds = 4", blocked, unstretched

SIZES:

ADULT'S S/M (L/XL)

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS:

CIRCUMFERENCE: 17¾ (19½)", unstretched

HEIGHT: 8½ (9)"

Instructions are for smallest size, with larger size in parentheses. When one number is given it applies to all sizes.

**MATERIALS:**

YARN:

WOOLSTOK (WORSTED)

(100% Fine Highland Wool, 50g/123yds): 2 hanks

NEEDLES:

SIZE 5 (3.75mm) 16" circular needle, or size needed to obtain gauge

SIZE 5 (3.75mm) double pointed needles or preferred needle for small circumference knitting, or size needed to obtain gauge

COLOR SHOWN:

RED ROCK

NO.1315

OTHER TOOLS:

Stitch marker, tapestry needle, & cable needle.

## NOTES

You may wish to place additional stitch markers between each 12-stitch chart repeat.

Change to double pointed needles when stitches no longer fit comfortably on circular needle.

This hat uses approximately 55 gram leaving enough left for an optional pom pom if desired.

STEP NO. 1:

## HAT

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With circ ndl and using Alternating Cable CO or CO of your choice, CO 108 (120) sts. Do not join.

Work one row in Twisted Rib.

Pm and join to work in the rnd, being careful not to twist sts.

Beg working in the rnd.

Work 12 (16) rnds in Twisted Rib.

Cont, following charts or written instructions.

Work rnds 1-22 of Body Pattern, then work rnds 3-20 one more time.

Work rnds 1-16 of Crown Pattern.

STEP NO. 2:

## FINISHING

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Cut yarn, leaving an 8" tail. With tapestry ndl, thread tail through rem sts and pull to close.

Weave in ends. Block as desired.

STEP NO. 3:

## CARE

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Hand wash or dry clean. Wash in tepid water using a mild soap. Do not twist. Shape and dry flat on a towel.

## STITCH PATTERNS

BODY PATTERN (MULTIPLE OF 12 STS):

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RND 1: \*k1tbl, p1, 1/1 LPT, [k1tbl, p1] two times, k1tbl, 1/1 RPT, p1; rep from \* to end.

RND 2: \*k1tbl, p2, \*[k1tbl] two times, p1, k1tbl, p1, \*[k1tbl] two times, p2; rep from \* to end.

RND 3: \*k1tbl, p2, 1/1 LPT, p1, k1tbl, p1, 1/1 RPT, p2; rep from \* to end.

RND 4: \*k1tbl, p3, [k1tbl, p1] two times, k1tbl, p3; rep from \* to end.

RND 5: \*k1tbl, p3, 1/1 LPT, k1tbl, 1/1 RPT, p3; rep from \* to end.

RND 6: \*k1tbl, p4, [k1tbl] three times, p4; rep from \* to end.

RNDS 7 AND 8: \*[k1tbl] two times, [p4, k1tbl] two times; rep from \* to end.

RND 9: \*p1, 1/1 LPT, p7, 1/1 RPT; rep from \* to end.

RND 10: \*p2, k1tbl, p7, k1tbl, p1; rep from \* to end.

RND 11: \*p2, 1/1 LPT, p5, 1/1 RPT, p1; rep from \* to end.

RND 12: \*p3, k1tbl, p5, k1tbl, p2; rep from \* to end.

RND 13: \*p3, 1/1 LPT, p3, 1/1 RPT, p2; rep from \* to end.

RND 14: \*p4, [k1tbl, p3] two times; rep from \* to end.

RND 15: \*k1tbl, p3, 1/1 LPT, p1, 1/1 RPT, p3; rep from \* to end.

RND 16: \*k1tbl, p4, k1tbl, p1, k1tbl, p4; rep from \* to end.

RNDS 17 AND 18: repeat rnds 7 and 8.

RND 19: \*k1tbl, 1/1 LPT, p3, k1tbl, p3, 1/1 RPT; rep from \* to end.

RND 20: \*k1tbl, p1, [k1tbl, p3] two times, k1tbl, p1; rep from \* to end.

RND 21: \*k1tbl, p1, 1/1 LPT, p2, k1tbl, p2, 1/1 RPT, p1; rep from \* to end.

RND 22: \*k1tbl, p2; rep from \* to end.

CROWN PATTERN (MULTIPLE OF 12 STS):

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RND 1: \*k1tbl, p1, 1/1 LPT, p2, k1tbl, p2, 1/1 RPT, p1; rep from \* to end

RND 2 (DEC RND): \*k1tbl, ssp, 1/1 LPT, p1, k1tbl, p1, 1/1 RPT, p2tog; rep from \* to end. [90 (100) sts rem]

RND 3: \*k1tbl, p2, 1/1 LPT, k1tbl, 1/1 RPT, p2; rep from \* to end.

RND 4: \*k1tbl, p4; rep from \* to end.

RND 5 (DEC RND): \*k1tbl, ssp, p2, k1tbl, p2, p2tog; rep from \* to end. [72 (80) sts rem]

RNDS 6 AND 7: \*k1tbl, p7; rep from \* to end.

RND 8 (DEC RND): \*k1tbl, ssp, p3, p2tog; rep from \* to end. [54 (60) sts rem]

RNDS 9 AND 10: \*k1tbl, p5; rep from \* to end.

RND 11 (DEC RND): \*k1tbl, ssp, p1, p2tog; rep from \* to end. [36 (40) sts rem]

RNDS 12 AND 13: \*k1tbl, p3; rep from \* to end.

RND 14 (DEC RND): \*k1tbl, p3tog; rep from \* to end. [18 (20) sts rem]

RND 15: \*k1tbl, p1; rep from \* to end.

RND 16 (DEC RND): \*Half-Twisted SSK; rep from \* to end. [9 (10) sts rem]

TWISTED RIB (MULTIPLE OF 2 STS):

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EVERY RND: \*k1tbl, p1; rep from \* to end.

## SPECIAL METHODS

ALTERNATING CABLE CO:

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Place a slip knot on left needle; insert right needle through slip knot knitwise, wrap yarn around right needle, pull loop through, place loop on left needle (2 stitches on left needle); \*insert right needle from back to front between first and second stitches on left needle, wrap yarn around needle, pull loop through to back, place loop on left needle (1 stitch cast on purlwise); insert right needle from front to back between first and second stitches on left needle, wrap yarn around needle, pull loop through to front, place loop on left needle (1 stitch cast on knitwise); repeat from \* to desired number of stitches.

HALF-TWISTED SSK:

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Slip 1 stitch purlwise, slip 1 stitch knitwise, insert left needle in front of 2 slipped stitches, knit 2 slipped stitches together.
